OPINION AND ORDER ON PETITIONER'S MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION

Now pending is Petitioner's Motion for Reconsideration concerning the Special Hearing request in the above case. The Petition for Special Exception for a service garage was denied, and Petitioner is not seeking reconsideration of that aspect of the final order. The motion pertains only to the modified parking plan referenced in the Special Hearing request.

Petitioner notes the gravel parking lot on site has been in existence for many years. While the lot is not paved or striped, I believe that is advantageous since it reduces the amount of impervious surface in the Liberty Reservoir watershed. As such the Motion for Reconsideration will be granted subject to the conditions and restrictions noted below.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED this <u>11th</u> day of March, 2019, by this Administrative Law Judge, that the Motion for Reconsideration be and is hereby GRANTED.

<u>OPINION AND ORDER</u>

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) for consideration of Petitions for Special Hearing and Special Exception filed on behalf of Worthington Family Properties, LLC, legal owner ("Petitioner"). The Special Hearing was filed pursuant to Section 500.7 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("BCZR") for a modified parking plan to allow parking on all lots under common ownership, to allow the existing gravel lot to remain (not durable and dustless or striped), an existing one-way drive aisle to two (2) spaces with a 90 degree parking angle of as little as 11 ft. to remain and off-street loading as it exists to remain. A Petition for Special Exception seeks approval for a service garage under BCZR Section 230.3.

Peter Worthington and landscape architect Andrew Stine attended the public hearing in support of the requests. Lawrence E. Schmidt, Esq. and Jason T. Vettori, Esq. represented Petitioner. Several neighbors attended the hearing and opposed the requests. The Petition was advertised as required by the BCZR. Substantive Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC) comments were received from the Bureau of Development Plans Review ("DPR") and the Department of Planning ("DOP"). Neither agency opposed the requests.

The subject property is approximately 1.093 acres in size and is zoned BL-CR. The

property is comprised of two (2) separate lots, one of which is improved with a one-story commercial building (approximately 2,900 sq. ft.). The other lot is unimproved and has a large gravel-covered area used for parking vehicles. The commercial building is at present leased to 3 tenants, one of which operates a business that purchases and repairs/restores used motor vehicles. The cars are stored and repaired on the subject property and are later transferred to a used car operation in Howard County known as Showtime Motors. The Office of Zoning Review considered the use as described to be a "service garage," which is permitted by special exception in the BL-CR zone. BCZR § 230.3. As discussed at the hearing the BCZR contains in Section 101.1 an expansive definition of "service garage." Even so, I do not believe the operation described at the hearing would qualify as such, and thus the petition for special exception will be denied.

As noted above, the lessee which operates the business at this site also sells used cars at a dealership on Route 40 in Ellicott City. According to the proffered testimony the tenant purchases used vehicles which are then driven or towed to this site. Photos were submitted which depicted the storage of these cars, and according to neighbors some of these vehicles remain on site for several months or more. The lessee performs mechanical and body/fender repairs on these vehicles to prepare them to be sold at the Ellicott City location.

In these circumstances I believe the subject property is being used as an adjunct to the Howard County used car sales operation. Essentially, the cars stored on the subject property constitute the "inventory" of that business which will eventually be sold to customers. All of the vehicles on the subject property are owned by the lessee and may be stored on site for an indefinite period of time. As Petitioner recognizes, the storage or parking of vehicles is the primary activity or use of the premises.

The small portion (approximately 25%) of the commercial building leased by the tenant is

not equipped with a vehicle lift, and neighbors testified repairs are performed outside or under a tent/canopy erected at the site. No evidence or testimony was presented concerning the lessee's use of the space inside the commercial building, and it would not seem as if repairs could be safely undertaken in that setting given that two other tenants operate non-automotive related businesses in the same enclosed space. In any event, it is doubtful in the circumstances of this case that small portion of the structure would qualify as a "garage" in the first instance. As such, I do not believe the use as described constitutes a service garage.

SPECIAL HEARING

In light of the denial of the petition for special exception, the petition for special hearing will be dismissed without prejudice.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED this 30th day of January, 2019, by this Administrative Law Judge, that the Petition for Special Hearing for a modified parking plan to allow parking on all lots under common ownership, to allow the existing gravel lot to remain (not durable and dustless or striped), an existing one-way drive aisle to two (2) spaces with a 90 degree parking angle of as little as 11 ft. to remain and off-street loading as it exists to remain, be and is hereby DISMISSED without prejudice.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Petition for Special Exception to approve a service garage be and is hereby DENIED.

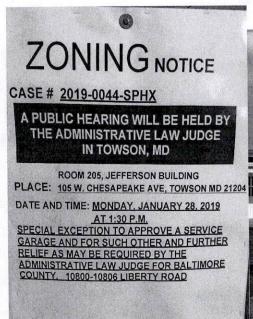

PETITIONER'S MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION

Petitioner moves for reconsideration of Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") Beverungen's above referenced Opinion and Order dated January 30, 2019. Specifically, Petitioner only seeks reconsideration of the petition for special hearing which was dismissed without prejudice.

ALJ Beverungen's "Opinion and Order" constitutes an order and Rule K of the Rules of Practice and Procedure before the Zoning Commissioner/Hearing Officer of Baltimore County clearly and unambiguously states that "[a] party may file a motion for reconsideration of an order issued by the Zoning Commissioner." The motion raises new issues of fact that would allow the special hearing relief to be granted without the special exception relief in order to avoid manifest injustice or clear error through a potential future res judicata claim. As such, the instant motion for reconsideration is being submitted.

ALJ Beverungen found that it was doubtful that the small portion of the existing structure would qualify as a "garage" and, as such, the use does not constitute a service garage. Having denied the request for special exception relief, the special hearing relief was

dismissed without prejudice and without a decision regarding the same on the merits. However, the Petitioner would still like to have the option to use the existing gravel parking lot. Having had the special exception relief denied, Petitioner has terminated the lease with the tenant for whom he was seeking special exception relief. The Petitioner would like to use the existing gravel lot as off-street parking for retail customers and employees of existing and/or future tenants of the building. The Petitioner would obviously like to lease the space within the existing structure which is being vacated to another tenant for a use which is permitted under Section 230 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("BCZR"), which lists the uses permitted by right on property zoned Business, Local ("BL"). It would be beneficial to lease the soon to be vacated space to a new tenant if that tenant and others could utilize the gravel parking area without having to file a new petition for zoning hearing to confirm that parking lot is permitted.

The Petition for Special Hearing sought a modified parking plan pursuant to BCZR § 409.12.B to allow parking on all lots under common ownership, to allow the existing gravel lot to remain (not durable and dustless or striped), an existing one-way drive aisle to two spaces with a 90 degree parking angle of as little as 11' to remain and off-street loading as it exists to remain. The first portion of the relief requested was for the existing gravel lot on the west side of the frontage of the BL zoned property. The testimony and evidence indicated that this parking area has been there for years. As illustrated on the plan to accompany the petition, there is an existing fence around said parking lot. The second portion of the relief requested was for a one-way drive aisle that is used to access two spaces adjoining the east side of the building and Allen Road which has been used for many years. Allen Road is not

time. Lastly, the relief requested sought confirmation that the off-street loading as it exists was adequate. The existing gravel parking area has always provided adequate space for off-street parking when loading was taking place for the other uses in the existing building.
