OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) for Baltimore County for consideration of Petitions for Special Hearing, Special Exception and Variance filed on behalf of Nickbiel, LLC, legal owner, and Jabber Five, Inc., lessee ("Petitioners").

The Petition for Special Hearing was filed pursuant to Section 500.7 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("BCZR") to confirm that 13 off-street parking spaces are sufficient; and (2) if necessary, to confirm the nonconforming status of four (4) parking spaces along the eastern property line. A Petition for Variance was filed: (1) to allow a freestanding ambulatory care facility to be located a minimum of 0 feet from a residential property line in lieu of the required 750 feet; and (2) to allow 13 off-street parking spaces in lieu of the required 21 parking spaces. Finally, a Petition for Special Exception was filed for a state-licensed medical clinic (freestanding ambulatory care facility for an urologist practice only).

Appearing at the public hearing in support of the requests was Dr. Robert Thompson and professional engineer Rick Richardson. David H. Karceski, Esq. and Jennifer Frankovich, Esq., represented the Petitioners. Several citizens attended the hearing to obtain additional information regarding the project. The Petition was advertised and posted as required by the BCZR. A substantive Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC) comment was submitted by the Department of

Planning ("DOP"). That agency proposed several conditions for inclusion in the final order although it did not oppose the zoning requests.

The subject property is approximately 17,119 square feet in size and is split-zoned BL & DR 5.5. The property is improved with a one-story commercial building (4,554 sq. ft.) constructed in 1964. Most recently a restaurant was operated at the site, although the building is now vacant. Petitioners propose to operate a urology clinic, and will reuse the existing building and site improvements for that purpose. No exterior changes or improvements are proposed at this time.

## **Special Hearing**

Article 4C of the BCZR contains a unique provision that permits the Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") to determine with respect to a state-licensed medical clinic whether sufficient parking exists for the proposed use. In this case Dr. Thompson explained the clinic will perform outpatient surgical procedures on urology patients. Dr. Thompson stated the practice will have far fewer patients on a daily basis than would a general medical office or walk-in clinic. Only one physician will be on-duty at any one time, along with four (4) nurses/technicians. The floorplan shows two procedure rooms and one operating room, and Dr. Thompson opined there would not be any more than five (5) patients (and perhaps their spouses/families) in the clinic at the same time. Thirteen spaces are shown on the plan and in my opinion that number is sufficient for this urology clinic given the operation as described at the hearing.

#### **Special Exception**

Under Maryland law, a special exception use enjoys a presumption that it is in the interest of the general welfare, and therefore, valid. *Schultz v. Pritts*, 291 Md. 1 (1981). The *Schultz* standard was revisited in *Attar v. DMS Tollgate, LLC*, 451 Md. 272, (2017), where the court of appeals discussed the nature of the evidentiary presumption in special exception cases. again emphasized a special exception is properly denied only when there are facts and circumstances showing that the adverse impacts of the use at the particular location in question would be above and beyond those inherently associated with the special exception use.

Mr. Richardson testified via proffer Petitioners satisfied the requirements of BCZR Section 502.1 and the case law interpreting that the provision. In the absence of any evidence to the contrary the petition for special exception will be granted.

## **Variances**

A variance request involves a two-step process, summarized as follows:

- (1) It must be shown the property is unique in a manner which makes it unlike surrounding properties, and that uniqueness or peculiarity must necessitate variance relief; and
- (2) If variance relief is denied, Petitioner will experience a practical difficulty or hardship.

Cromwell v. Ward, 102 Md. App 691 (1995).

The property is small (0.3 acres), especially when compared to neighboring commercial sites along York Road. As such the property is unique. If the Regulations were strictly interpreted Petitioners would experience a practical difficulty because they would be unable to operate the clinic at this location. Finally, I find that the variance can be granted in harmony with the spirit and intent of the BCZR, and in such manner as to grant relief without injury to the public health, safety and general welfare.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED this <u>11<sup>th</sup></u> day of **December**, **2018**, by this Administrative Law Judge, that the Petition for Special Hearing filed pursuant to Section 500.7 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("BCZR") to confirm that 13 off-street parking spaces are sufficient, be and is hereby GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Petition for Special Exception for a state-licensed

medical clinic (freestanding ambulatory care facility for an urologist practice only), be and is hereby GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Petition for Variance: (1) to allow a freestanding ambulatory care facility to be located a minimum of 0 feet from a residential property line in lieu of the required 750 feet; (2) to allow 13 off-street parking spaces in lieu of the required 21 parking spaces; and (3) to permit a fence in a DR zone eight (8) feet in height in lieu of the maximum 6 feet, be and is hereby GRANTED.

The relief granted herein shall be subject to the following:

- 1. Petitioners may apply for necessary permits and/or licenses upon receipt of this Order. However, Petitioners are hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at their own risk until 30 days from the date hereof, during which time an appeal can be filed by any party. If for whatever reason this Order is reversed, Petitioners would be required to return the subject property to its original condition.
- 2. Petitioners must inform all employees of the medical clinic that they are permitted to park only on the subject property in one of the off-street spaces designated for that purpose.
- 3. The special exception approval granted herein is for the operation of a freestanding ambulatory care facility (*i.e.*, urology practice) only; any other use permitted by special exception would require approval following a public hearing.
- 4. Only a single freestanding sign shall be permitted at the site.
- 5. Petitioners shall construct at their sole cost and expense a board-on-board fence eight (8) feet in height along the entire eastern property boundary.

Any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

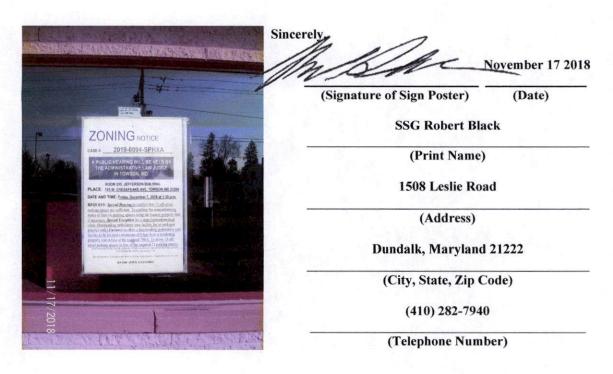

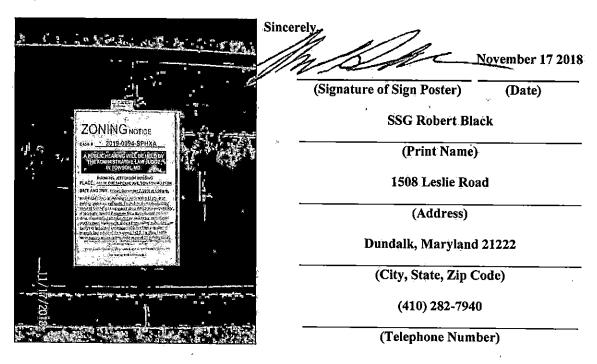

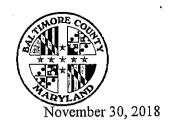

Good Afternoon. My name is Suzanne Royer. I live on Margate Road in Lutherville and I'm on the board of the York Manor Improvement Association (YMIA). 1701 York Road backs up to homes in York Manor (YMIA)

YMIA has strong concerns about parking and the requested parking variance. We ask how many physicians and staff are expected on a daily basis and how many patients are expected.

The closest side street is Haddington Road. Parking challenges along Haddington Road are regularly discussed at YMIA board meetings. Employees of the veterinary clinic on York Road across from Haddington already park on Haddington Road. Their cars extend almost to Bedworth Road, making it difficult for residents to park. There are at least seven employees from the veterinary clinic parking on Haddington Rd. on any given day.

There is an in-home day care center on Haddington Road near York Road. The day care prefers that the space in front of their building be open for drop-off and pick-up. There is a business located at 1621 York Road which has a small parking lot (this business is not zoned commercial and is subject to YMIA covenants). In short, there is no room for employees or visitors to the proposed medical clinic to park on nearby residential streets.

Haddington Road is also impacted by turn-around traffic from Lutherville Lab School. Signage only permits a right turn (southbound) onto York Road from the side exit of the school. Many cars leave the school, go a short distance southbound on York Road, then turn left onto Haddington Road. They turn around in Haddington Garth, and then exit northbound on York Road. There is a steady steam of cars doing this when school lets out.

What efforts will be made to minimize light pollution? Nearby residential properties have been negatively impacted by the retail structure which replaced Watson's Garden Center. That structure has bright signage which is elevated and casts light pollution down Haddington Road.

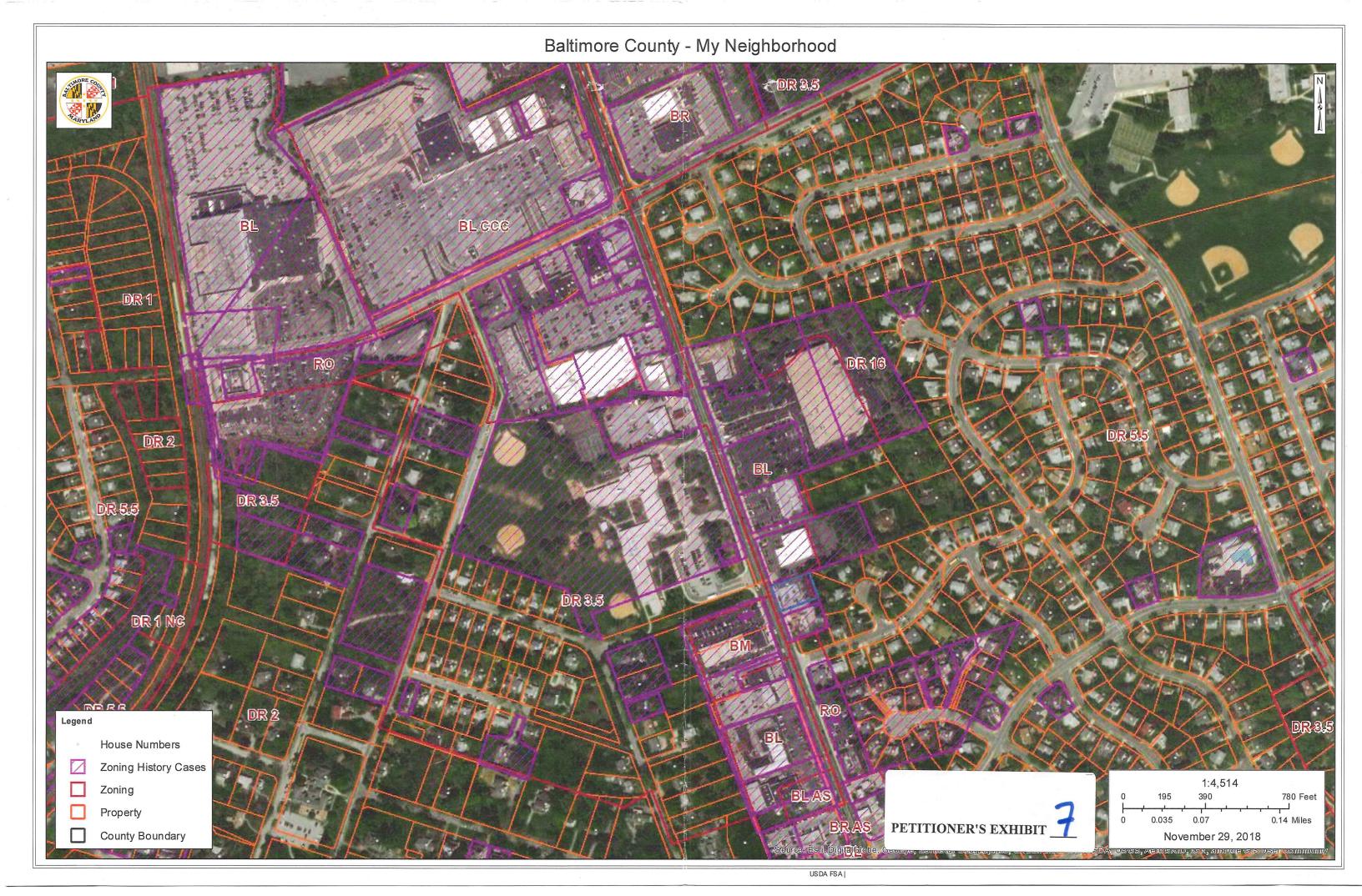
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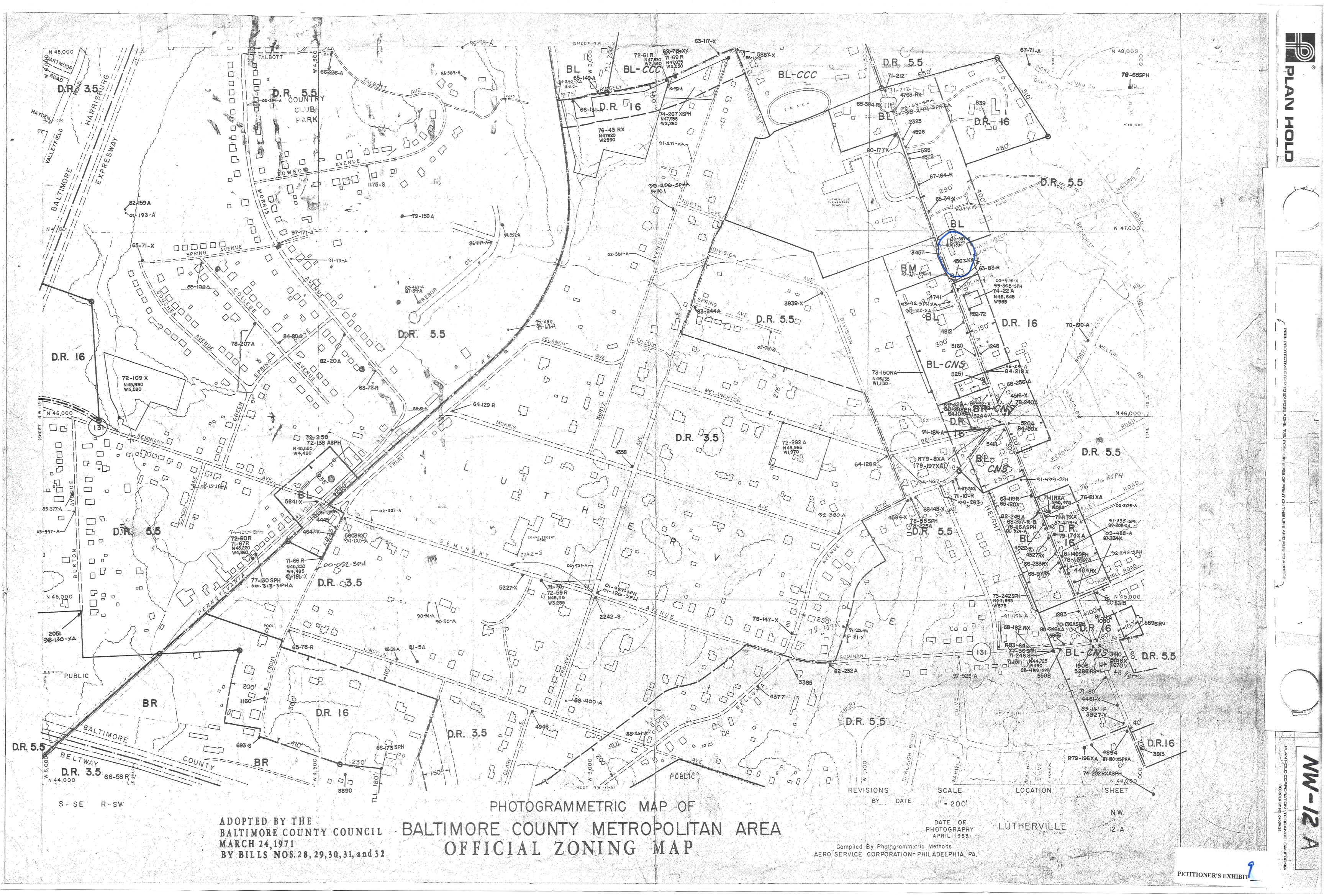
FLOOR PLAN

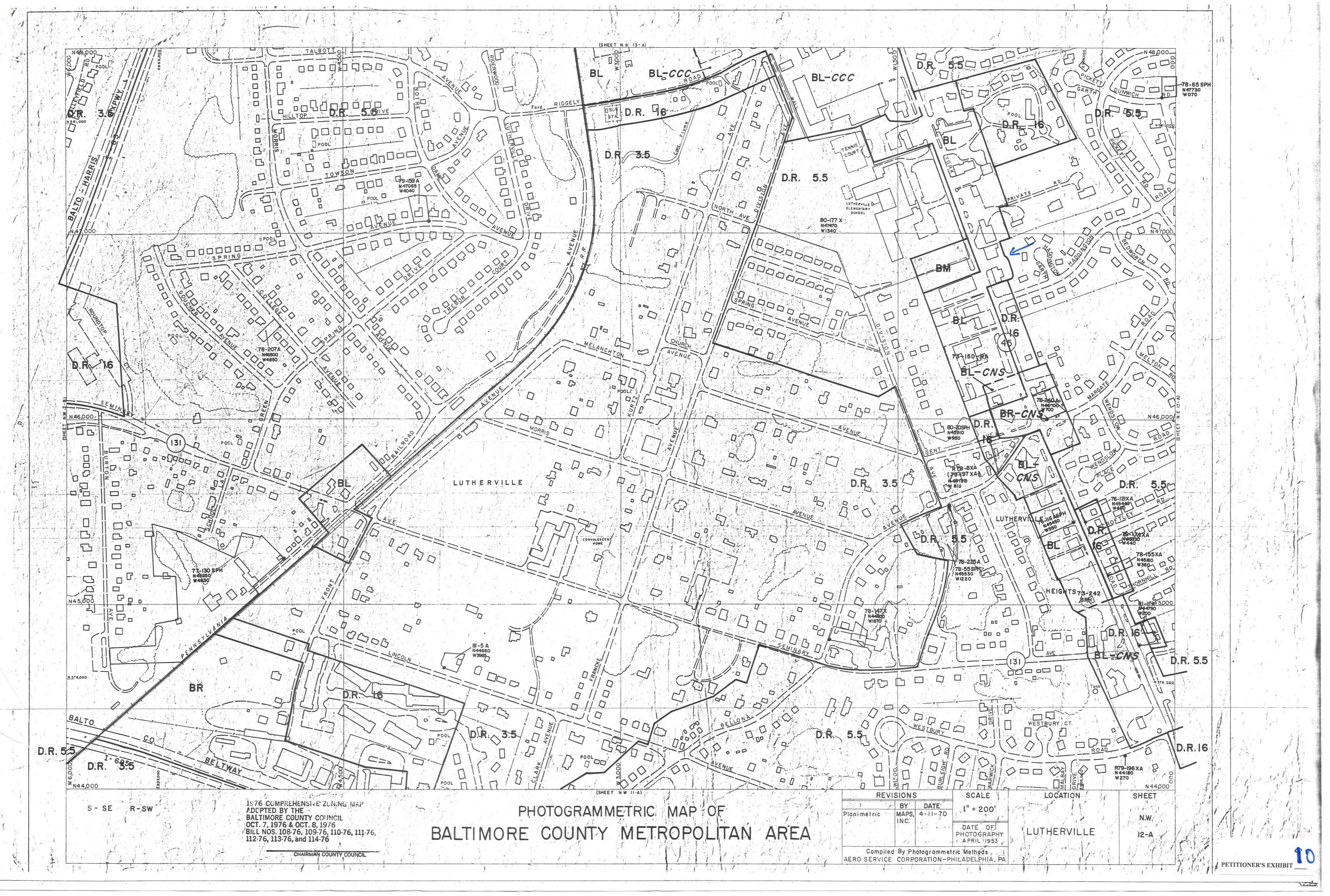
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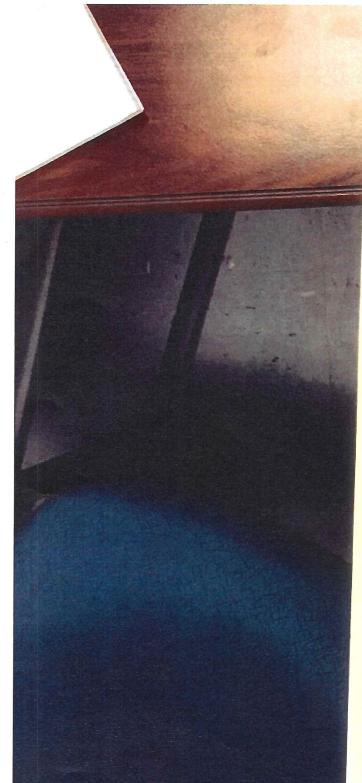
