OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) as Petitions for Special Exception and Variance filed for property located at 8202 Pulaski Highway. The Petitions were filed on behalf of Fazal, LLC, legal owner of the subject property ("Petitioner"). The Special Exception petition seeks to allow a used motor vehicle outdoor sales area, separated from sales agency building. The Petition for Variance seeks: (1) to permit a 0' setback from the rear, side, and front property lines for the parking in lieu of the required 10' rear, side, and front yard setbacks; and (2) to permit no design, screening and landscaping along all sides of the existing parking area and driveway in lieu of the required design, screening and landscaping in accordance with the landscape manual. A site plan was marked as Petitioner's Exhibit 3.

Appearing in support of the petitions were Qaisar Shahzad and surveyor Bruce Doak. David Lynch, Esq. represented the Petitioner. Russ Mirable on behalf of the Rosedale Community Association appeared in opposition to the requests. The Petition was advertised and posted as required by the BCZR. Substantive Zoning Advisory Committee ("ZAC") comments were received from the Department of Planning ("DOP") and the Bureau of Development Plans Review ("DPR"). Neither agency opposed the requests.

The subject property is approximately 0.396 acres in size and zoned BR-AS. The property is located along a heavily travelled stretch of Pulaski Highway, and neighboring uses are either commercial or industrial. The property is improved with a one story commercial building which previously operated as a fast food restaurant. Petitioner proposes to operate a used car facility at the site, a use permitted by special exception in the BR-AS zone.

SPECIAL EXCEPTION

Under Maryland law, a special exception use enjoys a presumption that it is in the interest of the general welfare, and therefore, valid. *Schultz v. Pritts*, 291 Md. 1 (1981). The *Schultz* standard was revisited in *Attar v. DMS Tollgate*, *LLC*, 451 Md. 272 (2017), where the court of appeals discussed the nature of the evidentiary presumption in special exception cases. The court again emphasized a special exception is properly denied only when there are facts and circumstances showing that the adverse impacts of the use at the particular location in question would be above and beyond those inherently associated with the special exception use. Mr. Doak opined Petitioner satisfied the requirements of BCZR §502.1 and the Maryland case law interpreting that provision. As such the petition for special exception will be granted.

I am mindful of the concerns raised by Mr. Mirable; *i.e.*, that many of the other used care lots in the area are overcrowded and resemble junkyards more than auto dealerships. In an attempt to address this concern I have imposed in the order below a condition limiting to fifty the number of vehicles which may be displayed for sale on the property. And to a certain extent I believe the unsightly nature of a used car lot is one of the *inherent* detrimental impacts associated with this use. As such the petition cannot be denied on this basis. *Clarksville Residents Against Mortuary Defense Fund, Inc. v. Donaldson Properties*, 453 Md. 516, 543 (2017)("there is a presumption that the [special exception] use is in the interest of the general welfare, a presumption that may ORDER RECEIVED FOR FILING

only be overcome by probative evidence of unique adverse effects"). This issue is raised routinely in such cases, and the photos submitted in this case highlight the point.

In support of his argument the site would be overcrowded Mr. Mirable submitted a plan (Prot. Ex. 1) containing parking calculations for the proposed use. Mr. Mirable testified that BCZR Section 409 was applicable in this case, and the measurements and calculations shown on his plan were premised upon that assumption. While Section 409 is clearly applicable as concerns employee and customer parking, I do not believe the off-street parking regulations are applicable in the case of the used vehicle inventory displayed for sale. In a zoning case involving the Antwerpen automotive dealership on Route 40 in Catonsville, the undersigned determined that the new vehicle inventory maintained by that dealership was not subject to the provisions of BCZR Section 409. See Case No. 2016-0062-SPHA. I believe the same principle is applicable in this case.

VARIANCE

A variance request involves a two-step process, summarized as follows:

- It must be shown the property is unique in a manner which makes it unlike surrounding properties, and that uniqueness or peculiarity must necessitate variance relief; and
- 2. If variance relief is denied, Petitioner will experience a practical difficulty or hardship.

Cromwell v. Ward, 102 Md. App. 691 (1995).

Mr. Doak testified the site was unique in that the commercial building is situated in the center of the lot, meaning that much of the inventory will be kept in the back of the property. He explained while this may have been ideal for a fast food restaurant which has a circular traffic flow around the site, a used car dealer prefers to display vehicle inventory towards the front of the lot so it is visible to passing motorists. In light of this testimony I find the property is unique. If the BCZR

were strictly interpreted Petitioner would suffer a practical difficulty since it would be unable to operate the used car facility at the site.

Finally, I find that the variances can be granted in harmony with the spirit and intent of the BCZR, and in such manner as to grant relief without injury to the public health, safety, and general welfare. This is demonstrated by the lack of County agency opposition. In addition, Mr. Shahzad testified (and aerial photographs were submitted in support of the proposition—Pet. Ex. Nos. 2 & 4) there are at least six other automobile dealers and/or service garages in the immediate vicinity. As such, I do not believe granting the variances will be injurious to the community.

The Bureau of DPR indicated in its ZAC comment a landscape plan was required for this project. Mr. Doak testified the entire site is paved, and that there is really nowhere vegetation can be installed without excavation and significant time and expense. Perhaps more importantly, he submitted photos (Pet. Ex. No. 5) which clearly show none of the other commercial and industrial sites in this corridor have landscaping. In these circumstances I believe there is good cause to excuse this requirement.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the Administrative Law Judge for Baltimore County, this <u>27th</u> day of **February**, **2019**, that the Petition for Special Exception to allow a used motor vehicle outdoor sales area, separated from sales agency building, be and is hereby GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Petition for Variance: (1) to permit a 0 ft. setback from the rear, side, and front property lines for off-street parking in lieu of the required 10 ft. rear, side, and front yard setbacks; and (2) to permit no design, screening and landscaping along all sides of the existing parking area and driveway in lieu of the required design, screening and landscaping in accordance with the landscape manual, be and is hereby GRANTED.

The relief granted herein shall be subject to and conditioned upon the following:

ORDER RECEIVED FOR FILING

- 1. Petitioner may apply for necessary permits and/or licenses upon receipt of this Order. However, Petitioner is hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at its own risk until 30 days from the date hereof, during which time an appeal can be filed by any party. If for whatever reason this Order is reversed, Petitioner would be required to return the subject property to its original condition.
- 2. No damaged and/or disabled motor vehicles may be kept on the premises.
- 3. Petitioner may display for sale on site no more than 50 motor vehicles at any one time.
- 4. Within 15 days of the date hereof Petitioner shall submit to Baltimore County a redlined site plan indicating where on the site vehicle inventory will be displayed. The plan must also be amended to reflect the location of customer and/or employee parking, which spaces must be striped as required by BCZR §409.
- 5. No temporary banners, signs or advertising flags shall be permitted on the subject property.

Any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) as Petitions for Special Exception and Variance filed for property located at 8202 Pulaski Highway. The Petitions were filed on behalf of Fazal, LLC, legal owner of the subject property ("Petitioner"). The Special Exception petition seeks to allow a used motor vehicle outdoor sales area separated from sales agency building in a BR zone. The Petition for Variance seeks: (1) to permit a 0 ft. setback from the rear, side and front property lines for the parking in lieu of the required 10 ft. rear, side and front yard setbacks; and (2) to permit no design, screening and landscaping along all sides of the existing parking area and driveway in lieu of the required design, screening and landscaping in accordance with the Landscape Manual. A site plan was marked as Petitioner's Exhibit 1.

Appearing in support of the petitions were Qaisar Shahzad and surveyor Bruce Doak. Russ Mirable appeared in opposition to the requests. The Petition was advertised and posted as required by the BCZR. Substantive Zoning Advisory Committee ("ZAC") comments were received from the Department of Planning ("DOP") and the Bureau of Development Plans Review ("DPR").

The subject property is approximately 0.396 acres in size and zoned BR-AS. The property is improved with a one-story commercial building which until a few years ago housed a fast food

restaurant. The property is now vacant and Petitioner proposes to operate a used motor vehicle sales facility at the site, a use permitted by special exception in the BR-AS zone.

At the outset of the hearing Mr. Mirable raised the issue that the petitioner (a legal entity, or "person" under Maryland law per Md. R. 1-202(t)) was not represented by a lawyer. Mr. Doak assisted Petitioner, and while he is an experienced and knowledgeable surveyor, he is not a lawyer. Mr. Mirable correctly noted the "Zoning Checklist" prepared by the County expressly states a lawyer is required to represent an entity at a hearing before the Administrative Law Judge. Of course this is simply a restatement of long-existing Maryland law which states that an attorney is required to represent a corporation or other legal entity in a judicial or (as in this case) a quasi-judicial proceeding. Lukas v. Bar Ass'n. of Montgomery County, 35 Md. App. 442, 444-45 (1977); Md. Bus. Occ. & Prof. Code Ann. §10-206.

In light of the above I am obliged to dismiss the zoning petition. The dismissal will be without prejudice, which means Petitioner could obtain counsel and again seek zoning relief to operate a used car sales facility at the property without being barred by *res judicata* and/or collateral estoppel.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the Administrative Law Judge for Baltimore County, this 29th day of October, 2018, that the Petition for Special Exception to allow a used motor vehicle outdoor sales area separated from sales agency building in a BR zone, be and is hereby DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Petition for Variance: (1) to permit a 0 ft. setback from the rear, side and front property lines for the parking in lieu of the required 10 ft. rear, side and front yard setbacks; and (2) to permit no design, screening and landscaping along all sides of the existing parking area and driveway in lieu of the required design, screening and landscaping in

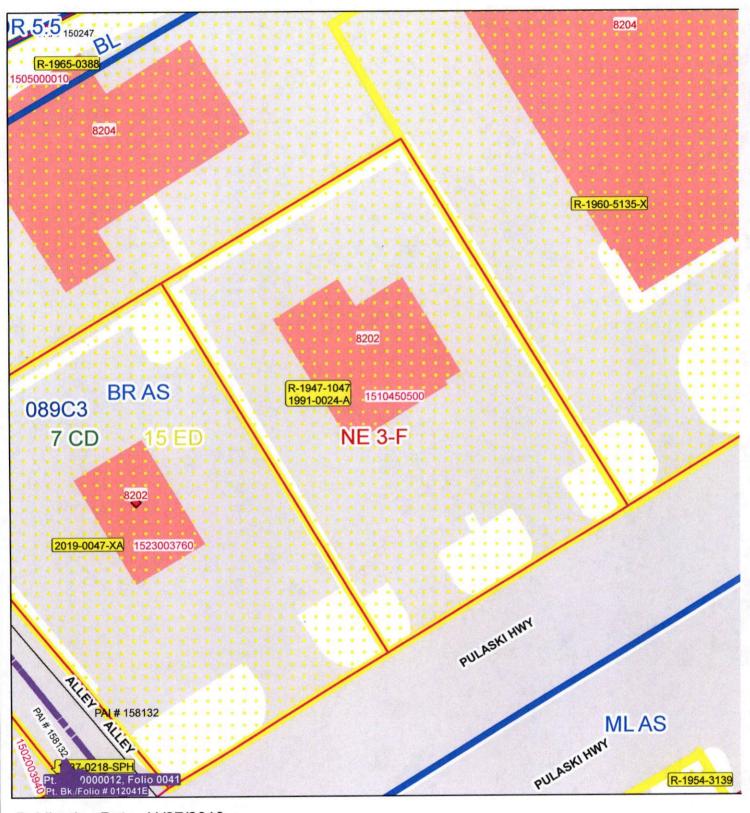
accordance with the Landscape Manual, be and is hereby DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE.
