OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings ("OAH") for Baltimore County as a Petition for Variance filed by Salvo Industrial Park, legal owner of the subject property ("Petitioner"). Petitioner is requesting variance relief from Sections 409 and 450 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("BCZR") as follows: Freestanding Joint Identification Signs: (1) To permit a maximum of three freestanding joint identification signs in lieu of the permitted one per frontage; (2) To permit a maximum of 17 lines of text in lieu of the permitted 5 for Freestanding Joint ID Sign No. 1, 14 lines in lieu of the permitted 5 for Freestanding Joint ID Sign No. 2, and 15 lines in lieu of the permitted 5 for Freestanding Joint ID Sign No. 3; (3) To permit a minimum copy height of 1.5 inches in lieu of the required 8 inches; (4) To permit a maximum area per face of 175 sq. ft. in lieu of the permitted 107 sq. ft. for Freestanding Joint ID Sign No. 1, 270 sq. ft. in lieu of the permitted 107 sq. ft. for Freestanding Joint ID Sign No. 2, and 115 sq. ft. in lieu of the permitted 107 sq. ft. for Freestanding Joint ID Sign No. 3. façade without a customer entrance for Enterprise Sign #12. **Parking** – (9) To permit a total of 81 parking spaces in lieu of the required 100 spaces.

Landscape architect Matt Bishop appeared in support of the petition. Timothy M. Kotroco, Esq. represented Petitioner. There were no protestants or interested citizens in attendance. The Petition was advertised and posted as required by the BCZR. A substantive Zoning Advisory Committee ("ZAC") comment was received from the Department of Planning ("DOP"). That agency (with the exception of one sign discussed below) did not oppose the variance requests.

The site is approximately 1.6 acres in size and is split-zoned BLR-BL. The property is improved with a strip shopping center as shown on the site plan marked as Petitioner's Exhibit 1. This case concerns signage at the property; Petitioner does not propose any new or additional signs, but requires zoning relief to keep the existing signs at the shopping center.

A variance request involves a two-step process, summarized as follows:

- (1) It must be shown the property is unique in a manner which makes it unlike surrounding properties, and that uniqueness or peculiarity must necessitate variance relief; and
- (2) If variance relief is denied, Petitioner will experience a practical difficulty or hardship.

Cromwell v. Ward, 102 Md. App. 691 (1995).

The property has an irregular shape and is therefore unique. If the Regulations were strictly interpreted, Petitioner would experience a practical difficulty because it would be unable to retain the long-existing signage on site. Finally, I find that the variance can be granted in harmony with the spirit and intent of the BCZR, and in such manner as to grant relief without injury to the public health, safety and general welfare. Conditions will be included in the order below which are designed to improve the appearance of the site and the safety of motorists.

A March 14, 2019 letter submitted by Mike Pierce was discussed at the hearing. Therein,

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Mr. Pierce raised several issues which merit further analysis. One issue concerned the text of the lettering on the signs, which he believed was too small and could cause a "traffic hazard." I agree, and believe three inch text height has been the minimum size approved in recent cases (*See*, *e.g.*, Case No. 2018-0350-SPHA) and the Order below will adopt that standard. Both Mr. Pierce and the DOP expressed concern with temporary signs at the site. Counsel stated Petitioner has removed all temporary signs and a condition will be included prohibiting all such temporary signs, banners and flags at the site.

The other issues raised in that correspondence concerned (for the most part) the freestanding joint identification signs at the site. With regard to the number of "lines" on such signs, Mr. Pierce is correct that the Office of Zoning Review has long interpreted this to correspond to the number of panels identifying each individual tenant. Whether or not that is the only possible interpretation of the sign regulations, I believe it is a reasonable interpretation which is entitled to deference under Maryland case law. As Maryland's highest court has held, the "interpretation of a statute by the agency charged with its administration is entitled to great deference, especially when the interpretation has been applied consistently and for a long period of time." BGE v. Public Service Comm'n., 305 Md. 145, 161 (1986). Mr. Bishop explained that in preparing the zoning petition he counted the number of individual lines when formulating variance request No. 2, which as noted above is incorrect. The order below will consider the number of panels on each sign, consistent with the County policy.

As discussed at the hearing, the undersigned is unaware of any recent zoning cases wherein a property owner was permitted to have three freestanding joint identification signs on a single road frontage in lieu of one. But based on the exhibits and testimony at the hearing, I believe only two such signs are on the Petitioner's property, and that variance request will be granted. The third

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joint identification sign is located on a small triangle (approximately 256 sq. ft.) of property at the western-most portion of the site, which is technically owned by Petitioner. But by agreement dated February 1, 1989 (Pet. Ex. 2) Petitioner granted to the owners of the adjacent shopping center (known as Joppa Corner Square) at 4134 East Joppa Road a "perpetual easement" to erect a sign in this small triangular area. Petitioner agreed not to construct any improvements upon or otherwise interfere with the sign erected at this location. While legal title may not have passed in these circumstances, the law considers the adjoining shopping center to be the equitable owner of this land, and that entity is entitled pursuant to BCZR Section 450 to have a freestanding joint identification sign. *Burroughs v. State*, 21 Md. App. 648, 655 (1974)("one may have the record title when, in fact, he may have nothing but the bare, naked legal title, and another may be the equitable owner.")

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, this 19th day of March, 2019, by the Administrative Law Judge for Baltimore County, that the Petition for Variance seeking relief from Sections 409 and 450 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("BCZR") as follows: Freestanding Joint Identification Signs: (1) To permit a maximum of two freestanding joint identification signs in lieu of the permitted one per frontage; (2) To permit a maximum of 6 lines of text in lieu of the permitted 5 for Freestanding Joint ID Sign No. 1 and 8 lines in lieu of the permitted 5 for Freestanding Joint ID Sign No. 2; (3) To permit a minimum copy height of 3 inches in lieu of the required 8 inches; (4) To permit a maximum area per face of 175 sq. ft. in lieu of the permitted 107 sq. ft. for Freestanding Joint ID Sign No. 1 and 270 sq. ft. in lieu of the permitted 107 sq. ft. for Freestanding Joint ID Sign No. 2. Wall-Mounted Enterprise Signs: (5) To permit a maximum area per face of 50.75 sq. ft. in lieu of the permitted 40 sq. ft. for Enterprise Sign #5; (6) To permit a maximum area per face of 87 sq. ft. in lieu of the permitted 80 sq. ft. for Enterprise

Sign #6; (7) To permit a maximum area per face of 43.75 sq. ft. in lieu of the permitted 40 sq. ft. for Enterprise Sign #8; (8) To permit a wall-mounted enterprise sign on a façade without a customer entrance for Enterprise Sign #12. Parking – (9) To permit a total of 81 parking spaces in lieu of the required 100 spaces, be and is hereby GRANTED.

The relief granted herein shall be subject to the following:

- 1. Petitioner may apply for necessary permits and/or licenses upon receipt of this Order. However, Petitioner is hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at its own risk until 30 days from the date hereof, during which time an appeal can be filed by any party. If for whatever reason this Order is reversed, Petitioner would be required to return the subject property to its original condition.
- 2. No temporary signs, banners or flags of any type shall be permitted on the subject premises.
- 3. Petitioner shall install landscaping at the base of the freestanding joint identification signs, as determined in the sole discretion of the Baltimore County landscape architect.
- 4. The existing freestanding signs shall within 60 days of the date hereof be painted, repaired or otherwise improved so as to comply with the objectives set forth in Sections 35-2-401 et. seq. of the Baltimore County Code, as determined in the sole discretion of the DOP.
- 5. The existing wall-mounted enterprise sign (which is composed of fabric/vinyl) shown on the site plan as Enterprise Sign #12 shall be removed within 30 days of the date hereof.

Any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

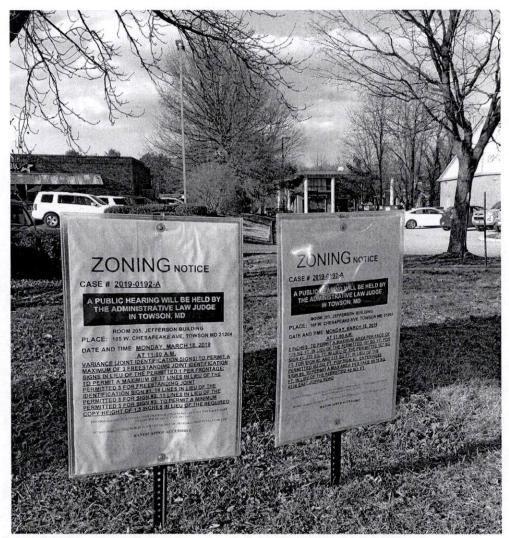

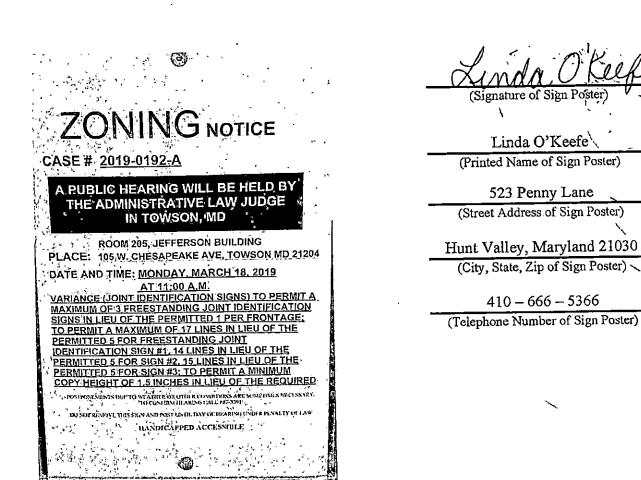

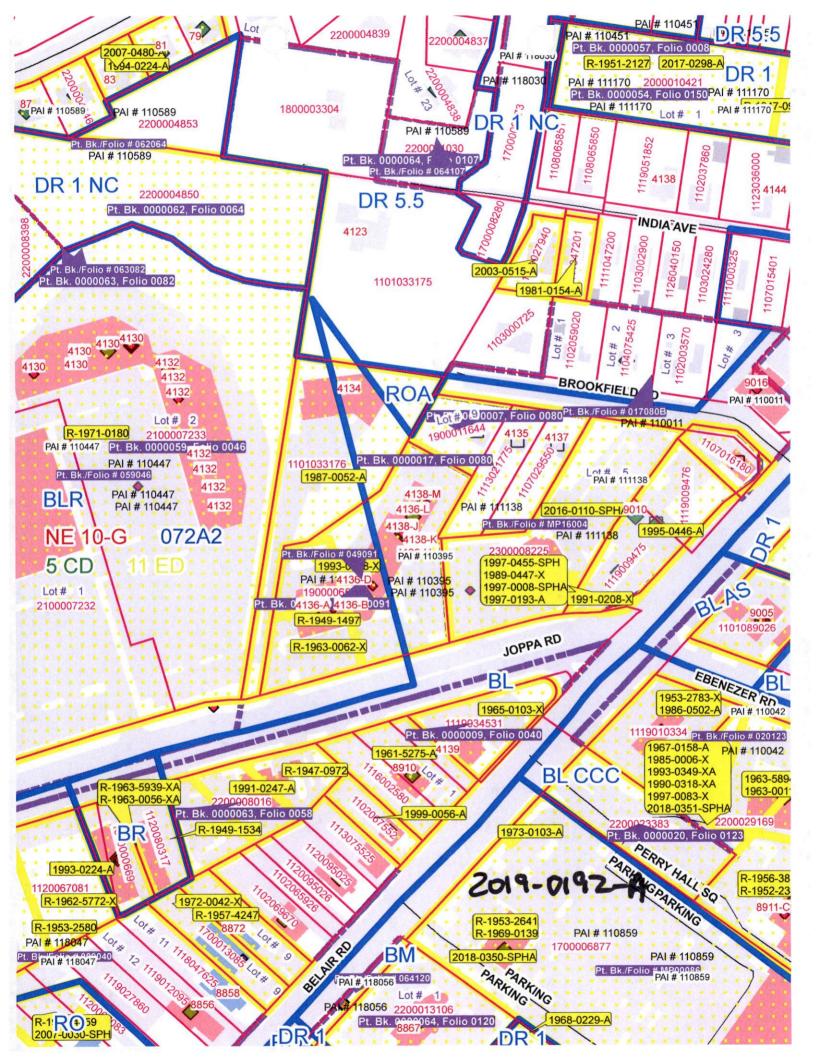

I will not be able to attend this hearing on March 18 due to a previously planned trip (to celebrate my birthday that day). I do not consider this to be justification to request a postponement, as I trust that written comments will be given the same weight as in-person testimony in these proceedings.

I am opposed to most of the relief being sought in this case, as it is contrary to the Baltimore County Sign Code in BCZR 450. As stated as the purpose of Section 450, "excessive signage unduly distracts drivers" and "Baltimore County's appearance is marred ...". § 450, carefully written in 1997, appropriately limits each multi-tenant property to a single Joint ID sign per frontage, with limits on the amount and size of text. Even the old § 413, as far back as 1955, limited commercial properties to one Joint ID sign per frontage.§ 450, when enacted, gave a very generous 15-year abatement period and eliminated "grandfathering".

This case comes about due to a Code Violation citation that was in response to my complaint, which was prompted by the erection of an additional non-permitted enterprise sign and temporary flags, which were subsequently removed, leaving the two Joint ID signs (and an ugly, perpetual "Space Available" sign.

Following, I detail the objections/comments to specific parts of the petition.

Joint ID sign #3

Joint ID Sign #3 on the plan is for a different shopping center on an adjacent parcel. Due to the strange shape of that other parcel, including a pan-handle driveway which doesn't even lie within the legal bounds of that property, that sign was installed on the subject property under the agreement recorded in Liber 8098 Folio 175. It would be appropriate to memorialize the allowance for this otherwise "off-premise sign" via this hearing, however, the requirement for a 100 ft separation in §450.5.B.4.a should be considered. This sign is barely 50 ft from Joint ID Sign #2.

There is no record online of permits for this or the other two freestanding signs.

Size of text

The limitation in the BCZR of at least 8 inches high has the clear purpose of ensuring that drivers can easily read all text. Straining to read text that is too small causes a traffic hazard.

The national Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices, 2011edition, (MUTCD) which Maryland has adopted, provides guidelines for traffic signs regarding these issues (size and amount of text). Although not directly applicable to these signs, it never-the-less provides meaningful guidelines. Applicable pages are attached.

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In order to satisfy the basic requirement that a sign be "legible to those for whom it is intended and that it be understandable in time to permit a proper response", it calls for "adequately sized letters, short legend, and no use of phone numbers. Specific objectives on size are given in §2A.14 as "25 mm (1 in) of letter height per 12m (40 ft) of legibility distance." The driving approach to these signs, even from the near (west-bound) lane, provides about 100 ft to the sign to be adequately read. The far lane is further. This would suggest 2.5 inches as a reasonable minimum.

Number of "Lines"

Note that Zoning has interpreted "lines" to mean "panels", with each "panel" possibly including multiple lines for one business entity. I believe that interpretation to be wrong.

The purpose of a Joint ID sign is to identify the shopping center, not to provide identification or advertising for every business, distinctly different from an enterprise sign "which may otherwise advertise the products or services association with individual companies". Shopping centers were never expected to be allowed to list every store or business on such a sign, and certainly not to include extraneous advertising.

The limitation in the BCZR of 5 lines of text" is clearly to limit the amount of information that a driver may attempt to read and comprehend. Excessive text causes a traffic hazard as suggested in the MUTCD.

The present signs (#1 and #2) contain 6 and 16 "panels" respectively with some businesses using multiple "panels" while the petition is for 17 and 14 "lines", so it appears that the request is to legitimize the present signs, which are old, rusty, slightly leaning, and with several panels consisting of temporary soft vinyl panels. This type of material is not supposed to be used for permanent signs. I can actually recall a time about 10 years ago when the top blew off of Sign #2 and I found the broken, sharp pieces of hard plastic on the other side of Joppa Rd. It was repaired, but remains susceptible to wind damage.

Note also, that the present signs contain numerous phone numbers contrary to the MUTCD recommendation and excessive text beyond simple identification. These apparently make up some of the requested "lines".

Wall-mounted enterprise signs.

There are 11 stores on the property, each with a wall-mounted sign which seems to be appropriate and easily observable from Joppa Rd, again reducing the need or justification for listing on a free-standing joint ID signs. The variance for slight increases over what is allowed is acceptable to legalize the current signs, some of which were apparently installed without permits.

However, Sign #12 on the end of the building should not be allowed. It is, in fact, made of soft vinyl material which should not be used for a permanent sign.

The major result of the freestanding signs is to block the view of the wall-mounted signs. See attached views from east-bound lane of Joppa Rd from GoogleEarth.

Parking

Although I am generally against parking variances, there are sufficient adjacent available parking lots which presumably can be used.

Conclusion

The request for a second freestanding Joint ID sign for this shopping center should be denied and the owner should be encouraged to erect a new, better-looking single sign to replace the two existing sorry-looking signs. That new sign could then be more midway between the tasteful new CVS sign and the existing Joint ID sign #3. This would greatly enhance this property.

Standard:

Determination of the particular signs to be applied to a specific condition shall be made in accordance with the provisions set forth in Part 2. Before any new highway, private road open to public travel (see definition in Section 1A.13), detour, or temporary route is opened to public travel, all necessary signs shall be in place. Signs required by road conditions or restrictions shall be removed when those conditions cease to exist or the restrictions are withdrawn.

Support

Object markers are defined in Section 2C.63.

Section 2A.06 Design of Signs

Support:

- This Manual shows many typical standard signs and object markers approved for use on streets, highways, bikeways, and pedestrian crossings.
- In the specifications for individual signs and object markers, the general appearance of the legend, color, and size are shown in the accompanying tables and illustrations, and are not always detailed in the text.
- Detailed drawings of standard signs, object markers, alphabets, symbols, and arrows (see Figure 2D-2) are shown in the "Standard Highway Signs and Markings" book. - The basic requirements of a sign are that it be legible to those for whom it is intended and that it be understandable in time to permit a proper response. Desirable attributes include:

- Standardized colors and shapes are specified so that the several classes of traffic signs can be promptly recognized. Simplicity and uniformity in design, position, and application are important.

Standard:

- The term legend shall include all word messages and symbol and arrow designs that are intended to convey specific meanings.
- 07 Uniformity in design shall include shape, color, dimensions, legends, borders, and illumination or retroreflectivity.
- Standardization of these designs does not preclude further improvement by minor changes in the proportion or orientation of symbols, width of borders, or layout of word messages, but all shapes and colors shall be as indicated.
- All symbols shall be unmistakably similar to, or mirror images of, the adopted symbol signs, all of which are shown in the "Standard Highway Signs and Markings" book (see Section 1A.11). Symbols and colors shall not be modified unless otherwise provided in this Manual. All symbols and colors for signs not shown in the "Standard Highway Signs and Markings" book shall follow the procedures for experimentation and change described in Section 1A.10.

Option:

Although the standard design of symbol signs cannot be modified, the orientation of the symbol may be changed to better reflect the direction of travel, if appropriate.

Standard:

- Where a standard word message is applicable, the wording shall be as provided in this Manual.
- In situations where word messages are required other than those provided in this Manual, the signs shall be of the same shape and color as standard signs of the same functional type.

 Option:
- State and local highway agencies may develop special word message signs in situations where roadway conditions make it necessary to provide road users with additional regulatory, warning, or guidance information, such as when road users need to be notified of special regulations or warned about a situation that might not be readily apparent. Unlike colors that have not been assigned or symbols that have not been approved for signs, new word message signs may be used without the need for experimentation.

Standard:

Except as provided in Paragraph 16 and except for the Carpool Information (D12-2) sign (see Section 21.11), Internet addresses and e-mail addresses, including domain names and uniform resource locators (URL), shall not be displayed on any sign, supplemental plaque, sign panel (including logo sign panels on Specific Service signs), or changeable message sign.

Guidance:

- Unless otherwise provided in this Manual for a specific sign, and except as provided in Paragraph 16, telephone numbers of more than four characters should not be displayed on any sign, supplemental plaque, sign panel (including logo sign panels on specific service signs), or changeable message sign.

 Option:
- Internet addresses, e-mail addresses, or telephone numbers with more than four characters may be displayed on signs, supplemental plaques, sign panels, and changeable message signs that are intended for viewing only by pedestrians, bicyclists, occupants of parked vehicles, or drivers of vehicles on low-speed roadways where engineering judgment indicates that an area is available for drivers to stop out of the traffic flow to read the message.

Standard:

Pictographs (see definition in Section 1A.13) shall not be displayed on signs except as specifically provided in this Manual. Pictographs shall be simple, dignified, and devoid of any advertising. When used to represent a political jurisdiction (such as a State, county, or municipal corporation) the pictograph shall be the official designation adopted by the jurisdiction. When used to represent a college or university, the pictograph shall be the official seal adopted by the institution. Pictorial representations of university or college programs shall not be permitted to be displayed on a sign.

Section 2A.07 Retroreflectivity and Illumination

Support:

There are many materials currently available for retroreflection and various methods currently available for the illumination of signs and object markers. New materials and methods continue to emerge. New materials and methods can be used as long as the signs and object markers meet the standard requirements for color, both by day and by night.

Standard:

- Regulatory, warning, and guide signs and object markers shall be retroreflective (see Section 2A.08) or illuminated to show the same shape and similar color by both day and night, unless otherwise provided in the text discussion in this Manual for a particular sign or group of signs.
- The requirements for sign illumination shall not be considered to be satisfied by street or highway lighting.

Option:

- of Sign elements may be illuminated by the means shown in Table 2A-1.
- Retroreflection of sign elements may be accomplished by the means shown in Table 2A-2.
- Light Emitting Diode (LED) units may be used individually within the legend or symbol of a sign and in the border of a sign, except for changeable message signs, to improve the conspicuity, increase the legibility of sign legends and borders, or provide a changeable message.

AGREEMENT OF EASEMENT
