### **OPINION AND ORDER**

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings ("OAH") for Baltimore County as a Petition for Variance filed by FP Sub, LLC, legal owner, and PSP Stores, LLC, lessee of the subject property ("Petitioners"). The Petitioners are requesting variance relief from Section 421.2 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("BCZR") to permit a pet shop within 64.7 feet of the nearest property line in lieu of the required 200 ft., and within 0 ft. of the nearest lease line in lieu of the required 200 ft. A site plan was marked as Petitioners' Exhibit 1.

Joe Hochendoner, Mike Ogden, Ryan McCoy and Michael Gesell appeared in support of the petition. Justin Williams, Esq. represented Petitioners. There were no protestants or interested citizens in attendance. The Petition was advertised and posted as required by the BCZR. No substantive Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC) comments were received from any of the County reviewing agencies.

The subject property is approximately 18.37 acres in size and is improved with a strip shopping center. This case concerns only a 7,976 sq. ft. portion of the overall site, which is the space which would be occupied by the Lessee. The property is split-zoned BR, BL & DR 5.5. A Salvo auto parts store was previously located in the leased area. Petitioners propose to open a Pet Supplies Plus store in the space, but require variance relief given the 200 ft. setback requirement

for "pet shops" imposed by Section 421 of the BCZR.

As discussed at the hearing, a "pet shop" is an antiquated concept now that there are legal and/or ethical restrictions upon the sale of dogs and cats from retail storefronts. The Lessee would sell gerbils and similar small animals but would not sell dogs and cats at the store. Like other "big box" specialty pet retailers, the Lessee (which operates 435+ stores in 33 states) would sell pet foods, toys and supplies, and would also offer pet grooming and dog wash services. The imposition of a 200 ft. setback requirement seems unnecessary in this scenario, although the operation arguably constitutes a "pet shop" as defined under the BCZR.

A variance request involves a two-step process, summarized as follows:

- (1) It must be shown the property is unique in a manner which makes it unlike surrounding properties, and that uniqueness or peculiarity must necessitate variance relief; and
- (2) If variance relief is denied, Petitioner will experience a practical difficulty or hardship.

Cromwell v. Ward, 102 Md. App. 691 (1995).

The property has irregular dimensions and was found to be unique in several recent zoning cases. *See* Case Nos. 2019-0062-A & 2017-0338-SPHA. If the Regulations were strictly interpreted, Petitioners would experience a practical difficulty because they would be unable to operate the proposed pet shop. Finally, I find that the variance can be granted in harmony with the spirit and intent of the BCZR, and in such manner as to grant relief without injury to the public health, safety and general welfare. This is demonstrated by the absence of County and/or community opposition.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, this 5th day of April, 2019, by the Administrative Law Judge for Baltimore County, that the Petition for Variance pursuant to Section 421.2 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("BCZR") to permit a pet shop within 64.7 feet of the nearest property line in lieu of the required 200 ft., and within 0 ft. of the nearest lease line in lieu

#### OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) for consideration of Petitions for Special Hearing and Variance filed on behalf of FP SUB LLC, legal owner and Weis Markets, lessee ("Petitioners"). The Special Hearing was filed pursuant to § 500.7 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("B.C.Z.R) to permit a fuel service station canopy sign with electronic changeable copy components pursuant to B.C.Z.R. §450. In addition, a Petition for Variance seeks to permit a fuel service station in a planned shopping center to be located on a lot that is within 0 ft. of a residentially zoned property in lieu of the required 100 ft. A site plan was marked and accepted into evidence as Petitioners' Exhibit 5.

Professional engineer Michael Gesell and Jack O'Hara & Alex Ororbia, Sr. (from Weis Markets) appeared in support of the requests. Caroline L. Hecker, Esq. and Justin Williams, Esq. represented the Petitioners. Two neighbors attended the hearing to express certain concerns with the requests. The Petition was advertised and posted as required by the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations. A substantive Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC) comment was received from the Bureau of Development Plans Review (DPR), noting landscape and lighting plans would be required.

The subject property is approximately 18.37 acres in size and is primarily zoned BR with small slivers of BL and DR 5.5. A large shopping center (166,322 sq. ft.) known as Fullerton Plaza was



constructed at the site in the 1970s. The former "anchor" tenant (K-Mart) closed its doors about 1 ½ years ago, and Weis Markets proposes to open a large (approximately 60,000 sq. ft.) grocery store in that space. As it has in many other locations, Weis proposes to open a fuel service station as an ancillary use to the grocery store. A fuel service station is permitted by right in the BR zone, since the DOP confirmed in a memorandum dated July 6, 2015 (See Exhibit 3) the Fullerton Plaza qualifies as a "planned shopping center." B.C.Z.R. §405.2.A.1.

#### SPECIAL HEARING

The petition for special hearing concerns the request to display gasoline price information on the service station canopy. Similar requests have been made and approved in other zoning cases, and I do not believe the signage would have any adverse impact upon the community. As Petitioners note, state law requires retailers to display fuel price information, and also exempts such signage from the requirements of local zoning laws concerning the size and number of such signs permitted. As such, the special hearing request will be granted.

#### **VARIANCE**

A variance request involves a two-step process, summarized as follows:

- (1) It must be shown the property is unique in a manner which makes it unlike surrounding properties, and that uniqueness or peculiarity must necessitate variance relief; and
- (2) If variance relief is denied, Petitioner will experience a practical difficulty or hardship.

Cromwell v. Ward, 102 Md. App. 691 (1995).

Petitioners have met this test. The large site is irregularly shaped and was found to be "unique" in several prior zoning cases. See Case Nos. 1981-0130-A, 1982-0089-A and 2011-0343-A. As such a similar finding is appropriate in this case. Petitioners would experience practical difficulty if the

regulations were strictly interpreted because they would be unable to construct the fuel service station, which is permitted by right under the Regulations.

Though the variance request seeks a 0 ft. setback from a residential zone boundary, this is due to the wording of the applicable regulation (B.C.Z.R. §405.2) which states "no part of the **lot** [may be] within 100 feet of a residentially zoned property." To be conservative Petitioners considered the "lot" to be the entire shopping center parcel, which has for many years directly abutted a residential zone. The reality is the service station itself will be over 40 ft. from the residential zone while the fuel pumps will be located at least 98 ft. from the residential zone boundary. Finally, certain conditions will be included in the order below to help ensure that granting the request will not have a detrimental impact upon the community.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED this <u>3rd</u> day of May, 2017, by this Administrative Law Judge, that the Petition for Special Hearing filed pursuant to § 500.7 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("B.C.Z.R") to permit a fuel service station canopy sign with electronic changeable copy components pursuant to B.C.Z.R. §450, be and is hereby GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Petition for Variance to permit a fuel service station in a planned shopping center to be located on a lot that is within 0 ft. of a residentially zoned property in lieu of the required 100 ft., be and is hereby GRANTED.

The relief granted herein shall be subject to and conditioned upon the following:

1. Petitioners may apply for necessary permits and/or licenses upon receipt of this Order. However, Petitioners are hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at their own risk until 30 days from the date hereof, during which time an appeal can be filed by any party. If for whatever reason this Order is reversed, Petitioners would be required to return the subject property to its original condition.

- 2. Prior to issuance of permits Petitioners must submit for approval by the Baltimore County landscape architect landscape and lighting plans for the site.
- 3. The fuel service station may not have hours of operation which extend beyond those of the Weis grocery store. In other words, the fuel service station must be closed at such times as the grocery store is also closed.
- 4. Petitioners shall erect a fence no less than 6 feet in height along the boundary to screen the site from nearby dwellings.
- 5. The fuel service station must turn off all exterior lighting when it is closed for business.

Any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

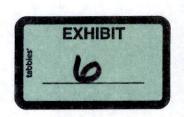

#### OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) for consideration of Petitions for Special Hearing and Variance filed on behalf of KIMCO Realty Corporation, legal owner ("Petitioner"). The Special Hearing was filed pursuant to § 500.7 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("B.C.Z.R.") as follows: (1) to permit continuance of 3 existing pad sites; and (2) to amend prior zoning orders and previously approved plans if deemed necessary.

In addition, a Petition for Variance seeks: (1) To permit two (2) freestanding enterprise signs along the site frontage in lieu of the permitted one (1) per frontage (existing pad #2); (2) To permit a freestanding enterprise sign with a maximum size of 195 sq. ft. in lieu of the permitted 75 sq. ft. (existing pad #1); (3) To permit wall mounted enterprise signs with a total square footage each of up to 4.55 times the length of the wall to which the sign is affixed converted to square footage in lieu of the permitted two (2) times the length of the wall converted to square footage (shopping center and fuel kiosk); (4) To permit two (2) wall mounted enterprise signs on the front wall with a customer entrance in lieu of the permitted one (1) wall-mounted sign (Weis Markets); (5) To permit ten (10) wall mounted enterprise signs affixed to a wall without an exterior customer



entrance. (signs L-U); (6) To permit a freestanding enterprise sign with a height of 45 ft. in lieu of the permitted 25 ft. (existing pad #1); (7) To permit three (3) wall mounted enterprise signs on the front wall with a customer entrance in lieu of the permitted one (1) wall mounted sign (Salvo Auto Parts); (8) To permit three (3) wall mounted enterprise signs on the front wall with a customer entrance in lieu of the permitted one (1) wall mounted sign (New Samys Liquor); (9) To permit 53 off street parking spaces in lieu of the required 91 off-street parking spaces (existing pad #2); and (10) To permit 690 off-street parking spaces in lieu of the required 766 off-street parking spaces (shopping center). A 5- sheet site plan (with signage detail) was marked and accepted into evidence as Petitioner's Exhibit 1.

Professional Engineer Michael Gessell appeared in support of the requests. Jennifer R. Busse, Esq. represented the Petitioner. Two neighbors attended the hearing to obtain additional information about the requests. The Petition was advertised and posted as required by the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations. Substantive Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC) comments were received from the Department of Planning (DOP) and the Bureau of Development Plans Review (DPR).

The subject property is approximately 18.37 acres in size and split-zoned BR, BL and DR 5.5. The site is improved with a large strip shopping center, and along the periphery of the property are "pad sites" occupied by a fuel service station, restaurants and other retail stores. The center is being renovated, and the primary purpose of the petition is to "legitimize" existing signage. The only new signage proposed is a freestanding joint identification sign at the entrance to the center (which would replace an existing freestanding enterprise sign for the former K-Mart store) and two wall-mounted signs on the front façade of the Weis grocery store.

#### SPECIAL HEARING

The petition for special hearing seeks confirmation of three existing pad sites along the Belair Road frontage. These sites are occupied by Mr. Tire, Ihop restaurant and McDonalds. The DOP did not object to the special hearing request, and based on a review of the site plan I believe these three sites are far removed from the strip center stores and can be accurately identified as pad sites.

Part of the difficulty in making such a determination is that the zoning regulations do not define "pad site." In Case No. 2015-0062-SPH, the zoning review office submitted a memorandum which stated the "pad site" definition was removed years ago from the B.C.Z.R. The only references to "pad site" are found in Section 259 of the B.C.Z.R., which concerns the Md. Route 43 overlay district. The Regulations state "[f]reestanding enterprise and freestanding joint identification signs are not permitted on individual pad sites unless the signage is an existing permitted use." B.C.Z.R. §259.9.D.1. Under familiar principles of statutory construction, the implication is that such signage is permitted on pad sites not located in the Route 43 overlay district. And that is also consistent with the long-standing policy of the zoning office, which permits an owner to seek special hearing relief to approve a sign on a pad site.

#### **VARIANCES**

A variance request involves a two-step process, summarized as follows:

- (1) It must be shown the property is unique in a manner which makes it unlike surrounding properties, and that uniqueness or peculiarity must necessitate variance relief; and
- (2) If variance relief is denied, Petitioner will experience a practical difficulty or hardship.

Cromwell v. Ward, 102 Md. App. 691 (1995).

The property has an irregular shape and there is a significant grade change at the front of the site. As such it is unique. If the Regulations were strictly interpreted Petitioner would experience a practical difficulty because it would be unable to retain the existing signage. Finally, I find that the variances can be granted in harmony with the spirit and intent of the B.C.Z.R., and in such manner as to grant relief without injury to the public health, safety and general welfare. This is demonstrated by the lack of community and/or Baltimore County opposition.

In its ZAC comment, the DOP indicated it did not oppose the relief requested in the petition for a special hearing; i.e., that three pad sites exist on this property. But that agency also stated it opposed freestanding signs for the Ihop restaurant and Mr. Tire store. But, as noted above, county policy permits a freestanding enterprise sign to be erected on a pad site.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED this <u>9<sup>th</sup></u> day of August, 2017, by this Administrative Law Judge, that the Petition for Special Hearing filed pursuant to § 500.7 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("B.C.Z.R."): (1) to permit continuance of 3 existing pad sites; and (2) to amend prior zoning orders and previously approved plans, in accordance with the terms of this order, be and is hereby GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Petition for Variance: (1) To permit two (2) freestanding enterprise signs along the site frontage in lieu of the permitted one (1) per frontage (existing pad #2); (2) To permit a freestanding enterprise sign with a maximum size of 195 sq. ft. in lieu of the permitted 75 sq. ft. (existing pad #1); (3) To permit wall mounted enterprise signs with a total square footage each of up to 4.55 times the length of the wall to which the sign is affixed converted to square footage in lieu of the permitted two (2) times the length of the wall converted to square footage (shopping center and fuel kiosk); (4) To permit two (2) wall

mounted enterprise signs on the front wall with a customer entrance in lieu of the permitted one

(1) wall mounted sign (Weis Markets); (5) To permit ten (10) wall mounted enterprise signs

affixed to a wall without an exterior customer entrance. (signs LU); (6) To permit a freestanding

enterprise sign with a height of 45 ft. in lieu of the permitted 25 ft. (existing pad #1); (7) To

permit three (3) wall mounted enterprise signs on the front wall with a customer entrance in lieu

mounted enterprise signs on the front wall with a customer entrance in lieu of the permitted one

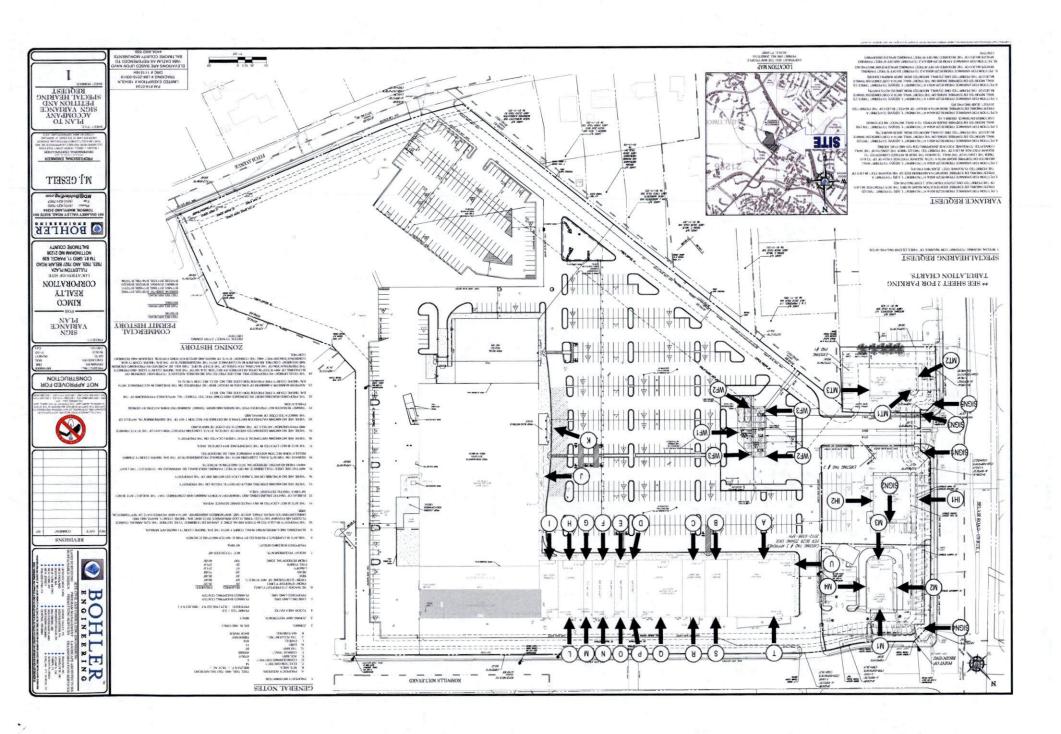

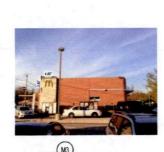

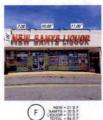

OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) for Baltimore County as a Petition for Variance filed by FP SUB LLC, legal owner of the subject property ("Petitioner"). Petitioner is requesting variance relief pursuant to the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("BCZR") as follows: (1) To permit a freestanding identification sign with a maximum size of 228 sq. ft. in lieu of the permitted 150 sq. ft. (Sign #1); (2) To permit a joint identification sign with a minimum sign copy of six (6) inches in height in lieu of the required eight (8) inches in height for sign copy (Sign #1); (3) To permit a joint identification sign with a minimum sign copy of 2.5 inches in height in lieu of the required eight (8) inches in height for sign copy (Sign #2); (4) To allow wall-mounted enterprise signs on building facades without separate, exterior customer entrances (Sign #3 and #4); (5) To allow wall-mounted enterprise signs to be installed in a different location than the tenant space (Sign #3 and #4); and (6) To permit two (2) additional electronic changeable copy, freestanding joint identification signs accessory to a planned shopping center for a total of four (4) on a single premises in lieu of the permitted one (1) sign (Sign #1 and #2). A site plan was marked as Petitioner's Exhibit 1.

Michael Gesell, Alex Ororbia and Michael Ogden appeared in support of the petition.

Justin Williams, Esq. represented Petitioner. There were no Protestants or interested citizens in



attendance. The Petition was advertised and posted as required by the BCZR. No substantive Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC) comments were received from any of the reviewing County agencies.

The site is approximately 18.37 acres in size and split-zoned BR, BL & DR 5.5. A shopping center is operated at the site and features a Weis grocery store and fuel service station along with several other retail tenants. A large fitness facility will soon be added to the center, and Petitioner seeks certain changes to its existing signage to accommodate this tenant. In addition, Weis also proposes signage for the facades of its store which can be seen by motorists on Rossville Boulevard.

A variance request involves a two-step process, summarized as follows:

- (1) It must be shown the property is unique in a manner which makes it unlike surrounding properties, and that uniqueness or peculiarity must necessitate variance relief; and
- (2) If variance relief is denied, Petitioner will experience a practical difficulty or hardship.

Cromwell v. Ward, 102 Md. App. 691 (1995).

This large parcel has an irregular shape and is therefore unique, as confirmed by similar findings in several prior variance cases. If the Regulations were strictly interpreted Petitioner would experience a practical difficulty because it would be unable to provide signage for its tenants. Finally, I find that the variance can be granted in harmony with the spirit and intent of the BCZR, and in such manner as to grant relief without injury to the public health, safety and general welfare. This is demonstrated by the absence of County and/or community opposition.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, this <u>3<sup>rd</sup></u> day of **December**, **2018**, by the Administrative Law Judge for Baltimore County, that the Petition for Variance as follows: (1) To permit a freestanding identification sign with a maximum size of 228 sq. ft. in lieu of the permitted 150 sq.

ft. (Sign #1); (2) To permit a joint identification sign with a minimum sign copy of six (6) inches in height in lieu of the required eight (8) inches in height for sign copy (Sign #1); (3) To permit a joint identification sign with a minimum sign copy of 2.5 inches in height in lieu of the required eight (8) inches in height for sign copy (Sign #2); (4) To allow wall-mounted enterprise signs on building facades without separate, exterior customer entrances (Sign #3 and #4); (5) To allow wall-mounted enterprise signs to be installed in a different location than the tenant space (Sign #3 and #4); and (6) To permit two (2) additional electronic changeable copy, freestanding joint identification signs accessory to a planned shopping center for a total of four (4) on a single premises in lieu of the permitted one (1) sign (Sign #1 and #2), be and is hereby GRANTED.

The relief granted herein shall be subject to the following:

(1) Petitioner may apply for necessary permits and/or licenses upon receipt of this Order. However, Petitioner is hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at its own risk until 30 days from the date hereof, during which time an appeal can be filed by any party. If for whatever reason this Order is reversed, Petitioner would be required to return the subject property to its original condition.

Any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

#### ZONING COMMISSIONER'S POLICY MANUAL

#### SECTION 102.2

#### A. MIXED USES ON ONE PROPERTY

- If several uses are proposed as separate structures on one property, each use must meet the zoning requirements as if it was a separate parcel.
- Even if subdivision of the property is not proposed, the Zoning Commissioner may require that a line of division either a lease line or a zoning use division line between each use be shown on the plat.
  - a. <u>Conditions</u>: The following guidelines have been formulated so that this matter can be handled consistently:
    - i. Both existing and proposed uses, as divided, must be able to meet the B.C.Z.R. requirements with respect to area, density, parking, setbacks between buildings and to the division lines as if they were property lines.
    - ii. Residential density may be calculated on the overall property acreage if all uses are residential and is allowed in that zone.
  - b. <u>Interpretation</u>: This determination may be subject to a Special Hearing at the discretion of the Zoning Commissioner.

#### B. SETBACKS AND BUILDINGS ACROSS ZONE LINES

 If the property is bisected by a zone or a use and setback limitation line, the required applicable setbacks (for a building legally located in one of these zones) would be measured to the property or street right of way line and not the zone line.

The only exceptions to this method of measuring setbacks would be:

- a. If there is a specific use limitation within a certain distance of a particular zone, then the distance would have to be maintained, or <u>if</u> <u>possible</u>, a variance may be applied for.
- b. If there are 2 principal buildings proposed in different zones, on the same property, in close proximity, then the greatest distance between principal buildings will have to be maintained or a variance granted.
- 2. If a building is proposed across a zone or use and setback limitation line, regardless of what percentage of the building is on each side, the setbacks for each section of the building will be determined and applied separately, according to each separate zone or zone proximity requirement.

#### I. INTRODUCTION

- 5. This is a petition for a variance to permit Pet Supplies Plus to occupy in-line tenant space within the Fullerton Plaza, which is located in the Nottingham area of Baltimore County.
- 6. The requested variance is shown on the Plan to Accompany Variance Petition, sealed by Michael Gesell, P.E.
  - i. Exhibit 1 Plan to Accompany Variance Petition

#### II. EXISTING CONDITIONS

- 1. Zoning Classification: Primarily B.R.; small slivers are zoned B.L. and D.R.5.5
- 2. The Property is known as Fullerton Plaza and is located in the Nottingham area of Baltimore County. It has a total site area of 18.37 AC± (800,253 SF), and is improved with a 166,322-SF± shopping center.
- 3. The Property is located along the Belair commercial corridor just north of I-695 at the intersection of Rossville Blvd. The shopping center is situated in line with a number of smaller commercial strip centers and is directly across Belair Road from the Putty Hill Plaza. While a handful of residential properties are located to the southwest of the Property, the closest house is over 250' from the shopping center property.

- 4. Constructed in the 1970s, Fullerton Plaza's anchor tenant was Kmart until it shuttered its location in the plaza in November 2015.
- 5. By memorandum dated July 6, 2015, the Department of Planning approved the landlord's request to designate Fullerton Plaza as a "Planned Shopping Center."

6. In April 2018, pursuant to approvals granted in Case No. 2017-241-SPHA, Weis Markets took over the former K-Mart space and constructed a Gas N' Go fuel service station in the parking lot.

- 7. In connection with Weis' build-out of its space, Kimco also launched a renovation of the entire shopping center, including a new façade, signage, and landscaping improvements pursuant to approvals granted in Case No. 2017-338-SPHA.
  - i. Exhibit 6 Opinion and Order / Site Plan Excerpt Case No. 2017-338-SPHA
  - ii. Note, under the variance plan approved in the case, approval was granted to permit wall-mounted enterprise signage with a total square footage each of up to 4.55 times the length of the wall to which the sign is affixed converted to square footage.
- 8. Finally, pursuant to approvals granted in Case No. 2019-0062-A, Kimco installed new freestanding and wall-mounted signage prompted in part, by a fitness center assuming a 34,000-SF addition to the shopping center.

9. Kimco proposes to lease an 8,000 SF± space within the shopping center to Pet Supplies Plus, to be located in a part of the space formerly occupied by Salvo Auto Parts, which has relocated within the Shopping Center.

#### III. PET SUPPLIES PLUS – TESTIMONY FROM JOSEPH HOCHENDONER

- 1. With 435+ stores in 33 states, Michigan-based Pet Supplies Plus (PSP) is the 3<sup>rd</sup> largest specialty pet food retailer in the US. There are several PSP stores in the DC area and one in Odenton. This would be the first store in Baltimore County.
- 2. As indicated in the quick facts presentation document, PSP's philosophy is that pets and their owners prefer to shop in smaller, neighborhood stores, rather than big box locations.

#### i. Exhibit 8 – PSP Quick Facts Presentation

- 3. PSP offers pet parents a wide selection of natural pet foods, goods and pet services at low prices and focus on a unique, rich in-store experience for "neighbors" (the term PSP uses for customer).
- 4. As shown in the Presentation Exhibit, the store will also feature self-pet wash stations, grooming services, community rooms. Additionally, community neighbors will have the opportunity to take advantage of knowledgeable pet care team members and carry-out service in which team members carry heavy items to neighbors' cars.
- 5. The proposed PSP, like all of their stores, will make it a point to welcome dogs, cats, and other pets to its stores (it displays biscuits at "nose level" so dogs can take samples while shopping); however, it will not offer dogs or cats for sale. PSP will work with local rescue agencies to offer cats and dogs for adoption from time to time. Smaller live animals (e.g., fish, reptiles, hermit crabs) are proposed to be offered for sale.

#### IV. SITE PLAN/REQUESTED RELIEF - TESTIMONY FROM MICHAEL GESELL

1. The Site Plan in this case was prepared by Michael Gesell, a licensed professional engineer, an expert in the application of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("BCZR" or "Zoning Regulations") as to sign regulations. He has previously been qualified as an expert witness in Baltimore County zoning proceedings.

#### i. Exhibit 9 – Gesell, C.V.

- 2. The location of the PSP leased premises is shown on the Site Plan, in a portion of the former space occupied by Salvo Auto Parts.
- 3. The former Salvo space had a frontage of approximately 120.17 linear feet, and PSP will occupy a space with 79.75' of that frontage. The remainder of the former Salvo space, which has a frontage of 40.42', will be occupied by another tenant.
- 4. As indicated on Sheet 2 of the plan, the wall-mounted signage approved for the former-Salvo space in Case No. 2017-338-SPHA has been apportioned between the PSP space and the space to be occupied by another tenant, and thus is permitted by right.

#### 5. Zoning Relief Requested:

- i. Under Section 421.2 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations, a pet shop may not be located within 200 feet of the nearest property line or lease line. The PSP premises is 64.70' from the nearest property line (along Rossville Boulevard). Accordingly, relief is requested to permit the pet shop to be located within 64.70' of the nearest property line in lieu of the required 200'.
- ii. The term "lease line" is not defined in the BCZR. Its use in the Zoning Commissioner's Policy Manual appears to use "lease line" in connection with a ground lease recorded in lieu of a subdivision, and not a building lease.

However, to be safe, at the request of Zoning Staff, when filing the Petition for Variance, the request was modified to also include a request to permit a pet store to be located within 0' of the nearest lease line in lieu of the required 200'.

#### V. VARIANCE – LEGAL STANDARDS

1. Mr. Gesell would testify that the Property meets the standard for granting the necessary variance(s) under Section 307.1 of the BCZR and the test in *Trinity Assembly of God v. People's Counsel*, 407 Md. 53, 80 (2008).

#### 2. <u>Legal standards:</u>

BCZR Section 307.1 authorizes the Administrative Law Judge to "grant variances ... from sign regulations ... in cases where <u>special circumstances or conditions exist that are peculiar to the land or structure</u> which is the subject of the variance request and where strict compliance with the Zoning Regulations for Baltimore County would result in <u>practical difficulty or unreasonable hardship</u>... Furthermore, any such variance shall be granted only if in strict harmony with the <u>spirit and intent</u> of said height, area, off-street parking or sign regulations, and only in such manner as to grant relief without injury to public health, safety and general welfare.

#### 3. Uniqueness/Special Circumstances:

As indicated in the Opinion and Order issued in Case No. 2017-241-SPHA, the Property is unique due to its irregular shape. The Property is well-hidden and buffered by its surroundings. The Property slopes down from Belair Road and Rossville Boulevard.

The Property's uniqueness has also been found in Case Nos. 1981-130-A, 1982-89-A, 2011-343-A, 2017-338-A, and 2019-0062-A.

#### 4. Practical Difficulty or Hardship:

The unique aspects of the Property work in concert to create a practical difficulty for the PSP to locate on the Property in an area that is 200' from a property line, much less 200' feet from a "lease line." If required to locate 200 feet away from the property or lease line, the pet shop would need to be located in the parking lot and closer to the nearest residential area.

#### 5. Spirit and Intent:

The granting of these variances is in harmony with the purpose of the Zoning Regulations. The pet store setback regulations are intended to limit the impact on neighboring property owners (or perhaps neighboring tenants).

As sited, the PSP store will be located 320' from the nearest residentially-zoned property and 580' from the nearest dwelling.

While there is arguably a 0' setback from the "lease line," the landlord of the premises, Kimco, would not lease space within the renovated shopping center unless it were confident that PSP is compatible with surrounding tenants.

#### 6. Without Injury to Public Health, Safety, and General Welfare:

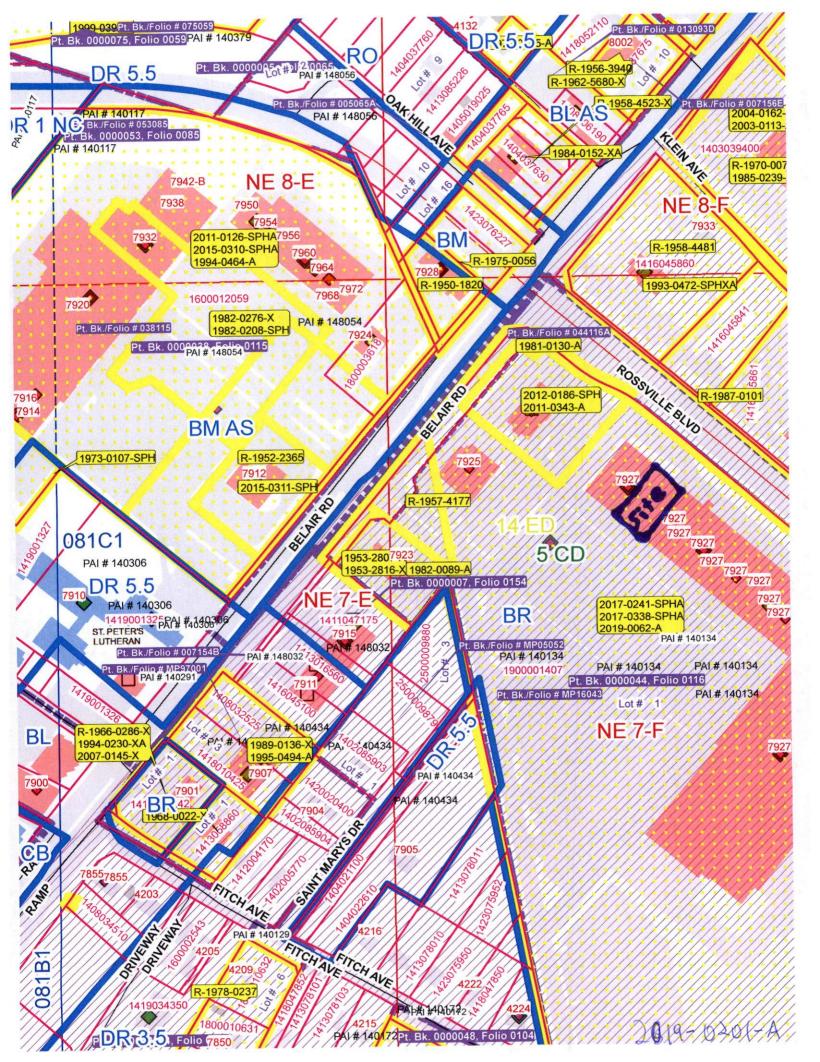
The granting of the variances will not cause any injury to the public health, safety, or general welfare. As stated above, the PSP store will be setback at least 320' from the nearest residentially-zoned property. The neighboring tenants will not be disturbed by PSP and should welcome the potential pet owning "neighbors" (patrons) who will be drawn to the area who may not have otherwise had a reason to go to the Fullerton Plaza.

#### VI. CONCLUSION

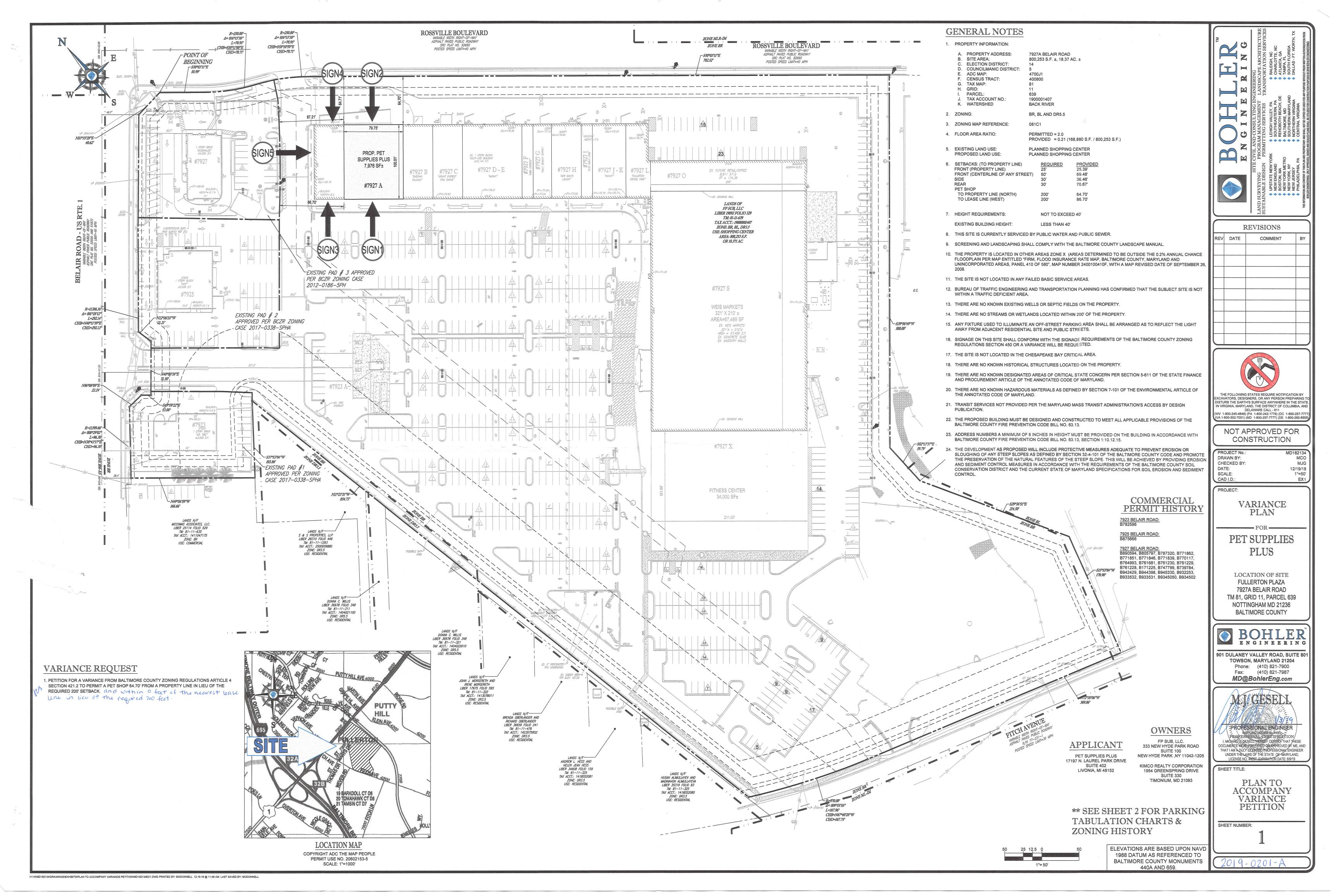
For these reasons, we respectfully request that the variance requests be granted.

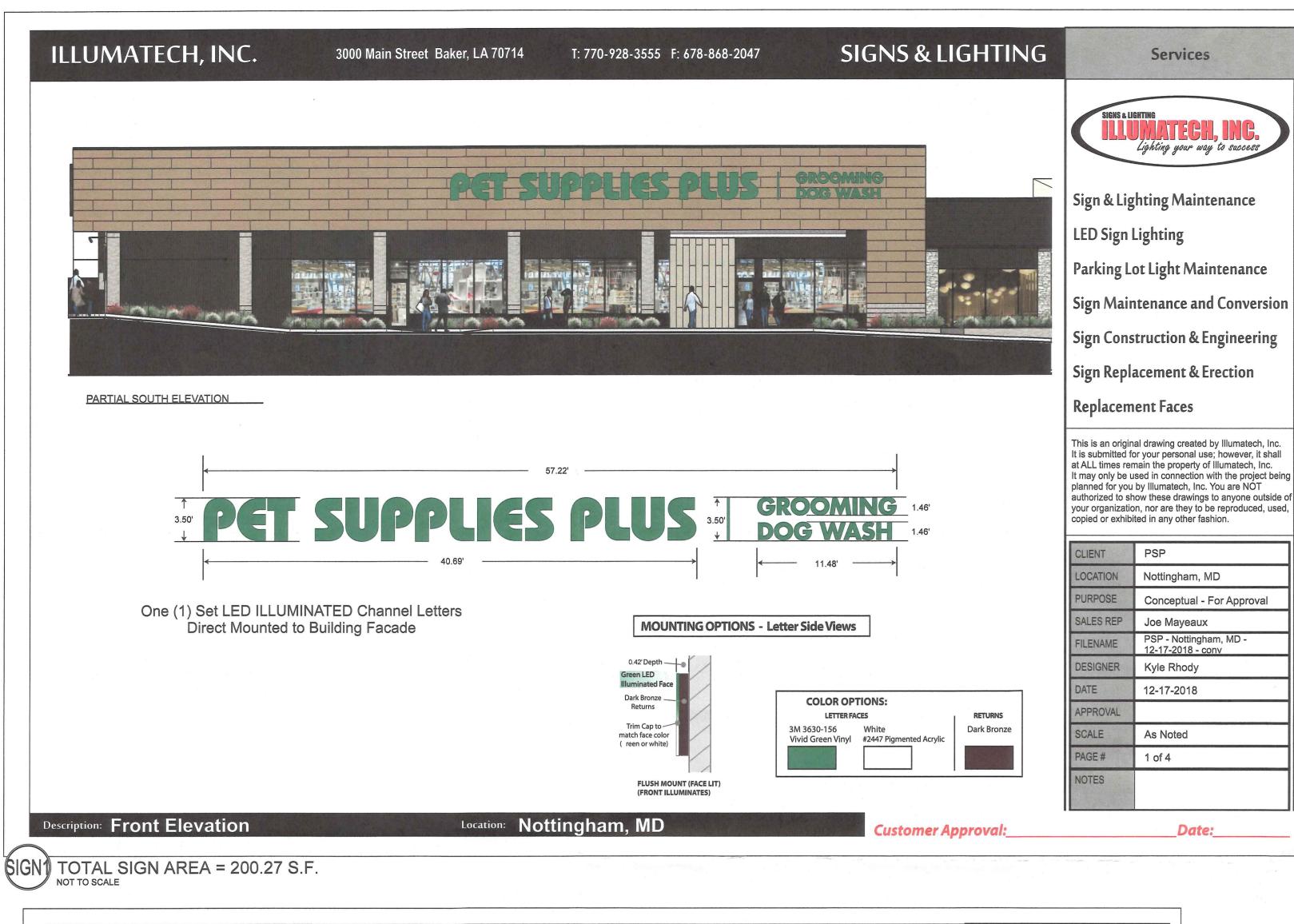
Exhibit 11 - Hearing Outline

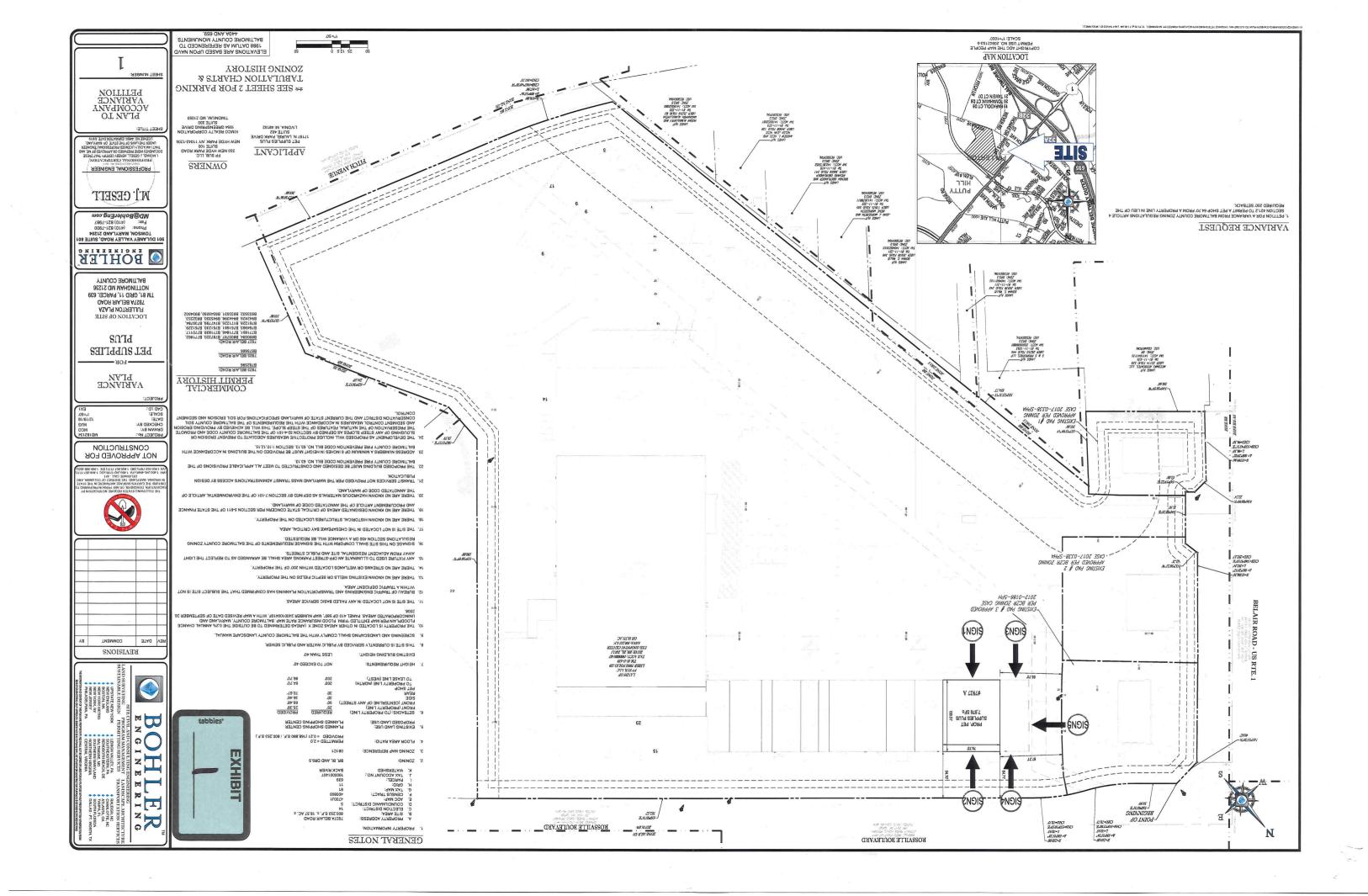

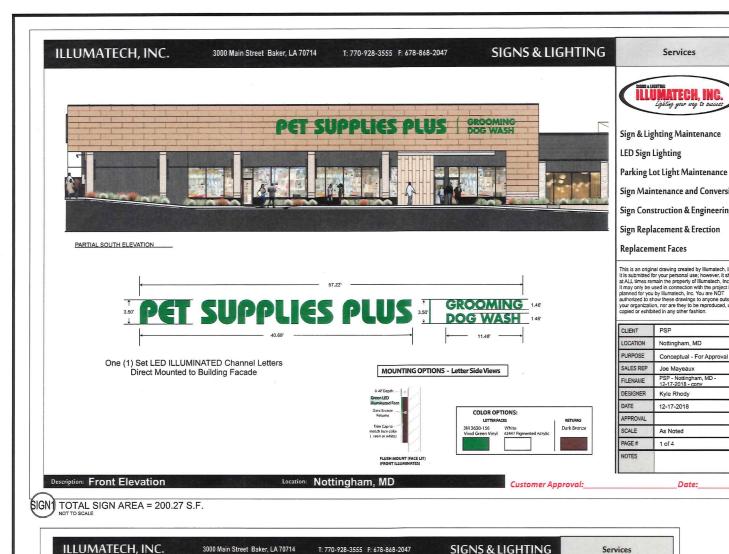
