AMENDED OPINION AND ORDER

By Order dated May 17, 2019, Petitioner was granted Special Hearing and Variance relief with respect to the subject property identified above. By letter dated May 22, 2019, counsel for Petitioner advised the undersigned that an agreement reached with Chapel Village Condominium Council (marked and admitted as Petitioner's Exhibit 9) was inadvertently not referenced in the final order. As such, this Amended Order is issued to correct the oversight and the aforementioned agreement will be deemed part of the final order.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED this <u>28th</u> day of May, 2019, by this Administrative Law Judge, that the Petition for Special Hearing pursuant to Section 500.7 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("BCZR") to approve commercial parking (for 23 passenger vehicles) in a DR 3.5 residential zone, be and is hereby GRANTED.

OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings ("OAH") for consideration of Petitions for Special Hearing and Variance filed on behalf of The Huang's Group, LLC, legal owner ("Petitioner"). The Special Hearing was filed pursuant to Section 500.7 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("BCZR") to approve commercial parking in a DR 3.5 residential zone. In addition, a Petition for Variance was filed pursuant to BCZR Section 229.6.C to allow a zero foot commercial side yard setback in lieu of the required 10 ft. A site plan was marked and accepted into evidence as Petitioner's Exhibit 1.

David Huang and surveyor Bruce Doak appeared in support of the requests. J. Neil Lanzi, Esq. appeared and represented the Petitioner. There were no protestants or interested citizens in attendance at the hearing. The Petition was advertised and posted as required by the BCZR. Substantive Zoning Advisory Committee ("ZAC") comments were received from the Department of Environmental Protection and Sustainability ("DEPS") and the Department of Planning ("DOP").

SPECIAL HEARING

Petitioner owns an unimproved lot 0.75 acres in size located in the Perry Hall area. The lot fronts on Belair Road and is split zoned with the BL zoned portion along Belair Road and a

DR 3.5/DR 16 portion at the rear of the site. Petitioner worked with both the Perry Hall Improvement Association and neighboring property owners to design the layout of the site, which would feature a commercial building with accessory parking. The consensus was that parking should be at the rear of the site, similar to the other commercial enterprises on Belair Road which are near the subject property. It was this design choice which necessitated the petition for special hearing to permit commercial parking in a residential zone.

BCZR Section 409.8 permits such an arrangement provided Petitioner can show (among other things) that the use would not have a detrimental impact upon the community. Mr. Doak described in detail the layout of the parking and noted Petitioner will plant a substantial landscape buffer (between 10 and 40 ft. in width) which will shield the parking facility from the only adjoining single-family dwelling and a condominium complex across the street bordering the rear of the site. Mr. Doak opined the use would not have a negative impact upon the community and that the proposal satisfied BCZR Section 502.1. I am persuaded by that testimony and will grant the petition for special hearing.

VARIANCE

A variance request involves a two-step process, summarized as follows:

- (1) It must be shown the property is unique in a manner which makes it unlike surrounding properties, and that uniqueness or peculiarity must necessitate variance relief; and
- (2) If variance relief is denied, Petitioner will experience a practical difficulty or hardship.

Cromwell v. Ward, 102 Md. App. 691 (1995).

Though the lot is 0.75 acres in size it has only 60 ft. of frontage on Belair Road. As Mr. Doak also testified there is a significant grade change across the site. As such the property is unique. If the Regulations were strictly interpreted, Petitioner would experience a practical difficulty

because it would be unable to construct the proposed commercial building. Finally, I find that the variance can be granted in harmony with the spirit and intent of the BCZR, and in such manner as to grant relief without injury to the public health, safety and general welfare. This is demonstrated by the lack of County and/or community opposition.

The DOP's ZAC comment was received on the day of the hearing. That agency did not oppose the zoning requests but suggested an additional variance was required to address RTA requirements. Under the BCZR the condominiums at the rear of the property would not generate an RTA, although the one single-family dwelling at the southwest corner of the site would. BCZR §1B01.1.B.1.b(1). The RTA regulations further specify that a parking lot (including one permitted under Section 409.8.B, as here) must have a 50 foot buffer and 75 foot setback. BCZR §1B01.1.B.1.e(5). As shown on the site plan Petitioner proposes a 40 foot buffer in the area adjacent to the dwelling, which would contain grass and "deciduous trees to be planted per the Landscape Manual."

In its ZAC comment the DOP noted Petitioner submitted a compatibility narrative and that agency "recommends the development will not adversely affect the community." In light of that recommendation, and pursuant to BCZR Section 1B01.1.B.1.c(1), I find the amount of RTA shown on the site plan for this "vacant" tract is sufficient and will not have a negative impact upon the community. While the aforementioned regulation indicates the granting of this relief is not subject to Section 307, the caption of the subjection refers to "variance of RTA" and the petition will therefore be amended to include this additional variance request.

The Department of Planning has reviewed the petition for a special hearing and variance to determine whether or not the administrative Law Judge should approve zoning relief as listed on the attachment submitted in support of the petition.

A site visit was conducted on 4/19/2019. The subject site is located on the Belair Road corridor in the Perry Hall community plan area and was the subject of 2016 CZMP issue 5-007 wherein the Petitioner applied for BM zoning. The existing zoning was retained.

Petitioners have submitted a compatibility narrative pursuant to BCZR §1B01.B.1.c.(2) and the Department recommends the development will not adversely affect the community. Petitioners have met with the adjacent residential community and have arrived at agreements to specific conditions regarding lighting, fencing, and hours of operation, a draft copy of which was provided to the Department. The Department does not oppose said agreement but cannot be a party to it.

The Department of Planning has no objection to granting the petitioned zoning relief conditioned upon the following:

- Petitioners shall provide class a landscape screening per the requirements of BCZR §1B01.B.1.d.(3) to the satisfaction of the Baltimore County Landscape Architect and the Administrative Law Judge.
- The determination of the Baltimore County Development Review Committee notwithstanding, petitioners shall submit to the contact person listed below an updated site plan denoting the location of the lighting, proposed fencing and orientation of the retail building prior to issuance of a building permit.

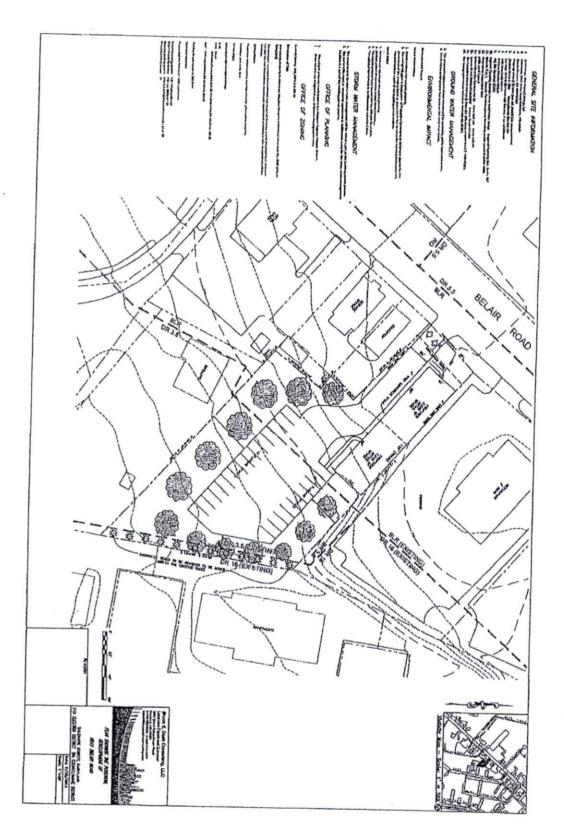

This letter shall set forth the terms of an agreement between your client, The Chapel Village Condominium Council, Inc. ("Association") and my client, The Huang's Group, LLC ("Huang"), owner of the property known as 9541 Belair Road ("Property") the subject of the above referenced zoning case scheduled for hearing on May 13, 2019 at 1:30 p.m.

Specifically, the following terms, if acceptable, will be presented to the hearing officer at the May 13, 2019 hearing as proposed conditions to any zoning approvals for the subject property.

- 1. For purposes of background, the subject property contains approximately .82 acres, Tax Account No. 1112000325. The Association is a condominium association in Baltimore County made up of 144 units whose property is located adjacent to the Property. The Property is currently zoned BLR, DR 16 and DR 3.5.
- 2. In the Zoning Case referenced above, Huang has filed a Petition for Special Hearing pursuant to Section 500.7 of the BCZR to approve commercial parking in a residential zone and Variance from Section 229.6C of the BCZR to allow a zero-foot commercial side yard setback in lieu of 10 feet.
- 3. The Association is interested in preserving the existing character and quality of life for the Association residents living in the vicinity of the Property.
- 4. Huang and the Association desire to place certain restrictions on the Property in return for the Association's support of Huang's requested zoning relief in the Zoning Case necessary for Huang's proposed 2080 square foot retail building and proposed 1920 square foot office building.

- 5. Restrictions on the Property.
- a) The hours of operation shall be limited to 10:00 p.m. closing, Monday thru Sunday.
- b) Huang shall install an eight (8) foot high solid wood fence prior to the commencement of any construction on the Property. The fence shall be maintained in good order and repair so as not to be an eyesore from either side of the fence. The fence shall be replaced when necessary, but in no event later than 15 years after completion of construction. The fence may be replaced with modern materials (such as maintenance free composites) so long as the fence appears to be wood-like and of a medium to dark wood color unless the parties otherwise agree.)
- c) Any lighting on the Property shall be shielded and directed away from the residences located on the Association property.
- d) Huang shall provide a minimum 10-foot landscape buffer along the rear and side of the Property as shown on the site plan attached as **Exhibit A**. The landscaping shall include the planting of arborvitae trees. The health of the landscaping in the buffer shall be maintained and when necessary, the landscaping shall be replaced so as to maintain a continuous healthy mature landscape buffer between the properties.
- e) Parking on the subject property shall be located away from Belair Road and to the side and rear of the proposed buildings as shown on **Exhibit A**.

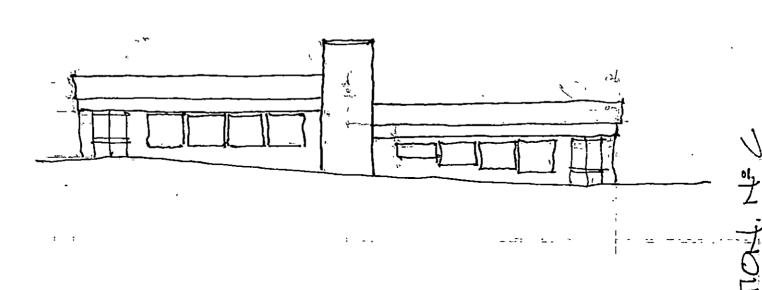

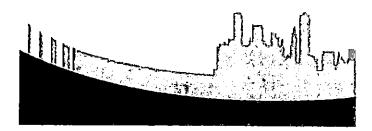

This purpose of this letter is explain how the proposed development of 9541 Belair Road will be compatible with the surrounding area in accordance with the guidelines in the comprehensive manual of development policies.

1) The arrangements and orientation of the proposed buildings and site improvements are patterned in a similar manner to those in the neighborhood:

The proposed building has been designed to be similar to the existing commercial buildings along Belair Road, but reflect a new generation of design. The brick exterior will provide a more formal look.

2) The building and parking lot layout reinforce existing building and streetscape patterns and assure that the placement of building and parking lots have no adverse impact on the neighborhood;

The proposed building will have a setback similar to those along Belair Road. Landscape being planted in the front of the building will provide streetscape where none exists along Belair Road in our area and will add positive impact on the neighborhood. The adjoining home and apartments will be protected from any impact by the parking area via a comparable transition area, which includes a 20- 40 foot landscape area planted with mature trees.

3) The proposed streets are connected with the existing neighborhood road network wherever possible and the proposed sidewalks are located to support the functional patterns of the neighborhood;

No new public streets or sidewalks are needed for this project. A sidewalk exists along and parallel to Belair Road and will be maintained. Sidewalk access to the new building will be to the front door and from the parking lot.

4) The open spaces of the proposed development reinforce the open space patterns of the neighborhood in form and siting and complement existing open space systems;

The open space area in the residential zone and adjoining it has been designed to provide an area of grass and trees that will transition to the adjoining house and apartments well.

5) Locally significant features of the site such as distinctive buildings or vistas are integrated into the site design;

The proposed building is designed to integrate architecturally with the surrounding neighborhood buildings and with the topography.

6) The proposed landscape design compliments the neighborhood's landscape patterns and reinforces its functional qualities;

The proposed landscaping reflects an attractive use of trees and plantings that helps to avoid adverse impact on the neighborhood.

7) The exterior signs, site lighting and accessory structures support a uniform architectural theme and present a harmonious visual relationship with the surrounding neighborhood;

Site lighting and signage will be designed to meet regulatory requirements and present a harmonious visual relationship with the surrounding neighborhood. Lighting will be controlled as to location, direction, hours of illumination, glare and intensity and will not be aimed or reflected into adjoining properties.

8) The scale, proportions, massing and detailing of the proposed building is in proportion to those existing in the neighborhood;

The proposed building footprint is 4,000 square feet. This building will have a median size in comparison to the other buildings in the neighborhood. The proposed building and architectural features were designed with the collective neighborhood in mind and meant to integrate into that neighborhood.

In summary, the professionals that are providing design for this project have kept in mind the overall relationship to the neighborhood and the opportunity for providing positive impact. We feel the design meets the spirit and intent of the guidelines in the comprehensive manual of development policies.

This letter shall set forth the terms of an agreement between your client, The Chapel Village Condominium Council, Inc. ("Association") and my client, The Huang's Group, LLC ("Huang"), owner of the property known as 9541 Belair Road ("Property") the subject of the above referenced zoning case scheduled for hearing on May 13, 2019 at 1:30 p.m.

Specifically, the following terms, if acceptable, will be presented to the hearing officer at the May 13, 2019 hearing as proposed conditions to any zoning approvals for the subject property.

- 1. For purposes of background, the subject property contains approximately .82 acres, Tax Account No. 1112000325. The Association is a condominium association in Baltimore County made up of 144 units whose property is located adjacent to the Property. The Property is currently zoned BLR, DR 16 and DR 3.5.
- 2. In the Zoning Case referenced above, Huang has filed a Petition for Special Hearing pursuant to Section 500.7 of the BCZR to approve commercial parking in a residential zone and Variance from Section 229.6C of the BCZR to allow a zero-foot commercial side yard setback in lieu of 10 feet.
- 3. The Association is interested in preserving the existing character and quality of life for the Association residents living in the vicinity of the Property.
- 4. Huang and the Association desire to place certain restrictions on the Property in return for the Association's support of Huang's requested zoning relief in the Zoning Case necessary for Huang's proposed 2080 square foot retail building and proposed 1920 square foot office building.

- 5. Restrictions on the Property.
- a) The hours of operation shall be limited to 10:00 p.m. closing, Monday thru Sunday.
- Huang shall install an eight (8) foot high solid wood fence prior to the commencement of any construction on the Property. The fence shall be maintained in good order and repair so as not to be an eyesore from either side of the fence. The fence shall be replaced when necessary, but in no event later than 15 years after completion of construction. The fence may be replaced with modern materials (such as maintenance free composites) so long as the fence appears to be wood-like and of a medium to dark wood color unless the parties otherwise agree.)
- Any lighting on the Property shall be shielded and directed away from the residences located on the Association property.
- Huang shall provide a minimum 10-foot landscape buffer along the rear and side of the Property as shown on the site plan attached as Exhibit A. The landscaping shall include the planting of arborvitae trees. The health of the landscaping in the buffer shall be maintained and when necessary, the landscaping shall be replaced so as to maintain a continuous healthy mature landscape buffer between the properties.
- Parking on the subject property shall be located away from Belair Road and to the side and rear of the proposed buildings as shown on Exhibit A.
