OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) as Petitions for Special Exception and Variance filed for property located at 4428 North Point Blvd. The Petitions were filed on behalf of NPR, LLC, legal owner of the subject property ("Petitioner"). The Special Exception petition seeks approval to allow a contractor's equipment storage yard, pursuant to § 236.2 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("BCZR"). The Petition for Variance seeks a side yard setback of 4 ft. in lieu of the required 30 ft., pursuant to § 238.2. A site plan was marked as Petitioner's Exhibit 1.

Appearing in support of the petitions were Rick Richardson of Richardson Engineering and Brian Dietz, a registered surveyor. David Cole, Esq. represented the Petitioner. Protestants Thomas and Dorothy Hayes were represented by Leslie Pittler, Esq. also attended. The Petition was advertised and posted as required by the BCZR. A substantive Zoning Advisory Committee ("ZAC") comment was received from the Department of Planning ("DOP"). That agency did not oppose the request.

Pete Forakis, a principal of Petitioner NPR, LLC appeared and testified that the property was purchased in January of 2019. At that time an abandoned building which has since been demolished was on the site. He stated that this site, zoned BR-AS and ML-IM is in an area

including a boat repair company, an auto repair company, manufacturing warehouses the A1 Abatement company, with a contractor yard and storage facilities, as well as other like businesses.

The witness noted that the LLC's intention is to improve the property with a structure and to rent it, including the ability to have it utilized as a contractor yard. He observed that they already have two verbal rental commitments from prospective tenants. He further stated that he has reached out to neighboring owners who have no objection (other than the Protestants at the hearing) to his petition, and produced a letter from the next door neighbor in support of his petition (Petitioner's Exhibit 4).

Patrick Richardson, principal of Richardson Engineering was offered and after voir dire by Mr. Pittler was accepted as an expert in land development and zoning in Baltimore County. He stated that he prepared the plat to accompany this petition and confirmed the site, which is approximately 28,183 square feet, split zoned BR-AS and ML-IM. He opined that the Petitioner's plans for the site do meet the definition of a contractors yard and noted the nature of the businesses in the area, a number of which have already qualified in the past four (4) special exception relief (Petitioners Exhibit 6 & 7). He identified a paved road with a 25 ft. right-of-way on the north side of the site. He was questioned as an expert familiar with the site, the surrounding area uses and the proposed use by the Petitioner as to the requirements for a special exception set out in BCZR §502.1 and cases arising therefrom. He responded to each that no adverse or negative impacts would occur, and in his opinion the requirements for special exception to be granted were met by the Petitioner.

As to the requested variance relief, he stated that the subject site was deep but not wide, and if the existing setbacks were left in force, there would be very little buildable land on the site.

Furthermore, he stated that without the variance relief there would not be sufficient access to the right-of-way, nor would there be sufficient space for vehicle and equipment turnaround.

The Protestants presented no witnesses or evidence.

SPECIAL EXCEPTION

Under Maryland law, a special exception use enjoys a presumption that it is in the interest of the general welfare, and therefore, valid. *Schultz v. Pritts*, 291 Md. 1 (1981). The *Schultz* standard was revisited in *Attar v. DMS Tollgate*, *LLC*, 451 Md. 272 (2017), where the court of appeals discussed the nature of the evidentiary presumption in special exception cases. The court again emphasized a special exception is properly denied only when there are facts and circumstances showing that the adverse impacts of the use at the particular location in question would be above and beyond those inherently associated with the special exception use.

Mr. Richardson, an expert familiar with the project and it's envisions testified unequivocally that the Petitioner met the requirements of the law and §502.1. I find that is more than sufficient to meet the burden for that relief.

VARIANCES

A variance request involves a two-step process, summarized as follows:

- It must be shown the property is unique in a manner which makes it unlike surrounding properties, and that uniqueness or peculiarity must necessitate variance relief; and
- 2. If variance relief is denied, Petitioner will experience a practical difficulty or hardship.

Cromwell v. Ward, 102 Md. App. 691 (1995).

I believe that the site configuration limiting the space for construction of a building along with the needed access to the right-of-way renders the site unique. If the BCZR were strictly ORDER RECEIVED FOR FILING

interpreted Petitioner would suffer a practical difficulty because it would be unable to utilize the site for the intended purpose, including vehicle turnaround and construction of a building on the site. Finally, I find that the variances can be granted in harmony with the spirit and intent of the BCZR, and in such manner as to grant relief without injury to the public health, safety, and general welfare. This is demonstrated by the lack of County and/or community opposition.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the Administrative Law Judge for Baltimore County, this <u>8th</u> day of **October**, **2019**, that the Petition for Special Exception to allow a contractor's equipment storage yard, be and is hereby GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Petition for Variance to seek a side yard setback of 4 ft. in lieu of the required 30 ft., be and is hereby GRANTED.

The relief granted herein shall be subject to and conditioned upon the following:

- 1. Petitioner may apply for necessary permits and/or licenses upon receipt of this Order. However, Petitioner is hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at its own risk until 30 days from the date hereof, during which time an appeal can be filed by any party. If for whatever reason this Order is reversed, Petitioner would be required to return the subject property to its original condition.
- 2. Prior to issuance of permits Petitioner must comply with the ZAC comment submitted by the DOP, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

This matter comes before this Deputy Zoning Commissioner as a Petition for Variance filed by the legal owners of the subject property, Rebecca L. and Michael H. Spivey. The Petitioners are requesting variance relief for property they own at 4432 North Point Boulevard located in the Dundalk area of Baltimore County. The variance request is to permit a side yard setback of 2 ft. and 4 ft. in lieu of the required 30 ft. and to waive the required 6-ft. parking set backs against adjacent commercial properties.

Appearing at the hearing on behalf of the variance request were Michael Spivey, owner of the property and Paul Gietka. There were no protestants or others in attendance.

Testimony and evidence indicated that the property, which is the subject of this variance request, consists of 0.68 acres, more or less, zoned BR-AS. The property is improved at this time with two single-family residential dwellings. Mr. Spivey has owned the property for the past five years and currently rents those single-family homes out to tenants. He is interested in tearing down the two old residences and constructing a new commercial building in their place. Mr. Spivey intends to operate his commercial business from the subject site. He is in the business of repairing engines and boat motors and their out-drives and intends to relocate his business to this site. In order to proceed with the construction of this new commercial building, the variance relief as previously specified is necessary.

An area variance may be granted where strict application of the zoning regulations would cause practical difficulty to Petitioners and their property. McLean v. Soley, 270 Md. 208 (1973). To prove practical difficulty for an area variance, the Petitioners must meet the following:

- 1) whether strict compliance with requirement would unreasonably prevent the use of the property for a permitted purpose or render conformance unnecessarily burdensome;
- 2) whether a grant of the variance would do a substantial justice to the applicant as well as other property owners in the district or whether a lesser relaxation than that applied for would give sufficient relief; and,
- 3) whether relief can be granted in such fashion that the spirit of the ordinance will be observed and public safety and welfare secured.

Anderson v. Bd. Of Appeals, Town of Chesapeake Beach, 22 Md. App. 28 (1974).

After due consideration of the testimony and evidence presented, it is clear that practical difficulty or unreasonable hardship will result if the variance is not granted. It has been established that special circumstances or conditions exist that are peculiar to the property which is the subject of this request and that the requirements from which the Petitioners seek relief will unduly restrict the use of the land due to the special conditions unique to this particular parcel. In addition, the relief requested will not cause any injury to the public health, safety or general welfare, and meets the spirit and intent of the B.C.Z.R.

Pursuant to the advertisement, posting of the property, and public hearing on this Petition held, and after considering the testimony and evidence offered by the Petitioners, I find that the Petitioners' variance request should be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, this 7¹/₂ day of January, 2003, by this Deputy Zoning Commissioner, that the Petitioners' request for variance from Section 238.2 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations, to permit a side yard setback of 2 ft. and 4 ft. in lieu of the required

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

This matter comes before this Deputy Zoning Commissioner for consideration of Petitions for Special Hearing and Special Exception filed by Charles S. Ratliff (deceased) and Betty A. Ratliff, the legal property owners, and Edwin and Dorothy Hayes, the contract purchasers. Special Hearing relief is requested pursuant to Section 500.7 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.) to determine that an asbestos, lead, and mold remediation and demolition contractor's equipment storage constitutes a contractor's equipment storage yard pursuant to Section 101 of the B.C.Z.R. The Special Exception is to allow a contractor's equipment storage yard in a B.R. Zone in accordance with Section 236.4 of the B.C.Z.R. The subject property and requested relief are more fully described on the site plan which was marked and accepted into evidence as Petitioners' Exhibit 1.

Appearing at the requisite public hearing in support of the requested special hearing and special exception were Petitioners Edwin and Dorothy Hayes, the contract purchasers. Leslie M. Pittler, Esquire, appeared and represented Petitioners, and Betty Ratliff also appeared. Also appearing in support of the requested relief was Kenneth Colbert, with Colbert Matz Rosenfelt,

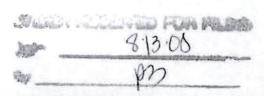

Inc., the professional engineer who prepared the site plan. There were no Protestants or other interested citizens in attendance at the hearing.

Testimony and evidence offered revealed that the subject property is L-shaped and consists of approximately 45,738 square feet or 1.05 acre, more or less, zoned B.R.-A.S. The property is located on the east side of North Point Boulevard, south of Wise Avenue, in the Sparrows Point area of Baltimore County. As shown on the site plan, the property is actually made up of three separate parcels. Parcel 219, Lot 11 (0.31 acre) is situated along North Point Boulevard and has an entry way directly to the road. This parcel is proposed to be improved with a one-story 1,600 square foot warehouse for administrative offices and storage. Parcel 491 (0.28 acre) is located to the east of (directly behind) Parcel 219. It is currently unimproved and is proposed for the contractor's equipment storage yard. Parcel 212 (0.46 acre) is located to the north of (directly above) Parcel 491 and is also proposed for the contractor's equipment storage yard.

Petitioners Edwin and Dorothy Hayes have owned and operated A-1 Demolition for approximately 20 years. They have operated at the subject location for approximately the last 10 years. Petitioners recently became interested in purchasing the subject property and according to Mr. Pittler, settlement on the property already occurred between Mr. and Mrs. Hayes and Betty Ratliff and Petitioners are now the legal owners of the property. Because Petitioners are now owners of the property and because they wish to make certain improvements to the property in order to increase the efficiency of their business and enhance the appearance of the site, they desire to legitimize the existing conditions and uses on the site; hence the Petitions for Special Hearing and Special Exception.

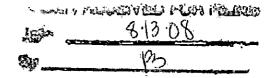
Petitioners' business specializes in demolition, removal, and temporary storage of hazardous materials including asbestos abatement and mold and lead paint removal. The company also performs general demolition services that do not require the stringent demolition and storage



procedures that accompany hazardous materials abatement. The company utilizes closed trailers for the temporary storage of the hazardous materials and dumpsters for non-hazardous general demolition. The company also stores general construction equipment as well as equipment specifically for hazardous material removal. The company is certified by the Maryland Department of the Environment (MDE) and is re-certified each year. As such, MDE will visit the site each year and inspect various aspects of hazardous materials storage to ensure compliance with MDE standards.

As shown on the aerial photograph that was marked and accepted into evidence as Petitioners' Exhibit 2, the surrounding area is a mix of industrial and commercial uses. To the west of the subject property are large, heavy industrial uses. The aerial photograph that was marked and accepted into evidence as Petitioner's Exhibit 3 shows a closer view of the subject property and surrounding businesses. These include a metal processing company, a crane company, a rental systems company, a general contractor, and an auto service business. There is also a lumber and hardware company, another auto repair business, a marine service business, and a used car sales lot. Located to the east, behind the subject property is a wooded area that backs up to Interstate 695 and the Amtrak railroad tracks. A zoning map marked and accepted into evidence as Petitioners' Exhibit 4 shows the zoning in the area to be predominantly business and manufacturing, including B.L., B.M., B.R., M.L., and M.H., with portions having an A.S. and I.M. overlay.

Photographs of the site which were marked and accepted into evidence as Petitioners' Exhibit 5 show the appearance of the site and the surrounding properties. Two photographs labeled "site frontage" depict the front parcel (Parcel 219, Lot 11) with the 1,600 foot warehouse that has been constructed pursuant to Baltimore County permit number B698070. The photographs labeled "rear parcels" depict the other two parcels (Parcels 491 and 212) where the



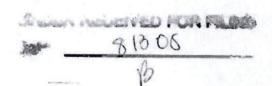
contractor's equipment storage yard is proposed. It is apparent based on the photographs that the site is well maintained and organized. Debris is placed in closed containers or dumpsters, depending on whether the debris consists of hazardous materials or general demolition materials. The photo labeled "containers" shows the containers that are used to temporarily store the hazardous materials.

In addressing the special hearing to determine whether Petitioners' storage of asbestos, lead, and mold materials and demolition and remediation equipment constitutes a contractor's equipment storage yard pursuant to Section 101 of the B.C.Z.R., Petitioners' consulting engineer, Kenneth Colbert, testified at the hearing. Mr. Colbert is a registered professional engineer in the State of Maryland and has practiced in the field of civil engineering and site planning and land development for approximately 40 years. He has testified extensively as an expert in the field of civil engineering and land development before this Commission and the Board of Appeals. He was offered and accepted as an expert in this case.

A Contractor's Equipment Storage Yard is defined in Section 101 of the B.C.Z.R. as follows:

The use of any space, whether inside or outside a building, for the storage or keeping of contractor's equipment or machinery, including building materials storage, construction equipment storage or landscaping equipment and associated materials.

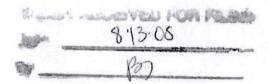
Mr. Colbert indicated that Petitioners utilize the subject property, and specifically Parcels 491 and 212, to store their construction equipment related to their general demolition work and their demolition and removal of hazardous materials. He also indicated that Petitioners utilize the parcels to temporarily store the hazardous materials in the closed storage trailers, in compliance with MDE requirements, and to store general demolition materials in dumpsters. Mr. Colbert



offered his opinion that these activities are consistent with the definition of a Contractor's Equipment Storage Yard.

Mr. Colbert then addressed the Special Exception criteria set forth in Section 502.1 of the B.C.Z.R. pertaining to the request to use the property as a contractor's equipment storage yard in a B.R. Zone pursuant to Section 236.4 of the B.C.Z.R. Mr. Colbert opined that the use would not be detrimental to the health, safety or general welfare of the locale. The manner in which the materials are handled and stored will not result in any negative impacts to the surrounding community. Mr. Colbert also indicated that the use would not have a negative impact on any of the other 502.1 criteria, and in particular would not be inconsistent with the purposes of the property's zoning classification nor in any other way inconsistent with the spirit and intent of the Zoning Regulations. And again, based on the manner in which materials are handled and stored, Mr. Colbert opined that the use would not be detrimental to the environmental and natural resources of the site and vicinity. In addition, the site is sufficiently screened from other properties with landscaping and fencing so as not to cause any adverse impact.

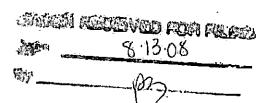
The Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC) comments were received and are made part of the record of this case. Comments were received from the Office of Planning dated June 26, 2008 which indicates that the site currently has stored on it a number of dumpsters full of plastic bags, as well as building material debris, pieces of mechanical equipment, lumber (under a large storage roof) and two closed truck trailers. There is a mixture of industrial, retail and office uses proximate to the site. The Planning Office recommends that Petitioner clean up and clear the existing site to meet the description on the site plan. Provide a clear and accurate description of the procedures for transporting, unloading and storing the referenced materials, so as to convince the Zoning Commissioner that there will be no contamination of the subject property or adjacent properties.



Based on the testimony and evidence presented, I am persuaded to grant the special hearing relief. I agree with the uncontroverted testimony of Petitioner's expert, Mr. Colbert, that the storage of Petitioners' construction equipment related to their general demolition work and their demolition and removal of hazardous materials, the temporary storage of the hazardous materials in the closed storage trailers — in compliance with MDE requirements, and the storage of general demolition materials in dumpsters, are consistent with the definition of a Contractor's Equipment Storage Yard in Section 101 of the B.C.Z.R..

I am also persuaded to grant the requested special exception relief pursuant to Section 236.4 of the B.C.Z.R. Again, the testimony is uncontroverted that Petitioners' use of the property will not have any detrimental impacts on the criteria set forth in Section 502.1 of the B.C.Z.R. I am convinced that as long as the site is well kept and maintained, that all equipment and materials are properly stored and the property secured, and that storage of hazardous materials is in compliance with the standards required by the MDE, that the use can be permitted with no adverse impacts on the surrounding community.

Pursuant to the advertisement, posting of the property, and public hearing on these petitions held, and after considering the testimony and evidence offered by Petitioners, I find that Petitioners' request for special hearing and special exception should be granted.



IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the request for Special Exception to allow a contractor's equipment storage yard in a B.R. Zone in accordance with Section 236.4 of the B.C.Z.R. be and is hereby GRANTED.

This Order is subject to the following restrictions which are conditions precedent to the relief granted herein:

- 1. Petitioners may apply for permits and be granted same upon receipt of this Order; however, Petitioners are hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at their own risk until such time as the 30-day appellate process from this Order has expired. If, for whatever reason, this Order is reversed, Petitioners would be required to return, and be responsible for returning, said property to its original condition.
- 2. Petitioners shall properly maintain the site and keep the site well organized and clear of unnecessary debris, with the storage of construction and demolition equipment in designated areas, and the storage of general demolition materials and hazardous materials in designated areas and in proper dumpsters or closed trailers.
- 3. Petitioners shall maintain their certification with the Maryland Department of the Environment (MDE) for the demolition, remediation, and temporary storage of hazardous materials. Petitioner shall comply with all MDE standards and/or requirements.
- 4. Petitioners shall permit the property to be subject to inspections by the Baltimore County Division of Code Inspections and Enforcement to ensure that the site is well maintained and in compliance with all County Codes and Regulations.

Any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.
