AMENDED ORDER

On November 26, 2019 the Petitioner filed a Motion for Reconsideration concerning condition 3 of the original Order, which provides that "[t]he Petitioner shall maintain the 'pocket park' at the front of the property except for the portion upon which the driveway is depicted on the rubricated Site Plan." In the Motion for Reconsideration counsel for Petitioner states that "[t]his restriction appears to convey in perpetuity the obligation to permanently restrict this portion of the Petitioner's property for use as a park," and that "this bench and landscaping was placed on this property without the prior written approval or written permission of the owner, at a time when the property was vacant. The property was [then] sold at auction to my client. As the new owner, he is willing to allow the benches and landscaping to remain so long as they do not interfere with his current or future use of his property." Counsel then explains that in the future his client may need to move or alter the "pocket park" in order to permit all necessary ingress and egress. Finally, the Motion asks that the original Order be amended in order to clarify that his client has not conveyed or ceded any legal interest in the property.

It was not my meaning or intent to Order the Petitioner to convey any legal interest in this property, as I understand I do not have the authority to do so under the Baltimore County Charter or Code. Indeed, nowhere in the Order is this stated nor is there any named grantee of such a

conveyance. However, counsel for Petitioner did state at the hearing of this matter that his client would maintain the "pocket park" at the front of the lot to the extent possible for use by the community in conjunction with the MTA bus stop. While this was purely voluntary, this offer was made to the community at the hearing in an attempt to address their opposition to the requested variance relief, and I trust that the offer was made in good faith.

Therefore, upon consideration of the Motion for Reconsideration, paragraph 3 of the Order of October 29, 2019 is amended as follows:

3. Petitioner shall in good faith maintain the "pocket park" at the front of the property for use by the community in connection with the MTA bus stop. If and when the Petitioner needs to remove any of the landscaping or benches in order to have necessary ingress and egress to the site the Petitioner will restore the benches and landscaping to the extent reasonably possible. Nothing in this Order purports to convey any legal interest in the property or create legal or equitable rights on the part of any person or group other than the owner of record.

All other aspects and provisions of the Order of October 29, 2019 shall remain in full force and effect.

Any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

PETITIONER'S MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION

The Petitioner and Owner, Joseph Corasiniti, by and through his undersigned counsel, requests this Honorable Court to reconsider its decision dated the 29st day of October, 2019 and in support thereof, states the following:

- This matter came on for a hearing before your Honor on the 24th day of October,
 2019.
- After a hearing on the merits, the petition for variance was granted by Order dated the 29th day of October 2019, subject to certain conditions and restrictions. (Copy Attached)
- 3. The purpose of this request for reconsideration involves restriction #3 of that Order which states: "The Petitioner shall maintain the "pocket Park" at the front of the property except for that portion upon which the driveway is depicted on the rubricated Site Plan".
- 4. This restriction appears to convey in perpetuity the obligation to permanently restrict this portion of the Petitioner's property for use as a park. You may recall that the testimony at the hearing demonstrated that members of the community placed two benches and some landscaping onto the front portion of this lot, to be used in connection with the MTA bus stop that is located within the County's right of way at the corner of Sollers Point Road and Turner Avenue.

This bench and landscaping was placed on this property without the prior written approval or written permission of the owner, at a time when the property was vacant. The property was sold at auction to my client. As the new owner, he is willing to allow the

benches and landscaping to remain so long as they do not interfere with his current or future use of his property. He already needs to construct a driveway through that area of the property so that he may have access from Sollers Point Road to his own property. This will cause him to have to move the benches to make way for the driveway access to his storage building.

Also, as stated at the hearing, the owner intends to store a very rare and antique steam engine within the new storage building. The steam engine is a working train engine which is difficult to transport and maneuver. Proper driveway access from Sollers Point Road is an absolute necessity in order to back the steam engine and trailer into the storage building.

Accordingly, based on the above, we ask that you modify restriction #3 to read as follows or language similar to the following:

"The Petitioner has voluntarily agreed, but is not legally obligated to maintain the benches and landscaping that support the existing MTA bus stop. This restriction does not convey to the community any legal interest in the property, as this ALJ does not have the authority to convey an interest in property. The owner may retract this permission, should the need arise in the future for the owner to utilize that portion of his property.

OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings ("OAH") for Baltimore County as a Petition for Variance filed by Joseph Corasaniti, legal owner of the subject property ("Petitioner"). Petitioner is requesting variance relief from Sections 232.2 & 232.1 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("BCZR") as follows: (1) to permit a side yard setback of 7.5 ft. in lieu of the required 10 ft.; and (2) to allow a front yard setback of 27 ft. and 20 ft. in lieu of the required 40 ft. A rubricated site plan was marked as Petitioner's Exhibit 1.

Civil Engineer, William Bafitis appeared in support of the petition. Timothy M. Kotroco, Esq. represented Petitioner. There were protestants and interested citizens in attendance. The Petition was advertised and posted as required by the BCZR. Substantive Zoning Advisory Committee ("ZAC") comments were received from the Department of Planning ("DOP"), the Department of Environmental Protection and Sustainability ("DEPS") and the Bureau of Development Plans Review ("DPW").

Mr. Kotroco proffered the following facts. His client, Mr. Corasaniti purchased the property at auction. It is a vacant lot upon which he wants to build a storage building to store a couple of antique automobiles as well as an antique steam engine. The plans call for an office and a restroom within the structure. The building will be used for Corasiniti's personal storage use

only. There will be no commercial use of any kind. This is a use that is permitted as of right in this BL zone. *See*, Petitioner's Exhibit 5.

Mr. Kotroco described the unique features of the property, including the following: It is long and narrow and slightly asymmetrical. It has a public bus stop at the front right corner. Mr. Kotroco submitted a series of aerial photos (Petitioner's Exhibit 2) as well as a series of numbered ground level photos with a corresponding Site Plan (Petitioner's Exhibit 3). Residents of the neighborhood have created a "pocket park" at the front of the property near the bus stop. They have planted a row of evergreen trees which screens this park area from the rest of the lot and they have placed a couple of park benches there. Mr. Kotroco stated that he has spoken with Ms. Edie Brooks, a neighborhood activist, and he has assured her that Mr. Corasiniti will keep the park on the property for the community's use and benefit. Mr. Kotroco noted that several of the trees appear to be dying and he pledged that his client would plant similar trees in their place. He explained that the property is bordered on the front by Sollers Point Road and on the right by Turner Avenue. As a result the lot has "double frontage" under BCZR Sections 232.1 (front yard) and 232.2 (side yard). He explained that they meet the setbacks from Sollers Point Road but they need variance relief from the setbacks from Turner Avenue.

Cheryl James then posed several questions. She owns the home at 110 Turner Avenue, which adjoins the subject property at the rear. She asked how tall the structure would be. The engineer, Mr. Bafitis testified that it will be a one story structure and would be 20' high at the most. Ms. James asked whether landscaping would be planted at the rear of the building to screen it as much as possible from her property. Mr. Bafitis stated that they would move the building up several feet from the rear property line and would plant a landscape screen.

Servant Courtney Speed then testified. She explained that a "charrette" was held for this

neighborhood back in 2003 and that one of the long term planning goals was to encourrag local business development that would create jobs for members of the Turner Station community. She observed that this proposed storage structure would not do that. She did concede that the property has sat vacant and undeveloped for many years (Ms. James estimated 15 years). None of the community members in attendance had any questions about the specific setback relief requested in the Petition and none voiced any objections to that specific relief.

I note that in the comments from the Department of Planning, they too point out that the site is in the Eastern Baltimore County Revitalization Strategy plan area, and that "a stated goal of said plan is the promotion of commercial development that 'stabilizes, strengthens, and diversifies the neighborhood's economy and improves the economic and visual image of the area." (emphasis in original). In light of this the DOP recommends several conditions for the requested variance relief, including review and final approval by the County Landscape Architect, as well as the use of "solid, quality materials in its construction." No comment is made concerning the fact that this use will not have any impact on the neighborhood's economy.

VARIANCE

A variance request involves a two-step legal analysis, summarized as follows:

- (1) It must be shown the property is unique in a manner which makes it unlike surrounding properties, and that uniqueness or peculiarity must necessitate variance relief; and
- (2) If variance relief is denied, Petitioner will experience a practical difficulty or hardship.

Cromwell v. Ward, 102 Md. App. 691 (1995).

For the reasons explained above, I find that the property is unique. It has an irregular shape, and has a bus stop and "pocket park." Further it has "double frontage" which necessitates the requested variance relief. If the Regulations were strictly interpreted, Petitioner would experience

a practical difficulty because he would be unable to build the planned storage structure. Finally, I find that the variance can be granted in harmony with the spirit and intent of the BCZR, and in such manner as to grant relief without injury to the public health, safety and general welfare. Although it would have been ideal to have a local business on this property that would create employment for the community the fact is that this property has sat vacant for the last fifteen years. The storage building planned for this site will be a very passive use that will not create any traffic, noise or nuisance of any kind. And, as noted above, this use is permitted by right in this BL zone.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, this <u>29th</u> day of October, 2019, by the Administrative Law Judge for Baltimore County, that the Petition for Variance pursuant to the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations as follows: (1) to permit a side yard setback of 7.5 ft. in lieu of the required 10 ft.; and (2) to allow a front yard setback of 27 ft. and 20 ft. in lieu of the required 40 ft., be and is hereby GRANTED.

The relief granted herein shall be subject to the following:

- 1. Petitioner may apply for necessary permits and/or licenses upon receipt of this Order. However, Petitioner is hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at his own risk until 30 days from the date hereof, during which time an appeal can be filed by any party. If for whatever reason this Order is reversed, Petitioner would be required to return the subject property to its original condition.
- 2. Prior to issuance of permits, Petitioner must comply with ZAC comments submitted by DOP, DEPS and DPR, copies of which are attached hereto and made a part hereof.
- 3. Petitioner shall maintain the "pocket park" at the front of the property except for the portion upon which the driveway is depicted on the rubricated Site Plan.
- 4. The building will be sited far enough from the rear property line to accommodate a landscape screen between this building and the property at 110 Turner Avenue to the rear.
- 5. The building will be no higher than 20 feet.

The subject property is located within the Chesapeake Bay Critical Area. According to BCZR Section 500.14, no decision shall be rendered on any petition for special exception, zoning variance, or zoning special hearing for a property within the Critical Area until the Department of Environmental Protection and Sustainability (EPS) has provided written recommendations describing how the proposed request would:

1. Minimize adverse impacts on water quality that result from pollutants that are discharged from structures or conveyances or that have run off from surrounding lands;

The subject property is located within an Intensely Developed Area (IDA) of the Chesapeake Bay Critical Area and may be subject to practices that reduce water quality impacts associated with stormwater runoff, commonly referred to as the Critical Area 10% Rule. The applicant's plan proposes the construction of a one-story office building and a storage building, with reduced front yard and side yard setbacks. The project will be reviewed for application of the Critical Area 10% Rule. By meeting the IDA pollutant reduction requirements, allowing the additional impervious surface requested by the applicant will result in minimal impacts to water quality.

2. Conserve fish, wildlife, and plant habitat; and

The subject property is not a waterfront property, nor is it immediately adjacent to a tidal or non-tidal resource, therefore, the property does not contain a Critical Area buffer, however, the current development proposal for the property will be reviewed for application of the IDA 10% pollutant reduction requirements, which will improve off site

buffer functions and conserve fish habitat in proximity to nearby Peach Orchard Creek and Bear Creek.

3. Be consistent with established land use policies for development in the Chesapeake Bay Critical Area which accommodate growth and also address the fact that, even if pollution is controlled, the number, movement and activities of persons in that area can create adverse environmental impacts.

The applicant's proposal is subject to review for application of the Critical Area IDA pollutant reduction requirements, therefore, is consistent with this goal. The requests, if granted, will be consistent with established land-use policies, provided that the applicants meet any IDA requirements applicable to the proposal.
