ORDER ON MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION

Now pending is a Motion for Reconsideration of the December 13, 2019 Order issued in the above case. That Order granted with conditions both the Petitions for Special Hearing and Variance. Specifically, the Petition for Special Hearing sought relief from Section 1B01.1.B.1.g(6) of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("BCZR") to permit a building for religious practice with a finding that the proposed improvements are planned in such a way that compliance, to the extent possible with Residential Transition Area ("RTA") use requirements, will be maintained and the plan can otherwise be expected to be compatible with the character and general welfare of the surrounding residential premises. In addition, the Petition for Variance sought relief from Sections 409.6, 1B01.2.C.1, 1B01.1.B.1.e(3) and 1B01.1.B.1.e(5) of the BCZR to: (1) to permit 2 parking spaces in lieu of the required 3 spaces; (2) to permit a front setback of 35 ft. front yard in lieu of the required 50 ft. for a non-residential building, and a street corner side yard of 34 ft. in lieu of the required 35 ft.; (3) to permit an RTA undisturbed buffer of 0 ft. in lieu of the required 50 ft.; and (4) to permit an RTA structure or parking lot setback of a minimum of 34 ft. in lieu of the required 75 ft.,

interest in his neighborhood, and the time he has taken to attend the Hearing and to prepare and file the Motion for Reconsideration. The rest of the issues raised in the Motion are simply a rehash of the testimony that Mr. Abrams gave at the Hearing and do not change my view of the case.

OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings ("OAH") for consideration of Petitions for Special Hearing and Variance filed on behalf of Havkim, LLC, legal owner ("Petitioner"). The Special Hearing was filed pursuant to Section 1B01.1.B.1g(6) of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("BCZR") to permit a building for religious practice with a finding that the proposed improvements are planned in such a way that compliance, to the extent possible with Residential Transition Area ("RTA") use requirements, will be maintained and that the plan can otherwise be expected to be compatible with the character and general welfare of the surrounding residential premises. In addition, a Petition for Variance was filed pursuant to §§ 409.6, 1B01.2.C.1, 1B01.1.B.1.e(3) and 1B01.1.B.1.e(5) as follows:. (1) to permit 2 parking spaces in lieu of the required 3 spaces; (2) to permit a front setback of 35 ft. front yard in lieu of the required 50 ft. for a non-residential building, and a street corner side yard of 34 ft. in lieu of the required 35 ft.; (3) to permit an RTA undisturbed buffer of 0 ft. in lieu of the required 50 ft.; and (4) to permit an RTA structure or parking lot setback of a minimum of 34 ft. in lieu of the required 75 ft. A site plan was marked and accepted into evidence as Petitioner's Exhibit 1.

Shlomo Rosenbaum appeared in support of the requests. Herbert Burgunder, III, Esq. represented Petitioner. A letter of opposition from James J. Buchwalter, who resides at 6603

Baythorne Road, was submitted in advance of the hearing. The Petition was advertised and posted as required by the BCZR. A substantive Zoning Advisory Committee ("ZAC") comment was received from the Department of Planning ("DOP"). Two protestants, Barbara Gruber, and Paul Abrams attended the hearing.

SPECIAL HEARING

Mr. Rosenbaum testified that the proposed mikvah will serve the surrounding community and will particularly benefit those who are in closer proximity to this location than the main mikvah on Clark's Lane in Pikesville. He explained that the exterior of the structure will remain the same, except for the one story addition enclosing the existing patio on the rear of the structure. He stressed that there will be no signage identifying the mikvah and that it will continue to look just like a residence and blend in to the existing neighborhood. He further explained that no vehicular traffic will be generated by this use, other than cleaning and maintenance crews because the users are required by their faith to walk to the mikvah. As such, the proposed mikvah will not exacerbate the traffic or parking conditions in the neighborhood. He testified that they currently have no vehicular traffic associated with the main mikvah. Finally, he testified that this proposed mikvah will be open only on Fridays after sunset, and on approximately ten religious holidays a year. Rosenbaum estimates that they will serve 8 to 10 persons on those Friday evenings.

The protestants, Ms. Gruber and Mr. Abrams, voiced skepticism regarding Mr. Rosenbaum's testimony that the mikvah would not generate any further traffic in the area. They both described traffic from out of the area and from out of state that is generated by the existence of synagogues and ancillary religious buildings in the County. They testified that the traffic conditions on Smith Avenue in particular are already particularly dangerous, and they described several recent incidents where pedestrians have been hit by cars. Mr. Rosenbaum stated that he is ready and

willing to work in good faith with the relevant County agencies to install any and all appropriate traffic calming devices in the area as he is also concerned for the safety of those walking to the mikvah.

Based on the record evidence I am satisfied that the use of this property as a mikvah, as depicted in the site plan and described by Mr. Rosenbaum complies to the extent possible with the RTA requirements. I further find that this non-intensive use will be compatible with the character and general welfare of the surrounding residential premises. I do not believe that the proposed mikvah will exacerbate the existing parking or traffic conditions, which were the only concerns raised by the protestants.

VARIANCE

A variance request involves a two-step process, summarized as follows:

- (1) It must be shown the property is unique in a manner which makes it unlike surrounding properties, and that uniqueness or peculiarity must necessitate variance relief; and
- (2) If variance relief is denied, Petitioner will experience a practical difficulty or hardship.

Cromwell v. Ward, 102 Md. App. 691 (1995).

The lot in question if somewhat irregularly shaped lot. Further, the residential structure is sited to the right of center on the lot, presumably so as to be set back farther from Smith Avenue which borders it on the north. As such the property is unique. If the Regulations were strictly interpreted, Petitioner would experience a practical difficulty because there is not sufficient space on the lot to create a third parking place or to construct the mikvah. In fact, I believe the mikvah, which will be open less than seventy days a year (Friday evenings and approximately ten Jewish holidays), will likely generate less traffic, noise, congestion, and parking issues than an average residence would. Finally, I find that the variance can be granted in harmony with the spirit and

intent of the BCZR, and in such manner as to grant relief without injury to the public health, safety and general welfare. This is demonstrated by the lack of County opposition.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED this 13th day of December, 2019, by this Administrative Law Judge, that the Petition for Special Hearing to permit a building for religious practice with a finding that the proposed improvements are planned in such a way that compliance, to the extent possible with Residential Transition Area ("RTA") use requirements, will be maintained and the plan can otherwise be expected to be compatible with the character and general welfare of the surrounding residential premises, be and is hereby GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Petition for Variance: (1) to permit 2 parking spaces in lieu of the required 3 spaces; (2) to permit a front setback of 35 ft. front yard in lieu of the required 50 ft. for a non-residential building, and a street corner side yard of 34 ft. in lieu of the required 35 ft.; (3) to permit an RTA undisturbed buffer of 0 ft. in lieu of the required 50 ft.; and (4) to permit an RTA structure or parking lot setback of a minimum of 34 ft. in lieu of the required 75 ft., be and is hereby GRANTED.

The relief granted herein shall be subject to the following:

1. Petitioner may apply for necessary permits and/or licenses upon receipt of this Order. However, Petitioner is hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at his own risk until 30 days from the date hereof, during which time an appeal can be filed by any party. If for whatever reason this Order is reversed, Petitioner would be required to return the subject property to its original condition.

2. Petitioner must comply with the ZAC comment submitted by the DOP, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

3. The mikvah shall operate only on Fridays after sundown and on Jewish holidays.

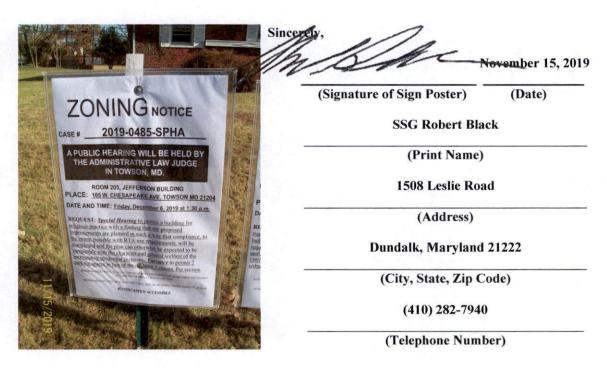

To Whom It May Concern:

I, Paul Abrams, appeared before Judge Paul M. Mayhew at a special hearing before the Baltimore County Review Board concerning the zoning approval of the house located at 6615 Baythorne Rd., to be converted for religious use as a Jewish Mikvah.

As a lifetime, Jewish citizen of Baltimore County and the same neighborhood where I grew up and continue to reside, in Mt. Washington/Pikesville, I am greatly concerned about the safety of our residents. I have asked and received 2 additional street lights in my neighborhood of the 6700 block of Baythorne Rd. and the 6700 block of Old Pimlico Rd. I live at my family house at 2304 Baythorne Ct., of which my family has owned since 1960. I do not agree with using 6615 Baythorne Rd. as a Mikvah. As I mentioned at the hearing, there is already an existing Mikvah(bath house), located within 6701 Old Pimlico Rd., Rabbi Kaplan's Shul....If the Jewish neighbors do not see "Eye to Eye" with the Kaplan family, in regards to sharing their Mikvah with the surrounding neighbors, as I have heard from several families over the years...why can't the community approach the owner of the vacant Bank Building., sharing the same large parking lot as the Royal Farm Store at the corner of Smith Ave. and Old Pimlico Rd. This would be an ideal bldg. to convert to a Mikvah, rather than taking a house off the property tax revenue list of Baltimore County. The entry of the present old bank building could be changed to the opposite end (rear) of the structure, so it would be safer for persons entering & exiting the building. The building has been empty for several years...only a blight to the neighborhood.

The house at 6615 Baythorne was purchased by Mr. Abramson, at a foreclosure sale, possibly 3 years ago. Mr. Abramson, whose family lives on Wickfield Rd. in the Pickwick neighborhood and has HIS OWN address as the mailing address for 6615 Baythorne Rd. has left the house since it was purchased in poor condition, with some windows boarded up and not maintained. The previous owner used the house for foster teenagers. They disrespected the surrounding community, often yelling obscenities at adults (like myself) and children in the area. I am more than glad to see them all move out, several years ago. However, converting the existing house to be used as a Mikvah is wrong. The new crosswalk lights (hands free design) at the corner of Old Pimlico Rd. & Smith Ave. is ideal for a Mikvah at the old Bank Building, just a short walk away. Having a Mikvah 2 blocks down Smith Ave. will only make it more dangerous for pedestrians using the Mikvah. Whenever the traffic light turns red at Smith & Old Pimlico Rd., cars and trucks speed up to get through the intersection, racing down Smith Ave., with no other traffic signal until you get to Kelly Ave. ,in Baltimore City, and the street lighting is generally poor. Mr. Abramson and his entourage should have asked Baltimore County to make improvements to the street lighting just after purchasing the house, if they were really concerned with the safety and welfare of the neighbors, as well as asking the County to install a traffic circle at Pebblebrooke Rd. & Smith Ave., only a few blocks down east on Smith Ave. Traffic circles are actually safer than traffic signals, since I witness many drivers going through red lights. I would rather see the house sold (possibly demolished) and another house built...like many neighbors are doing in the Ranchleigh neighborhood (adding additional tax revenue to the County, or simply renovated. If the owner of the old bank building is uncooperative, than the County could condemn the property and take it in eminent domain....Also, there are no sidewalks on the north side of Smith Ave., in the 2200 & 2300 BLOCKS OF Smith Ave., making crossing the street very dangerous at times...Also, Baythorne Rd. in the 6700 block, dead ends at Smith Ave., with no right of way(to install a continuous walkway to Smith Ave). Please consider everything I have mentioned here. I also asked the County to do a streetscape along Smith Ave., with new trees on the north side and new lampposts on the south side, between the existing telephone poles.
