OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings ("OAH") for Baltimore County as a Petition for Variance filed by Shoppes at Nottingham Square Business Trust, legal owner of the subject property ("Petitioner"). Petitioner is requesting variance relief from § 409.6.A.2 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("BCZR") to allow a total of 145 off-street parking spaces in lieu of the required 191 parking spaces. A site plan was marked as Petitioner's Exhibit 1.

Kathleen McLaren appeared in support of the petition. David H. Karceski, Esq. represented Petitioner. Chris Armstrong, the professional engineer who prepared and sealed the site plan also attended the hearing. His *curriculum vitae* was admitted as Petitioner's Exhibit 2. There were no protestants or interested citizens in attendance. The Petition was advertised and posted as required by the BCZR. No substantive Zoning Advisory Committee ("ZAC") comments were received from any of the County reviewing agencies.

The site is approximately 2.52 acres in size and is zoned BM. The Petitioner intends to open and operate a Japanese restaurant on the premises. A series of aerial and ground level photographs of the site were admitted as Petitioner's Exhibit Nos. 3 and 4, respectively. These photos show the diverse mix of retail and commercial uses in the vicinity as well as the adjoining

environmental features. They also document the abundance of existing parking. This site is within the White Marsh Community Master Plan which contains a wide mix of zoning classifications, uses, and environmental areas. The subject building has been vacant and the proposed new restaurant will add to the mix of existing restaurants in the area. A variance of 145 parking spaces in lieu of 191 spaces is requested. Mr. Karceski proffered that Mr. Armstrong and Ms. McLaren would testify that they have been at the location on a number of dates and times and that parking is abundant.

A variance request involves a two-step process, summarized as follows:

- (1) It must be shown the property is unique in a manner which makes it unlike surrounding properties, and that uniqueness or peculiarity must necessitate variance relief; and
- (2) If variance relief is denied, Petitioner will experience a practical difficulty or hardship.

Cromwell v. Ward, 102 Md. App. 691 (1995).

As noted above, the site is located within the Whitemarsh Community Master Planned development which contains a wide variety of uses and which adjoins several different environmentally sensitive areas, including White Marsh Run. As such the property is unique. If the Regulations were strictly interpreted, Petitioner would experience a practical difficulty because it would be unable to open the proposed new restaurant. Finally, I find that the variance can be granted in harmony with the spirit and intent of the BCZR, and in such manner as to grant relief without injury to the public health, safety and general welfare. This is demonstrated by the absence of community opposition, or County agency opposition.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, this 18th day of December, 2019, by the Administrative Law Judge for Baltimore County, that the Petition for Variance pursuant to the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations to allow a total of 145 off-street parking spaces in lieu of the required 191

parking spaces, be and is hereby GRANTED.

The relief granted herein shall be subject to the following:

1. Petitioner may apply for necessary permits and/or licenses upon receipt of this Order. However, Petitioner is hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at its own risk until 30 days from the date hereof, during which time an appeal can be filed by any party. If for whatever reason this Order is reversed, Petitioner would be required to return the subject property to its original condition.

Any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

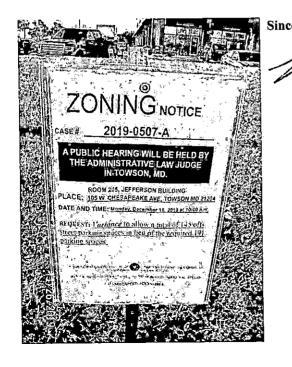

OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) for Baltimore County as a Petition for Variance on behalf of Retail Properties Business Trust, the legal owner of the subject property, and Chick-Fil-A, Inc., Lessee ("Petitioners"). The Petitioners are requesting Variance relief from the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.) §§ 409.6 and 409.10.B (1) to allow 66 off-street parking spaces in lieu of the required 80 parking spaces; and (2) to allow a drive-thru lare to cross principal pedestrian access to the building, if necessary. The subject property and requested relief is more fully depicted on the site plan that was marked as Petitioners' Exhibit 1.

Rex Powell of Chick-Fil-A appeared in support of the petition. David H. Karceski, Esq. represented the Lessee. The Petition was advertised and posted as required by the B.C.Z.R. No Protestants or ir terested citizens attended the hearing. There were no substantive Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC) comments received.

The subject property is approximately 1.3 acres and is zoned BM. The property is improved with a Chick-Fil-A restaurant which has operated at the location for over ten years. The restaurant plans to add a second drive-thru lane and construct a small addition to the kitchen and storage areas, as shown on the site plan. Exhibit 1. To do so zoning relief is required.

To obtain variance relief requires a showing that:

(1) The property is unique; and

(2) If variance relief is denied, petitioner will experience a practical difficulty or hardship.

Trinity Assembly of God v. People's Counsel, 407 Md. 53, 80 (2008).

Petitioners have met this test. The pad site on which the restaurant is located is part of an overall White Marsh Community plan, a sprawling land area with many different uses and owners. Exhibit 6. In addition, the White Marsh Run is adjacent to the site which imposes a variety of environmental constraints upon the property. Therefore, the property is unique. If the Regulations were strictly interpreted, Petitioners would experience a practical difficulty because they could not construct the proposed improvements. Finally, I find that the variance can be granted in harmony with the spirit and intent of the B.C.Z.R., and in such manner as to grant relief without injury to the public health, safety, and general welfare. This is demonstrated by the lack of Baltimore County and/or community opposition.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, this 1st day of October, 2015, by the Administrative Law Judge for Baltimore County, that the Petition for Variance seeking relief from the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("B.C.Z.R.") §§ 409.6 & 409.10.B: (1) to allow 66 off-street parking spaces in lieu of the required 80 parking spaces; and (2) to allow a drive-thru lane to cross principal pedestrian access to the building, be and is hereby GRANTED.

The relief granted herein shall be subject to the following:

1. Petitioners may apply for necessary permits and/or licenses upon receipt of this Order. However, Petitioners are hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at their own risk until 30 days from the date hereof, during which time an appeal can be filed by any party. If for whatever reason this Order is reversed, Petitioners would be required to return the subject property to its original condition.
