OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) for Baltimore County for consideration of Petitions for Special Hearing, Special Exception and Variance filed on behalf of Balaji, LLC, legal owner, and Dundalk North Point, LLC, contract purchaser ("Petitioners").

The Petition for Special Hearing was filed pursuant to the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("BCZR") to determine whether a Special Exception pursuant to §§ 405.2 and 236.2 is required in order: (1) to approve additional fuel service and ancillary uses permitted under BCZR § 405.4.D (convenience store less than 6,000 square feet, ATM, self-service vacuum and compressed air) at a legally existing fuel service station; (2) to approve the expansion and reconstruction of a fuel service station legally existing on the effective date of Bill 172-1993, including the provision of additional fuel service and ancillary uses permitted by BCZR §405.4.D (convenience store less than 6,000 square feet, ATM, self-service vacuum and compressed air); (3) to determine that the colored striped banding shown on the service station canopy is a decorative feature that does not contribute to the message of any sign and, in accordance with the definition of "Area" as provided in BCZR § 450.3 and Zoning Case 2002-399-SPHA, this decorative feature should not be included in the area of the canopy signs; (4) to determine whether ORDER RECEIVED FOR FILING

a variance is required for the canopy signs as shown on the Plan to Accompany Petition; and (5) to amend the previously approved zoning site plan in cases 2002-399-SPHA and 1990-392-SPHA. A Petition for Variance was filed pursuant to § 238.2 for a side yard setback of 21 feet in lieu of 30 feet required and a rear yard setback of 6 feet in lieu of 30 feet required. If, pursuant to Special Hearing Request No. 4, the Zoning Commissioner determines that a variance is required for the canopy sign as shown on the Plan to accompany the Petition for Special Hearing, than a variance from BCZR § 450.4 for canopy signs of 96 square feet, 96 square feet, 246 square feet and 246 square feet, respectively, in lieu of 25 square feet per sign otherwise permitted. Finally, a Petition for Special Exception was filed pursuant to Special Hearing Request No. 1, the Zoning Commissioner determines that a Special Exception is required in order to approve additional fuel service and ancillary uses permitted under BCZR § 405.4.D (convenience store less than 6,000 square feet, ATM, self-service vacuum and compressed air) at a legally existing fuel service station in accordance with the Plan to Accompany Petition for Zoning Hearing in this case, then a Special Exception for the same under BCZR § 405.2 and 236.2.

Appearing at the public hearing in support of the requests were the Petitioners, Michael Carp and Ed Scott. The engineers, Jennifer Leonard, and Keith Koscher of Kimley Horn also attended. Dino C. La Fiandra, Esq. represented the Petitioners. There were no Protestants or interested citizens in attendance. The Petition was advertised and posted as required by the BCZR. Substantive Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC) comments were submitted by the Department of Planning ("DOP"), the Bureau of Development Plans Review ("DPR"), the Department of Environmental Protection and Sustainability ("DEPS") and the State Highway Administration ("SHA").

Record Evidence

Mr. La Fiandra proffered the following evidence. The subject property is approximately 39,976 square feet in size and is split-zoned BR-IM. An expertly prepared five sheet site plan was admitted as Petitioner's Exhibit 1. Sheet 1, showing the existing site conditions was admitted separately as Petitioner's Exhibit 1A. Sheet 2, showing the proposed conditions was admitted separately as Exhibit 1B, and Sheet 4, showing the parking stacking plan was admitted separately as Exhibit 1C. Mr. La Fiandra briefly explained the somewhat lengthy zoning history pertaining to the site and submitted the prior zoning Orders as Exhibits 2A thru 2E.

The site is at the corner of Baltimore Street and North Point Blvd. in Dundalk. There is presently a three pump Shell gas station and convenience store there with two access points on both adjoining roads. The plan proposes to raze all the existing structures and to construct: six fuel stations under a canopy; a self-service vacuum machine; and a 3010 sq. ft. 7-11 convenience store with an ATM. They will have a maximum of three employees there. In the interest of improving traffic flow the access points will be reduced from four to two – one on Baltimore Street and one on North Point Blvd. In addition, these access points will be moved farther back from the intersections than the current access points. Counsel noted that the property does not have any basic services issues. As depicted on Exhibit 1B, the plan meets or exceeds the minimum square lot area, parking, and stacking requirements. The plan also meets all setback requirements except for the rear and one side of the convenience store. A rendering depicting the store's elevations and the canopy design and signage was admitted as Exhibit 4. A schematic landscape plan was admitted as Exhibit 5.

Counsel noted that, under the Order in Case No. 90-392-SPHA (Petitioner's Exhibit 2C) there was a legally existing "gas and go" and convenience store on this site as of the effective date

of Bill No. 172-93 (Petitioner's Exhibit 3), which Counsel proffered was January 13, 1994. Accordingly, Counsel urges that the "expansion and reconstruction" provisions of BCZR § 405.6 are applicable in this case because all of the proposed improvements will be within the site limits of that pre-existing use, and the site plan otherwise meets all the requirements of §§ 405.6 and 405.4.

Counsel further urged that the Deputy Zoning Commissioner's Order in Case No. 02-399-SPHA (Petitioner's Exhibit 2E) should also be controlling here with respect to the signage measurement issue. In that case the DZC held that the painted façade and decorative trim surrounding the word "Shell" on the sign should not be included when measuring the sign's dimensions under BCZR § 450.3 because the paint and trim are not part of the sign's "message."

Finally, in response to comments from the DOP regarding sidewalks, Counsel submitted a redlined site plan showing sidewalks along the entire site frontage on both Baltimore Street and North Point Blvd. This was admitted as Petitioner's Exhibit 8. Counsel called the engineer, Jennifer Leonard who testified that from a planning perspective a sidewalk along North Point Blvd. is not necessary and may even create an increased hazard for pedestrians who would potentially use this new sidewalk along this busy commercial highway rather than the existing sidewalk on North Point Road, which is only one block south and which currently provides connectivity for the adjacent residential area. Ms. Leonard submitted an aerial photo of the neighborhood to illustrate this point (Petitioner's Exhibit 6), as well as a series of street level photos showing that there are currently no sidewalks along North Point Blvd. in this area. (Petitioner's Exhibit 7).

Finally, Mr. La Fiandra urged that the rear and side variance requests should be granted because of the uniqueness of the property and the hardship that would otherwise result, in that they would have to reconfigure the entire site. He noted that several of the photos in Petitioner's Exhibit

7 show that there are no residential uses that would be impacted by the reduced setbacks, and that the property to the rear is a commercial trucking operation that would likewise not be adversely impacted.

In closing Mr. La Fiandra stated that he had spoken with People's Counsel about this proposal and that People's Counsel believes that the proposed site plan should be approved, if at all, as a special exception use, rather than under BCZR § 405.6.A because People's Counsel does not believe that special hearing relief has ever been granted under that section of the zoning regulations. Mr. La Fiandra urged that the Petitioner is in fact entitled to the special hearing relief requested, but alternatively, that Petitioner is also entitled to a special exception because all the factors of BCZR § 502.1 have been met, as have the elements in *Schultz v. Pritts*, 291 Md. 1 (1981).

Special Hearing

Based on the record evidence and legal argument discussed above, I find that the Petitioner is entitled to proceed with their proposed site plan under BCZR § 405.6. Specifically, I find that there was a legally existing fuel service station on this site as of January 13, 1994, the effective date of Bill No. 172-1993. I further find that this proposed renovation and expansion is permitted in this B.R. – I.M. zone, and that the site plan conforms in all respects to the requirements of BCZR § 405.4., that it has been properly reviewed by all the relevant County agencies, and that subject to various comments, these agencies do not oppose the special hearing relief. I also concur with Counsel on the issue of the signage. Under principles of *stare decisis* I believe I should follow the reasoning and decision in Case No. 2002-399-SPHA. Accordingly, I find that the background and trim on the proposed signage in this case do not contribute to the message conveyed by the "7-11" on the signage. Therefore, the background and trim of the signage should not be included in the "area" measurements under BCZR § 450.3 and no variance

relief is necessary for the signage. Finally, I will also grant the request to amend the previously approved site plans in Case Nos. 2002-399-SPHA, and 1990-392-SPHA.

Special Exception

Under Maryland law, a special exception use enjoys a presumption that it is in the interest of the general welfare, and therefore, valid. *Schultz v. Pritts*, 291 Md. 1 (1981). The *Schultz* standard was revisited in *Attar v. DMS Tollgate, LLC*, 451 Md. 272, (2017), where the court of appeals discussed the nature of the evidentiary presumption in special exception cases. The court again emphasized a special exception is properly denied only when there are facts and circumstances showing that the adverse impacts of the use at the particular location in question would be above and beyond those inherently associated with the special exception use. As an alternative to the special hearing relief under BCZR § 405.6, I also find that the proposed site plan should be approved as a special exception.

I am satisfied that the requirements of BCZR § 502.1 are met. Specifically, I find that the revised ingress and egress points depicted on the site plan will actually improve traffic safety and flow. I further note that there are no basic services map issues associated with this site. In sum, I find that the special exception is within the spirit and intent of the BCZR and will not result in harm to the general health, safety, and welfare of the public.

Variances

A variance request involves a two-step process, summarized as follows:

- (1) It must be shown the property is unique in a manner which makes it unlike surrounding properties, and that uniqueness or peculiarity must necessitate variance relief; and
- (2) If variance relief is denied, Petitioner will experience a practical difficulty or hardship.

The property is split-zoned and irregularly shaped and is bordered at odd angles by two roads. As such the property is unique. If the Regulations were strictly interpreted Petitioners would experience a practical difficulty because they would be unable to proceed with their razing and renovation plans as depicted on the site plan. I am convinced that the adjoining properties will not be adversely impacted by the two small setback variances requested. Finally, I find that the variance can be granted in harmony with the spirit and intent of the BCZR, and in such manner as to grant relief without injury to the public health, safety and general welfare.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED this 16th day of March, 2020, by this Administrative Law Judge, that the Petition for Special Hearing filed to determine whether a Special Exception pursuant to §§ 405.2 and 236.2 is required in order: (1) to approve additional fuel service and ancillary uses permitted under BCZR § 405.4.D (convenience store less than 6,000 square feet, ATM, self-service vacuum and compressed air) at a legally existing fuel service station; (2) to approve the expansion and reconstruction of a fuel service station legally existing on the effective date of Bill 172-1993, including the provision of additional fuel service and ancillary uses permitted by BCZR §405.4.D (convenience store less than 6,000 square feet, ATM, self-service vacuum and compressed air); (3) to determine that the colored striped banding shown on the service station canopy is a decorative feature that does not contribute to the message of any sign and, in accordance with the definition of "Area" as provided in BCZR § 450.3 and Zoning Case 2002-399-SPHA, this decorative feature should not be included in the area of the canopy signs; (4) to determine whether a variance is required for the canopy signs as shown on the Plan to Accompany Petition; and (5) to amend the previously approved zoning site plan in cases 2002-399-SPHA and 1990-392-SPHA, be and is hereby GRANTED.

filed pursuant to Special Hearing Request No. 1, the Zoning Commissioner determines that a Special Exception is required in order to approve additional fuel service and ancillary uses permitted under BCZR § 405.4.D (convenience store less than 6,000 square feet, ATM, self-service vacuum and compressed air) at a legally existing fuel service station in accordance with the Plan to Accompany Petition for Zoning Hearing in this case, then a Special Exception for the same under BCZR §§405.2 and 236.2, be and is hereby GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Petition for Variance filed pursuant to § 238.2 for a side yard setback of 21 feet in lieu of 30 feet required and a rear yard setback of 6 feet in lieu of 30 feet required be and is hereby GRANTED.

The relief granted herein shall be subject to the following:

- Petitioners may apply for necessary permits and/or licenses upon receipt
 of this Order. However, Petitioners are hereby made aware that
 proceeding at this time is at their own risk until 30 days from the date
 hereof, during which time an appeal can be filed by any party. If for
 whatever reason this Order is reversed, Petitioners would be required to
 return the subject property to its original condition.
- 2. Prior to issuance of Permits, Petitioners must comply with ZAC comments submitted by DOP, DEPS, DPR and SHA; copies of which are attached hereto and made a part hereof.
- 3. With regard to sidewalks, the sidewalk as depicted on Petitioner's Exhibit 8, shall be required along Baltimore Street only. No sidewalks shall be required along North Point Blvd.

Any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the pate of this Order.

There is an existing sidewalk along Baltimore Street the applicant should retain or improve as part of the renovations. In addition, there is not currently a sidewalk along the portion of the property on North Point Blvd. As part of the plan, sidewalks shall be designed along North Point Blvd. This may require reducing the proposed landscape buffer. This part of North Point Blvd is not pedestrian accessible but there are portions that do have sidewalks and when development and redevelopment occurs in the county, all projects are required to adhere to the County's Complete Streets Policy. The applicant should consult with the State Highway Administration regarding the installation of sidewalks in this area.

The applicant has provided a landscape plan to the Department of Planning for review. If it is determined that sidewalks can go along North Point Road, the applicant should mitigate the loss of any proposed large deciduous trees by moving them to the area currently proposed for ground cover within the internal curb cuts of the proposed parking area as shown on the landscape plan.

In Zoning case 2002-399-SPHA, it was determined that a narrow painted façade of an existing Shell gas station canopy is not considered to be part of a sign. This case happens to be located at the property in question. The language states that this ruling applies to other Shell stations with similar canopy designs. In the spirit of this ruling, a 7-Eleven with striped paint along the canopy would likely be viewed similarly and should also not be considered part of a sign.

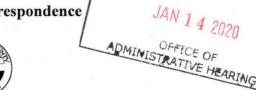

The Department of Planning has reviewed the petition for a special hearing to determine whether a special exception is required to approve additional fuel service and ancillary uses; and to approve the expansion and reconstruction of a fuel service legally existing on the effective date of Bill 172-1993; and to determine whether the color-striped banding around the service station canopy is considered part of the sign; and to determine whether a variance is required for the canopy signs; and to amend the previously approved zoning site plan in cases 2002-399-SPHA and 1990-392-SPHA.

The site is located at the southeast corner of North Point Boulevard and Baltimore Street. It is located in Dundalk and is currently zoned BR-IM. The site is currently operating as a Shell gas station and convenience store. The existing structures will be demolished and replaced with a 7-Eleven convenience store with 12 fuel service spaces (MPD's) and 12 stacked spaces. There is an existing 7-Eleven immediately to the south of the property owned by a franchisee and will not be renewed when the lease expires, according to the applicant.

The applicant is also requesting a variance from §238.2 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (BCZR) for a side yard setback of 21 feet in lieu of 30 feet and a rear yard setback of 6 feet in lieu of 30 feet. The area adjacent to the requested rear setback relief is part of a panhandle lot for the property at 201 North Point Road. The applicant states that the panhandle offers a buffer that will help mitigate setback concerns. The application meets the county requirements for fuel station and fuel canopy setbacks. The setback relief for the new 7-Eleven building is necessary in order to fit the fuel stations without additional setback relief.

A site visit was conducted on January 25, 2019. The property currently has two entrances along North Point Boulevard and two entrances along Baltimore Street. The applicant is proposing one entrance along North point Boulevard and one entrance along Baltimore Street. This should help mitigate coming and going from the gas station.

There is an existing sidewalk along Baltimore Street the applicant should retain or improve as part of the renovations. In addition, there is not currently a sidewalk along the portion of the property on North Point Blvd. As part of the plan, sidewalks shall be designed along North Point Blvd. This may require reducing the proposed landscape buffer. This part of North Point Blvd is not pedestrian accessible but there are portions that do have sidewalks and when development and redevelopment occurs in the county, all projects are required to adhere to the County's Complete Streets Policy. The applicant should consult with the State Highway Administration regarding the installation of sidewalks in this area.

The applicant has provided a landscape plan to the Department of Planning for review. If it is determined that sidewalks can go along North Point Road, the applicant should mitigate the loss of any proposed large deciduous trees by moving them to the area currently proposed for ground cover within the internal curb cuts of the proposed parking area as shown on the landscape plan.

In Zoning case 2002-399-SPHA, it was determined that a narrow painted façade of an existing Shell gas station canopy is not considered to be part of a sign. This case happens to be located at the property in question. The language states that this ruling applies to other Shell stations with similar canopy designs. In the spirit of this ruling, a 7-Eleven with striped paint along the canopy would likely be viewed similarly and should also not be considered part of a sign.

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

This matter comes before this Deputy Zoning Commissioner as a Petition for Special Hearing and Variance filed by the legal owners of the subject property, SMO, Inc. The special hearing request involves property located at 201 North Point Boulevard, located in the Dundalk area of Baltimore County. The subject property is zoned BR-IM. The petitions were prepared and filed by David Gildea and Sebastian Cross, attorneys at law.

Appearing at the hearing on behalf of the property owners were Steve Stookey, Brian Fenwick, representing SMO, Inc., and Evangeline Baulch and David Sang appearing on behalf of Frederick Ward Associates, the engineers who prepared the site plan of the property. Sebastian Cross and David Gildea, attorneys at law, appeared representing the Petitioners. There were no protestants in attendance.

The property owners have filed a special hearing request for an interpretation of Section 450.3 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.). The special hearing request is for a determination as to whether the manner in which the "area" of the Petitioners' sign package was appropriately calculated in accordance with the dictates of Section 450.3 of the B.C.Z.R. In the alternative, depending on the outcome of the special hearing request, the

Petitioners have filed a variance from Section 450.4 of the B.C.Z.R., to permit 474 sq. ft. of canopy signage in lieu of the permitted 25 sq. ft.

Testimony and evidence indicated that the property, which is the subject of this zoning request, consists of 0.780 acres, more or less, zoned BR-IM. The subject property is located on the southeast corner of the intersection of Old North Point Boulevard and Baltimore Street in Dundalk. The property is the site of an existing Shell Gasoline Service Station. The particulars of the property are more specifically identified on Petitioners' Exhibit No. 1, the site plan submitted into evidence. This particular fuel service station is owned by SMO, Inc., whose headquarters are located in La Plata, Maryland. SMO not only owns this particular Shell Service Station, but also owns approximately 40 other service stations in Baltimore County. SMO has undertaken a program to renovate and redevelop their existing service station sites. This is the first of many sites in Baltimore County which is slated to be renovated. The renovation of the site proposes a new sign and canopy package for each of the existing Shell Service Stations. The old signs and old canopies are proposed to be torn down and the new canopies and signage installed as depicted on Petitioner's Exhibit Nos. 2 & 3.

At issue in this case is the interpretation of Section 450.3 of the B.C.Z.R. and its application to the manner in which the area of the new signs for this service station shall be calculated. As the testimony demonstrated, this is a Shell Gasoline Service Station. It is proposed to be identified at this location by a 12 sq. ft. sign containing the letters "Shell". This 12 sq. ft. "Shell" sign appears on two sides of the canopy façade. There are no other words or symbols appearing on the canopy itself, other than the two 12 sq. ft. signs.

The canopy itself will contain two colors, that being a yellow base color of the canopy façade with a small red accent stripe, approximately 6 inches in width, running along the bottom of the canopy. This red accent decorative feature is proposed to be illuminated.

Mr. Gildea, arguing on behalf of the Petitioners, asserted that the definition of area, as contained within the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations at Section 450.3, excludes the painted façade and decorative stripe, and that only the word "Shell" should be considered to be the area of this canopy sign.

After considering the testimony and evidence offered at the hearing and the language as contained in Section 450.3.a & b of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations, I hereby find that the canopy sign proposed for this Shell Service Station shall be interpreted to consist of two separate canopy signs, each containing 12 sq. ft. of signage, that being the word "Shell" and shall not include the yellow painted canopy façade or the red decorative stripe, both of which are not part of the message of this sign. It should be noted that this sign package, as proposed for this site, is entirely appropriate for this and other Shell Service Stations. The ruling herein shall apply to this property location and any other Shell Service Station, whereupon this exact same sign and canopy package is proposed to be installed. Given that the redevelopment of this service station and the sign and canopy package is appropriately designed, it shall not be necessary for this Petitioner to have to request this special hearing and variance relief for each and every gasoline service station that they intend to renovate.

Inasmuch as I have interpreted Section 450.3 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations to require that only the word "Shell" be calculated as the area of the sign for this application, then the variance request also filed herein shall be dismissed as being

unnecessary. It should be noted that the Petitioners are permitted to have six separate canopy

signs, each of which could contain a square footage of up to 25 sq. ft. The Petitioners

propose only two separate canopy signs containing square footage of 12 sq. ft. each. The sign

package proposed is substantially less than what is permissible for this property. Inasmuch as

the special hearing has been approved, the variances shall be dismissed.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, by the Deputy Zoning Commissioner for Baltimore

County, this 3 day of June, 2002, that the Petitioners' Special Hearing request for a

determination that the yellow canopy background color and the red decorative stripe do not

contribute to the signs message and, therefore, should not be included in the area of this sign

in accordance with Section 450.3 of the B.C.Z.R., be and is hereby GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the variances requested by the Petitioners, be and

they are hereby DISMISSED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that any appeal of this decision must be made within

thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Testimony indicated that the Petitioner is desirous of converting the existing full service station and food store to a gas and go service station in combination with a food store, in accordance with Petitioner's Exhibit No.1. 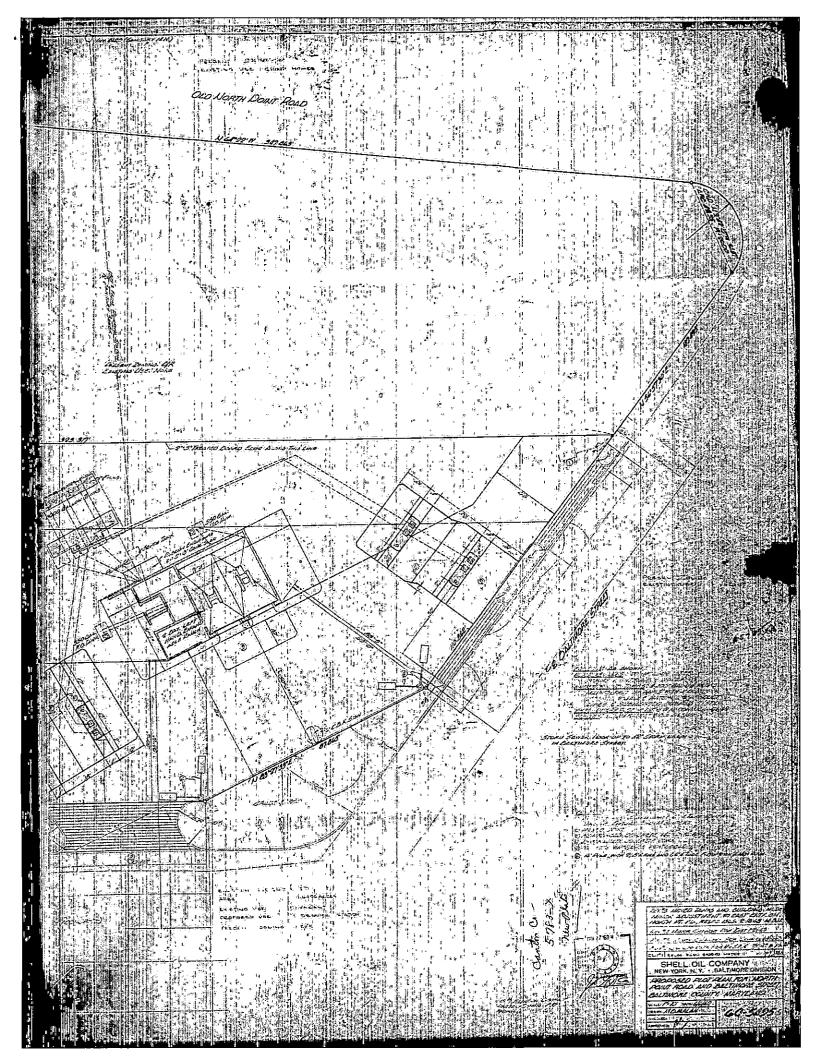

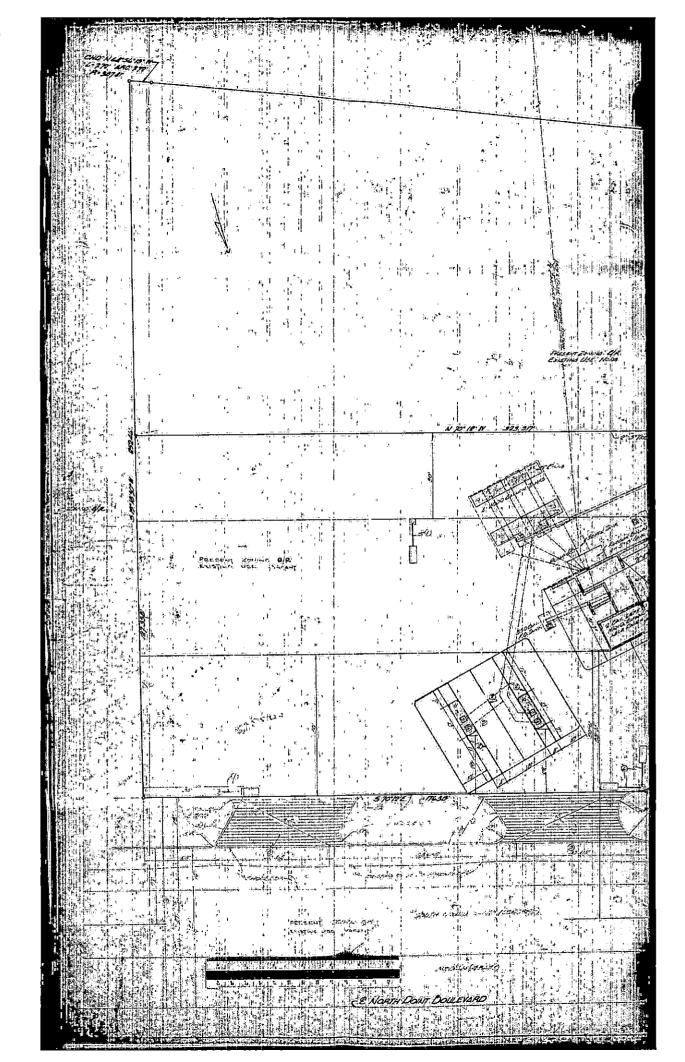

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Petitioner herein requests a special exception to approve a food mart use in combination with an existing service station on the subject property, in accordance with Petit uner's Exhibit 1.

The Petitioner, by James Kozak, Territory Manager, and Todd V. Suhre, Project Engineer with Shell Oil Company, appeared, testified, and were represented by J. Neil Lanzi, Esquire. Also appearing on behalf of the Petition was John Hess, Operator of the existing service station. There were no Protestants.

Testimony indicated that the subject property, known as 201 North Point Boulevard, consists of 1.03 acres more or less zoned B.R.-I.M., and is the site of an existing service station. A service station has operated from the subject property since 1965 as a result of a special exception granted in Case No. 5783-XA on February 27, 1963. Petitioner proposes converting 400 sq.ft. of existing space to a convenience store. Testimony presented by Messrs. Suhre, Kozak and Hess indicated that in their opinion, the conditions delineated in Section 502.1 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.) would be satisfied by the requested modification. Mr. Hess, operator of the existing service station since October, 1987, indicated the decision to add a convenience store to the existing facility was made after discussing the subject with many of the customers

and neighbors who have expressed an interest and have no objection to Petitioner's plans.

Petitioner submitted pictures of the subject property to support its position that the conversion of a portion of the existing building to a convenience store facility will not be detrimental to the health, safety or general welfare of the community. Further testimony presented by Petitioner's witnesses indicated that there is ample room for parking for food mart customers and that the proposed modifications to the site plan will not create any traffic problems for the community.

In response to the comments submitted by the Office of Planning, Mr. Hess testified that he currently provides compressed air and water and will continue to do so. Further, Petitioner is willing to submit a land-scaping plan for approval by the Baltimore County Landscape Planner to insure the property is landscaped at a minimum in compliance with the Baltimore County Landscaping Manual.

It is clear that the B.C.Z.R. permits the use proposed in a B.R.
I.M. zone by special exception. It is equally clear that the proposed use

would not be detrimental to the primary uses in the vicinity. Therefore,

it must be determined if the conditions as delineated in Section 502.1 are
satisfied.

The Petitioner had the burden of adducing testimony and evidence which would show that the proposed use met the prescribed standards and requirements set forth in Section 502.1 of the B.C.Z.R. The Petitioner has shown that the proposed use would be conducted without real detriment to the neighborhood and would not adversely affect the public interest. The facts and circumstances do not show that the proposed use at the particular location described by Petitioner's Exhibit 1 would have any ad-

verse impact above and beyond that inherently associated with such a special exception use, irrespective of its location within the zone.

Schultz v. Prit's, 432 A.2d 1319 (1981).

The proposed use will not be detrimental to the health, safety, or general welfare of the locality, nor tend to create congestion in roads, streets, or alleys therein, nor be inconsistent with the purposes of the property's zoning classification, nor in any other way be inconsistent with the spirit and intent of the B.C.Z.R.

After reviewing all of the testimony and evidence presented, it appears that the special exception should be granted with certain restrictions as more fully described below.

Pursuant to the advertisement, posting of the property, and public hearing on this Petition held, and for the reasons given above, the relief requested in the special exception should be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the Deputy Zoning Commissioner for Baltimore County this day of March, 1989 that the Petition for Special Exception to approve a food mart use in combination with an existing service station on the subject property, in accordance with Petitioner's Exhibit 1, be and is hereby GRANTED, subject, however, to the following restrictions which are conditions precedent to the relief granted:

3) Fetitioner shall provide corpressed air and water for its customers.

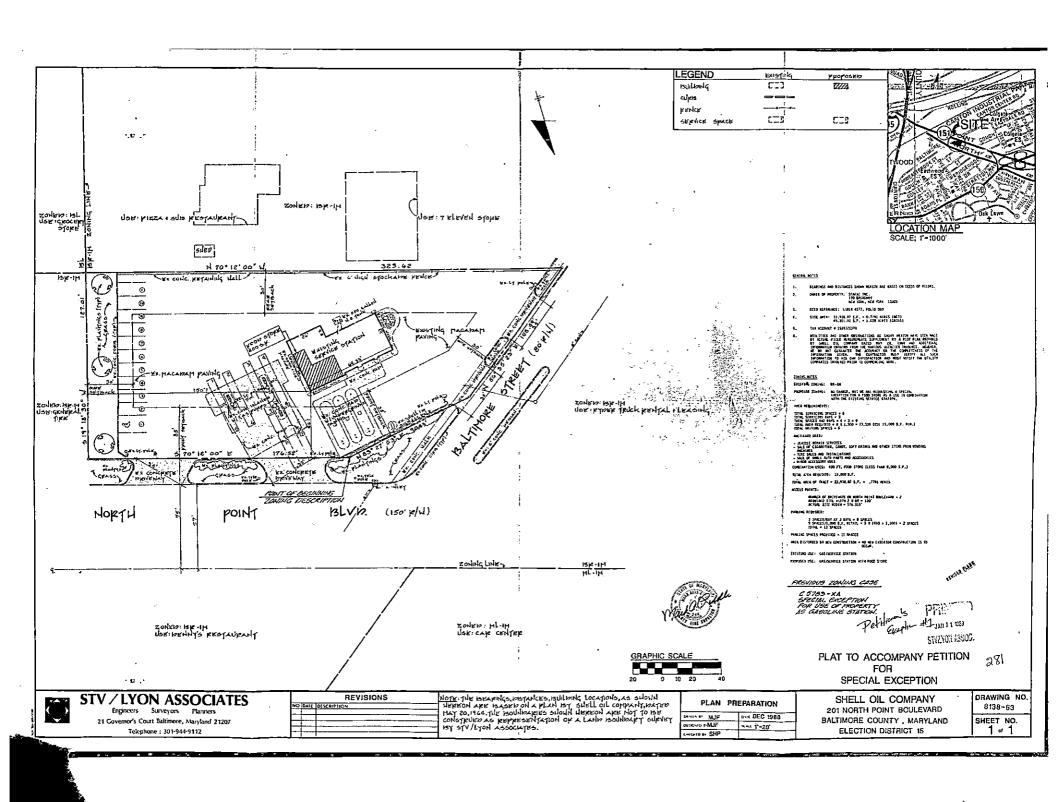

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAM

The Potitioner herein requests, pursuant to the Petition for Special Hearing, approval of the conversion of an existing full service station with a food store to a gas and go service station in combination with a food store and to amend site plan under case #89-371-X, and a Zoning Variance from Section 405.4A(2) to allow a setback of 3 ft. off-street right of way for illuminated 1.0. sign in lieu of the required 6 ft. and variance from Section 413.2(f) to allow one double faced illuminated business sign having a total area of 128 sq. ft. in lieu of the required 100 sq. ft., as more particularly described on Petitioner's Exhibit 1.

Testimony indicated that the Petitioner is desirous of converting the existing full service station and food store to a gas and go service station in combination with a food store, in accordance with Petitioner's Exhibit No.1. Testimony also indicated that the Petitioner is planning to eliminate the full service garage and use the area for storage purposes only.

An dres variance may be granted where strict application of the zoning regulations would come practical difficulty to the Petitioner and his property. Release v. Edicy, 270 Md. 208 (1973). To prove practical difficulty for an area variance, the Petitioner sunt most the following:

- whether atrict compliance with requirement would unreasonably prevent the use of the property for a permitted purpose or render conformance unnecessarily burdenses;
- 2) whether the grant would do substantial injustice to applicant as well as other property compan in the district or whether a lesser relaxation than that applied for would give substantial relief; and
- 1) whother relief can be granted in such fanhion that the spirit of the ordinance will be observed and public safety and welfare secured.

Andorson v. Bd. of Appeals, Town of Chesapeako Beach, 22 Md. App. 28 (1974).

It is also from the testisiony that if the variances are granted, such use as proposed would not be contrary to the spirit of the B.C.Z.R. and would not result in substantial detrieont to the public good.

After due consideration of the testisony and evidence presented, it is clear that a practical difficulty or unreasonable hardship would result if the variances and special hearing relief were not granted. It has been established that the requirements from which the Politicaer seeks relief would unduly restrict the use of the land due to the special conditions unlique to this particular parcel. In addition, the variances requested will not be detrimental to the public health, safety and general welfare.

In addition, the Politicher's witnesses have descentrated that the requested relief is consistent with the requirements of Section 502.1 of the Baltimore County Roming Regulations [B.C.Z.R.] and would otherwise not be detrimental to the public health, calety and general welfare of the community.

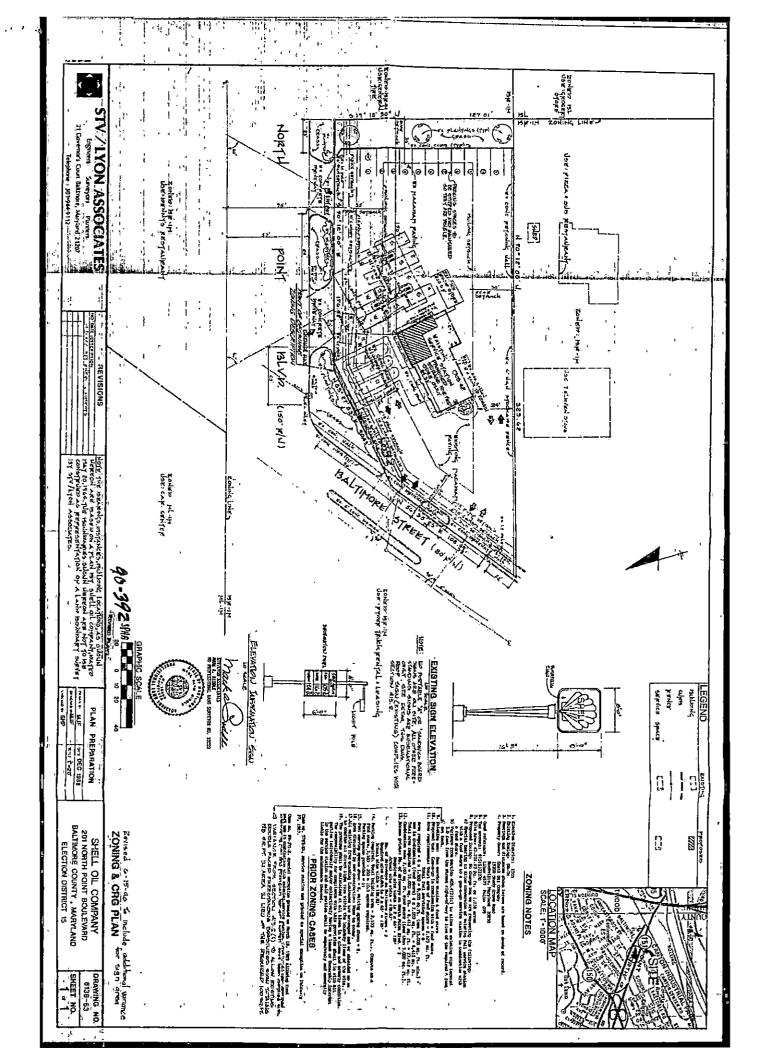

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

This matter comes before this Deputy Zoning Commissioner as a Petition for Special Hearing and Variance filed by the legal owners of the subject property, SMO, Inc. The special hearing request involves property located at 201 North Point Boulevard, located in the Dundalk area of Baltimore County. The subject property is zoned BR-IM. The petitions were prepared and filed by David Gildea and Sebastian Cross, attorneys at law.

Appearing at the hearing on behalf of the property owners were Steve Stookey, Brian Fenwick, representing SMO, Inc., and Evangeline Baulch and David Sang appearing on behalf of Frederick Ward Associates, the engineers who prepared the site plan of the property. Sebastian Cross and David Gildea, attorneys at law, appeared representing the Petitioners. There were no protestants in attendance.

The property owners have filed a special hearing request for an interpretation of Section 450.3 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.). The special hearing request is for a determination as to whether the manner in which the "area" of the Petitioners' sign package was appropriately calculated in accordance with the dictates of Section 450.3 of the B.C.Z.R. In the alternative, depending on the outcome of the special hearing request, the

Petitioners have filed a variance from Section 450.4 of the B.C.Z.R., to permit 474 sq. ft. of canopy signage in lieu of the permitted 25 sq. ft.

Testimony and evidence indicated that the property, which is the subject of this zoning request, consists of 0.780 acres, more or less, zoned BR-IM. The subject property is located on the southeast corner of the intersection of Old North Point Boulevard and Baltimore Street in Dundalk. The property is the site of an existing Shell Gasoline Service Station. The particulars of the property are more specifically identified on Petitioners' Exhibit No. 1, the site plan submitted into evidence. This particular fuel service station is owned by SMO, Inc., whose headquarters are located in La Plata, Maryland. SMO not only owns this particular Shell Service Station, but also owns approximately 40 other service stations in Baltimore County. SMO has undertaken a program to renovate and redevelop their existing service station sites. This is the first of many sites in Baltimore County which is slated to be renovated. The renovation of the site proposes a new sign and canopy package for each of the existing Shell Service Stations. The old signs and old canopies are proposed to be torn down and the new canopies and signage installed as depicted on Petitioner's Exhibit Nos. 2 & 3.

At issue in this case is the interpretation of Section 450.3 of the B.C.Z.R. and its application to the manner in which the area of the new signs for this service station shall be calculated. As the testimony demonstrated, this is a Shell Gasoline Service Station. It is proposed to be identified at this location by a 12 sq. ft. sign containing the letters "Shell". This 12 sq. ft. "Shell" sign appears on two sides of the canopy façade. There are no other words or symbols appearing on the canopy itself, other than the two 12 sq. ft. signs.



The canopy itself will contain two colors, that being a yellow base color of the canopy façade with a small red accent stripe, approximately 6 inches in width, running along the bottom of the canopy. This red accent decorative feature is proposed to be illuminated.

Mr. Gildea, arguing on behalf of the Petitioners, asserted that the definition of area, as contained within the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations at Section 450.3, excludes the painted façade and decorative stripe, and that only the word "Shell" should be considered to be the area of this canopy sign.

After considering the testimony and evidence offered at the hearing and the language as contained in Section 450.3.a & b of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations, I hereby find that the canopy sign proposed for this Shell Service Station shall be interpreted to consist of two separate canopy signs, each containing 12 sq. ft. of signage, that being the word "Shell" and shall not include the yellow painted canopy façade or the red decorative stripe, both of which are not part of the message of this sign. It should be noted that this sign package, as proposed for this site, is entirely appropriate for this and other Shell Service Stations. The ruling herein shall apply to this property location and any other Shell Service Station, whereupon this exact same sign and canopy package is proposed to be installed. Given that the redevelopment of this service station and the sign and canopy package is appropriately designed, it shall not be necessary for this Petitioner to have to request this special hearing and variance relief for each and every gasoline service station that they intend to renovate.

Inasmuch as I have interpreted Section 450.3 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations to require that only the word "Shell" be calculated as the area of the sign for this application, then the variance request also filed herein shall be dismissed as being

unnecessary. It should be noted that the Petitioners are permitted to have six separate canopy signs, each of which could contain a square footage of up to 25 sq. ft. The Petitioners propose only two separate canopy signs containing square footage of 12 sq. ft. each. The sign package proposed is substantially less than what is permissible for this property. Inasmuch as the special hearing has been approved, the variances shall be dismissed.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, by the Deputy Zoning Commissioner for Baltimore County, this 3d day of June, 2002, that the Petitioners' Special Hearing request for a determination that the yellow canopy background color and the red decorative stripe do not contribute to the signs message and, therefore, should not be included in the area of this sign in accordance with Section 450.3 of the B.C.Z.R., be and is hereby GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the variances requested by the Petitioners, be and they are hereby DISMISSED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

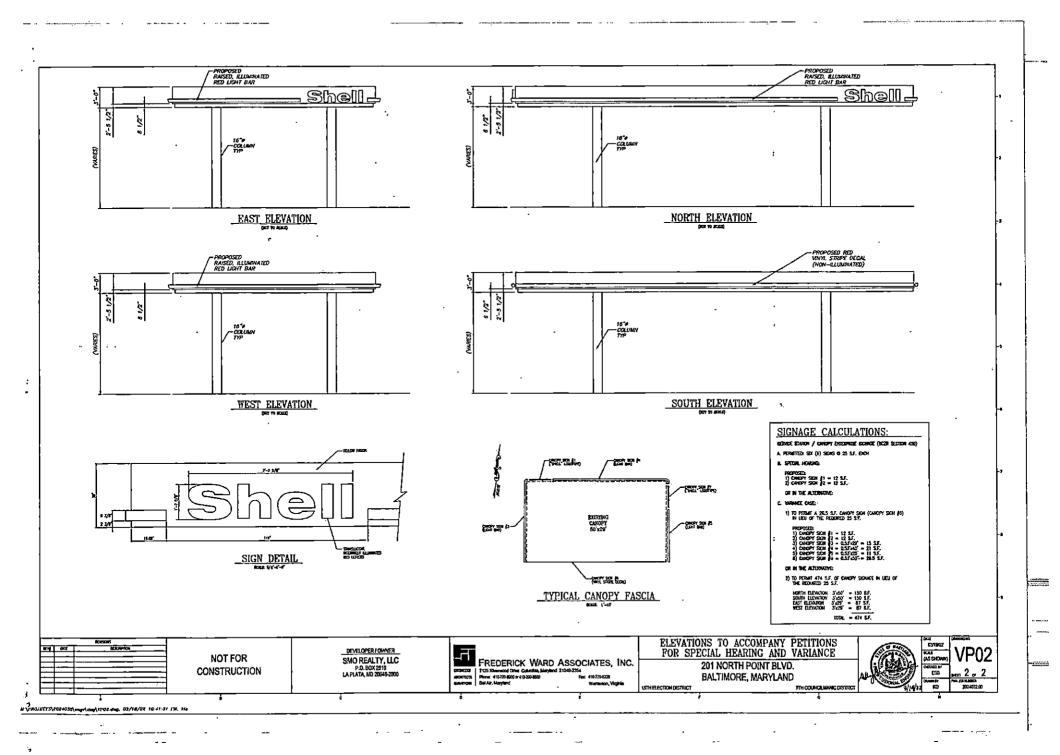
