OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings ("OAH") for consideration of a Petition for Special Exception filed on behalf of Point Breeze Credit Union, legal owner ("Petitioner"). The special exception petition was filed pursuant to § 405 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("BCZR") to approve a fuel service station in an MLR-IM zone.

Kim Maugrum appeared in support of the petition on behalf of Point Breeze and Peter Shkreli appeared on behalf of the Developer. Adam M. Rosenblatt, Esq. represented the Petitioner. There were no Protestants or interested citizens in attendance. Substantive Zoning Advisory Committee ("ZAC") comments were received from the Department of Environmental Protection and Sustainability ("DEPS"), the Department of Planning ("DOP"), and the Department of Public Works ("DPW"). These agencies expressed concerns about whether any of the proposed development site is within a riverine floodplain and DPW has requested that the Developer be required to undertake an updated ultimate conditions floodplain study and that no permits be issued until the study has been submitted and the proposed site plan conforms to the Baltimore County Building Code requirements for riverine floodplains.

Because there were no Protestants present Mr. Rosenblatt was allowed to proffer the following relevant facts. The site is 1.68 acres and is zoned MLR-IM as depicted on the site plan,

which was admitted as Petitioner's Exhibit 1. The site plan was prepared by Chris Armstrong of Bohler Engineering. Mr. Armstrong's *curriculum vitae* was admitted as Petitioner's Exhibit 2 and he was accepted as an expert in engineering, site planning, and the BCZR. Currently there is a branch of the Point Breeze Credit Union on the site. Point Breeze intends to move this branch to an adjoining site to the west and when this project is completed the existing Point Breeze branch will be razed and replaced by the proposed fuel station and convenience store. As shown by Petitioner's Exhibit 3, an aerial photographer of the area, the relevant neighborhood consists of a variety of commercial and industrial uses along Philadelphia Road just north of I-695. There are no residential properties in the neighborhood.

#### Special Exception

Under Maryland law, a special exception use enjoys a presumption that it is in the interest of the general welfare, and therefore, valid. *Schultz v. Pritts*, 291 Md. 1 (1981). The *Schultz* standard was revisited in *Attar v. DMS Tollgate, LLC*, 451 Md. 272 (2017), where the court of appeals discussed the nature of the evidentiary presumption in special exception cases. The court again emphasized a special exception is properly denied only when there are facts and circumstances showing that the adverse impacts of the use at the particular location in question would be above and beyond those inherently associated with the special exception use. Mr. Armstrong explained the development proposal and expressed his expert opinion that it complies in all respects with BCZR Sec. 502.1, as well as the specific requirements of BCZR Secs. 405 and 409 concerning fuel service stations and parking, respectively. Mr. Rosenblatt further explained that the Developer commissioned a traffic study that was performed by Joseph Caloggero, P.E., PTOE, PTP, whose *curriculum vitae* was admitted as Petitioner's Exhibit 8, and who was accepted

as an expert in traffic engineering. The traffic study concluded that there would be no adverse impacts on traffic or congestion as a result of this proposed development.

With regard to the floodplain issue, Mr. Rosenblatt noted that in *Attar v. DMS Tollgate*, *LLC*, *supra*, the court of appeals held that under the BCZR it is permissible for a Petitioner to seek a special exception "before receiving County approval for the proposed road relocation and approval of the flood plain relocation from [the Federal Emergency Management Agency]." *Id.* at 451 Md. at 278. While this may be so, I explained to Mr. Rosenblatt that any approval of the special exception request in this case would be subject to the conditions requested by the County agencies.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED this **20th** day of **February**, **2020**, by this Administrative Law Judge, that the Petition for Special Exception seeking a special exception to allow a fuel service station as defined by BCZR Sec. 405 in an MLR-IM zone, be and is hereby GRANTED.

The relief granted herein shall be subject to the following:

 Prior to issuance of Permits, Petitioner must comply with the ZAC comments submitted by DEPS and DPW, copies of which are attached hereto and made a part hereof.

2. Prior to issuance of Permits, Petitioner shall conduct and submit to DPW for its review and approval an updated ultimate conditions floodplain study of the property.

3. No permits shall issue for any new buildings within the riverine floodplain.

Any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

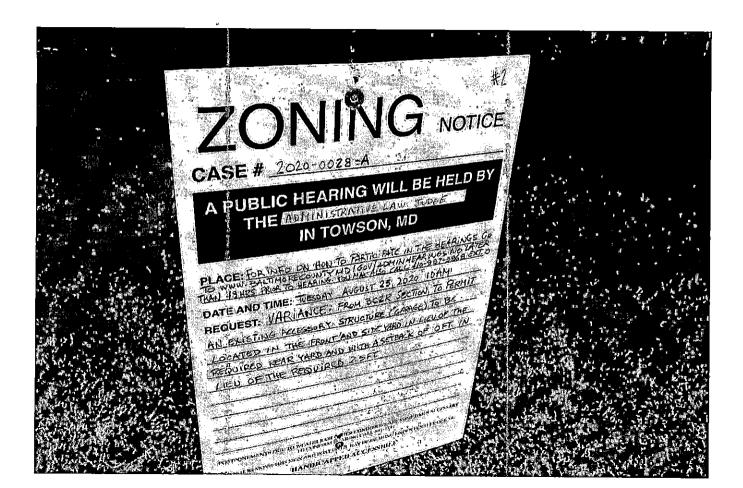

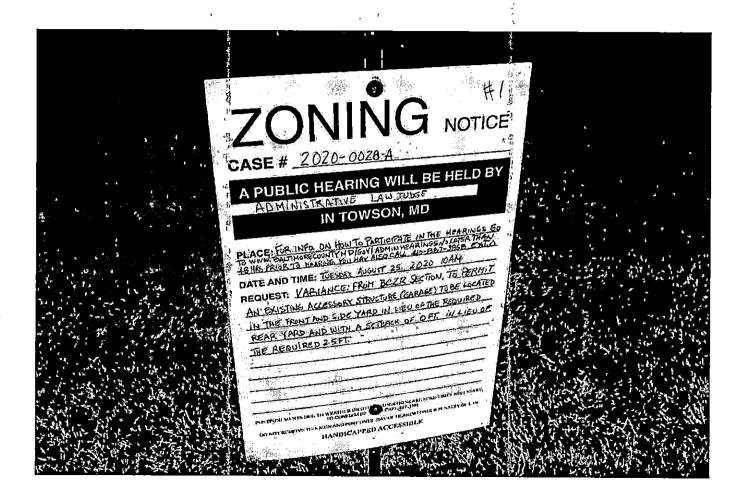

#### Good afternoon,

Yesterday I met with Adam Rosenblatt (Venable, LLP) the attorney and Mike Gesell (Bohler Engineering) the engineer representing the developer for the above referenced project. Based on the conversation, they understood that we are asking for an updated flood study because the original flood study was performed in the mid 80's and our standards in the design manual have changed since then. The zoning hearing for a Special Exception to allow a fuel service station in the MLR IM zone for this site is on Tuesday, February 18, 2020. To perform an up-to-date flood study, Bohler Engineering will need more time.

Also, based on our conversation and a letter shown to me by Mr. Rosenblatt, the Department of Environmental Protection and Sustainability (DEPS) will be requiring this plan approval to go to the Development Review Committee (DRC). This will take some time after the zoning hearing on February 18, 2020.

The Department of Public Works agrees that a flood study is still required. If the Special Exception to allow a fuel service station in the MLR IM zone is granted, we are asking the Administrative Law Judge to consider the special exception with a condition. The condition should be a flood study must be reviewed and "Accepted for Filing" by the Department of Permits, Approvals and Inspections Bureau of Development Plans Review and no permits will be granted until such time.

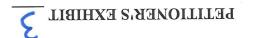


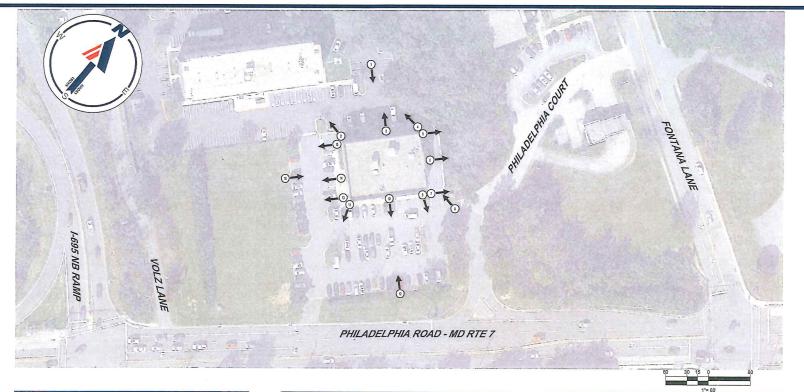






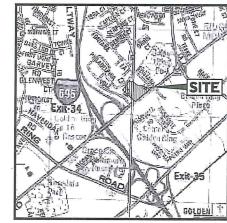












LOCATION MAP

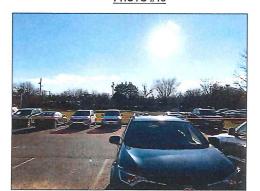

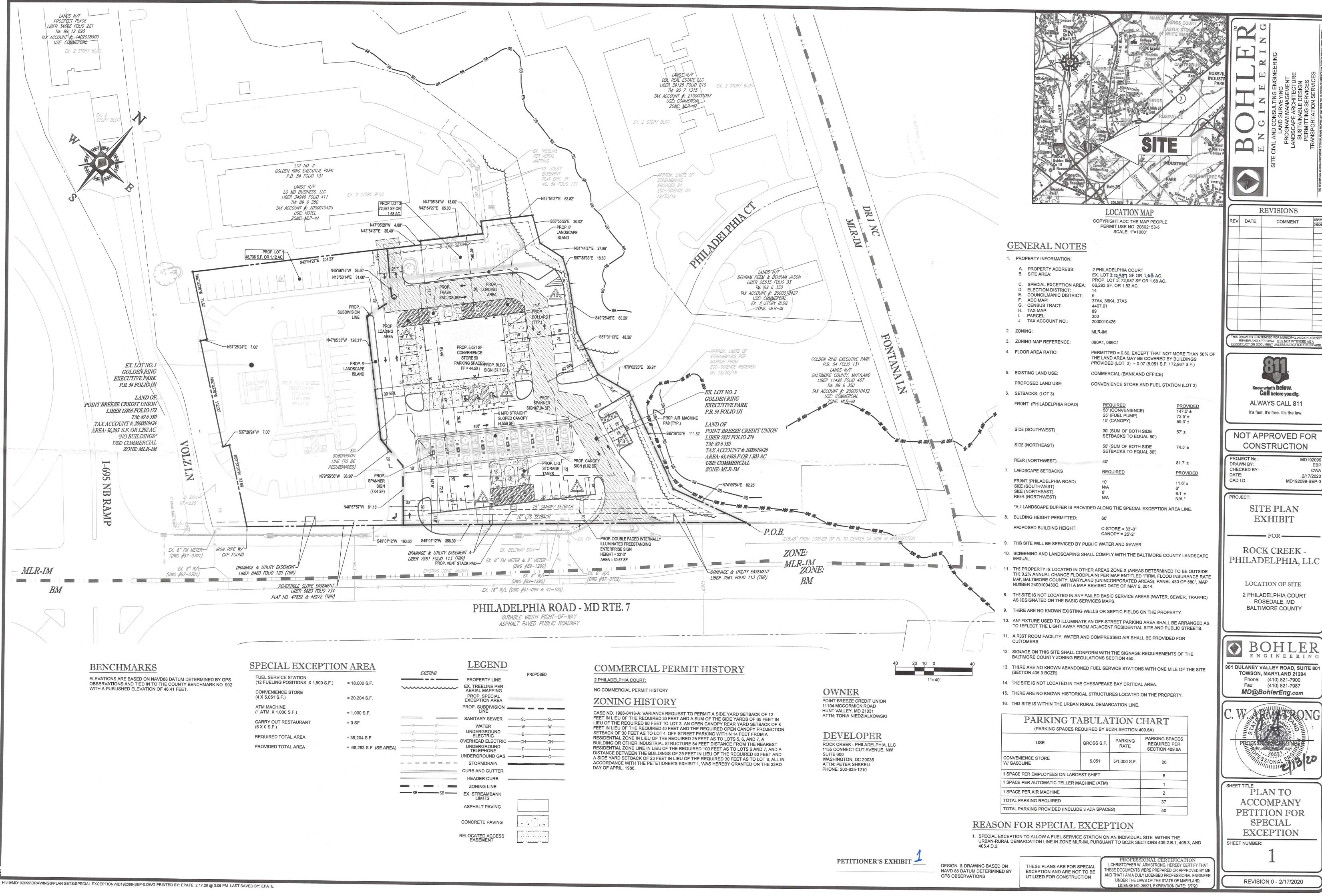
