**OPINION AND ORDER** 

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings ("OAH") for Baltimore County for consideration of a Petition for Administrative Variance filed by the legal owner of the subject property, Gregory Maddox ("Petitioner"). The Petitioner is requesting Variance relief pursuant to Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("BZCR") § 400.3 to approve an accessory structure (garage) in the rear yard with a total height of 22 ft. in lieu of the required 15 ft. height maximum. The subject property and requested relief is more fully depicted on the site plan that was marked and accepted into evidence as Petitioner's Exhibit 1.

The Zoning Advisory Committee ("ZAC") comments were received and are made part of the record of this case. A ZAC comment was submitted by the Department of Environmental Protection and Sustainability ("DEPS"), dated May 29, 2020, indicating Petitioner must comply with the critical area and flood protection regulations.

The Petitioner having filed a Petition for Administrative Variance and the subject property having been posted on May 29, 2020, and there being no request for a public hearing, a decision shall be rendered based upon the documentation presented.

The Petitioner has filed the supporting affidavits as required by § 32-3-303 of the Baltimore County Code ("BCC"). Based upon the information available, there is no evidence in

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the file to indicate that the requested variance would adversely affect the health, safety or general welfare of the public and should therefore be granted. In the opinion of the Administrative Law Judge, the information, photographs, and affidavits submitted provide sufficient facts that comply with the requirements of § 307.1 of the BCZR. Furthermore, strict compliance with the BCZR would result in practical difficulty and/or unreasonable hardship upon the Petitioners.

Although the Department of Planning did not make any recommendations related to the proposed accessory structure (detached garage) height and usage, I will impose conditions that the detached garage shall not be converted into a dwelling unit or apartment, not contain any sleeping quarters, living area, kitchen or bathroom facilities, or used for commercial purposes.

Pursuant to the posting of the property and the provisions of both the BCC and the BCZR, and for the reasons given above, the requested variance should be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, this <u>18<sup>th</sup></u> day of **June**, **2020**, by the Administrative Law Judge for Baltimore County, that the Petition for Variance seeking relief from § 400.3 to approve an accessory structure (garage) in the rear yard with a total height of 22 ft. in lieu of the required 15 ft. height maximum, be and is hereby GRANTED.

The relief granted herein shall be subject to the following:

- Petitioner may apply for his appropriate permits and be granted same upon receipt of this Order; however, Petitioner is hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at his own risk until such time as the 30-day appellate process from this Order has expired. If, for whatever reason, this Order is reversed, Petitioner would be required to return, and be responsible for returning, said property to its original condition.
- Petitioner or subsequent owners shall not convert the detached garage into a
  dwelling unit or apartment. The proposed detached garage shall not contain
  any sleeping quarters, living area, and kitchen or bathroom facilities.
- The proposed detached garage shall not be used for commercial purposes.

The Department of Environmental Protection and Sustainability has reviewed the subject zoning petition for compliance with the goals of the State-mandated Critical Area Law listed in the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations, Section 500.14. Based upon this review, we offer the following comments:

 Minimize adverse impacts on water quality that result from pollutants that are discharged from structures or conveyances or that have run off from surrounding lands:

The subject property is partially located within a Limited Development Area (LDA) and is subject to Critical Area requirements. The applicant is proposing to permit a replacement garage in the rear yard with a total height of 22 feet in lieu of the required 15 foot height maximum. The lot is not waterfront. Any proposed development within the portion of the lot that is within the LDA must meet all LDA requirements, including lot coverage limits and afforestation requirements. Existing lot coverage information was not provided. On the 20,720 square feet of the property that is within the LDA, lot coverage is limited to a maximum of 31.25% square feet (6,475 square feet), with mitigation required for any new lot coverage between 25% and 31.25%. Proposed lot coverage information was not provided. 15% afforestation (6 trees) is required on the portion of the lot within the LDA. If the lot coverage and afforestation requirements are been met, then the relief requested by the applicant will result in minimal adverse impacts to water quality.

2. Conserve fish, plant, and wildlife habitat;

This property is not waterfront and must meet all lot coverage and afforestation requirements. If lot coverage and afforestation requirements are met, this request will help conserve fish, plant, and wildlife habitat in the Chesapeake Bay.

3. Be consistent with established land use policies for development in the Chesapeake Bay Critical Area, which accommodate growth and also address the fact that, even if pollution is controlled, the number, movement and activities of persons in that area can create adverse environmental impacts;

This is a grandfathered lot. Provided that the applicants meet their lot coverage and afforestation requirements, then the relief requested will be consistent with the established land-use policies.

### **PURPOSE**

To remove a detached garage 23' in height, remove a shed and construct a detached garage 22' in height.

- 1. "To Prove <u>undue hardship</u> for a use variance, the following three criteria must be met:
  - (i) Applicant must be unable to secure a reasonable return or make any reasonable use of his property (mere financial hardship or opportunity for greater profit is not enough) The hardship would be the cost to repair the existing damaged garage. The cost would be higher then to simply replacing the structure. The detached garage was built over 80 years ago. There is no financial gain.
  - (ii) The difficulties or hardship is peculiar to the subject property in contrast with other properties in the zoning district. I have attached pictures of the garages in my neighborhood. Replacing the garage will improve the character of the neighborhood.
  - (iii) Hardship was not the result of applicant's own actions.
    I am taking all the necessary steps to precure all applicable Approvals.

## 2. To provide <u>practical difficulty</u> for an area variance, the following criteria must be met:

- (i) Whether strict compliance with requirement would unreasonably prevent the use of the property for a permitted purpose or render conformance unnecessarily burdensome.
  As previously stated, I would not be able to park my truck in the garage or use the garage for its intended purpose.
- (ii) Whether the grant would be substantial injustice to applicant, as well as other property owners in district, or whether a lesser relaxation that that applied for would give substantial relief. Since the existing detached garage has been there for years and I am simply replacing it I feel that I should be able to get relief from the code.
- (iii) Whether relief can be granted in such fashion that the spirit of the ordinance will be observed, and public safety and welfare secured.

The spirit of ordinance will be preserved.

The Department of Environmental Protection and Sustainability has reviewed the subject zoning petition for compliance with the goals of the State-mandated Critical Area Law listed in the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations, Section 500.14. Based upon this review, we offer the following comments:

1. Minimize adverse impacts on water quality that result from pollutants that are discharged from structures or conveyances or that have run off from surrounding lands;

The subject property is partially located within a Limited Development Area (LDA) and is subject to Critical Area requirements. The applicant is proposing to permit a replacement garage in the rear yard with a total height of 22 feet in lieu of the required 15 foot height maximum. The lot is not waterfront. Any proposed development within the portion of the lot that is within the LDA must meet all LDA requirements, including lot coverage limits and afforestation requirements. Existing lot coverage information was not provided. On the 20,720 square feet of the property that is within the LDA, lot coverage is limited to a maximum of 31.25% square feet (6,475 square feet), with mitigation required for any new lot coverage between 25% and 31.25%. Proposed lot coverage information was not provided. 15% afforestation (6 trees) is required on the portion of the lot within the LDA. If the lot coverage and afforestation requirements are been met, then the relief requested by the applicant will result in minimal adverse impacts to water quality.

2. Conserve fish, plant, and wildlife habitat;

This property is not waterfront and must meet all lot coverage and afforestation requirements. If lot coverage and afforestation requirements are met, this request will help conserve fish, plant, and wildlife habitat in the Chesapeake Bay.

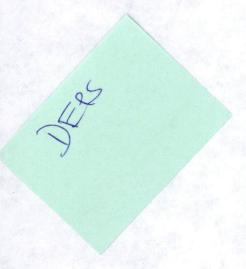
3. Be consistent with established land use policies for development in the Chesapeake Bay Critical Area, which accommodate growth and also address the fact that, even if pollution is controlled, the number, movement and activities of persons in that area can create adverse environmental impacts;

This is a grandfathered lot. Provided that the applicants meet their lot coverage and afforestation requirements, then the relief requested will be consistent with the established land-use policies.
