OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings ("OAH") for consideration of Petitions for Special Hearing and Variance filed on behalf of Colonial Stoner, LLC, legal owner ("Petitioner"). The Special Hearing is requested under § 450.4 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("BCZR") (Table of Sign Regulations) 5(g) (Sign E), to confirm that the sign area/face for a freestanding enterprise sign, which contains the message on the structural and supportive elements of the sign, is 24 sq. ft. In addition, a Petition for Variance was filed under BCZR § 450.4 (Table of Sign Regulations) 5(a) to allow three enterprise signs on one facade in lieu of the permitted three enterprise signs, with no more than two on a single facade (Sign B, C, D); and from BCZR § 450.4 (Table of Sign Regulations) 3(a) to allow a directional sign with a sign area/face of 26 sq. ft. in lieu of the permitted 8 sq. ft. (Sign A); and from BCZR § 450.4 (Table of Sign Regulations) 5(g) to allow a freestanding enterprise sign with a sign area/face of 144 sq. ft. and a height of 19 ft. in lieu of the permitted 50 sq. ft. and 25 ft. in height, if necessary (Sign E).

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, a public WebEx hearing was conducted virtually in lieu of an in-person hearing. The Petition was properly advertised and posted. A site plan was marked and accepted into evidence as Petitioners' Exhibit 1.

Barry Stoler appeared in support of the requests. Dick Matz, of the Cobert Matz Rosenfelt, engineering firm also appeared and was accepted as an expert. David H. Karceski, Esq. represented the Petitioner. There were no protestants or interested persons in attendance. However, People's Counsel did submit a letter opposing the requested relief on the grounds that it was barred, at least in part, by the doctrine of *res judicata*.

Substantive Zoning Advisory Committee ("ZAC") comments were received from the Department of Planning ("DOP") dated June 24, 2020. They did not oppose the requested relief, subject to proposed conditions, which will be incorporated into the Order.

The property is approximately 4.03 acres and is zoned BR and D.R. 16. At the outset of the hearing Mr. Karceski submitted and Amended Petition (admitted as Petitioner's Exhibit 1A) that abandoned the variance relief requested in paragraph 3 of the original Petition, which had sought an area variance for a freestanding enterprise sign at the entrance to the property. This is the aspect of the Petition that People's Counsel had urged was barred by *res judicata* – a position I agree with. The Special Hearing relief was also abandoned as it too related to the enterprise sign.

Therefore, Mr. Karceski explained that the only relief they are now seeking relates to the wall mounted signage. Mr. Karceski explained that the subject property is unique because there is a significant north-south grade change along Reisterstown Road, as well as a 23 foot grade change from Reisterstown Road down to where the buildings are sited. Further, the lot is irregularly shaped and the buildings are sited far back from the road. These unique features necessitate the variance relief - one additional sign on the Reisterstown façade, and a 26 sq. ft. directional sign in lieu of the permitted 8 sq. ft. sign.¹

At the hearing the undersigned pointed out that People's Counsel had noted that the property had been found not ORDERINGE in Case No 2017-0023 SPHA. Mr. Karceski could not explain the basis for that ruling since the property

Variance

A variance request involves a two-step process, summarized as follows:

- (1) It must be shown the property is unique in a manner which makes it unlike surrounding properties, and that uniqueness or peculiarity must necessitate variance relief; and
- (2) If variance relief is denied, Petitioner will experience a practical difficulty or hardship.

Cromwell v. Ward, 102 Md. App. 691 (1995).

As detailed above, the property is unique in several respects. The significant grade changes and the substantial setbacks of the buildings from the road necessitate the requested sign variances. If these variances are not granted the petitioner would suffer harm and practical difficulty because their clients would have difficulty identifying their business and finding the service department. I find that the relief can be granted within the spirit and intent of the BCZR and without causing harm to the public health, safety or welfare.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED this <u>8th</u> day of October, 2020, by this Administrative Law Judge, that the Petition for Special Hearing seeking relief pursuant to § 450.4 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("BCZR") (Table of Sign Regulations) 5(g) (Sign E), to confirm that the sign area/face for a freestanding enterprise sign, which contains the message on the structural and supportive elements of the sign, is 24 sq. ft. of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("BCZR") is hereby DISMISSED, WITH PREJUDICE.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Petition for Variance seeking relief pursuant BCZR § 450.4 (Table of Sign Regulations) 5(a) to allow three enterprise signs on one facade in lieu of the permitted three enterprise signs, with no more than two on a single facade (Sign B, C,

was found to be unique in a more recent case (Case No. 2018-0150-A). And in that case the ALJ had noted that "the ORD property was found to be unique in at least four prior zoning cases dating back to 1974."

D); and from BCZR § 450.4 (Table of Sign Regulations) 3(a) to allow a directional sign with a sign area/face of 26 sq. ft. in lieu of the permitted 8 sq. ft. (Sign A); and from BCZR § 450.4 (Table of Sign Regulations) be and are hereby GRANTED.

The relief granted herein shall be subject to the following:

- Petitioner may apply for necessary permits and/or licenses upon receipt of this Order. However, Petitioner is hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at their own risk until 30 days from the date hereof, during which time an appeal can be filed by any party. If for whatever reason this Order is reversed, Petitioner would be required to return the subject property to its original condition.
- Petitioner shall expeditiously remove the existing non-conforming free standing enterprise sign on Reisterstown Road and replace it with a conforming free standing enterprise sign.

Any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

ORDER ON MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION

Petitioner in the above case sought variance and special hearing relief in connection with a proposed freestanding sign at a Lexus automobile dealership. Both requests were denied in an Order dated September 29, 2016. Petitioner seeks reconsideration of the ruling on the petition for special hearing, which pertains to the calculation of the sign area.

Petitioner's primary argument is that the Administrative Law Judge should not defer to the zoning office's interpretation of the regulations concerning the "area" of a sign. Petitioner's expert agreed the zoning office adhered in this case to its longstanding pattern and practice in calculating the sign area. The zoning office determined the entire face of the sign (rather than just the 45 sq. ft. rectangle containing the "Lexus" lettering and logo) must be included in the area calculation since the color and design of the structure constituted part of the sign's message.

Petitioner contends this interpretation disregards "exclusion A" found in the definition of "area" at B.C.Z.R. § 450.3. I respectfully disagree. That provision would exclude from the calculation any support structures or features which "are <u>not</u> part of the message of the sign." <u>Id.</u> (emphasis added). For example, a structural support pole on which a sign was located would not be included in the area calculation. But the zoning office here determined the color and design

of the sign face was integral to the message (i.e., "Lexus") and so should be part of the sign "area."

The Zoning Commissioner's Policy Manual, at p. 4-69.9 (a copy of which is attached hereto), Example 5, shows how the area of a Volvo automobile dealership sign is calculated, and I believe the zoning office's interpretation is consistent with this example.

WHEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED this 14th day of October, 2016, by this Administrative Law Judge, that the Motion for Reconsideration be and is hereby DENIED.

Any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

SIGNS

TABLE-DEFINITION OF COLUMNS- The following table specifies the allowable combinations of sign classes and sign types, along with locational, dimensional and other pertinent conditions, as follows:

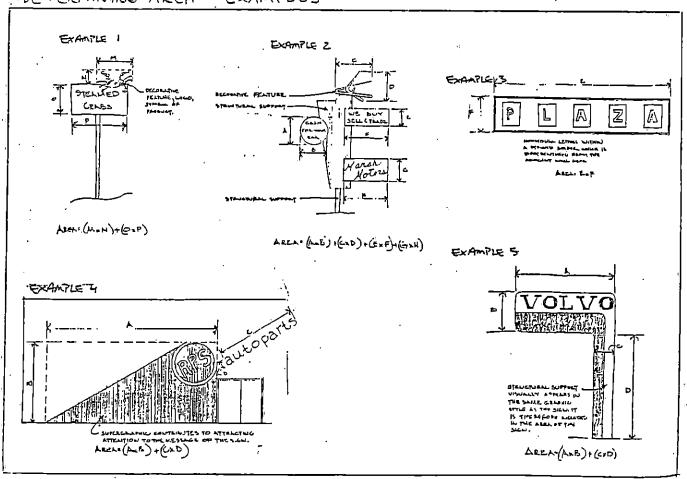
Column:

- A. <u>Class</u> Refers to the overall purpose and general character of the entire sign.
- B. <u>Structural Type</u> Identifies the structural type(s) that may be used to display signs of the given class, subject to the requirements in the succeeding columns. (See definitions of types on Page 4.)
- C. Zone or Use Defines the zone(s) wherein signs of the class and type combination(s) may be displayed. In certain cases, the permissibility is granted for a sign in conjunction with a particular type of land use, as identified in this column, in whichever zone(s) such use is permitted.
- D. <u>Permit Required</u> A "Bldg." entry indicates that a Building Permit must be obtained for each sign. A "None" entry indicates that a Building Permit is not required, provided that the sign complies with all other applicable provisions of these Regulations. An "SE" indicates that each such sign is permitted only as a Special Exception use authorized pursuant to Section 502. A "Use" entry indicates that a permit pursuant to Section 500.4 must be obtained for each such sign.

If the proposed sign(s) will be accessory to a structure, use or development that otherwise is required to obtain a building or use permit or development approval, all pertinent information regarding the sign(s) must be included as part of the otherwise-required application(s).

E. Maximum Area or Face - Defines the maximum number of square feet, or the rule for calculating the maximum number, that may be included within the face of any single permitted sign of the given class, regardless of the type; the number is not to be interpreted as a separate limit for each type identified in Column B, but the maximum area may be divided among more than one sign to the extent permitted in Column F. Subject to the limit in Column F regarding the maximum number of signs, compliance with the maximum area is determined by the following rules:

OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) for consideration of Petitions for Special Hearing and Variance filed on behalf of Colonial Stoler, LLC, legal owner ("Petitioner"). The Special Hearing was filed pursuant to § 500.7 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("B.C.Z.R) to permit a sign of 45 sq. ft. in lieu of the 225 sq. ft. as determined under the County's interpretation of the required area which includes the entire structure. In the alternative, a Petition for Variance seeks to permit a sign of 225 sq. ft. in lieu of the 50 sq. ft. permitted. A site plan was marked and accepted into evidence as Petitioner's Exhibit 1.

Appearing at the public hearing in support of the requests were Barry Stoler and Mitchell Kellman. Marvin I. Singer, Esq. represented the Petitioner. George Harmon, on behalf of the Reisterstown-Owings Mills-Glyndon Coordinating Council, opposed the request. The Petition was advertised and posted as required by the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations. A substantive Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC) comment was received from the Bureau of Development Plans Review (DPR), concerning landscaping and lighting requirements.

The subject property is 4.085 acres in size and is zoned BR. A Lexus automobile dealership ("Len Stoler Lexus") is operated at the property. Counsel indicated the manufacturer

has adopted new branding and logos, and that the applicable agreements require franchisees to install new signage at the dealership.

SPECIAL HEARING

Petitioner's counsel and Mr. Kellman met with County zoning staff to discuss the petition. The County determined - - in keeping with its long-standing policy - - the sign area included the entire 9' x 25' structure shown on the plan. Petitioner contends the sign area should only include the approximate 45 sq. ft. rectangle containing the "Lexus" script and logo, and the special hearing request seeks confirmation of this interpretation.

The resolution of this issue involves several definitions found in the sign regulations, including: "area," "face," "message," and "sign." B.C.Z.R. §450.3. The determination of a sign's "area" involves drawing a rectangle around the "face" of the sign. The face is the flat surface containing the "message of the sign." Under the Regulations the "message" includes not only "written words" and "symbols," but also "colors, illumination or theme comprising the face of a sign." According to Mr. Kellman, County staff believed the color, design and theme of the sign were integral to the message it delivered; i.e., the "Lexus" brand.

While there are reasonable arguments on both sides, I believe under Maryland law I am obliged to defer to the zoning staff's long-standing interpretation of the sign regulations. Mr. Kellman confirmed the calculation of the sign area in this case was consistent with the agency's procedure and determination in similar cases. As Maryland's highest court has held, the "interpretation of a statute by the agency charged with its administration is entitled to great deference, especially when the interpretation has been applied consistently and for a long period of time." *BGE v. Public Service Comm'n.*, 305 Md. 145, 161 (1986).

VARIANCE

A variance request involves a two-step process, summarized as follows:

- (1) It must be shown the property is unique in a manner which makes it unlike surrounding properties, and that uniqueness or peculiarity must necessitate variance relief; and
- (2) If variance relief is denied, Petitioner will experience a practical difficulty or hardship.

Cromwell v. Ward, 102 Md. App. 691 (1995).

While the dimensions of the property are somewhat irregular, the site does not have any truly inherent characteristics (i.e., size, shape, topography, etc.) that would render it unique under Maryland law. The petitioner must establish the property is unique or peculiar in a way that is unlike other properties in the neighborhood. In a contested case requiring a rigorous application of the variance standard, the petitioner faces an uphill battle. In fact, I was unable to locate a Maryland appellate court opinion from the last twenty years which upheld the grant of a variance. Under Maryland law, variances should be granted "sparingly" since it is "an authorization for [that] ... which is prohibited by a zoning ordinance." Cromwell, 102 Md. App. at 699.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED this <u>29th</u> day of September, **2016**, by this Administrative Law Judge, that the Petition for Special Hearing filed pursuant to § 500.7 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("B.C.Z.R) to permit a sign of 45 sq. ft. in lieu of the 225 sq. ft. under the County's interpretation of the required area which includes the entire structure, be and is hereby DENIED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED the petition for variance to permit a sign of 225 sq. ft. in lieu of the 50 sq. ft. permitted, be and is hereby DENIED.



Any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

Dear Judge Mayhew,

A hearing is scheduled in the aforementioned case on October 1, 2020. Our office feels compelled to present our position to the Administrative Law Judge in the aforementioned case, having litigated the same sign for the same petitioner less than 3 years ago. Moreover, the Department of Planning recognized the prior case in 2017 for a freestanding sign by the same Petitioner at the same location. Planning rightly deferred to the ALJ on this legal issue. We respectfully wish to convey our position on res judicata and variance law.

The petitioner, Colonial Stoler LLC, filed a special hearing petition in 2017 for the free standing sign that is the subject of a special hearing and a variance petition in this case. In 2017 Petitioner claimed the area did not exceed the perimeter around the word Lexus although the face of the sign measured 225 square feet. Petitioner contended the integral color and design of a Lexus key fob within the area should not be considered as part of the sign's size limitation of 50 square feet under BCZR 450.6 (g). (See attached BCZR page 4:189).

The special hearing relief in the 2017 case was denied by the ALJ, denied on reconsideration by the ALJ, denied by the CBA and affirmed by the CC. The opinions rejected Petitioner's claim that the design is excluded from the definition of area in BCZR

450. The CBA denied the variances and held the site was not unique and the decision was upheld in the Circuit Court.

The Circuit Court Order was issued January 19, 2018. Just two years and 4 months later Petitioner has returned for relief for the same sign and virtually the same relief. This is a blatant case of res judicata.

The 2017 Petition requested the following:

"Variance Request - Section 450.4 Attachment 1 #5(g)

To request a variance permitting a sign of 225 sq.ft. in lieu of the 50 sq.ft. permitted by Sec. 450.4 or,

Special Hearing

In the alternative, permitting a sign of 45 sq. ft. in lieu of the 225 sq. ft. under the County's interpretation of the required area including the entire structure, which is the subject of the requested Special Hearing, as set forth herein"

The current Petition states:

- "1. B.C.Z.R Section 450.4 (Table of Sign Regulations) 5(a) to allow three enterprise signs on one facade in lieu of the permitted three enterprise signs, with no more than two on a single facade (Sign B,C,D).
- 2. Variance from B.C.Z.R Section 450.4 (Table of Sign Regulations) 3(a) to allow a directional sign with a sign area/face of 26 square feet in lieu of the permitted 8 square feet (Sign A).
- 3. Variance from B.C.Z.R Section 450.4 (Table of Sign Regulations) 5(g) to allow a freestanding enterprise sign with a sign area/face of 144 square feet and a height of 19 feet in lieu of the permitted 50 square feet and 25 feet in height, if necessary (Sign E)."

Variance #3 and the Special Hearing pertain to the same freestanding sign as in the 2017 case and are barred by res judicata. Variance #1 and #2 require a finding of uniqueness and practical difficulty. The 2017 opinions held the site is not unique for sign relief, thus barring variance relief in the instant case.

The sign illustrations are attached. Clearly, it is the same sign in terms of logo, language, color. Under BCZR the sign still exceeds the area requirements. Petitioner is just taking another stab at securing zoning approval despite a final order denying the same sign; this is exactly what *res judicata* prohibits and is the purpose of this long standing legal principle.

"The law, in dispensing even-handed justice to all, has wisely taken care "ut sit finis litium," and if matters, which have been once solemnly decided, could be again drawn into controversy, there would be no end of litigation. Mr. Greenleaf has happily said, "justice requires that every cause be once fairly and impartially tried; but the public tranquility demands that having been once so tried, all litigation of that question and between the same parties should be closed forever." McKinzie v. Baltimore & O.R. Co. 28 Md. 161, 168 (1868).

It is well-settled that res judicata applies to administrative cases, including zoning matters. Batson v. Shiflett 325 Md.684 (1992). Whittle v. Board of Zoning Appeals of Baltimore County 211 Md. 36(1956). More recently, and to the point in the instant case, Judge Meredith in CSA's Seminary v. Dulaney Valley 192 Md. App. 719,732 (2010) held that the legal theory to support a parking variance advanced in the second case "... could have been advanced in the first case." The CSA denied all relief requested in the second case based on res judicata.

Likewise here Petitioner seeks to circumvent the plain language of the area definition and the 50 sq. foot limit on freestanding signs for new car dealers with yet another bogus theory as similarly vacuous as the 2017 case. The Petitioner is basing approval on the same theory – only the written word should be the measuring barometer and not anything else within the four corners of the sign area. How many times must we be faced with these petitions claiming yet another reason to permit a clearly illegal sign?

The sign legislation in BCZR 450 is particularly detailed, both in the definitions and the chart. There is no ambiguity. Moreover, the County Council specifically included design, symbols, and color scheme as part of the message in determining the sign's size. If these factors are to be excluded as Petitioner again proposes it is up to the legislature, not the parties and, respectfully, not the Administrative Judge (s). But given that many, if not most, establishments incorporate symbols, color schemes, logos in lieu of words for branding and advertisements, it is only reasonable that such features should be part of the sign face; otherwise a size limitation is meaningless.

An agency may not bypass or usurp a legislative prescription. The Court of Special Appeals recently reiterated in Montgomery County v. Rios 244 Md. App. 629, 639 (2020):

"... the Commission's regulations 'cannot override the plain meaning of the statute or extend its provisions beyond the clear import of the language employed,' quoting Vest v. Giant Food Stores, Inc., 329 Md. 461, 476, 620 A.2d 340 (19 93))."

The legislature has wide discretion to make judgments and draw lines. Lonaconing Trap Club v. Maryland Department of Environment 410 Md. 326 (2009). The law must be implemented as written and intended, with the legislature available to make modifications in any direction. We are dealing with legislation and the rule of law.

It is up to legislative judgment and prerogative whether to expand or contract the permitted sign sizes and particulars of measurement. If the County Council wishes to amend the sign regulation, it may do so. They have not done it.

Robert Bolt gave voice to Thomas More in Man For All Seasons (1960), the focus must be on what is legal, not what a property owner or developer happens to think is "right," a very elusive and subjective inquiry.

On the variances, in its June 9, 2017 Opinion, the CBA stated on page 5: "A basic requirement is that the proponent of the variance demonstrate that the lot is unique and the "uniqueness" creates a practical difficulty in the use of the lot without the grant of a variance. In this matter, there is <u>absolutely</u> nothing about Stoler's lot that makes it unique." (emphasis added). There has been no change or alternation at the site, let alone any change meeting the uniqueness standards under <u>Cromwell v. Ward</u>, 102 Md. App. 691 (1995) and BCZR 307.1.

For these reasons the Petition for Variances and the Petition for Special Hearing must be denied.

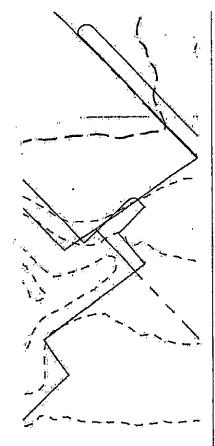

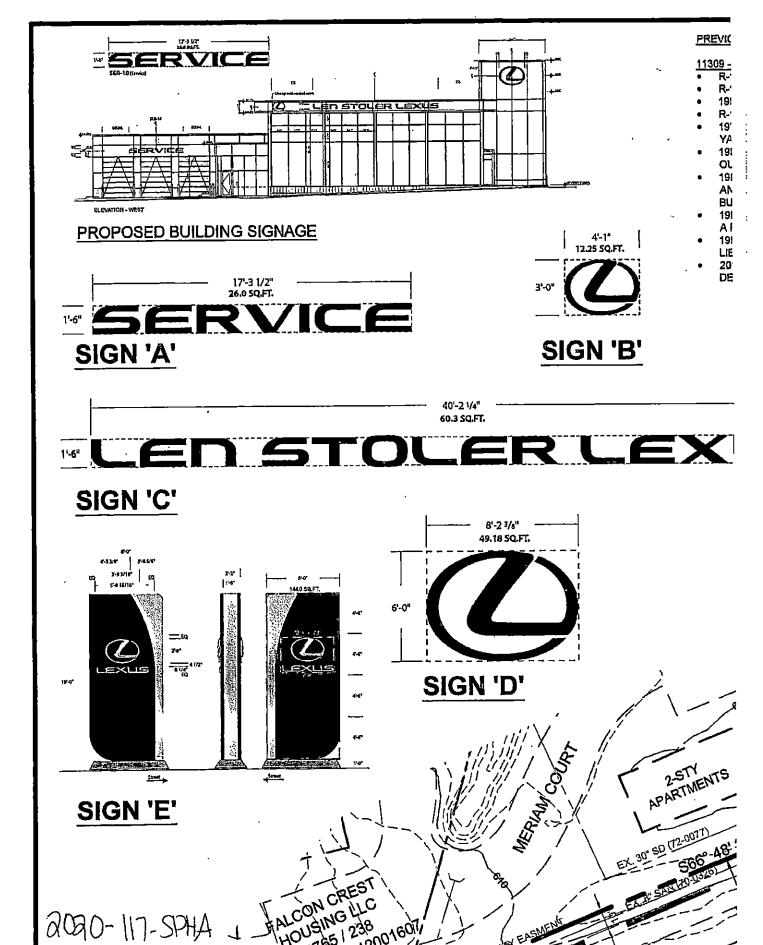

OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) for consideration of Petitions for Special Hearing and Variance filed on behalf of Colonial Stoler, LLC, legal owner ("Petitioner"). The Special Hearing was filed pursuant to § 500.7 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("B.C.Z.R) to permit a sign of 45 sq. ft. in lieu of the 225 sq. ft. as determined under the County's interpretation of the required area which includes the entire structure. In the alternative, a Petition for Variance seeks to permit a sign of 225 sq. ft. in lieu of the 50 sq. ft. permitted. A site plan was marked and accepted into evidence as Petitioner's Exhibit 1.

Appearing at the public hearing in support of the requests were Barry Stoler and Mitchell Kellman. Marvin I. Singer, Esq. represented the Petitioner. George Harmon, on behalf of the Reisterstown-Owings Mills-Glyndon Coordinating Council, opposed the request. The Petition was advertised and posted as required by the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations. A substantive Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC) comment was received from the Bureau of Development Plans Review (DPR), concerning landscaping and lighting requirements.

The subject property is 4.085 acres in size and is zoned BR. A Lexus automobile dealership ("Len Stoler Lexus") is operated at the property. Counsel indicated the manufacturer

has adopted new branding and logos, and that the applicable agreements require franchisees to install new signage at the dealership.

SPECIAL HEARING

Petitioner's counsel and Mr. Kellman met with County zoning staff to discuss the petition. The County determined - - in keeping with its long-standing policy - - the sign area included the entire 9' x 25' structure shown on the plan. Petitioner contends the sign area should only include the approximate 45 sq. ft. rectangle containing the "Lexus" script and logo, and the special hearing request seeks confirmation of this interpretation.

The resolution of this issue involves several definitions found in the sign regulations, including: "area," "face," "message," and "sign." B.C.Z.R. §450.3. The determination of a sign's "area" involves drawing a rectangle around the "face" of the sign. The face is the flat surface containing the "message of the sign." Under the Regulations the "message" includes not only "written words" and "symbols," but also "colors, illumination or theme comprising the face of a sign." According to Mr. Kellman, County staff believed the color, design and theme of the sign were integral to the message it delivered, i.e., the "Lexus" brand.

While there are reasonable arguments on both sides, I believe under Maryland law I am obliged to defer to the zoning staff's long-standing interpretation of the sign regulations. Mr. Kellman confirmed the calculation of the sign area in this case was consistent with the agency's procedure and determination in similar cases. As Maryland's highest court has held, the "interpretation of a statute by the agency charged with its administration is entitled to great deference, especially when the interpretation has been applied consistently and for a long period of time." BGE v. Public Service Comm'n., 305 Md. 145, 161 (1986).

VARIANCE

A variance request involves a two-step process, summarized as follows:

- (1) It must be shown the property is unique in a manner which makes it unlike surrounding properties, and that uniqueness or peculiarity must necessitate variance relief; and
- (2) If variance relief is denied, Petitioner will experience a practical difficulty or hardship.

Cromwell v. Ward, 102 Md. App. 691 (1995).

While the dimensions of the property are somewhat irregular, the site does not have any truly inherent characteristics (i.e., size, shape, topography, etc.) that would render it unique under Maryland law. The petitioner must establish the property is unique or peculiar in a way that is unlike other properties in the neighborhood. In a contested case requiring a rigorous application of the variance standard, the petitioner faces an uphill battle. In fact, I was unable to locate a Maryland appellate court opinion from the last twenty years which upheld the grant of a variance. Under Maryland law, variances should be granted "sparingly" since it is "an authorization for [that] ... which is prohibited by a zoning ordinance." *Cromwell*, 102 Md. App. at 699.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED this 29th day of September, 2016, by this Administrative Law Judge, that the Petition for Special Hearing filed pursuant to § 500.7 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("B.C.Z.R) to permit a sign of 45 sq. ft. in lieu of the 225 sq. ft. under the County's interpretation of the required area which includes the entire structure, be and is hereby DENIED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED the petition for variance to permit a sign of 225 sq. ft. in lieu of the 50 sq. ft. permitted, be and is hereby DENIED.

Any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

ORDER ON MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION

Petitioner's primary argument is that the Administrative Law Judge should not defer to the zoning office's interpretation of the regulations concerning the "area" of a sign. Petitioner's expert agreed the zoning office adhered in this case to its longstanding pattern and practice in calculating the sign area. The zoning office determined the entire face of the sign (rather than just the 45 sq. ft. rectangle containing the "Lexus" lettering and logo) must be included in the area calculation since the color and design of the structure constituted part of the sign's message.

Petitioner contends this interpretation disregards "exclusion A" found in the definition of "area" at B.C.Z.R. § 450.3. I respectfully disagree. That provision would exclude from the calculation any support structures or features which "are <u>not</u> part of the message of the sign." <u>Id.</u> (emphasis added). For example, a structural support pole on which a sign was located would not be included in the area calculation. But the zoning office here determined the color and design

of the sign face was integral to the message (i.e., "Lexus") and so should be part of the sign "area."

The Zoning Commissioner's Policy Manual, at p. 4-69.9 (a copy of which is attached hereto), Example 5, shows how the area of a Volvo automobile dealership sign is calculated, and I believe the zoning office's interpretation is consistent with this example.

WHEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED this 14th day of October, 2016, by this Administrative Law Judge, that the Motion for Reconsideration be and is hereby DENIED.

Any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

TABLE-DEFINITION OF COLUMNS- The following table specifies the allowable combinations of sign classes and sign types, along with locational, dimensional and other pertinent conditions, as follows:

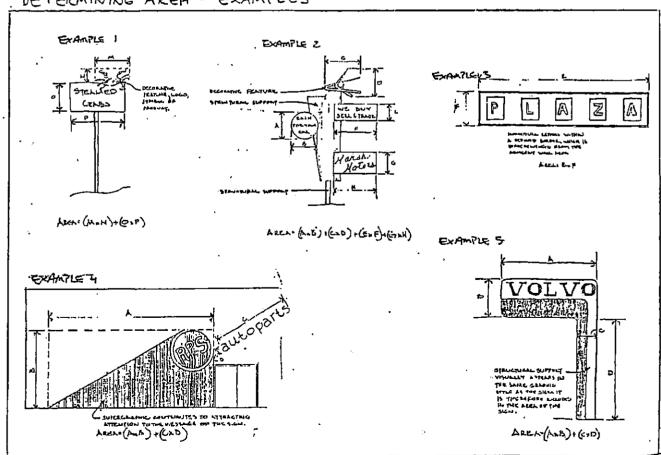
Column:

- A. <u>Class</u> Refers to the overall purpose and general character of the entire sign.
- B. <u>Structural Type</u> Identifies the structural type(s) that may be used to display signs of the given class, subject to the requirements in the succeeding columns. (See definitions of types on Page 4.)
- C. Zone or Use Defines the zone(s) wherein signs of the class and type combination(s) may be displayed. In certain cases, the permissibility is granted for a sign in conjunction with a particular type of land use, as identified in this column, in whichever zone(s) such use is permitted.
- D. <u>Permit Required</u> A "Bldg." entry indicates that a Building Permit must be obtained for each sign. A "None" entry indicates that a Building Permit is not required, provided that the sign complies with all other applicable provisions of these Regulations. An "SE" indicates that each such sign is permitted only as a Special Exception use authorized pursuant to Section 502. A "Use" entry indicates that a permit pursuant to Section 500.4 must be obtained for each such sign.

If the proposed sign(s) will be accessory to a structure, use or development that otherwise is required to obtain a building or use permit or development approval, all pertinent information regarding the sign(s) must be included as part of the otherwise-required application(s).

E. <u>Maximum Area or Face</u> - Defines the maximum number of square feet, or the rule for calculating the maximum number, that may be included within the face of any single permitted sign of the given class, regardless of the type; the number is not to be interpreted as a separate limit for each type identified in Column B, but the maximum area may be divided among more than one sign to the extent permitted in Column F. Subject to the limit in Column F regarding the maximum number of signs, compliance with the maximum area is determined by the following rules:

OPINION

This matter comes before the Board of Appeals for Baltimore County (the "Board") as a de novo appeal from an original hearing before Administrative Law Judge John E. Beverungen. The Petitioner (hereinafter "Stoler") seeks permission to replace its sign at its Lexus dealership on Reisterstown Road. As an initial matter, Stoler sought a ruling that the definition of sign size in the BCZR means that its proposed new sign is permitted by right. Assuming, however, that the proposed sign is not permitted by right under the current regulations, Stoler alternatively seeks a variance from the zoning regulations to allow the construction of its proposed sign. Judge Beverungen found that the County's standing interpretation of the definitions of "area", "face", "message", and "sign" in BCZR § 450.3 precludes the Stoler sign. In addition, he found that Stoler's request for a variance does not meet the requirements under Cromwell v. Ward, 102 Md. App. 691 (1995). Stoler thereafter noted a timely appeal to the Board of Appeals.

A de novo hearing before the Board was held on January 19, 2017. As an initial matter, Stoler sought to amend its request for a variance to include a request for a variance for its present sign, which is much smaller than Stoler's proposed new sign, but which is presently nonconforming. People's Counsel objected on procedural grounds. We determined that Stoler's amended request for variance relief is simply a "lesser included" version of its original variance

request. As such, we held that it is not the kind of amendment which constitutes a substantive change, requiring separate notice, petition, and hearing at the ALJ level. See e.g. McLean v. Soley, 270 Md. 208 (1973). Accordingly, we allowed Stoler to pursue its additional variance request at the Board of Appeals level.

Stoler's counsel made an excellent presentation, and if this were simply a matter of aesthetics, the Board would rule in Stoler's favor. Further, as Stoler's counsel pointed out, there are a number of automobile dealership signs on Reisterstown Road which are similar in size and appearance to the sign Stoler seeks in this case, lending a level of equitable appeal to Stoler's position. Nonetheless, the Board believes that the law clearly requires it to rule against Stoler on all three substantive grounds for relief sought in its Petition.

Stoler called two witnesses, Mitchell Kellman and Michael Meagher. Mr. Kellman is Director of Zoning Services for Daft-McCune-Walker, Inc, an entity which provides support services to businesses seeking zoning relief. In brief, Mr. Kellman established that the present Lexus sign was erected in 1992. It stands 27 feet high and, under the prevailing size definition in the BCZR, it is 70 square feet. Today's zoning requirements limit such signs to 50 square feet. BCZR § 450.5(g). Because the zoning requirements limiting the size of signs, like Stoler's, to 50 square feet came into effect in 1997, the Stoler sign was pre-existing and nonconforming. The BCZR provides a 15-year grace period for businesses to bring their signs into compliance. Since Stoler erected its sign in 1992, it has not altered the sign, and the BCZR grace period expired in 2012.

In his testimony, Mr. Kellman described Stoler's proposed new sign. It is to be a large solid structure in the shape of the Lexus device used in the automobile in place of the ignition key (hereinafter referred to as "key"). The proposed "key sign" is 25 ft. high and 9 ft. wide, amounting

to 225 square feet. In the middle of the proposed key sign, in white letters, is to be the word "Lexus". If one were to draw a perimeter around the portion of the sign that contained only the word "Lexus", the area inside that perimeter would be 45 square feet. Later testimony by Mr. Meagher, the general manager of the Stoler dealership on Reisterstown Road, established that this key shape is, in effect, a Lexus icon or insignia and the branding symbol by which Stoler's customers, and any possible Lexus customer nationwide, could identify this, or any, Lexus dealership.

The BCZR § 450.3 defines the "area" of sign as "[t]he number of square feet within the perimeter of one contiguous rectangle enclosing the face of the sign". The definition further states that the "area" is "... differentiated from the structure supporting it or upon which it is erected." The "face" is the flat surface "within a continuous perimeter enclosing the outer limits of the message of a sign." The sign's message is "[a] communication, statement or display of information or ideas through written words, letters, numerals, images, illumination or theme comprising the face of the sign". The definition further indicates that the message is "distinguishable" from the structure and the supporting apparatus of the sign. Finally, for our purposes, a "sign" is "[a]ny structure or other object, or part thereof, which displays any word, illustration, decoration or other symbolic representation which: A. Is used or intended to inform, advertise or otherwise attract attention or convey a message regarding a ... commercial... place..."

Clearly, the entirety of proposed structure is a "sign." More to the point, under the County interpretation, the proposed new sign would be 225 square feet instead of the permitted 50 square feet, because, in this instance, the entire structure itself is the "message". The entire sign is in the symbolic shape of a Lexus key. It is the icon by which Lexus is to be identified nationwide. As

such, in this instance, the "face" and the "message" are the same. Thus, according to the County, the new sign was not permitted.

Stoler argued that only the word Lexus on this new sign was the "message". An imaginary perimeter could be drawn around that word, and the area inside that perimeter is only 45 square feet. Thus, according to Stoler, its proposed sign is permitted by right because it is less than the 50 square feet maximum allowed by law. According to Stoler, the balance of the edifice – namely, the Lexus key-shaped object upon which the word "Lexus" was imposed – was simply a "supportive element" without message content or meaning.

Stoler's position is incorrect. The testimony from Stoler's own witnesses established, without question, that the entire piece was intentionally shaped like the Lexus key so that the sign in its entirety would be, and become, the symbolic representation of the Lexus brand. There is, according to the testimony, a nationwide Lexus effort to make the shape of this entire sign into a symbolic representation of the Lexus brand. On this issue, Mr. Meagher stated: "[The sign's purpose is] the branding...There is a difference between advertising and branding... The car key that you get is that sign..." This testimony established that under any definition of area, face, and message, the entire Lexus sign – in the shape of the Lexus key – is the message; it is the symbol being communicated. Thus, the testimony established beyond all doubt that the entire edifice is the sign, and not simply the small area created by a perimeter around the word Lexus. As a result, any claim that there is ambiguity in the definition of "area", "size", "message" or the application of those definitions is irrelevant. Even if one were to accept the Stoler interpretation on the critical definitions – and this Board does not – the proposed sign is unpermitted because, as established factually by the Stoler testimony, the entire edifice is the message rather than it being a supporting structure for the single word "Lexus".

As an alternative, Stoler has requested a variance that would permit construction of the sign. Again, if this were solely a question of aesthetics, the Board would happily grant a variance. Unfortunately, the Board is required to apply the variance principles as stated in *Cromwell v. Ward*, 102 Md. App. 691 (1995) and codified in BCZR § 307.1. A basic requirement is that the proponent of the variance demonstrate that the lot is unique and the "uniqueness" creates a practical difficulty in the use of the lot without the grant of a variance. In this matter, there is absolutely nothing about Stoler's lot that makes it unique. Further, the testimony established that Stoler's customers have had no difficulty in finding the Stoler Lexus dealership and there has been no apparent impediment to its business (even if financial hardship could satisfy the practical difficulty requirement, which, under *Cromwell*, it cannot). *See Cromwell*, 102 Md. App. at 703-21. The Board thus concludes that Stoler has failed to carry its burden of proof to show uniqueness and practical difficulty that are requirements for variance relief.

Finally, as indicated above, Stoler has requested a more limited variance for its present sign. This variance would allow for Stoler to continue to use a sign, as it has since 1992, which is 70 square feet in size, rather than the permitted 50 square feet, and which is 27 feet high in lieu of the permitted 25 foot height. Again, however, Stoler cannot show that its site is unique and that that uniqueness causes a practical difficulty, as required under *Cromwell*. Accordingly, the amended request for a variance must also be denied.

ORDER

ORDERED that the Petition for Special Hearing pursuant to BCZR § 500.7 to permit a sign of 45 square feet in lieu of the 225 square feet as determined by the County is hereby DENIED; and it is further

ORDERED that the Petition for Variance to permit erection of the aforementioned 225 square feet sign in lieu of the 50 square feet permitted is **DENIED**; and it is further

ORDERED that the oral amendment requesting a Variance to permit a sign that is 70 square feet in lieu of the permitted 50 square feet and that is 27 feet high in lieu of the 25 feet permitted, is **DENIED**.

Any petition for judicial review from this decision must be made in accordance with Rule 7-201 through Rule 7-210 of the *Maryland Rules*.

OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings ("OAH") for Baltimore County as a Petition for Variance filed by Colonial Stoler, LLC, legal owner of the subject property ("Petitioner"). The Petition seeks variance relief from Section 238.2 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("B.C.Z.R.") to permit a 13 ft. side yard setback in lieu of the required 30 ft. setback. A site plan was marked as Petitioner's Exhibit 1.

Professional Engineer Richard Matz appeared in support of the petition. Timothy M. Kotroco, Esq. represented the Petitioner. There were no protestants or interested citizens in attendance. The Petition was advertised and posted as required by the B.C.Z.R. No substantive Zoning Advisory Committee ("ZAC") comments were received from any of the County reviewing agencies.

The site is approximately 4.03 acres in size and zoned BR. A Lexus automobile dealership is operated at the property. The request in this case pertains to the service area of the dealership. At present, customers drive their vehicles under a carport to register for service and repairs. Petitioner would like to enclose this space so customers would be sheltered from the elements. Mr. Matz noted the variance request is in fact from an internal lot line, since Petitioner (or a related entity) also owns the adjoining lot at 11317 Reisterstown Road.

A variance request involves a two-step process, summarized as follows:

- (1) It must be shown the property is unique in a manner which makes it unlike surrounding properties, and that uniqueness or peculiarity must necessitate variance relief; and
- (2) If variance relief is denied, Petitioner will experience a practical difficulty or hardship.

Cromwell v. Ward, 102 Md. App. 691 (1995).

The property is irregularly shaped and is therefore unique. In addition, the property was found to be unique in at least four prior zoning cases dating back to 1974. If the Regulations were strictly interpreted Petitioner would experience a practical difficulty because it would be unable to complete the proposed improvements. Finally, I find that the variance can be granted in harmony with the spirit and intent of the BCZR, and in such manner as to grant relief without injury to the public health, safety and general welfare.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, this <u>2nd</u> day of February, 2018, by the Administrative Law Judge for Baltimore County, that the Petition for Variance seeking relief from §238.2 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("B.C.Z.R.") to permit a 13 ft. side yard setback in lieu of the required 30 ft. setback, be and is hereby GRANTED.

The relief granted herein shall be subject to the following:

1. Petitioner may apply for necessary permits and/or licenses upon receipt of this Order. However, Petitioner is hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at its own risk until 30 days from the date hereof, during which time an appeal can be filed by any party. If for whatever reason this Order is reversed, Petitioner would be required to return the subject property to its original condition.

Any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.
