OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings ("OAH") for consideration of Petitions for Special Hearing and Variance filed on behalf of Sara S. Rowan, legal owner ("Petitioner"). The Special Hearing was filed pursuant to § 500.7 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("BCZR"), to allow a 1,186 sq. ft. accessory apartment to be occupied by the parents of the property owner in accordance with BCZR § 400.4. In addition, a Petition for Variance was filed pursuant to § 400.1, of the BCZR to permit an accessory structure to be located in the side yard in lieu of the rear yard; and per § 400.3 of the BCZR to permit an accessory structure with a height not to exceed 26.5 in lieu of the 15 ft. maximum height limit.

Due to COVID-19 pandemic, a public WebEx hearing was conducted virtually in lieu of an inperson hearing. The Petition was properly advertised and posted. A site plan was marked and accepted into evidence as Petitioners' Exhibit 6.

Susan Rowan and her father John Rowan appeared in support of the requests. Robert S. Glushakow, Esq. represented the Petitioner. John Mariani Architecture, PA prepared the site plan. There were no protestants or interested persons in attendance. Substantive Zoning Advisory Committee ("ZAC") comments were received from the Department of Planning ("DOP") and from the Department of Environmental Protection and Sustainability Development

Coordination ("DEPS"). They did not oppose the requested relief, subject to proposed conditions, which will be incorporated into the Order.

Special Hearing

The property is approximately 2.11 acres and is zoned RC-6. The Rowans and counsel explained that Sara Rowan is the single mother of a three and a half year old son. Her parents care for the child several days a week so that she can work. They confirmed that they are aware of the parameters of this "in law" apartment use and they submitted the Declaration of Understanding required under BCZR § 400.4, which was admitted as Petitioner's Exhibit 11. In addition they submitted a petition signed by all the adjoining properties owners voicing their support for the requested relief. (Petitioner's Exhibit 10. The Rowans further acknowledged the conditions proposed by the DOP and confirmed that they agreed to them.¹

I find that the Rowans have satisfied all the requirements of BCZR § 400.4 and BCZR § 502.1 and that the special hearing relief can be granted within the spirit and intent of the BCZR, and without causing harm to the public health, safety, or welfare.

Variance

A variance request involves a two-step process, summarized as follows:

- (1) It must be shown the property is unique in a manner which makes it unlike surrounding properties, and that uniqueness or peculiarity must necessitate variance relief; and
- (2) If variance relief is denied, Petitioner will experience a practical difficulty or hardship.

Cromwell v. Ward, 102 Md. App. 691 (1995).

¹ The DEPS comment notes that it is possible that the proposed in-law apartment may require a separate septic system. If that is the case then the Rowans will not be bound by the DOP condition restricting separate septic systems.

Counsel explained that the site is irregularly shaped and has somewhat steep topography. It is also well forested with mature trees and shrubs which provide excellent buffering from the adjoining neighbors. The property is therefore unique. In addition, the siting of the existing residence makes it quite impractical to construct the proposed apartment in the rear of the residence. Mr. Rowan pointed out that to do so would also require a much longer driveway, with more impervious surface, and would also make connections to the existing well and septic systems more difficult. I find that the side yard variance relief is therefore necessitated by these unique features, and that practical difficulty and hardship would result if the relief were denied. Finally, the height variance is needed in order to construct a livable apartment for the Rowans. Counsel explained that the proposed structure is now only 22 ft. in height rather than the 26.5 ft. requested in the petition. In sum, I find that the variance relief can also be granted within the spirit and intent of the BCZR and without causing harm to the public health, safety, or welfare.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED this <u>1</u>st day of **December**, **2020**, by this Administrative Law Judge, that the Petition for Special Hearing seeking relief pursuant to § 500.7 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("BCZR"), to allow a 1,186 sq. ft. accessory apartment to be occupied by the parents of the property owner is hereby GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Petition for Variance seeking relief pursuant to § 400.1, of the BCZR to permit an accessory structure to be located in the side yard in lieu of the rear yard; and per § 400.3 of the BCZR to permit an accessory structure with a height not to exceed 22 ft. in lieu of the 15 ft. maximum height are also hereby GRANTED.

The relief granted herein shall be subject to the following:

 Petitioners may apply for necessary permits and/or licenses upon receipt of this Order. However, Petitioners are hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at their own risk until 30 days from the date hereof, during which time an appeal can be filed by any party. § 400.1. - Location; lot coverage.

Accessory buildings in residence zones, other than farm buildings (Section 404) shall be located only in the rear yard and shall occupy not more than 40 percent thereof. On corner lots they shall be located only in the third of the lot farthest removed from any street and shall occupy not more than 50 percent of such third. In no case shall they be located less than 2½ feet from any side or rear lot lines, except that two private garages may be built with a common party wall straddling a side interior property line if all other requirements are met. The limitations imposed by this section shall not apply to a structure which is attached to the principal building by a covered passageway or which has one wall or part of one wall in common with it. Such structure shall be considered part of the principal building and shall be subject to the yard requirements for such a building.

§ 400.2. - Setback.

[Bill No. 2-1992]

Accessory buildings, including parking pads, shall be set back not less than 15 feet from the center line of any alley on which the lot abuts.

§ 400.3. - Height.

The height of accessory buildings, except as noted in Section 300, shall not exceed 15 feet.

§ 400.4. - Accessory apartments.

[Bill No. 49-2011 山]

An accessory apartment is permitted as a temporary use within a principal single-family detached dwelling or within an accessory building situated on the same owner-occupied lot as the principal dwelling in any zone that permits single-family dwellings, subject to the following requirements:

- A. If located within an existing single-family detached dwelling:
 - 1. An applicant shall file with the Department of Permits, Approvals and Inspections an application for a use permit for an accessory apartment, on a form approved by the Department. With the application, the applicant shall submit a declaration of understanding, on a form approved by the Department, including but not necessarily limited to the following terms and conditions:
 - The size of the accessory apartment may not exceed one-third of the overall floor area of the dwelling or 2,000 square feet, whichever is less;
 - Any and all improvements to be dedicated as an accessory apartment shall be used solely as a single-family residence; and
 - c. The accessory apartment may not have separate utility meters, such as gas and electric service.
 - 2. The Director may approve the application upon a finding that the size, location, and purpose of the accessory structure will not negatively affect the health, safety, or general welfare of the surrounding community.
- B. If located within an accessory building on the same owner-occupied property as the principal single-family detached dwelling:

- 1. An applicant shall file a request for a special hearing and a use permit with the Department, together with a declaration of understanding as required by Subsection A1 of this section, and a public hearing before the Office of Administrative Hearings is required.
- 2. The size of the accessory apartment may not exceed 1,200 square feet, and the accessory building shall comply with the requirements of Section 400.
- 3. Following a public hearing, the Office of Administrative Hearings may grant a request upon a finding that the size, location, and purpose of the accessory apartment conform with Section 502.1 and may impose such conditions, restrictions or regulations consistent with Section 502.2 as may be deemed necessary or advisable for the protection of surrounding and neighboring properties, including the express prohibition that the accessory apartment not be converted to a second dwelling beyond the scope of this section.
- 4. The accessory apartment may not have separate utility meters or water and sewerage services unless approved by the Office of Administrative hearings based on specific findings of necessity for the accessory building.

C. Approval; renewal.

- 1. Approval. The approval of an application for a use permit in Subsection A or a request for a special hearing and a use permit in Subsection B shall be subject to the following:
 - a. The declaration of understanding and property description, including any conditions, restrictions, or regulations imposed by the Department or the Office of Administrative Hearings, shall be recorded in the land records of Baltimore County and a copy shall be filed with the Department; and
 - b. The accessory apartment shall only be utilized by immediate family members as defined in Section 101 and may not be used by any person other than an immediate family member for any other reason.
 - c. If the accessory apartment is no longer occupied by any person named in the use permit or if the property is sold, the use permit shall terminate, and any proposed changes in occupancy to the accessory apartment by the property owner or subsequent purchaser shall require a new request for a use permit as applicable under Subsection A or B.
- 2. Renewal. The applicant shall renew the use permit with the Department every two years by filing a renewal on a form approved by the Department, to be dated from the month of the initial approval, and shall list the name of any person occupying the accessory apartment.

1. Editor's Note—This Act stated that it applied retroactively to requests for in-law apartments filed on or after 8-1-2010, and also that owners of in-law apartments lawfully approved prior to the effective date of this Act must obtain a use permit required by this Act on or before 10-1-2012.

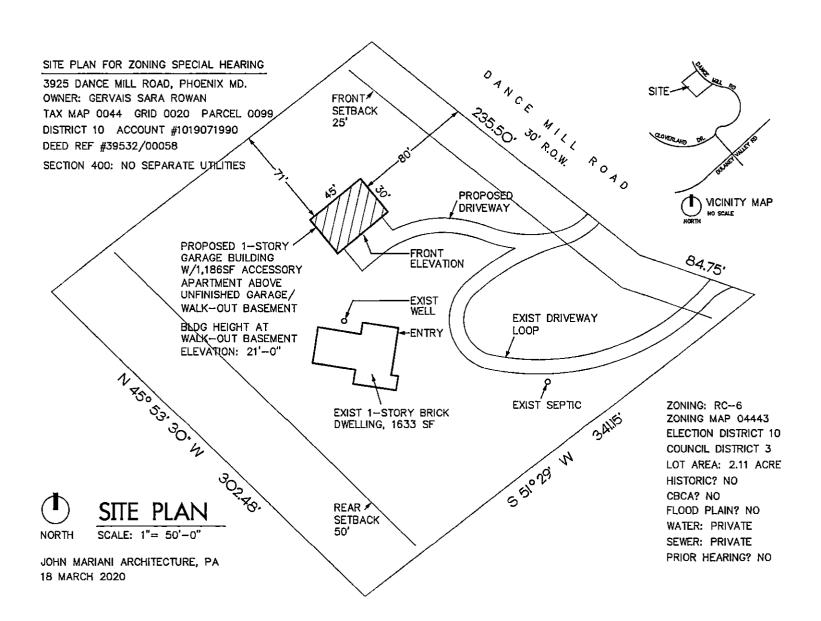

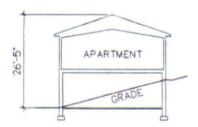
- A. The Declarant who is the owner of this property has filed an application for a use permit and special hearing to construct a detached 3-car garage to include an Accessory Apartment to be occupied by the Declarant's biological parents. The Property being located at 3925 Dance Mill Road, Phoenix MD 21131 and is more particularly described by metes and bounds in Exhibit A (The Property) and Exhibit B (The hearing plans) attached hereto and made part hereof. The Property is zoned RC-6 which is the particular zone in which the Property is located.
- B. 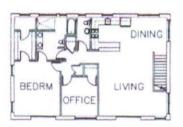


SITE PLAN FOR ZONING SPECIAL HEARING

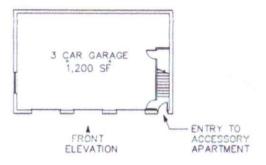

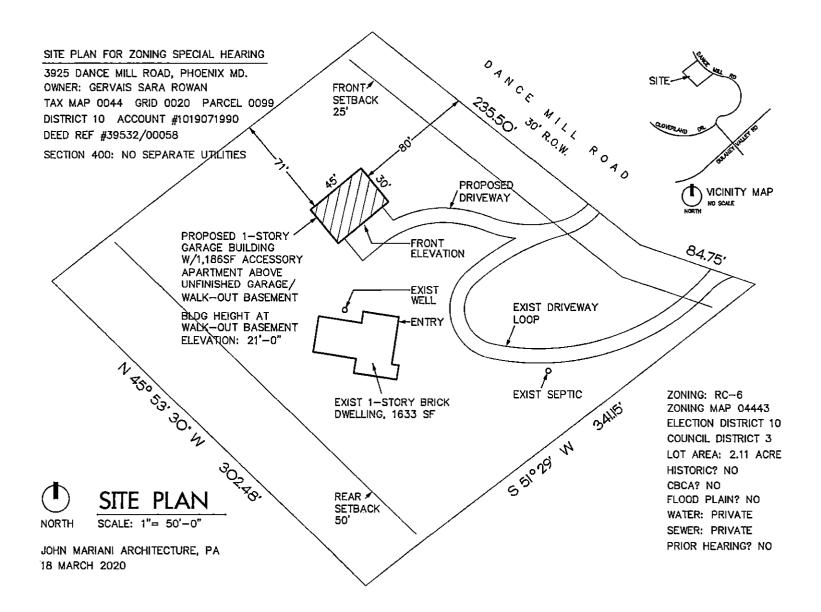


GARAGE/BASEMENT PLAN

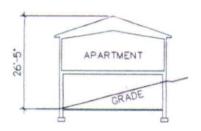

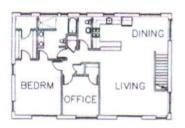

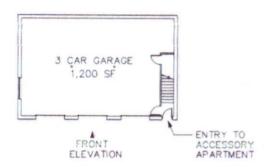

DECLARATION OF UNDERSTANDING

THIS DECLARATION OF UNDERSTANDING (hereinafter referred to as "Declaration") is made on this 2010 day of 2020, by and between Sara S. Rowan (hereinafter referred to as the "Declarant") and the Department of Permits, Approval and Inspections (hereinafter referred to as "PAI").

Recitals

- A. The Declarant who is the owner of this property has filed an application for a use permit and special hearing to construct a detached 3-car garage to include an Accessory Apartment to be occupied by the Declarant's biological parents. The Property being located at 3925 Dance Mill Road, Phoenix MD 21131 and is more particularly described by metes and bounds in Exhibit A (The Property) and Exhibit B (The hearing plans) attached hereto and made part hereof. The Property is zoned RC-6 which is the particular zone in which the Property is located.
- B. PAI (or) The Administrative Law Judge has approved the Declaration request to create an Accessory Apartment complete with dedicated bathing and cooking facilities, located on this owner-occupied Property. The Accessory Apartment will be housing for John J. Rowan, Jr. and Mary Jill Rowan, biological parents of the owner. The other residents of the Property are Sara S. Rowan (Owner) and Ryder M. Gervais, child of the owner and grandson of the parents. It is understood that the use permit must be renewed with PAI every (2)two years by filing a renewal on a PAI approved form, to be dated from the month of the initial approval.
- C. As a condition of approval of the Declarant's request, it is understood that Bill No. 49-11 requires the filling of this Declaration among the Land Records of Baltimore County, to provide notice to any future owners, subsequent bona ride purchasers or users of the Property that no part of any improvements or additions the Property may be used for separate living quarters and that all such improvements shall be used as a single-family residence, unless otherwise approved by and at the discretion of PAI.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the Declarant and PIA hereby declare as follows:

- 1. Any and all improvements now existing or to be constructed on the Property shall be used only as a single-family residence. No such improvements or additions shall ever be used as a separate living quarter or second residential unit. The kitchen for the Accessory Apartment will be constructed as part of the Property and shall be accessory to the principal use of the Property as a single-family residence. The Accessory Apartment shall house only the immediate family members listed in the Declaration and it is not be used by any other person for any other reason. The use permit and this Declaration are subject to the order, conditions or restrictions of any required zoning hearing. The hearing order is to be made part of this Declaration when it is recorded in Land Records.
- Once the Accessory Apartment is no longer occupied by the persons named in this Declaration or if the property is sold, or the use permit has not been renewed within the 2 year temporary use permit time limit, the use permit shall terminate, and any proposed changes in occupancy to the Accessory Apartment by the property owner of subsequent purchaser shall require a new request for use permit.
- 3. Upon use permit termination:
 - a. The Accessory Apartment in the accessory building requires removal of the kitchen and possibly other residential elements, at the discretion of PAI.

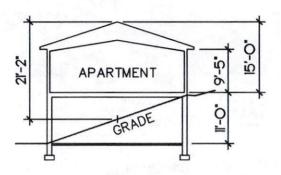

- b. The Declarant, upon termination of the use permit, will provide written notification to PAI for the closing of the Department file.
- 4. The covenants, conditions and restrictions stated above shall run with and bind the Property and shall be enforceable by Baltimore County, MD and by the owners of all or any portion of the Property.
- 5. Enforcement of the Covenants shall be by proceedings at law or in equity against any person or persons violating or attempting to violate any of the covenants, either to restrain the violation or to recover damages.

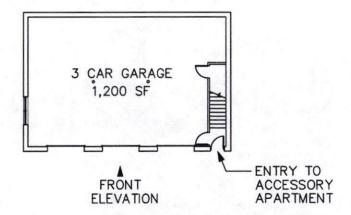

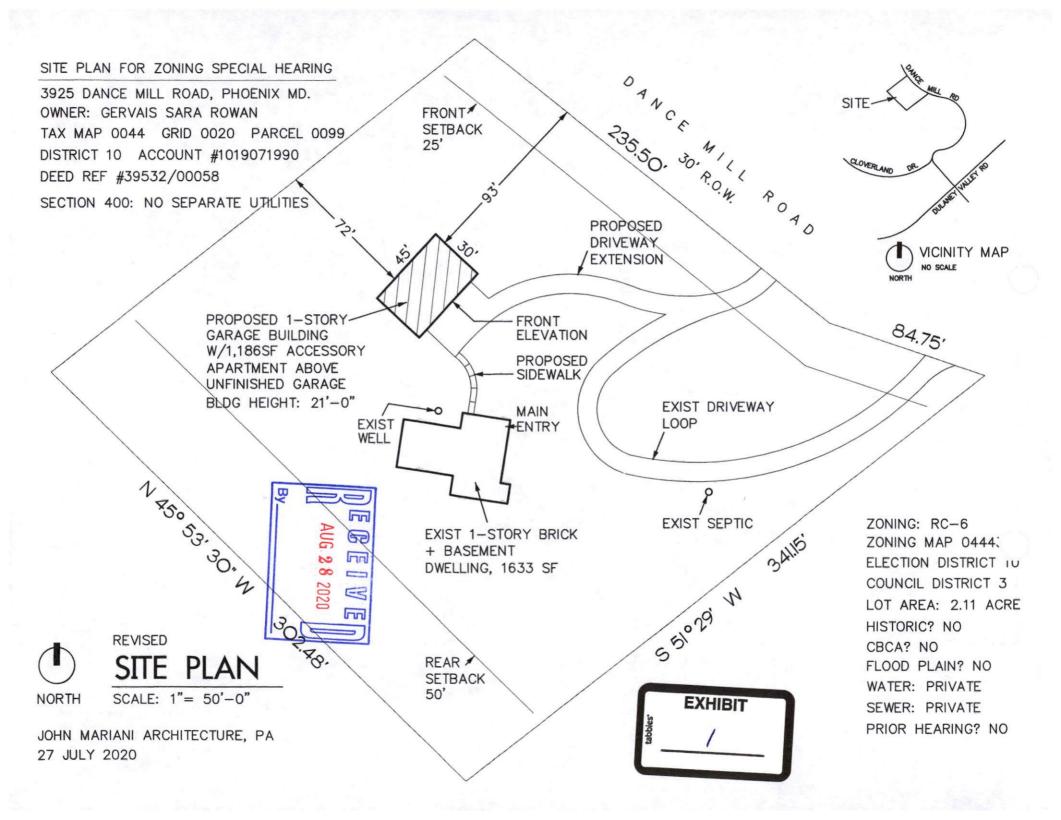

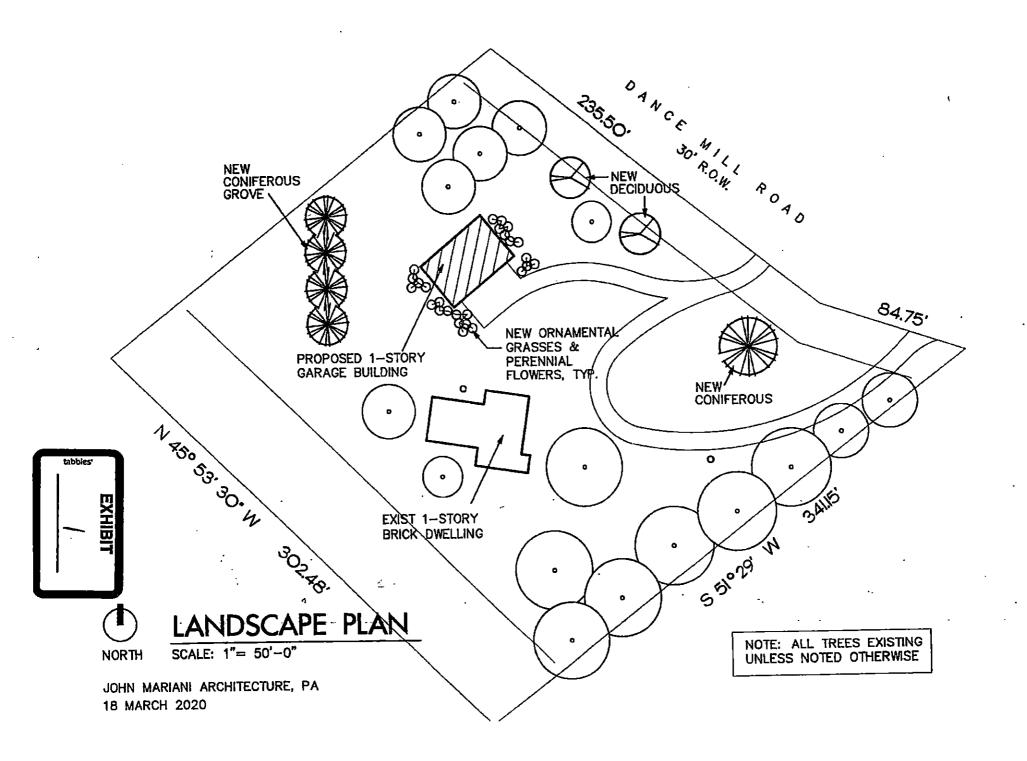

DECLARATION OF UNDERSTANDING

THIS DECLARATION OF UNDERSTANDING (hereinafter referred to as "Declaration") is made on this 2000 day of 2020, by and between Sara S. Rowan (hereinafter referred to as the "Declarant") and the Department of Permits, Approval and Inspections (hereinafter referred to as "PAI").

Recitals

- A. The Declarant who is the owner of this property has filed an application for a use permit and special hearing to construct a detached 3-car garage to include an Accessory Apartment to be occupied by the Declarant's biological parents. The Property being located at 3925 Dance Mill Road, Phoenix MD 21131 and is more particularly described by metes and bounds in Exhibit A (The Property) and Exhibit B (The hearing plans) attached hereto and made part hereof. The Property is zoned RC-6 which is the particular zone in which the Property is located.
- B. PAI (or) The Administrative Law Judge has approved the Declaration request to create an Accessory Apartment complete with dedicated bathing and cooking facilities, located on this owner-occupied Property. The Accessory Apartment will be housing for John J. Rowan, Jr. and Mary Jill Rowan, biological parents of the owner. The other residents of the Property are Sara S. Rowan (Owner) and Ryder M. Gervais, child of the owner and grandson of the parents. It is understood that the use permit must be renewed with PAI every (2)two years by filing a renewal on a PAI approved form, to be dated from the month of the initial approval.
- C. As a condition of approval of the Declarant's request, it is understood that Bill No. 49-11 requires the filing of this Declaration among the Land Records of Baltimore County, to provide notice to any future owners, subsequent bona ride purchasers or users of the Property that no part of any improvements or additions the Property may be used for separate living quarters and that all such improvements shall be used as a single-family residence, unless otherwise approved by and at the discretion of PAI.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the Declarant and PIA hereby declare as follows:

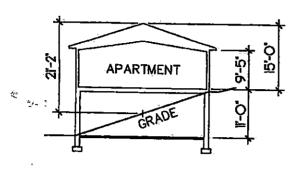
- 1. Any and all improvements now existing or to be constructed on the Property shall be used only as a single-family residence. No such improvements or additions shall ever be used as a separate living quarter or second residential unit. The kitchen for the Accessory Apartment will be constructed as part of the Property and shall be accessory to the principal use of the Property as a single-family residence.  - a. The Accessory Apartment in the accessory building requires removal of the kitchen and possibly other residential elements, at the discretion of PAI.

- 5. Enforcement of the Covenants shall be by proceedings at law or in equity against any person or persons violating or attempting to violate any of the covenants, either to restrain the violation or to recover damages.

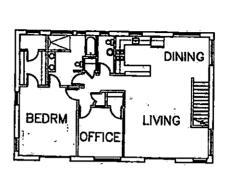

JOHN MARIANI ARCHITECTURE, PA 10 JUNE 2020 (REVISED)

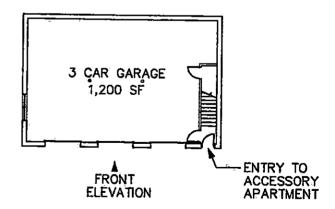

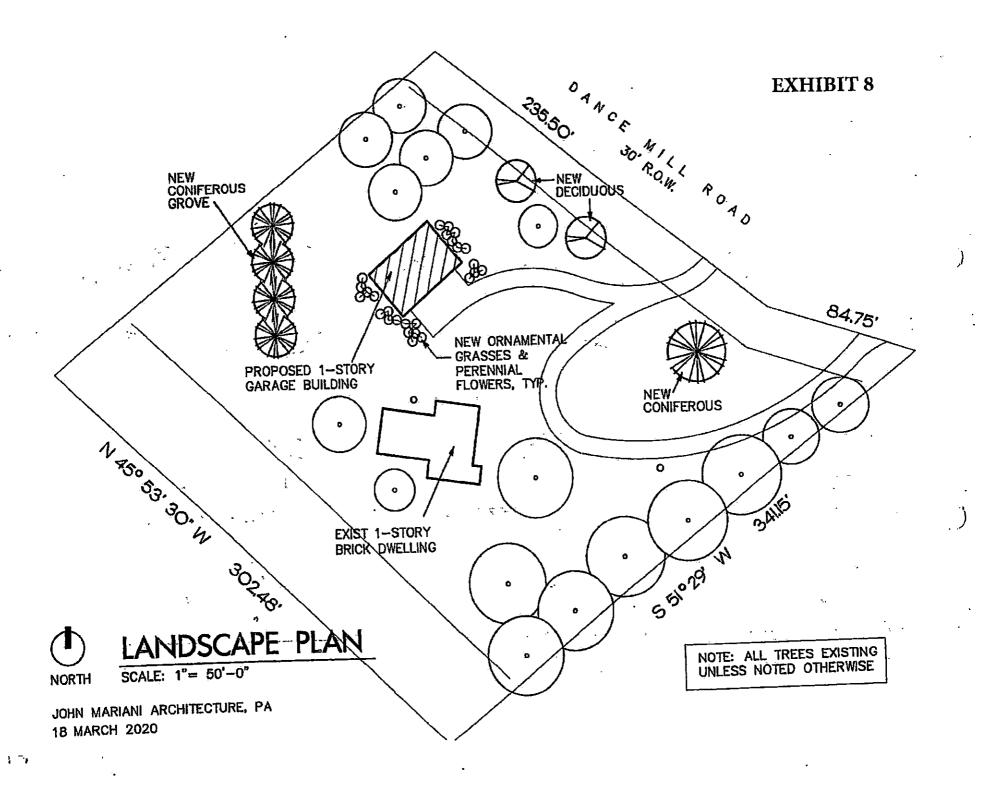
FIRST FLOOR PLAN

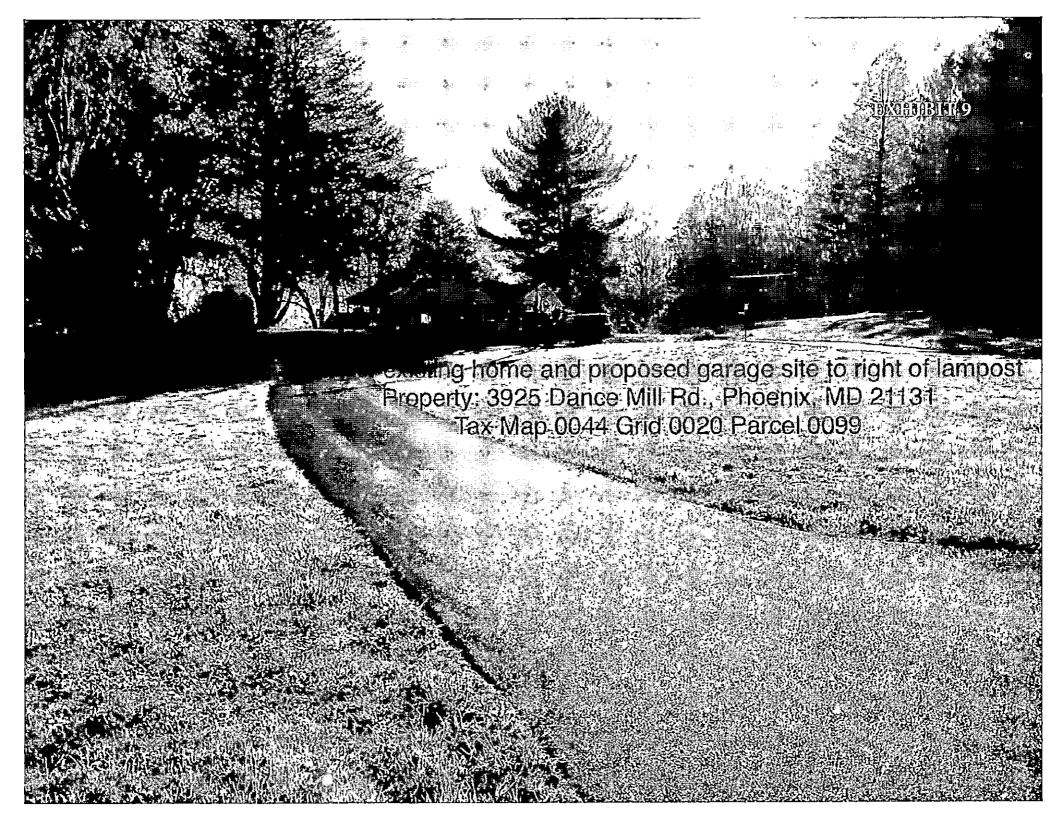

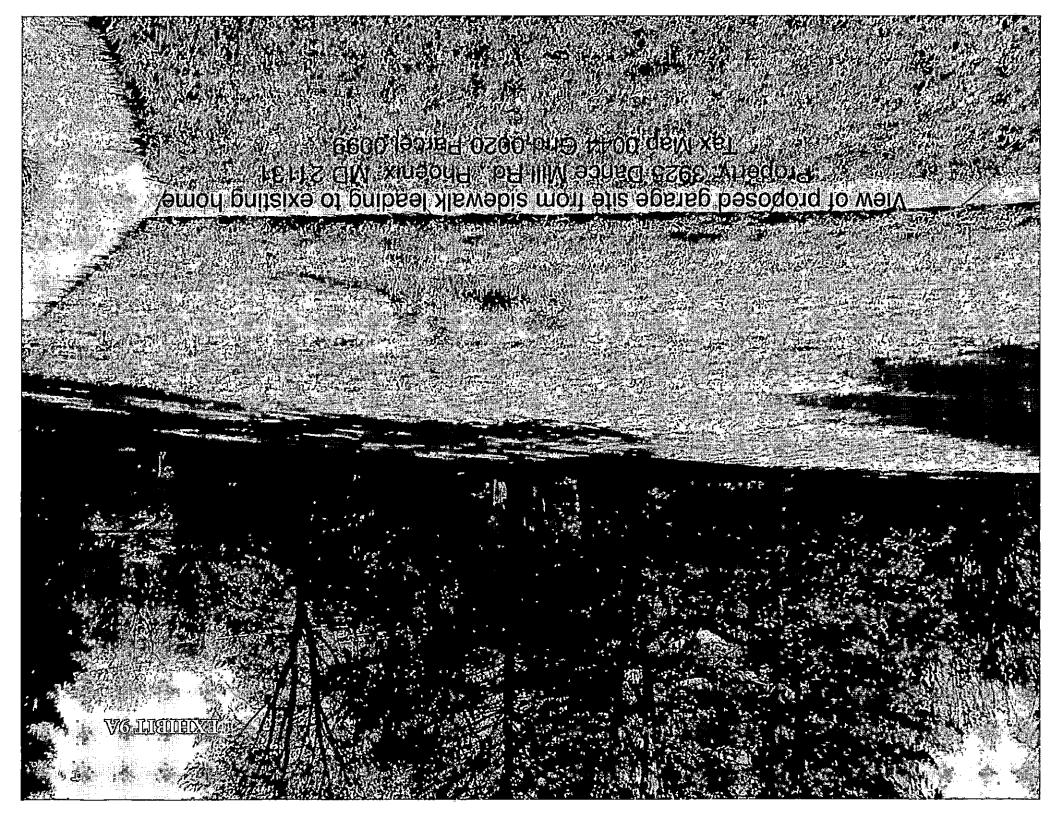


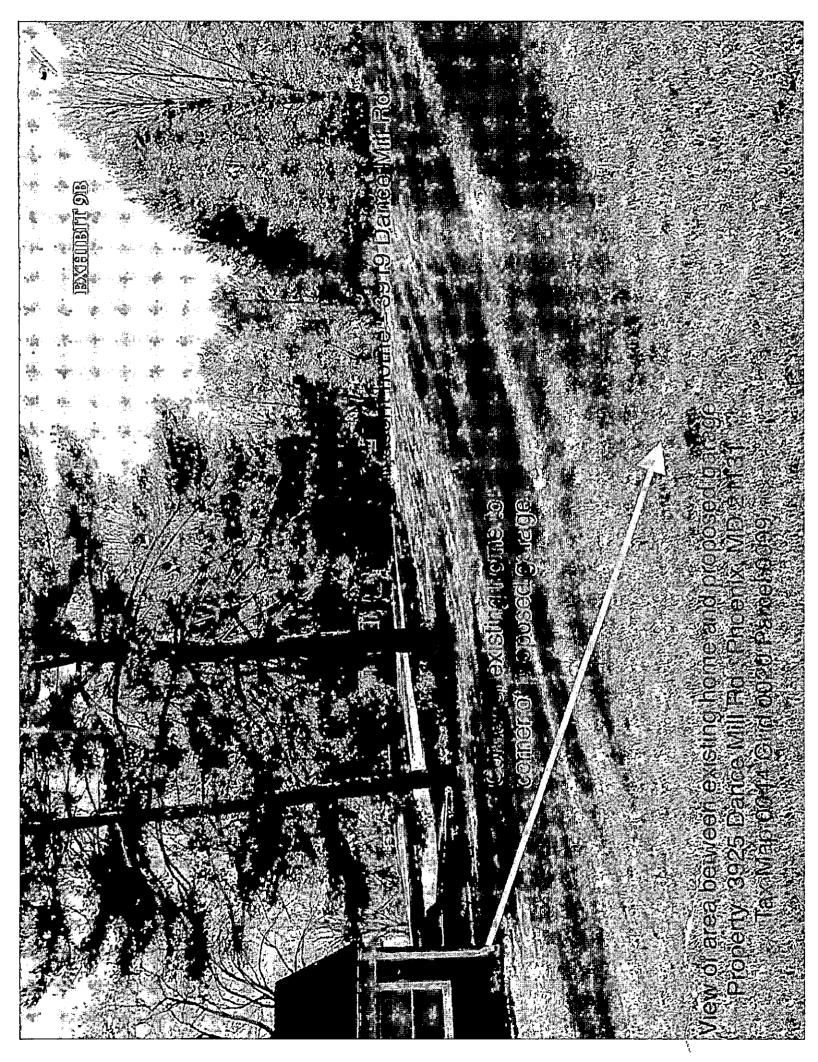
GARAGE/BASEMENT PLAN
