OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings ("OAH") as a Petition for Administrative Variance filed by the legal owners of the property, David A. Katz and Rebecca A. Leaf ("Petitioners"). The Petitioners are requesting Variance relief from the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("BCZR") § 1B01.2.C.1.b to permit a rear yard deck with a rear setback of 19 ft. in lieu of the required 22.5 ft. The subject property and requested relief is more fully depicted on the site plan that was marked and accepted into evidence as Petitioners' Exhibit 1.

The Zoning Advisory Committee ("ZAC") comments were received and are made part of the record of this case. There were no adverse ZAC comments submitted by any of the County reviewing agencies.

The Petitioners having filed a Petition for Administrative Variance and the subject property having been posted on August 9, 2020, and there being no request for a public hearing, a decision shall be rendered based upon the documentation presented.

The Petitioners have filed the supporting affidavits as required by § 32-3-303 of the Baltimore County Code ("BCC"). Based upon the information available, there is no evidence in the file to indicate that the requested variance would adversely affect the health, safety or general welfare of the public and should therefore be granted. Judge, the information, photographs, and affidavits submitted provide sufficient facts that comply with the requirements of § 307.1 of the BCZR. Furthermore, strict compliance with the BCZR would result in practical difficulty and/or unreasonable hardship upon the Petitioners.

Pursuant to the posting of the property and the provisions of both the BCC and the BCZR, and for the reasons given above, the requested variance should be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, this <u>27th</u> day of August, 2020, by the Administrative Law Judge for Baltimore County, that the Petition for Variance relief from BCZR § 1B01.2.C.1.b to permit a rear yard deck with a rear setback of 19 ft. in lieu of the required 22.5 ft., be and is hereby GRANTED.

The relief granted herein shall be subject to the following:

 Petitioners may apply for their appropriate permits and be granted same upon receipt of this Order; however, Petitioners are hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at their own risk until such time as the 30-day appellate process from this Order has expired. If, for whatever reason, this Order is reversed, Petitioners would be required to return, and be responsible for returning, said property to its original condition.

Any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

Baltimore County Zoning Review Board:

We are petitioning for a variance in order to build a small screened-in deck behind our home. Our plan requires a 4.5-foot variance.

Under Baltimore Code, the rear setback on our property (D2) is 30 feet, and we have exactly 30 feet from the rear of our home to the end of our property line. As a result, we're very limited in our ability to build a deck on our property – we only have 7.5 feet to build on.

Strict compliance with the BCZR would result in "undue hardship" as defined in *Anderson v. Bd. of Appeals, Town of Chesapeake Beach*, 22 Md. App. 28 for the following reasons:

- 1. A 7.5-foot deck is extremely small and would limit the use and enjoyment of our property. By way of example, a standard lounge chair is 7-feet long, so would not easily fit on our deck without a variance. Most contractors do not recommend building a deck shorter than 12 feet. We would like to enjoy the deck by making it large enough to fit two lounge chairs, a grill, and a small table and chairs.
- 2. Our home is designed with a sliding glass door off our kitchen, leading to the backyard. But the door is about 10 feet off the ground. Without the ability to build a deck off this kitchen door, we lose a means of egress from the home, which was clearly designed to exist there (both for everyday use and for emergencies). Without a variance that allows for enough usable space to build a deck behind the home, we lose the ability to access our backyard from the main level of our home. Instead, we have to either go through the basement or leave through the front door and walk around. Most homeowners have easy access to their backyards, so without a variance, we are limited in the functionality and use of our property in ways other homeowners are not.
- 3. Our backyard faces open land where deer graze morning and night. The view is beautiful and is part of the reason we chose to purchase in this community. We hope to be able to enjoy this view and the outdoors from our deck.
- 4. Due to COVID-19, we are maximizing our use of outdoor space. We have elderly parents and individuals in our family who are high-risk for contracting the virus, and we are taking all precautions by being in open-air spaces with them.
- 5. We were one of the last to purchase a home in our community and the few remaining lots were small. Most other lots in our community are large enough that those homeowners did not have to apply for variances to build their decks. Thus, they have been able to enhance their property both aesthetically and in value by adding decks that are large enough to be functional. If we are denied the variance, we would not be able to build a comparable deck to others in our community.

We appreciate the County's consideration.
