OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings ("OAH") as a Petition for Special Hearing filed by William and Beatrice Rueter, and Johnathon and Elizabeth Brett, legal owners and Petitioners ("Petitioners") for the property at 918 Greenspring Valley Road, Lutherville (the "Property"). The Special Hearing was filed pursuant to the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("BCZR"), §104.1 and §500.7 to affirm that three (3) existing dwellings located on a single 8.476 acre parcel of land are non-conforming.

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, a public WebEx hearing was conducted virtually in lieu of an in-person hearing. The Petition was properly advertised and posted. Johnathon and Elizabeth Brett appeared in support of the Petition along with Bruce E. Doak, licensed surveyor, with Bruce E. Doak Consulting who prepared and sealed a site plan (the "Site Plan"). (Pet. Ex. 1).

Zoning Advisory Committee ("ZAC") comments were received from the Department of Planning ("DOP"), the Department of Environmental Protection and Sustainability ("DEPS") and the Development Plan Review ("DPR") which agencies did not oppose the requested relief.

FACTS AND EVIDENCE

Mr. Doak proffered the merits of the case by way of the Petitioners' exhibits. The Petitioners purchased the Property on April 5, 2021. (Pet. Ex.2). An aerial photograph of the

current improvements was provided which show the 14,080 sf 3-story, single family home (addressed as 918) (the "Main Home"); a 2-story detached garage in the front yard (the "Main Garage") (addressed as 926); and a 2,000 sf, 2-story single family home with its own detached garage (addressed as 924) (the "Gate House"). (Pet. Exs. 2, 3). Notwithstanding 3-separate addresses, the only dwelling that is listed with SDAT is the Main House.

The Property is 8.47 acres +/- and is currently accessed via two (2) separate, private driveways. (Pet. Ex. 1). Apparently, the Property was already subdivided into 2 lots under BCZR, §1A01.3.B.1 (lots with gross acreage between 2-100 acres may only be subdivided into 2 lots) to create the lot for 930 Greenspring Valley Rd. That adjacent property is improved with a house, and shares one of the private driveways with the Property (the "Shared Driveway"). As such, subdividing the Property again is not an option. The Gate House faces the Shared Driveway which then branches off to access the Main House/Main Garage, and then to 930 Greenspring Valley Rd. (Pet. Ex. 1, 3). A second private driveway off Greenspring Valley Rd. traverses past the rear side of the Gate House and then to the Main House/Main Garage (the "Estate Entrance Driveway"). (Id.).

Street view photographs of all 3 structures were provided with a key sheet showing the location of each. (Pet. Ex. 4A-4H). The Main Garage is a 3-car garage with a brick façade matching the Main Home. (Pet. Exs. 4D-4F). Photographs of the Gate House and its detached garage also show brick façades. (Pet. Exs. 4G, 4H). Additionally, several newspaper clippings from various years were provided. (Pet. Ex6).

Petitioners testified that they purchased the Property by way of mortgage and when they attempted to refinance or obtain another mortgage, they were informed that the Main Garage and Gate House are illegal under BCZR, §1A01.3.B.4 and need to be approved as non-conforming.

The proffered argument was that since the Main House was constructed on or about 1923 (SDAT) (otherwise known as "Brandonwood Estate"), the Main Garage and Gate House must have also been constructed on or about 1923. Petitioner characterized the Main Garage as a 'carriage house' and said it was 'reasonable to assume' that an apartment on the first floor of the Main Garage had been used by a caretaker since 1939. They added that they had read the history of the Property and that this was in evidence.

Dale Lucas, the owner of 913 Greenspring Valley Rd., initially testified that in 1965, when a heavy snow storm broke off a section of pine trees on the Property, he brought a chain saw to help break up the branches. In 1965, he recalled being inside of a first floor apartment in the Main Garage where a caretaker had been living. He also testified that he had been hired by the former owners of the Property on a regular basis to remove snow and that all 3 structures were used as dwellings. Mr. Lucas and Carol Lucas executed an Affidavit wherein they certify and affirm that all 3 structures have been used as dwelling units since prior to 1965 until the present. (Pet. Ex. 5). With regard to the Gate House, Mr. Lucas testified that the mother of the prior owner lived in the Gate House.

The present zoning for the Property is Resource Conservation – Agricultural (RC 2) which permits only 1 dwelling per lot. (BCZR, §1A01.3.B.4). Mr. Doak stated that the zoning of the Property in 1945 was RDP (Rural-Planning Deferred), and remained RDP in 1955 when the BCZR was changed. He added that the RDP zone permitted 3 separate dwelling units on this Property. However, at the request of the undersigned, the Office of Zoning (OZR) confirmed that the zoning for this Property between 1945-1955 was 'A' Residence Zone ('Cottage') which permitted by right only one (1) detached dwelling occupied by one (1) family:

11. Dwelling, Single-Family: A detached dwelling arranged

or used for occupancy by one family.

12. <u>Dwelling: Two-Family</u>: A detached dwelling arranged or used for occupancy by not more than two families as separate housekeeping units, and with not more than one entrance on any side. Such a dwelling shall have one housekeeping unit over the other.

In 1955, when the BCZR was changed, OZR confirmed that the 'A' Residence Zone for this Property was changed to an 'R-40' Zone which remained in place for the years spanning 1955-1970. As with the 'A' Residence Zone, the R-40 Zone only permitted one (1) detached dwelling occupied by one (1) family by right as follows:

R. 40 Zone – Residence, One-Family
Section 200- USE REGULATIONS
The following uses only are permitted:
200.1 –One-family detached dwellings.

² The definition of One-Family Dwelling in the R.40 Zone is as follows:

Dwelling, One-Family: A detached building arranged or used for occupancy by one family.

¹ BCZR, Section II – Zones enacting in 1945 states:

[&]quot;For the purposes of these regulations, the County is hereby divided into Seven (7) Zones as follows:

[&]quot;A" Residence Zone - (Cottage)

[&]quot;B" Residence Zone – (Semi-detached)

[&]quot;C" Residence Zone - (Apartment)

[&]quot;D" Residence Zone - (Group)

[&]quot;E" Residence Zone - Commercial Zone

[&]quot;F" Residence Zone - Light Industrial Zone

[&]quot;G" Residence Zone - Heavy Industrial Zone

² BCZR was amended in 1955 replacing the A-G zoning classification of the 1945 BCZR with the following set of classifications:

[&]quot;R.40" Zone - Residence, one-family (1 acre)

[&]quot;R.20" Zone - Residence, one-family (0.5 acre)

[&]quot;R.10" Zone - Residence, one-family (0.25 acre)

[&]quot;R.6" Zone - Residence, one and two-family

[&]quot;R.G" Zone - Residence, group house

[&]quot;R.A." Zone - Residence, apartment

The OZR provided Zoning Maps which confirmed that it was not until 1971, and continuing through 1975, that the Property was zoned "RDP" (Rural-Deferred-Planning). And yet, in the RDP Zone, only one (1) detached dwelling occupied by one (1) family by right was permitted as follows:

1A00.2 - Use Regulations. [Bill No. 100, 1970]

A. Uses Permitted as of Right. The following uses, only, are permitted as of right in R.D.P. zones:

* * * *

2. One-family detached dwellings.

Finally, in 1976, when the Resource Conservation Zone-Agricultural (RC2) was created, it again permitted only one principal dwelling per lot, and has been applied to the Property since that time.

SPECIAL HEARING

A hearing to request special zoning relief is proper under BCZR, §500.7 as follows:

The said Zoning Commissioner shall have the power to conduct such other hearings and pass such orders thereon as shall, in his discretion, be necessary for the proper enforcement of all zoning regulations, subject to the right of appeal to the County Board of Appeals as hereinafter provided. The power given hereunder shall include the right of any interested person to petition the Zoning Commissioner for a public hearing after advertisement and notice to determine the existence of any purported nonconforming use on any premises or to determine any rights whatsoever of such person in any property in Baltimore County insofar as they are affected by these regulations.

"A request for special hearing is, in legal effect, a request for a declaratory judgment." *Antwerpen v. Baltimore County*, 163 Md. App. 194, 877 A.2d 1166, 1175 (2005). And, "the administrative practice in Baltimore County has been to determine whether the proposed Special Hearing would be consistent with the spirit and intent of the regulations." *Kiesling v. Long*, Unreported Opinion, No. 1485, Md. App. (Sept. Term 2016).

A valid and lawful nonconforming use is established if the owner can demonstrate that before and at the time of the adoption of a new zoning classification/ordinance, the property was being used in a lawful manner that, by later legislation, became non-permitted. Trip Assoc., Inc. v. Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, 392 Md. 563, 569 (2006). In Baltimore County, the law regarding nonconforming uses is set forth in BCZR, §104.1 and provides:

A nonconforming use (as defined in Section 101) may continue except as otherwise specifically provided in these regulations, provided that upon any change from such nonconforming use to any other use whatsoever or any abandonment or discontinuance of such nonconforming use for a period of one year or more, the right to continue or resume such nonconforming use shall terminate.

The definition of non-conforming use in BCZR, §101.1 is:

NONCONFORMING USE — A legal use that does not conform to a use regulation for the zone in which it is located or to a special regulation applicable to such a use. A specifically named use described by the adjective "nonconforming" is a nonconforming use.

The issue is not the Main House as that qualified as the one (1) permitted dwelling which existed prior to 1945. The Main House does not need affirmation as a nonconforming use even after 1945 and that request will be dismissed as moot. As to the Main Garage and Gate House, evidence was missing as to whether either or both were used as non-conforming dwellings prior to, and after, 1945. The definition of nonconforming use in BCZR, §101.1 makes clear, the use of the structures as 'non-conforming' dwellings must be legal after 1945 up through 1976 when the RC2 zone prohibited more than one (1) principal dwelling. Unfortunately, contrary to the Petitioners' assertion that the BCZR permitted 3 dwelling units on this Property prior to the creation of the RC2 Zone in 1976, only one (1) detached dwelling occupied by one (1) family was permitted by right in each of the prior zones ('A' Residence; R-40 Zone; RDP Zone) beginning in

1945 up to 1976. Thus, to the extent that either of the dwelling uses in those structures began after 1945, they were illegal at their inception. *Arundel Corp. v. Board of Zoning Appeals of Howard County*, 255 Md. 78 (1969) (a use cannot be non-conforming if it was not a legally permitted use at the time the regulation was enacted). (See also *In the Matter of Richard Niehaus*, CBA-14-015-SPHA; *In The Matter of Irvin M. Baddock, Sahbi Hookah, Inc.*, Case No.: 16-089-SPH; *aff'd*, Circuit Court for Baltimore County, Case No.: 03-C-17-000957 (2017); Pet. Writ. Cert., denied, 463 Md. 545, 206 A.2d 325 (2019)).

Assuming arguendo that the prior zoning classifications permitted more than one (1) dwelling unit on the Property after 1945 and through 1976 as Petitioners contend, the burden of proof is on the Petitioner to convincingly establish nonconforming use status for the Main Garage and Gate House (separately and individually) from the first date of use as a dwelling, and then chronologically for each year up to the present. Proof of nonconforming use status for an older property can be challenging where persuasive evidence is missing and a property has changed owners. Nonconforming uses are disfavored under the law. County Council of Prince George's County v. E.L. Gardner, Inc., 293 Md. 259, 443 A.2d 114 (1982).

While the evidence did not establish a date of construction for the Main Garage, the 1955-1970 BCZR Zoning Map provided by OZR for this Property does show the Main Garage was in existence at that time. However, the existence of the Main Garage on the Zoning Map does not prove that it was continuously and uninterrupted used as a dwelling prior to 1945, or that the use continued uninterruptedly, without abandonment or discontinuance, for a period of one year or more, from 1945 up to the present. The testimony and evidence was scant and speculative. Mr. Lucas testified that his earliest memory was that, in 1965, he recalled personally observing a caretaker occupying a first floor apartment in the Main Garage. His Affidavit also states that 1965

was the first time he had "enter[ed] the dwellings at Brandonwood..... at which time it was clear they had been in use for some time." (Pet. Ex. 5). Mr. Lucas' recollections while performing snow plow services over the years at the Property does not rise to the level of proof that is required. Moreover, I find the Affidavit contains general and unsubstantiated assertions about the "dwellings" and their use, and is insufficient to prove the Main Garage's use as a dwelling as required under BCZR §104.1.

Even more problematic for the Petitioners is the alleged use of the Gate House as a dwelling. No evidence was produced as to the date of its construction, much less any evidence as to the first date that the Gate House was used as a dwelling. The testimony was that the mother of the prior owners resided there, but no information was provided as to any time periods.

In Case No.: 07-274-A, the former owners of the Property, along with architect Donald Huber, did obtain an uncontested variance to construct a detached garage in the front yard of the Gate House near the Shared Driveway. (Pet. Ex. 4G). The site plan submitted in the 2007 case (the "2007 Site Plan") shows the Gate House and proposed detached garage location. The 2007 Site Plan also showed a *proposed* driveway connection to the Estate Entrance Driveway. Notably, the Main Garage is identified in both the Opinion and Order as well as the 2007 Site Plan only as: a "1 Story Brick Garage with a Loft"; it was not labeled as an apartment. For unexplained reasons, the nonconforming use status for neither the Gate House, nor the Main Garage, was addressed in the Opinion and Order. I will not infer, from the 2007 Case, that the approved variance legitimizes the use of the Gate House as a dwelling under BCZR, §104.1.

While it is undisputed that the Gate House existed in the 2007 case, the evidence was entirely lacking on its existence or use as a dwelling prior to 2007. Remarkably, the 1955-1970 Baltimore County Zoning Maps, the 1971-1975 Zoning Maps, as well as the 1976-2022 Zoning

Maps provided by OZR, do not show any building for the Gate House, much less even a typically-sized "gate house" that might be found at the entrance to an estate. Again, the Gate House is not listed with SDAT as a separate taxable dwelling (which Petitioners attribute the inability to further subdivide). Assuming that a typical "gate house" was, at some point, located at the Estate Entrance Driveway, there was no evidence as its removal, or its conversion into a dwelling. When compared to the testimony and Affidavit provided here, the foregoing Zoning Maps do not corroborate that evidence. I cannot glean from newspaper clippings or real estate listings, or what the Petitioners may have read about the Property's history, any substantive information required to prove nonconforming use status for the Gate House.

Accordingly, as with the Main Garage, I find that the Petitioners have failed to meet the burden of proof required to establish that the Gate House was used as dwelling prior to, and after 1945, or that it has continued uninterruptedly and continuously, without abandonment or interruption, for a period of 1 year of more, up to the present. For the reasons set forth herein, I also find that the Petition for Special Hearing is not consistent with the spirit and intent of the BCZR and as such, must be denied.

THEREFORE, ORDERED this <u>14th</u> day of February, 2022 by this Administrative Law Judge that the Petition for Special Hearing pursuant to the BCZR, §104.1 and §500.7 to affirm that the Main House has been used as an existing dwelling is hereby **DISMISSED AND MOOT** for the reasons set forth herein; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED, that the Petition for Special Hearing to affirm that the Main Garage and Gate House (as those structures are defined herein) located on a single 8.476 acre parcel of land are non-conforming be, and they are each hereby, **DENIED**.

Any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

William and Beatrice Rueter, and Johnathon and Elizabeth Brett filed a petition for special hearing '... to affirm three existing dwellings located on a single 8.476 acre parcel of land as nonconforming." The three designated dwellings include the main home, the main garage apartment, and a gate house dwelling. The petition comes under Baltimore County Zoning Regulation (BCZR) Sec. 500.7. It is effectively a petition for declaratory judgment. Antwerpen v. Baltimore County 163 Md. App. 194, 209 (2005).

The property is located at 918 Greenspring Valley Road and is zoned R.C. 2, Agricultural. The R.C. 2 Zone has a limit of one principal dwelling per lot. BCZR Sec. 1A01.3.B.4.

* * *

This letter provides a sketch of anticipated issues and relevant documents. We hope the County Board of Appeals (CBA) finds this helpful. Among other things, it should facilitate a streamlined opening statement and review of exhibits. This letter also alerts Petitioners to our office's baseline position and encapsulates our perspective.

Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Maureen E. Murphy conducted a public hearing and subsequently issued her opinion and order denying the nonconforming use petition on February 14, 2022. The Rueters and Bretts filed an appeal. The appeal is *de novo* pursuant to County Charter Section 604 and County Code Sec. 32-3-401.

The relevant nonconforming use law includes the definition of nonconforming use and pertinent controls. BCZR Secs. 101.1, 104.1. Our office reviews nonconforming use cases, including property location and characteristics, zoning history, background facts, and applicable law. This shapes a baseline for analysis.

Consistent with BCZR Sec. 104.1, Petitioner must prove strictly a continuous (without one-year interruption) legal nonconforming use back to the relevant legal baseline, discussed below. They must also prove there has been no change to such nonconforming use.

The Property: The attachments to this letter begin with ADC Map 50. The My Neighborhood Map confirms the zone is R.C. 2.

As ALJ Murphy described the situation, aerial and ground level photograph exhibits show a 14,080sf 3-story single family home (the "main" dwelling); a 2-story detached garage in the front yard; and a 2-story single family home with its own detached garage (with a 924 address, but apparently no separate SDAT Data.).

The attached SDAT Real Property Data refer to just the main single-family dwelling, built in 1923. The dimensions are as described above, along with additional details. The current owners acquired the property by deed dated September 25, 2020. Book 44451, Pages 342-57.

The attached 2020 deed includes an affidavit that the property will be the purchasers' principal residence for at least 7 months of the year following the conveyance. There is no reference to any apartment or multiple dwellings. The deed also refers to a use in common drive with the owners of the 2.8 parcel lying northwest. This is the 930 Greenspring Valley Road property, currently owned by Kevin and Desiree Plank., with a 14,827sf dwelling. We have not seen anything in the earlier deed history to describe multiple dwellings or apartments.

* * *

Zoning History. There is no dispute about zoning history back to January 2, 1945, the inaugural BCZR date. Here is what we found, based on the attached maps:

January 2, 1945: "A" Residence Zone. The 1945 Regulations are in Appendix K of the current BCZR. As we read Section III, "A" Residence Zone, and Section I, Definitions, Subsection 12, "Dwelling, Two-Family," there were permitted effectively duplex dwellings, "one housekeeping unit over the other."

March 30, 1955: R.40 Zone, Residence, One and Two-Family. This zone allowed for "One-family detached dwellings," with a minimum lot area of 40,000 square feet. BCZR 200.1; 202.1.

March 24, 1971-76: R.D.P. Zone. This also permitted "One-family detached dwellings," with a minimum lot acreage of 1-acre. BCZR Secs. 1A00.2.A.2; 1A00.3.B.1.

1976-present: We attach the 1976 and 2020 (My Neighborhood) maps for the sake of economy. There was no change in the years between.

According to ALJ Murphy's opinion, Petitioners contended the 1945-76 Zones ("A" Residence, R.40, and R.D.P.) permitted three dwellings on a single lot. This office concurs with ALJ Murphy's opinion that these various zones do not allow apartments or multiple dwellings on a single lot. Pages 6-7. So it looks like the zoning baseline to demonstrate a nonconforming use is 1945.

ALJ Murphy also reviewed the evidence and added Petitioners did not meet their burden to show continuous use of each dwelling each year from 1976 to date. Page 7.

* * *

Documents: We always ask for documentary history. So far, we have not seen documentary exhibits or proof to show a past triple dwelling and/or apartment use.

Overview and Case Law: This is another nonconforming use case where purchasers must prove nonconforming uses going back many decades. The attached County Board of Appeals (CBA) decision in the <u>Panchigar</u> case, 248 Clyde Avenue in Lansdowne is an example. Case No. 2020-207-SPH (July 15, 2021). The CBA denied the petition to establish a nonconforming apartment use in the garage of a single-family dwelling. Their decision effectively affirmed another decision by ALJ Maureen E. Murphy dated December 22, 2020.

It is difficult to prove a nonconforming use in such cases. The burden of proof is strict. The law intends nonconforming uses to disappear over time even if they ever existed. See <u>Prince George's County v. E.L. Gardner</u> 293 Md. 259 (1982); <u>Purich v.</u>

<u>Draper Properties</u> 395 Md. 694 (2006). The CBA addressed the subject extensively in <u>In the Matter of William Lagna</u> CBA Case No. 2012-239-SPH (2013), A. Belt, Chair, M. Murphy, W. Grier); affirmed, Circuit Court No. 03-C-13—01192 (Ballou-Watts, J.); CSA 2016 WL 327029 (2016), (Woodward, Arthur, Zarnoch, JJ.).

* * *

Lately, the majority of nonconforming use petitions tend to involve requests for multiple dwellings and/or apartments in residential zones, often filed by recent purchasers. The subject property has gone through a number of changes of ownership prior to Petitioners' 2020 acquisition. Ideally, property owners who believe they have nonconforming uses should file their petition as soon as reasonably possible after the relevant zoning legislation. If they do not, later purchasers are at a disadvantage.

The BCZR Sec. 500.7 special hearing process has been available since the 1955 BCZR revision. Page 68. The 1945 BCZR included a general authority for the then Zoning Commissioner to hold hearings. Page 19, Para. 8. The legislative comprehensive zoning map process has always included substantial public notice and hearings.

OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings ("OAH") as a Petition for Special Hearing filed by William and Beatrice Rueter, and Johnathon and Elizabeth Brett, legal owners and Petitioners ("Petitioners") for the property at 918 Greenspring Valley Road, Lutherville (the "Property"). The Special Hearing was filed pursuant to the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("BCZR"), §104.1 and §500.7 to affirm that three (3) existing dwellings located on a single 8.476 acre parcel of land are non-conforming.

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, a public WebEx hearing was conducted virtually in lieu of an in-person hearing. The Petition was properly advertised and posted. Johnathon and Elizabeth Brett appeared in support of the Petition along with Bruce E. Doak, licensed surveyor, with Bruce E. Doak Consulting who prepared and sealed a site plan (the "Site Plan"). (Pet. Ex. 1).

Zoning Advisory Committee ("ZAC") comments were received from the Department of Planning ("DOP"), the Department of Environmental Protection and Sustainability ("DEPS") and the Development Plan Review ("DPR") which agencies did not oppose the requested relief.

FACTS AND EVIDENCE

Mr. Doak proffered the merits of the case by way of the Petitioners' exhibits. The Petitioners purchased the Property on April 5, 2021. (Pet. Ex.2). An aerial photograph of the DROBER RECEIVED FOR FILING

current improvements was provided which show the 14,080 sf 3-story, single family home (addressed as 918) (the "Main Home"); a 2-story detached garage in the front yard (the "Main Garage") (addressed as 926); and a 2,000 sf, 2-story single family home with its own detached garage (addressed as 924) (the "Gate House"). (Pet. Exs. 2, 3). Notwithstanding 3-separate addresses, the only dwelling that is listed with SDAT is the Main House.

The Property is 8.47 acres +/- and is currently accessed via two (2) separate, private driveways. (Pet. Ex. 1). Apparently, the Property was already subdivided into 2 lots under BCZR, §1A01.3.B.1 (lots with gross acreage between 2-100 acres may only be subdivided into 2 lots) to create the lot for 930 Greenspring Valley Rd. That adjacent property is improved with a house, and shares one of the private driveways with the Property (the "Shared Driveway"). As such, subdividing the Property again is not an option. The Gate House faces the Shared Driveway which then branches off to access the Main House/Main Garage, and then to 930 Greenspring Valley Rd. (Pet. Ex. 1, 3). A second private driveway off Greenspring Valley Rd. traverses past the rear side of the Gate House and then to the Main House/Main Garage (the "Estate Entrance Driveway"). (Id.).

Street view photographs of all 3 structures were provided with a key sheet showing the location of each. (Pet. Ex. 4A-4H). The Main Garage is a 3-car garage with a brick façade matching the Main Home. (Pet. Exs. 4D-4F). Photographs of the Gate House and its detached garage also show brick façades. (Pet. Exs. 4G, 4H). Additionally, several newspaper clippings from various years were provided. (Pet. Ex6).

Petitioners testified that they purchased the Property by way of mortgage and when they attempted to refinance or obtain another mortgage, they were informed that the Main Garage and Gate House are illegal under BCZR, §1A01.3.B.4 and need to be approved as non-conforming.

The proffered argument was that since the Main House was constructed on or about 1923 (SDAT) (otherwise known as "Brandonwood Estate"), the Main Garage and Gate House must have also been constructed on or about 1923. Petitioner characterized the Main Garage as a 'carriage house' and said it was 'reasonable to assume' that an apartment on the first floor of the Main Garage had been used by a caretaker since 1939. They added that they had read the history of the Property and that this was in evidence.

Dale Lucas, the owner of 913 Greenspring Valley Rd., initially testified that in 1965, when a heavy snow storm broke off a section of pine trees on the Property, he brought a chain saw to help break up the branches. In 1965, he recalled being inside of a first floor apartment in the Main Garage where a caretaker had been living. He also testified that he had been hired by the former owners of the Property on a regular basis to remove snow and that all 3 structures were used as dwellings. Mr. Lucas and Carol Lucas executed an Affidavit wherein they certify and affirm that all 3 structures have been used as dwelling units since prior to 1965 until the present. (Pet. Ex. 5). With regard to the Gate House, Mr. Lucas testified that the mother of the prior owner lived in the Gate House.

The present zoning for the Property is Resource Conservation – Agricultural (RC 2) which permits only 1 dwelling per lot. (BCZR, §1A01.3.B.4). Mr. Doak stated that the zoning of the Property in 1945 was RDP (Rural-Planning Deferred), and remained RDP in 1955 when the BCZR was changed. He added that the RDP zone permitted 3 separate dwelling units on this Property. However, at the request of the undersigned, the Office of Zoning (OZR) confirmed that the zoning for this Property between 1945-1955 was 'A' Residence Zone ('Cottage') which permitted by right only one (1) detached dwelling occupied by one (1) family:

11. Dwelling, Single-Family: A detached dwelling arranged

By 2000

or used for occupancy by one family.

12. <u>Dwelling: Two-Family</u>: A detached dwelling arranged or used for occupancy by not more than two families as separate housekeeping units, and with not more than one entrance on any side. Such a dwelling shall have one housekeeping unit over the other.

In 1955, when the BCZR was changed, OZR confirmed that the 'A' Residence Zone for this Property was changed to an 'R-40' Zone which remained in place for the years spanning 1955-1970. As with the 'A' Residence Zone, the R-40 Zone only permitted one (1) detached dwelling occupied by one (1) family by right as follows:

R. 40 Zone – Residence, One-Family
Section 200- USE REGULATIONS
The following uses only are permitted:
200.1 –One-family detached dwellings.

² The definition of One-Family Dwelling in the R.40 Zone is as follows:

Dwelling, One-Family: A detached building arranged or used for occupancy by one family.

¹ BCZR, Section II – Zones enacting in 1945 states:

[&]quot;For the purposes of these regulations, the County is hereby divided into Seven (7) Zones as follows:

[&]quot;A" Residence Zone - (Cottage)

[&]quot;C" Residence Zone - (Apartment)

[&]quot;D" Residence Zone - (Group)

[&]quot;E" Residence Zone - Commercial Zone

² BCZR was amended in 1955 replacing the A-G zoning classification of the 1945 BCZR with the following set of classifications:

[&]quot;R.10" Zone - Residence, one-family (0.25 acre)

The OZR provided Zoning Maps which confirmed that it was not until 1971, and continuing through 1975, that the Property was zoned "RDP" (Rural-Deferred-Planning). And yet, in the RDP Zone, only one (1) detached dwelling occupied by one (1) family by right was permitted as follows:

1A00.2 – Use Regulations. [Bill No. 100, 1970]

A. Uses Permitted as of Right. The following uses, only, are permitted as of right in R.D.P. zones:

* * * *

2. One-family detached dwellings.

Finally, in 1976, when the Resource Conservation Zone- Agricultural (RC2) was created, it again permitted only one principal dwelling per lot, and has been applied to the Property since that time.

SPECIAL HEARING

A hearing to request special zoning relief is proper under BCZR, §500.7 as follows:

The said Zoning Commissioner shall have the power to conduct such other hearings and pass such orders thereon as shall, in his discretion, be necessary for the proper enforcement of all zoning regulations, subject to the right of appeal to the County Board of Appeals as hereinafter provided. The power given hereunder shall include the right of any interested person to petition the Zoning Commissioner for a public hearing after advertisement and notice to determine the existence of any purported nonconforming use on any premises or to determine any rights whatsoever of such person in any property in Baltimore County insofar as they are affected by these regulations.

"A request for special hearing is, in legal effect, a request for a declaratory judgment." *Antwerpen v. Baltimore County*, 163 Md. App. 194, 877 A.2d 1166, 1175 (2005). And, "the administrative practice in Baltimore County has been to determine whether the proposed Special Hearing would be consistent with the spirit and intent of the regulations." *Kiesling v. Long*, Unreported Opinion, No. 1485, Md. App. (Sept. Term 2016).

A valid and lawful nonconforming use is established if the owner can demonstrate that before and at the time of the adoption of a new zoning classification/ordinance, the property was being used in a lawful manner that, by later legislation, became non-permitted. Trip Assoc., Inc. v. Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, 392 Md. 563, 569 (2006). In Baltimore County, the law regarding nonconforming uses is set forth in BCZR, §104.1 and provides:

A nonconforming use (as defined in Section 101) may continue except as otherwise specifically provided in these regulations, provided that upon any change from such nonconforming use to any other use whatsoever or any abandonment or discontinuance of such nonconforming use for a period of one year or more, the right to continue or resume such nonconforming use shall terminate.

The definition of non-conforming use in BCZR, §101.1 is:

NONCONFORMING USE — A legal use that does not conform to a use regulation for the zone in which it is located or to a special regulation applicable to such a use. A specifically named use described by the adjective "nonconforming" is a nonconforming use.

The issue is not the Main House as that qualified as the one (1) permitted dwelling which existed prior to 1945. The Main House does not need affirmation as a nonconforming use even after 1945 and that request will be dismissed as moot. As to the Main Garage and Gate House, evidence was missing as to whether either or both were used as non-conforming dwellings prior to, and after, 1945. The definition of nonconforming use in BCZR, §101.1 makes clear, the use of the structures as 'non-conforming' dwellings must be legal after 1945 up through 1976 when the RC2 zone prohibited more than one (1) principal dwelling. Unfortunately, contrary to the Petitioners' assertion that the BCZR permitted 3 dwelling units on this Property prior to the creation of the RC2 Zone in 1976, only one (1) detached dwelling occupied by one (1) family was permitted by right in each of the prior zones ('A' Residence; R-40 Zone; RDP Zone) beginning in

1945 up to 1976. Thus, to the extent that either of the dwelling uses in those structures began after 1945, they were illegal at their inception. *Arundel Corp. v. Board of Zoning Appeals of Howard County*, 255 Md. 78 (1969) (a use cannot be non-conforming if it was not a legally permitted use at the time the regulation was enacted). (See also *In the Matter of Richard Niehaus*, CBA-14-015-SPHA; *In The Matter of Irvin M. Baddock, Sahbi Hookah, Inc.*, Case No.: 16-089-SPH; *aff'd*, Circuit Court for Baltimore County, Case No.: 03-C-17-000957 (2017); Pet. Writ. Cert., denied, 463 Md. 545, 206 A.2d 325 (2019)).

Assuming *arguendo* that the prior zoning classifications permitted more than one (1) dwelling unit on the Property after 1945 and through 1976 as Petitioners contend, the burden of proof is on the Petitioner to convincingly establish nonconforming use status for the Main Garage and Gate House (separately and individually) from the first date of use as a dwelling, and then chronologically for each year up to the present. Proof of nonconforming use status for an older property can be challenging where persuasive evidence is missing and a property has changed owners. Nonconforming uses are disfavored under the law. *County Council of Prince George's County v. E.L. Gardner, Inc.*, 293 Md. 259, 443 A.2d 114 (1982).

While the evidence did not establish a date of construction for the Main Garage, the 19551970 BCZR Zoning Map provided by OZR for this Property does show the Main Garage was in
existence at that time. However, the existence of the Main Garage on the Zoning Map does not
prove that it was continuously and uninterrupted used as a dwelling prior to 1945, or that the use
continued uninterruptedly, without abandonment or discontinuance, for a period of one year or
more, from 1945 up to the present. The testimony and evidence was scant and speculative. Mr.
Lucas testified that his earliest memory was that, in 1965, he recalled personally observing a
caretaker occupying a first floor apartment in the Main Garage. His Affidavit also states that 1965

was the first time he had "enter[ed] the dwellings at Brandonwood..... at which time it was clear they had been in use for some time." (Pet. Ex. 5). Mr. Lucas' recollections while performing snow plow services over the years at the Property does not rise to the level of proof that is required. Moreover, I find the Affidavit contains general and unsubstantiated assertions about the "dwellings" and their use, and is insufficient to prove the Main Garage's use as a dwelling as required under BCZR §104.1.

Even more problematic for the Petitioners is the alleged use of the Gate House as a dwelling. No evidence was produced as to the date of its construction, much less any evidence as to the first date that the Gate House was used as a dwelling. The testimony was that the mother of the prior owners resided there, but no information was provided as to any time periods.

In Case No.: 07-274-A, the former owners of the Property, along with architect Donald Huber, did obtain an uncontested variance to construct a detached garage in the front yard of the Gate House near the Shared Driveway. (Pet. Ex. 4G). The site plan submitted in the 2007 case (the "2007 Site Plan") shows the Gate House and proposed detached garage location. The 2007 Site Plan also showed a *proposed* driveway connection to the Estate Entrance Driveway. Notably, the Main Garage is identified in both the Opinion and Order as well as the 2007 Site Plan only as: a "1 Story Brick Garage with a Loft"; it was not labeled as an apartment. For unexplained reasons, the nonconforming use status for neither the Gate House, nor the Main Garage, was addressed in the Opinion and Order. I will not infer, from the 2007 Case, that the approved variance legitimizes the use of the Gate House as a dwelling under BCZR, §104.1.

While it is undisputed that the Gate House existed in the 2007 case, the evidence was entirely lacking on its existence or use as a dwelling prior to 2007. Remarkably, the 1955-1970 Baltimore County Zoning Maps, the 1971-1975 Zoning Maps, as well as the 1976-2022 Zoning

Maps provided by OZR, do not show any building for the Gate House, much less even a typically-sized "gate house" that might be found at the entrance to an estate. Again, the Gate House is not listed with SDAT as a separate taxable dwelling (which Petitioners attribute the inability to further subdivide). Assuming that a typical "gate house" was, at some point, located at the Estate Entrance Driveway, there was no evidence as its removal, or its conversion into a dwelling. When compared to the testimony and Affidavit provided here, the foregoing Zoning Maps do not corroborate that evidence. I cannot glean from newspaper clippings or real estate listings, or what the Petitioners may have read about the Property's history, any substantive information required to prove nonconforming use status for the Gate House.

Accordingly, as with the Main Garage, I find that the Petitioners have failed to meet the burden of proof required to establish that the Gate House was used as dwelling prior to, and after 1945, or that it has continued uninterruptedly and continuously, without abandonment or interruption, for a period of 1 year of more, up to the present. For the reasons set forth herein, I also find that the Petition for Special Hearing is not consistent with the spirit and intent of the BCZR and as such, must be denied.

THEREFORE, ORDERED this <u>14th</u> day of February, 2022 by this Administrative Law Judge that the Petition for Special Hearing pursuant to the BCZR, §104.1 and §500.7 to affirm that the Main House has been used as an existing dwelling is hereby **DISMISSED AND MOOT** for the reasons set forth herein; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED, that the Petition for Special Hearing to affirm that the Main Garage and Gate House (as those structures are defined herein) located on a single 8.476 acre parcel of land are non-conforming be, and they are each hereby, **DENIED**.

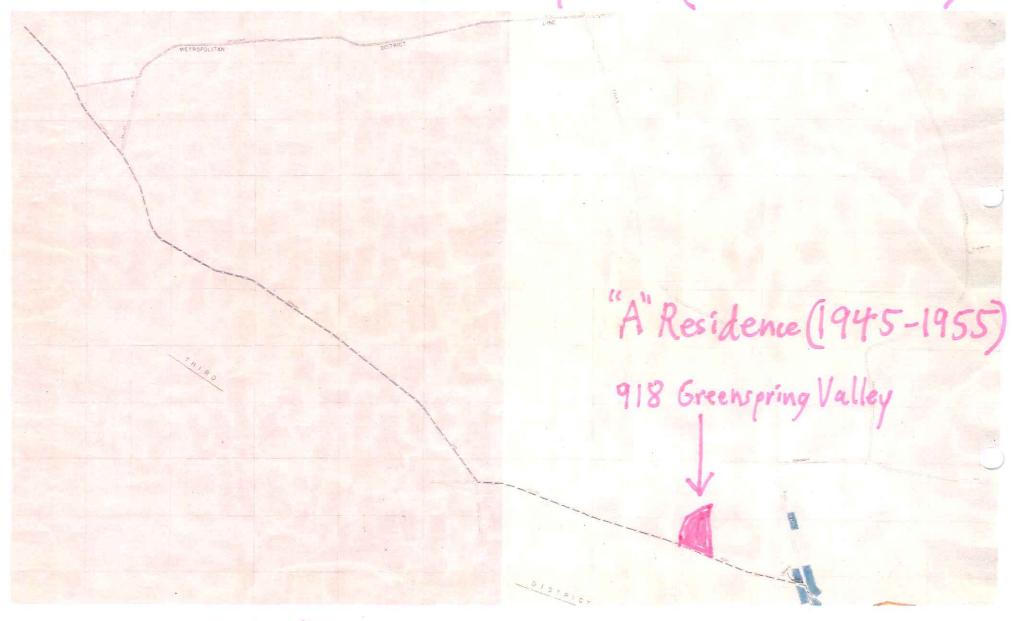

5. <u>Apartment House:</u> A detached building used and/or arranged for occupancy as dwellings for three or more families as separate housekeeping units. All such housekeeping units shall have unity in use and be supplied, in common, with heat, sewerage and/or other public convenience or utilities.

App. K

- 6. <u>Basement or Cellar:</u> That portion of a building below the first floor joists the floor of which is more than one-half the clear ceiling height below the adjacent ground.
- 7. <u>Building:</u> A structure having a roof supported by columns or walls for the shelter, support, or inclosure of persons, animals, or chattels. When any portion thereof is completely separated from all other portions by a division wall from the ground up to the roof and without any door or other openings, such portion shall be deemed a separate building.
- 8. <u>Building Line:</u> A line beyond which the foundation wall of a building shall not project.
- 9. <u>Courts:</u> An open, unoccupied space, other than a yard, on the same lot with a building, opening upon a street, alley, yard, lot line or setback, and which is bounded on two or more sides by such building.
- 10. Depth of Lot: The mean horizontal distance between the front line and the rear lot line.
- 11. <u>Dwelling, Single Family:</u> A detached dwelling arranged or used for occupancy by one family.
- 12. <u>Dwelling, Two-Family:</u> A detached dwelling arranged or used for occupancy by not more than two families as separate housekeeping units, and with not more than one entrance on any side. Such a dwelling shall have one housekeeping unit over the other.
- 13. <u>Dwelling, Semi-detached:</u> Two (single or two family) dwelling² designed and erected, side by side, as a single detached building and with not more than two entrances on any one side, such (single or two-family) dwellings shall be separated by a solid fire-proof partition wall from foundation to roof.
- 14. <u>Dwelling, Group House:</u> Not less than three or more than seven (single or two-family) dwellings designed and erected as a single detached building and with not more than one entrance for each (single or two family) dwelling on any one side, such (single or two family) dwellings shall be separated by a solid fireproof partition wall from foundation to roof.
- 15. <u>Garage, Private:</u> An accessory building used only for storage of not more than three motor driven vehicles, only one of which may be a commercial vehicle.
- 16. <u>Garage</u>, <u>Public-Storage</u>: Garage other than a private garage in which the repair facilities are incidental to its primary use for storage.
- 17. <u>Garage</u>, <u>Public Service</u>: A garage other than a private or public storage garage where motor driven vehicles are stored, equipped for operation, repaired, or kept for remuneration, hire or sale.
- 18. <u>Height of Building:</u> The vertical distance measured from the average ground level at the front of the building to the highest point of the building.

- 32. <u>Trailer:</u> A vehicle used, or intended for use as a conveyance upon the public street or highways, so designed, constructed, reconstructed, or added to by means of portable accessories in such manner as will permit the occupancy thereof as a movable dwelling or sleeping place.
- 33. <u>Trailer Camp</u>: Any land upon which, habitually or infrequently, one or more trailer or house cars, when detached from its automobile, or means of locomotion, or a combined car and house trailer, are placed or located, and whether or not used for occupancy as dwelling or otherwise, and shall include any structure or building used as a service building for such camp or intended for use as a part of the equipment of such camp.
- 34. <u>Wayside Stand:</u> A temporary structure including tables, or other method for display and sale of farm products or commodities.
- 35. <u>Yard:</u> An open space on the same lot as the building and unoccupied and unobstructed from the ground up (except such accessory buildings, or projections as are expressly permitted in these regulations) and not including a court.
- 36. <u>Yard, Front:</u> A yard extending across the full width of the lot and measured between the front lot line and the foundation wall of the building.
- 37. <u>Yard, Rear:</u> A yard extending across the full width of the lot measured between the rear lot line and the main building.
- 38. <u>Yard, Side:</u> A yard extending form the front yard to the rear yard and measured from the side lot line to the building.
- 39. Zone: An area for which the regulations governing the use of buildings and land are identical.

SECTION II — ZONES

For the purposes of these regulations, the County is hereby divided into Seven (7) Zones as follows:

"A" Residence Zone — (Cottage)

"B" Residence Zone — (Semi-detached)

"C" Residence Zone — (Apartment)

"D" Residence Zone — (Group)

"E" Commercial Zone.

"F" Light Industrial Zone.

"G" Heavy Industrial Zone.

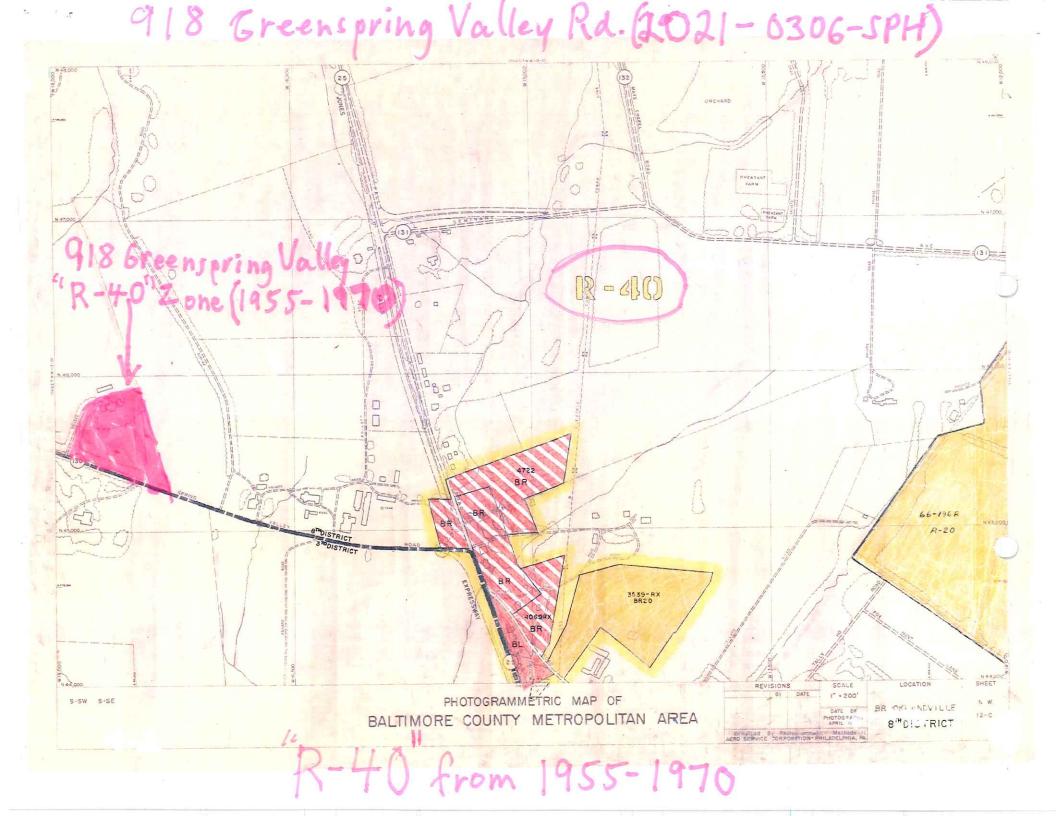
SECTION III — "A" RESIDENCE ZONE

- A. Use Regulations: In any "A" Residence Zone, except as hereinafter expressly provided, no building or land shall be used and no building or structure shall be hereafter erected, altered, repaired or used except for one or more of the following uses:
 - 1. Church, parochial school, convent or monastery.
 - 2. Dwelling, single family.
 - 3. Dwelling, two-family.
 - 4. Farming and buildings incidental thereto.
 - 5. Home Occupations, provided that no sign or signs shall be displayed on the lot so used exceeding a total of two square feet in area, not projecting more than one foot beyond the building, and not illuminated.
 - 6. Professional office when situated in the building used by practitioner as his or her private dwelling, provided that no name plate shall be displayed exceeding two square feet in area.
 - 7. Public park or playground.
 - 8. Public building.
 - 9. Public water works or reservoir.
 - 10. Trailer, one unoccupied, for storage only.
 - 11. Tourist home.
 - 12. Truck garden.
 - 13. Accessory building and uses incident to any of the above uses when located on the same lot and in the rear yard and not involving the conduct of a retail business, and which may include:
 - (a) Any accessory building when located not less than 60 feet from front lot line and in case of a corner lot where real lot line abuts on side line of lot adjoining on rear, no accessory building shall be less than 25 feet from the side street line except when built as a part of the main building, provided, however, that any accessory building which is erected within 60 feet of any side street line shall not be less than 10 feet from the rear lot line. In case of a corner lot where rear line of lot abuts on rear line of lot adjoining on rear, no accessory building shall be less than 15 feet from the side street line and in no case shall an accessory building be located within two feet of any lot line.
 - (b) Poultry house, provided use is of a private nature only and no poultry or eggs are sold, provided, however, that any poultry yard, run or enclosure, shall be, in its entirety, within the rear yard of such lot.
 - 14. Telephone and telegraph lines, electric light and power lines on public highways or carrying less than 5,000 volts on poles, underground conduits, cables and gas, sewer and water mains and pipes, provided that no building or structure except such poles shall be erected, altered, repaired or used in connection therewith without the issuance of a special permit as provided in Section XIII Sub-section I.

- B. Height Regulations: No building shall exceed a height of forty feet or three stories.
- C. Area Regulations: The minimum dimensions of yards, and the minimum lot area, except as provided in Section IX, shall be as follows:
 - Lot Area: Each dwelling hereafter erected shall be located on a lot having an area of
 not less than five thousand square feet and a width of not less than fifty feet at the
 front building line. No yard space or minimum area required for a building or use by
 these regulations shall be considered as any part of the yard space or minimum area
 for another building or use.
 - 2. Front Yard: The building line shall set back from the front lot line to provide for a front yard not less than twenty-five feet in depth, provided that when the majority of residential buildings on one side of a street between two intersecting streets, have been lawfully built with different front yard depths than the aforesaid twenty-five feet, then no building hereafter erected or altered shall have a less front yard than the average depth of said actual front yards of buildings immediately to either side of said building; and, provided, further that no building shall be required by the regulations to set back more than fifty feet in any case, and provided further that these regulations shall not be construed as to reduce to less than 22 feet the buildable width of a corner lot.
 - 3. Side Yard: There shall be a side yard not less than seven feet in width along each side lot line, except in case of a corner lot the side yard along the side street shall not be less than fifteen feet.
 - 4. Rear Yard: There shall be a rear yard, having a minimum average depth of twenty feet but in no case less than fifteen feet in depth at any one point.
 - 5. No portion of an alley shall be considered as any part of any side or rear yard.
 - 6. No dwelling shall be built on a lot which does not abut upon and front directly on a public street, or adequate rural right-of-way.

SECTION IV — "B" RESIDENCE ZONE

- A. Use Regulations: Except as hereinbefore expressly provided, no building or structure or land shall be used and no building or structure shall be hereafter erected, altered, repaired or used except for one or more of the following uses:
 - 1. Any use permitted in an "A" Residence Zone, any such use to be subject to the same conditions and limitations set forth as to such use in section III-A of these regulations:
 - 2. Children's Home
 - 3. Dwelling semi-detached.
 - 4. Fraternity or Sorority House
 - 5. Opphanage.
 - 6. Tea Room, when operated as a home occupation.



DEFINITIONS

Convalescent Home: This term includes rest homes, nursing homes, convalescent homes for children, and homes providing chronic and convalescent care. It does not include a "care home" as defined by the Maryland State Health Department, which merely provides board, shelter, and personal services in a protective environment for persons not gainfully employed.

Density, Gross: The acres within each separate zone in a project divided into the dwelling units in each such zone, including not more than half the width of bordering streets and alleys.

Density, Net: Net Density is based on the area of the lot or lots involved. Offstreet parking space shall be considered part thereof only if contained therein.

Dwelling: A building or portion thereof which provides living facilities for one or more families.

Dwelling, One-Family: A detached building arranged or used for occupancy by one family.

Dwelling, Two-Family: A building arranged or used for occupancy by two families as separate housekeeping units. It may be either a duplex or a semidetached dwelling.

Dwelling, Duplex: A two-family detached building with one housekeeping unit over the other.

Dwelling, Semi-detached: A building that has two one-family housekeeping units erected side by side on adjoining lots, separated from each other by an approved masonry party wall extending from the basement or cellar floor to the roof along the dividing lot line, and separated from any other building by space

Dwelling, Group House: A building that has not less than three nor more than six one-family housekeeping units erected in a row as a single building, on adjoining lots, each being separated from the adjoining unit or units by an approved masonry party wall or walls extending from the basement or cellar floor to the roof along the dividing lot line, and each such building being separated from any other building by space on all sides.

ART, 2 2-ZONES: USE, HEIGHT, AND AREA REGULATIONS

R. 40 Zone-Residence, One-Family

Section 200-USE REGULATIONS

The following uses only are permitted:

200.1-One-family detached dwellings.

200.2—Conversion of a one-family dwelling as conditioned in Section 402.

200.3—Churches and other buildings for religious worship, including church schools and private schools.

200.4-Trailers, as limited by Section 415.

200.5-Country club, golf course, or other outdoor recreation clubs, including club house, and quasi-public camps, including day camps, but no such use shall be located on less than 3 acres, and no building or parking lot thereon shall be located within 60 feet of any property line.

200.6-Community building, swimming pool, or other structural or land use devoted to civic, social, recreational and educational activities of the community.

200.7-Offices of a doctor or dentist but with no hospital facilities, and offices or studios of a lawyer, architect, engineer, or artist, when these or offices of similar professions are situated in the same dwelling used by any of the foregoing persons as his residence. Not more than 25% of the floor area of the dwelling shall be used for offices or studios; not more than one non-resident professional associate and two nonresident employees shall be permitted. Signs are prohibited except as noted in Section 413.

200.8-Home occupations, as heretofore defined in Section 101, provided that no sign shall be displayed except as noted in Section 413.

200.9—Accessory buildings and uses as limited by Section 400.

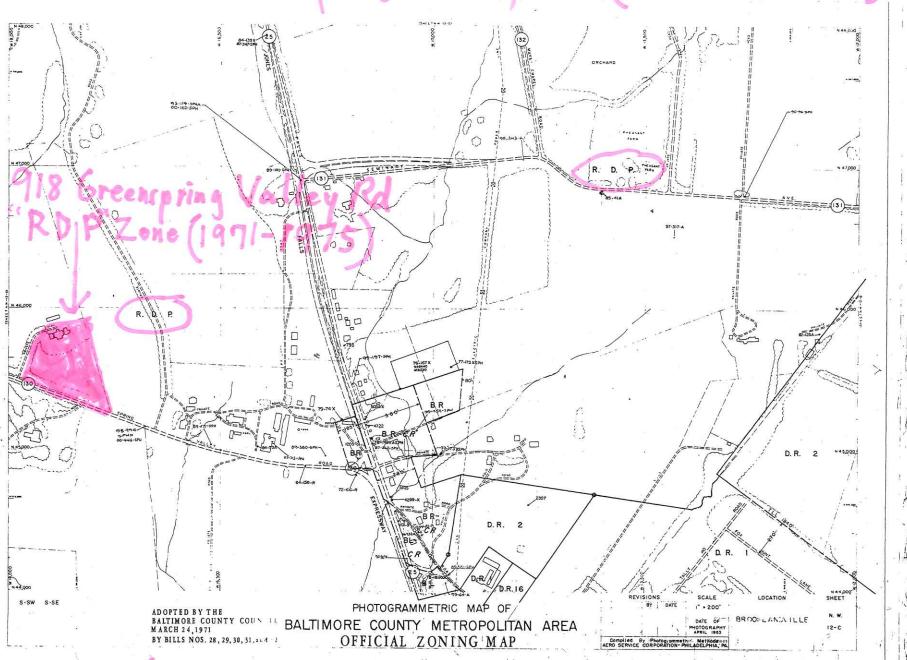

Section 1A00—R. D. P. ZONES (RURAL: DEFERRED-PLANNING). [Bill No. 100, 1970.]

1A00. 1—General Provisions. [Bill No. 100, 1970.]

- Purpose. The R.D.P. zoning classification is established, pursuant to the legislative findings set forth above,² in order to:
 - a. Prevent untimely urban development of relatively open rural land; and
 - Foster conditions favorable to agriculture and other low-intensity uses appropriate in rural areas, considering both the magnitude of total land acreage needed for such uses and the current prospective needs for developable urban land.

- c. That reclassification of land as R. D. P. shall not represent a commitment by Baltimore County with respect to type of future development, but only that more particular planning for the use of such land shall be executed in the future; and
