OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings ("OAH") as a Petition for Variance filed by Chris and Kris Keller ("Petitioners") for property located at 716 Stablersville Road, Parkton (the "Property"). Petitioners are requesting Variance relief from the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("BCZR") §§400.1 and 400.3 to approve an accessory building (garage) in the front yard on the left side and at a height of 30 ft., in lieu of the required rear yard placement and a maximum height of 15 ft., respectively.

A public WebEx hearing was conducted virtually in lieu of an in-person hearing. The Petition was properly advertised and posted. The Petitioners appeared at the hearing, in support of the Petition, *pro se*. The Petitioner Chris Keller is a contractor for Keller Contracting, LLC. A site plan was prepared by Landworks Civil Design. LLC (the "Site Plan"). (Pet. Ex. F). Neighboring property owner Nathanial Fitzpatrick, 806 Stablersville Rd., participated and asked questions of the Petitioners.

Zoning Advisory Committee ("ZAC") comments were received from the Department of Planning ("DOP") which agency did not oppose the requested relief. Department of Environmental Protection and Sustainability ("DEPS") noted that prior to permit approval compliance with Article 33 of the Baltimore County Code ("BCC") is required, and that

environmental Variances are required from both the Regulations for the Protection of Water Quality, Stream, Wetlands and Floodplains, and from Forest Conservation Regulations. Department of Plans Review ("DPR")/ Department Public Works and Transportation ("DPWT"), provided a comment that a floodplain study must be submitted to Permits Approvals and Inspections ("PAI") and "Accepted for Filing." ¹

The Property is 17 acres and is improved with a 30-foot tall, 1,898 sf farmhouse constructed in 1910. The farmhouse faces Stablersville Rd. As shown on the aerial photograph, Petitioners also own 54 acres +/- to the west of the Property, as well as 13 acres to the east of the Property. (Pet. Ex. D). The Property is zoned Resource Conservation – Agricultural (RC 2). A stream runs to the east of the farmhouse. (Pet. Ex. D). Petitioners reside in Pennsylvania and purchased the Property to live in during their retirement years. They do not operate and are not associated with any commercial farms.

In preparation for the construction of the proposed garage, Petitioners removed a Specimen Tree which was located to the west of the farmhouse without first obtaining an environmental Variance. Street view photographs show that Specimen Tree was located next to the farmhouse prior to its removal. (Pet. Exs. H-1, H-2). DEPS noted in its ZAC comment the need for an environmental Variance prior to removal. In regard to floodplain, Petitioners submitted an environmental easement document to show what they believe confirms that the garage will not be located in a Forest Buffer or Forest Conservation easement. (Pet. Exs. B, E). Petitioners also submitted a FEMA rendering superimposed on an aerial which they contend shows that that garage will not be located in Flood Zone A. (Pet. Ex. C).

¹ DPR/DPWT ZAC comment inadvertently mentioned a comment in regard to parking spaces within a 10 ft. right-of way for a different property located on Hollins Ferry Rd.

Petitioners assert that due to the steep topography behind the farmhouse, as well as location of the stream on the eastern side and rear yard, it is not possible to construct a detached garage in that location. The farmhouse was built into the foot of a steep hill. For a garage to be located in the rear yard, additional grading and installation of more impervious surface for the driveway would be detrimental to the stream and the Forest Buffer and Forest Conservation Easements. (Pet. Exs. B, E). The garage will still need to be built into the embankment which will permit a walkout, passenger door. (Pet. Ex. I-1). A floor plan of the proposed storage space was submitted. (Pet. Ex. A). Petitioners also contend that they need the extra 15 ft. in height, beyond the maximum 15 ft., for storage as the farmhouse does not have a basement or an attic, and otherwise has minimal storage. The garage will be used to park vehicles and to store lawn equipment. The additional height of the roof on the garage is also needed to match the roof pitch on the farmhouse.

A variance request involves a two-step process, summarized as follows:

- (1) It must be shown the property is unique in a manner which makes it unlike surrounding properties, and that uniqueness or peculiarity must necessitate variance relief; and
- (2) If variance relief is denied, Petitioner will experience a practical difficulty or hardship.

Cromwell v. Ward, 102 Md. App. 691 (1995). The Property is uniquely shaped as shown on the Site Plan and aerial photograph. The location of the existing 1,910 farmhouse, steep topography and environmental areas in the rear, limiting the area where garage can be constructed to the front yard. The additional height for the garage is needed to due to the lack of attic and basement storage space in the farmhouse. I find that the Petitioner would suffer a practical difficulty and unreasonable hardship if the height and area Variances were not granted because they would not be able to construct a detached garage due to the steep slopes, stream location, Forest Buffer and Forest Conservation Easement areas, and at a height to accommodate needed storage. I find that

the requested Variance relief can be granted in strict harmony with the spirit and intent of the BCZR and without injury to the health, safety or general welfare, particularly in light of the lack of opposition.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, this <u>18th</u> day of December, 2023, by the Administrative Law Judge for Baltimore County, that the Petition for Variance from BCZR, §400.1 and §400.3 to approve an accessory building (garage) in the front yard on the left side at a height of 30 ft. in lieu of the required rear yard placement and a maximum height of 15 ft., respectively be, and they are each hereby **GRANTED**.

The relief granted herein shall be subject to the following:

- 1. Petitioners may apply for necessary permits and/or licenses upon receipt of this Order. However, Petitioners are hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at their own risk until 30 days from the date hereof, during which time an appeal can be filed by any party. If for whatever reason this Order is reversed, Petitioners would be required to return the subject property to its original condition.
- 2. Petitioners and subsequent owners shall not convert the detached garage into a dwelling unit or apartment. The proposed detached garage shall not contain any sleeping quarters, bathroom, kitchen area or living area.
- 3. There shall be no second utility and/or electric meter(s). All utility and electric shall extend from the house to the detached garage.
- 4. The detached garage shall not be used for commercial or industrial purposes.
- 5. Prior to permitting, Petitioners shall comply with the DOP, DPR/DPWT, and the DEPS ZAC comments, copies of which are attached hereto.
- 6. The Site Plan (Pet. Ex. F) is attached hereto and incorporated herein in its entirety.

Any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

The Department of Planning has reviewed the petition for the following:

Variance -

1. From BCZR Sections 400.1 and 400.3 to approve an accessory building (garage) in the front yard on the left side at a height of 30 ft in lieu of the required rear yard placement and maximum height of 15 ft, respectively.

The property under consideration is located on the east side of York Road along the Fourth Mine Branch River top the east and Stablersville Road to the south in the Parkton area of Baltimore County. Spanning approximately 17.00 acres +/-, the property is zoned RC 2 and is improved with a residential dwelling. Farms, residential dwellings and forest conservation characterize the surrounding area.

The RC-2 zone is a zoning district established to preserve the rural character of the area and promote lowdensity residential development. This district is intended to maintain the natural beauty and peacefulness of the surrounding countryside, while providing for compatible land uses and development patterns.
