#### **OPINION AND ORDER**

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings ("OAH") as a Petition for Administrative Variance filed by the legal owner of the property, Jeffrey Schaufert ("Petitioner") for the property located at 1322 E. Riverside Avenue, Essex (the "Property"). The Petitioner is requesting Variance relief from the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("BCZR"), Sections 401.1 and 401.3, to permit a proposed garage with a height of 25 ft. to be located in the front yard (water-side) in lieu of the required rear yard placement (street-side) and maximum permitted height of 15 ft. The Property is more fully depicted on the site plan which was marked and accepted into evidence as Petitioner's Exhibit 1. A street view photograph of the Property was provided. (Pet. Ex. 2).

A ZAC comment was received from the Department of Environmental Protection and Sustainability ("DEPS") dated December 21, 2023, indicating that the property is subject to Critical Area Law listed in the BCZR, Section 500.14. Department of Plans Review/Department of Public Works & Transportation ("DPR/DPW&T") provided a ZAC comment which states:

"DPW&T: The property is within the Tidal Special Flood Hazard Area Zone AE (BFE=7.7) per panel FIRM 2400100555F dated 9/26/08. Must comply with Flood Plain Ordinance, See County Bill 40-15 (the latest edition of the Baltimore County Code) and Bill 42-15, and Section 32-4-414 of Article 32, Title 4 of the Baltimore County Code, 2003, as amended. The LiMWA is not on the property."

The Petitioner having filed a Petition for Administrative Variance and the Property having been posted on December 16, 2023 and January 1, 2024 and there being no request for a public hearing, a decision shall be rendered based upon the documentation presented.

The Petitioner has filed the supporting affidavits as required by Section 32-3-303 of the Baltimore County Code ("BCC"). The Petitioner intends to construct a garage to provide additional space currently lacking in the residence on the property. The rear-yard (street side) of the property has extremely limited space for the construction of a garage. Per Pet. Ex. 1, the residence on the neighboring property closest to the proposed garage is 24 ft. from the property line. In the opinion of the Administrative Law Judge, the information, photographs, and affidavits submitted provide sufficient facts that comply with the requirements of Section 307.1 of the BCZR. Furthermore, strict compliance with the BCZR would result in practical difficulty and/or unreasonable hardship upon the Petitioner. I find that there is no evidence in the file to indicate that the requested variance would adversely affect the health, safety or general welfare of the public and should therefore be granted.

Although the Department of Planning did not make any recommendations related to the detached garage, I will impose conditions that the detached garage shall not be converted into a dwelling unit or apartment, shall not contain any sleeping quarters, living area, kitchen or bathroom facilities, and will not have separate electric or utility connections, or used for commercial purposes.

Pursuant to the posting of the Property and the provisions of both the BCC and the BCZR, and for the reasons given above, the requested variance should be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, this <u>9th</u> day of **January**, **2024**, by the Administrative Law Judge for Baltimore County, that the Petition for Variance relief from the Baltimore County

Zoning Regulations ("BCZR"), Sections 401.1 and 401.3, to permit a proposed garage with a height of 25 ft. to be located in the front yard (water-side) in lieu of the required rear yard placement (street-side) and maximum permitted height of 15 ft., be, and it is hereby, **GRANTED**.

The relief granted herein shall be subject to the following

- 1. Petitioner may apply for his appropriate permits and be granted same upon receipt of this Order; however, Petitioner is hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at his own risk until such time as the 30-day appellate process from this Order has expired. If, for whatever reason, this Order is reversed, Petitioner would be required to return, and be responsible for returning, said property to its original condition.
- 2. Petitioner and subsequent owners shall not convert the detached garage into a dwelling unit or apartment. The detached garage shall not contain any sleeping quarters, living area, bathroom facilities or kitchen facilities.
- 3. The detached garage shall not have a separate utility or electric connection and shall connect all electrical to the home.
- 4. The detached garage shall not be used for commercial or industrial purposes.
- 5. Petitioner must comply with ZAC comments from DEPS and DPR/DPW&T, dated December 21, 2023 and December 19, 2023, respectively; copies of which are attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

DEPS has reviewed the subject zoning petition for compliance with the goals of the State-mandated Critical Area Law listed in the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations, Section 500.14. Based upon this review, we offer the following comments:

1. Minimize adverse impacts on water quality that result from pollutants that are discharged from structures or conveyances or that have run off from surrounding lands:

This property is located in a Limited Development Area (LDA) in the Chesapeake Bay Critical Area (CBCA) and must comply with maximum lot coverage limits, Critical Area buffer requirements, and forest requirements. Lot coverage is limited to a maximum of 15% of the area of the property above mean high tide. Also, it appears that the required Critical Area buffer may cover all or a majority of the site. Based on this, the proposed structure may require a CBCA administrative variance. If the proposed development can comply with all Critical Area requirements, including any required mitigation, adverse impacts on water quality from the pollutants discharged from the proposed development can be minimized.

2. Conserve fish, wildlife, and plant habitat; and

The proposed development can meet the requirement to conserve fish, wildlife, and plant habitat provided that all Critical Area requirements can be met.

3. Be consistent with established land use policies for development in the Chesapeake Bay Critical Area, which accommodate growth and also address the fact that, even if pollution is controlled, the number, movement and activities of persons in that area can create adverse environmental impacts;

If the proposed development can be designed to meet the Critical Area defined lot coverage requirements, and meet all Critical Area buffer, tree, and mitigation requirements, the relief requested will be consistent with established land-use policies.
