ORDER ON MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION

Now pending is a Motion for Reconsideration of the May 29, 2024 Opinion and Order issued in the above captioned case. Specifically, legal owner/Petitioners, Douglas and Maureen Long ("Petitioners") requested Variance relief from the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("BCZR"), §1B02.3.C.1 and §400.1, to permit a side yard addition (North River Drive side) with a proposed 8 ft side-street setback in lieu of the required 25 ft, and to permit an existing accessory garage to remain in the front yard in lieu of the required rear yard placement. The relief was granted subject to conditions.

By email dated July 12, 2024, Petitioners requested reconsidering of Condition #3 which reads as follows:

3. The existing detached garage shall not have a separate utility or electric connection and shall connect all electrical to the home.

Petitioners concede that their Motion for Reconsideration was not timely filed because they did not know about the decision until June 10, 2024, and then "spent the next few weeks trying to get a copy of that decision." While Motions for Reconsideration must be filed within 30 days of the date of the Order to which no exceptions are permitted, and while it is unclear why there was a

delay in obtaining the Order if Petitioners had notice of its existence on June 10, 2024, in the interests of judicial economy, a decision will be made on the Motion filed.

As to the merits of their Motion, Petitioners state that there is a separate, existing electrical service to the detached garage which is in the front yard. When the Petition was filed, Petitioners failed to seek zoning relief sought for the *unapproved*, detached garage which was located in the front yard in violation on BCZR, §400.1. Consequently, as a courtesy to the Petitioners, the Office of Zoning Review ("OZR") added the necessary relief for the detached garage to the Petition. Petitioners contend in their Motion that there is "a lot" which they identified as "lot 6810 Columbia Rd" and that it "has its own utility for electric." Petitioners next contend that the electrical service for "lot 6810 Columbia Rd" is connected to the detached garage at issue here. Petitioners add that this electrical service hook up existed at the time they purchased "both parcels" in 2010.

Sorting through the Petitioners' statements in the Motion for Reconsideration, upon additional research available to the public, there is no Property address of 6810 Columbia Rd. Moreover, it is certainly unorthodox for a detached garage which serves as an accessory structure to the home at 6812, to have electrical service hookup to another address which can not be identified. The reason for the conditions set forth in the Order regarding the detached garage is to prohibit it from being used a dwelling and to prohibit it from being used for commercial or industrial purposes.

Moreover, Petitioners contend that they purchased two parcels. Upon researching Plat No. 2 of Harewood Park filed in Land Records of Baltimore County on July 12, 1944 (Plat Book CHK 13, page 144) for this Property, there is only one parcel (Parcel 258) which is labeled on the Plat as Lot 131. While there are two (2) tax identification numbers with SDAT, the County does not

have a record of two (2) separate properties. Indeed, the SDAT tax map places both tax

identification numbers at the same property – 6812 Columbia Rd.

Having said all of that, I will remove Condition #3 but the other conditions will remain.

Accordingly, for the reasons set forth herein the Motion for Reconsideration will be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED this <u>24th</u> day of **July**, **2024**, by this Administrative Law Judge that the Motion for Reconsideration is hereby **GRANTED** and Condition #3 as set forth in

the Opinion and Order shall be removed, but all other Conditions contained in the Opinion and

Order shall remain the same.

Any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings ("OAH") as a Petition for Administrative Variance filed by the legal owners of the property, Douglas and Maureen Long ("Petitioners") for the property located at 6812 Columbia Road, Middle River (the "Property"). The Petitioners are requesting Variance relief from the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("BCZR"), §1B02.3.C.1 and §400.1, to permit a side yard addition (North River Drive side) with a proposed 8 ft. side-street setback in lieu of the required 25 ft., and to permit an existing accessory garage to remain in the front yard in lieu of the required rear yard placement. The Property is more fully depicted on the site plan which was marked and accepted into evidence as Petitioners' Exhibit 1. Street view photographs of the Property were provided. (Pet. Exs. 2A-2C). Architectural renderings were provided of the proposed addition. (Pet. Exs. 3A, 3B).

A Zoning Advisory Committee ("ZAC") comment was received from the Department of Environmental Protection and Sustainability ("DEPS"), dated May 22, 2024, offering comments regarding lot coverage requirements. Development Plans Review ("DPR")/Department of Public Works and Transportation ("DPWT") provided a ZAC comment but did not oppose the requested relief.

The Petitioners having filed a Petition for Administrative Variance and the Property having been posted on May 5, 2024 and there being no request for a public hearing, a decision shall be

rendered based upon the documentation presented.

The Petitioners have filed the supporting affidavit as required by §32-3-303 of the Baltimore County Code ("BCC"). Based upon the information available, there is no evidence in the file to indicate that the requested Variance would adversely affect the health, safety or general welfare of the public and should therefore be granted. In the opinion of the Administrative Law Judge, the information, photographs, and affidavits submitted provide sufficient facts that comply with the requirements of §307.1 of the BCZR. Furthermore, strict compliance with the BCZR would result in practical difficulty and/or unreasonable hardship upon the Petitioners.

Although the Department of Planning did not make any recommendations related to the detached garage, I will impose conditions that the existing detached garage shall not be converted into a dwelling unit or apartment, shall not contain any sleeping quarters, living area, kitchen or bathroom facilities, and will not have separate electric or utility connections, or used for commercial purposes. Additionally, Petitioners must comply with any conditions imposed by the Department of Environmental Protection and Sustainability ("DEPS") prior to permitting.

Pursuant to the posting of the Property and the provisions of both the BCC and the BCZR, and for the reasons given above, the requested Variance should be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, this <u>29th</u> day of May, <u>2024</u>, by the Administrative Law Judge for Baltimore County, that the Petition for Variance relief from the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("BCZR"), §1B02.3.C.1 and §400.1, to permit a side yard addition (North River Drive side) with a proposed 8 ft. side-street setback in lieu of the required 25 ft., and to permit an existing accessory garage to remain in the front yard in lieu of the required rear yard placement, respectively, be, and they are each hereby, **GRANTED**.

The relief granted herein shall be subject to the following:

- 1. Petitioners may apply for their appropriate permits and be granted same upon receipt of this Order; however, Petitioners are hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at their own risk until such time as the 30-day appellate process from this Order has expired. If, for whatever reason, this Order is reversed, Petitioners would be required to return, and be responsible for returning, said property to its original condition.
- 2. Petitioners and subsequent owners shall not convert the existing detached garage into a dwelling unit or apartment. The existing detached garage shall not contain any sleeping quarters, living area, bathroom facilities or kitchen facilities.
- 3. The existing detached garage shall not have a separate utility or electric connection and shall connect all electrical to the home.
- 4. The existing detached garage shall not be used for commercial or industrial purposes.
- 5. The property is located within the Chesapeake Bay Critical Area ("CBCA") and is subject to Critical Area requirements. As such, the Petitioners must comply with those conditions imposed by the Department of Environmental Protection and Sustainability ("DEPS") in their ZAC comment, dated May 22, 2024; a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order,

Zoning Advisory Committee Meeting of May 7, 2024.

EPS has reviewed the subject zoning petition for compliance with the goals of the Statemandated Critical Area Law listed in the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations, Section 500.14. Based upon this review, we offer the following comments:

1. Minimize adverse impacts on water quality that result from pollutants that are discharged from structures or conveyances or that have run off from surrounding lands:

The subject property is located within a Limited Development Area (LDA) and is subject to Critical Area requirements. The applicant is seeking approval to permit a side yard addition with a side yard setback of 8 feet in lieu of the required 25 feet and to allow an existing garage to remain in the front yard in lieu of the required rear yard placement. The proposed development must meet LDA requirements and the 15% afforestation requirement. According to the zoning property description, the property is 9,715 square feet. Based on this square-footage, the maximum lot coverage for this property is 3.035 square feet or 31.25%. If the proposed development can comply with the lot coverage restrictions and the 15% afforestation requirement, the relief requested can result in minimal adverse impacts to water quality.

2. Conserve fish, plant, and wildlife habitat;

This is a non-waterfront property. The property consists of a house, garage, and driveway with a lawn and scattered trees. Based on GIS, it appears there is no

forest, streams, or wetlands on the property. Meeting the lot coverage requirements and the 15% afforestation requirement will aid in the conservation of fish, plant, and wildlife habitat in the watershed.

3. Be consistent with established land use policies for development in the Chesapeake Bay Critical Area, which accommodate growth and also address the fact that, even if pollution is controlled, the number, movement and activities of persons in that area can create adverse environmental impacts.

If the proposed development can be designed to meet the lot coverage and afforestation requirements, the relief requested will be consistent with established land-use policies.

Zoning Advisory Committee Meeting of May 7, 2024.

EPS has reviewed the subject zoning petition for compliance with the goals of the Statemandated Critical Area Law listed in the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations, Section 500.14. Based upon this review, we offer the following comments:

1. Minimize adverse impacts on water quality that result from pollutants that are discharged from structures or conveyances or that have run off from surrounding lands;

The subject property is located within a Limited Development Area (LDA) and is subject to Critical Area requirements. The applicant is seeking approval to permit a side yard addition with a side yard setback of 8 feet in lieu of the required 25 feet and to allow an existing garage to remain in the front yard in lieu of the required rear yard placement. The proposed development must meet LDA requirements and the 15% afforestation requirement. According to the zoning property description, the property is 9,715 square feet. Based on this square-footage, the maximum lot coverage for this property is 3.035 square feet or 31.25%. If the proposed development can comply with the lot coverage restrictions and the 15% afforestation requirement, the relief requested can result in minimal adverse impacts to water quality.

2. Conserve fish, plant, and wildlife habitat;

This is a non-waterfront property. The property consists of a house, garage, and driveway with a lawn and scattered trees. Based on GIS, it appears there is no

forest, streams, or wetlands on the property. Meeting the lot coverage requirements and the 15% afforestation requirement will aid in the conservation of fish, plant, and wildlife habitat in the watershed.

3. Be consistent with established land use policies for development in the Chesapeake Bay Critical Area, which accommodate growth and also address the fact that, even if pollution is controlled, the number, movement and activities of persons in that area can create adverse environmental impacts.

If the proposed development can be designed to meet the lot coverage and afforestation requirements, the relief requested will be consistent with established land-use policies.
