OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings ("OAH") as Petitions for Special Exception and Variance filed by Linda, Laskey, Susan Keller, Lia Anne Calabrese and Joseph Bruno, Trustee, legal owners, and Sheetz, Inc., lessee, ("Petitioners") for the properties addressed as 4334, 4336 North Point Boulevard and 8902 Wise Avenue, Dundalk (the "Property"). A Petition for Special Exception was filed pursuant to Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("BCZR"), §405.2B.1 and §405.4.E.1, to allow a fuel service station on an individual site in combination with a convenience store and carry-out restaurant with a gross floor area larger than 6,000 sf in the BR-AS zone. Petitions for Variance relief were also filed seeking relief from BCZR:

- (1) §409.6 to allow a total of 36 off-street parking spaces in lieu of the required 43 parking spaces; ¹
- (2) §450.4, Table of Sign Regulations 5(a), to allow a total of four wall-mounted enterprise signs for a single tenant building in lieu of the three signs permitted, with no more than two signs on each facade (Sign Types A, B);

- (3) §450.4. Table of Sign Regulations 3(a), to allow freestanding directional signs with a sign height of 13 and 14 ft. in lieu of the permitted 6 ft. (Sign Types 6, 7, 9A/9B);
- (4) §450.4. Table of Sign Regulations 3(a), to allow sign areas/faces of 9, 11 and 17 sf in lieu of the permitted 8 sf (Sign Types 6, 7, 9A/9B);
- (5) §450.4. Table of Sign Regulations 5(f) to allow an order board ancillary to a drive-through lane with a height of 7 ft in lieu of the permitted 6 ft (Sign Type 10).

A public WebEx hearing was conducted virtually in lieu of an in-person hearing on January 16, 2025. The Petition was properly advertised and posted. John Eidberger, Entitlement Manager for Sheetz, Inc., appeared at the hearing in support of the Petition along with Brandon Rowe, PE of Bohler, the civil engineering firm who prepared and sealed the site plan (the "Site Plan"). (Pet. Ex. 1). David Karceski, Esquire, and Adam Rosenblatt, Esquire of Venable, LLP represented the Petitioners. There were no Protestants or interested citizens who testified in opposition at the hearing.

Zoning Advisory Committee ("ZAC") comments were received from the Department of Environmental Protection and Sustainability ("DEPS"), Department of Planning ("DOP"), and Development Plans Review ("DPR")/Department of Public Works and Transportation ("DPWT") which agencies did not oppose the requested relief.

FINDINGS OF FACT

The Property is comprised of three (3) parcels, each separately addressed and collectively measuring 4.42 acres +/- (192,535 sf). 4334 North Point Blvd. measures 1.76 ac +/-, 4336 North Point Blvd. measures 11, 365 sf, and 8902 Wise Ave. measures 2.400 ac +/-. Both 4334 North Point Blvd. and 4336 North Point Blvd., are rectangularly-shaped parcels which primarily front on North Point Blvd. 4336 North Point Blvd. also has some frontage along Wise Ave. 8902 Wise

Ave sits immediately behind those properties and has also some frontage along Wise Ave. Located along the rear boundary line of 8902 Wise Ave. is an access easement recorded in Land Records of Baltimore County (Liber 48468, folio 356, 364, 372) (the "Access Easement"), as well as a 10 ft. sanitary sewer easement.

As shown in street view photographs, the Property has several commercial buildings. (Pet. Ex. 5). The Property is zoned Business, Roadside with an Automotive Services overlay district (BR-AS). (Pet. Ex. 3A). The surrounding properties are largely commercial or industrial as depicted in the aerial photograph. (Pet. Ex. 3A). There are no residentially zoned properties within 50 ft. of this Property.

Petitioners propose to construct a Sheetz fuel service station with 16 fueling stations under a canopy, in combination with a 6,139 sf convenience store and carry out restaurant. (Pet. Ex. 1). There will also be a 380 sf outdoor seating area. There is no car wash being proposed, no auto repair services being offered, or sale of used vehicles at the Property. There are no vending machines or kiosks being proposed.

John Eidberger, whose job duties include managing all zoning and land use issues, handling permitting, retaining experts, and seeing new stores through to completion, testified that the proposed store would be the second Sheetz in Baltimore County. Sheetz is a family-owned and operated company with over 770 stores nationwide. (Pet. Ex. 12). Sheetz stores are known for their made-to-order food which can be purchased inside the store, or via a drive-thru. (Pet. Ex. 12). Sheetz stores are open 24 hours per day, 7 days per week, and 365 days per year and are automotive-intensive because they not only sell fuel, but encourage pre-ordering, paying and pickup of food from a drive-thru, without the customer leaving their vehicle. All food and/or products (except tobacco) are ordered through a touch-screen menu board. A site rendering of a typical

Sheetz store and fuel service station was provided. (Pet Ex. 6). This Sheetz store will employ 7 employees at a given time.

Brandon Rowe, PE of Bohler was accepted as an expert in civil engineering, with special knowledge of the BCZR and Special Exceptions. (Pet. Ex. 2). The proffered testimony was that the Property dimensions are 192,535 sf, and the area of the Special Exception area for the fuel service station/convenience store and carryout restaurant will be 93,710 sf. Both of these site dimensions meet the requirements in BCZR, §405.4.A.1. The fuel pumps will be located on the side of the convenience store/carry out restaurant, and not in front of the store. A restroom(s) will be provided inside the convenience store, where customers can also purchase water. (BCZR, §405.4.B). At the request of the DOP, the original location of the dumpster was moved to the north eastern corner, so it will not be in direct view. Toward that end, Mr. Rowe revised the Site Plan.

The proposed use will also meet all of the bulk regulations specific to fuel service stations as set forth in BCZR, §405.4.A.2.a for the building (at least 35 ft. away from any street); fuel pumps (at least 25 ft. from any street); and fuel station canopy (at least 15 ft. away from any street). In regard to the required landscape transition areas required along the entire perimeter of all fuel service stations under BCZR, §405.4.A.2.b, Mr. Rowe confirmed that there are no residentially zoned lands within 50 ft. of the Property. (Pet Ex. 3A). That fact notwithstanding, the Petitioners here are providing a 15 ft. landscape buffer along the northern boundary line because the adjoining property is residentially-used (although not residentially zoned where only a 6 ft. wide landscape buffer is actually required). Otherwise, Petitioners meet the required landscaped buffer area widths providing a 6 ft. buffer along the rear (eastern) Property line, and 10 ft. wide buffers along the Wise Ave. (southern) and North Point Blvd. (western) sides. Petitioners will file a Landscape Plan

which shall require that all landscape transition areas be vegetated and screened in accordance with the Landscape Manual for automotive uses. (BCZR, §405.4.A.2.c). A Lighting Plan will also be filed. (BCZR, §409.8.A.3).

In regard to stacking spaces, the Site Plan provides for the required one (1) stacking space behind each fuel service space for all 16 fuel pump stations. Additionally, the single lane drive-thru can provide 5 stacking spaces behind the pick-up window. While the order board is located on the southern end of the Property ancillary to the drive-thru lane, that area can also provide for at least 5 stacking spaces. Each stacking space measures 20 ft. in length. As required by BCZR, §409.10.B, the drive-thru lane will be distinctly marked by special striping or pavement markings and will not block entry to or exit from any off-street parking spaces.

All circulation, and drive aisle width requirements have also been met under BCZR, §405.4A.3 and §409.4.C with two-way drive aisles, the narrowest aisle width being 22 ft. wide on the western side. Mr. Rowe also prepared a truck-turning radius which shows ample space for a truck to enter, load, or unload and to turn around. (Pet. Ex. 8). (BCZR, §409.11). There are no dead-ends with the proposed design. (BCZR, §409.8.A.5). All surfaces will be paved for parking, driveway, aisles and stacking. (BCZR, §405.4.A.3.b; BCZR, §409.8.A.2). All parking spaces will be striped. (BCZR, §409.8.A.6). All parking spaces, along with a crosswalk, will be provided within 500 ft. of the building entrance. (BCZR, §409.7.B.1; BCZR, §409.10.B). Sidewalks will be installed along both North Point Blvd. and Wise Ave. (Pet. Ex. 1, 6). Bike racks will also be provided as recommended by DOP.

Using the street view photographs, Mr. Rowe described the Property and existing structures, only 1 of which will remain. (Pet. Ex. 5). He addressed the final design concept with a colored-rendering of the finished store. (Pet. Ex. 6). Mr. Rowe explained that the location of the

access easement along the rear boundary line, along with the 10 ft. sewer easement, shrinks the developable area for the proposed use. The proffered testimony was that, these easements, in combination with the Property being bound by streets on two fronts, requires additional requirements to be met for the proposed use (i.e., landscape buffer areas), further reducing the developable area.

Mr. Rowe testified that the proposed use here will have no greater impact than elsewhere in the same BR-AS zone. Consequently, he opined that, because the surrounding uses are commercial and industrial, this Sheetz will not be detrimental to the health, safety or general welfare of the locality involved. It will not create a potential hazard from fire, panic or other danger as the new store will meet all building and fire codes. This Sheetz will not tend to overcrowd the land, or cause undue concentration of population, as the design of the building, parking, drive-thru lane, and location of fuel pumps provides good circulation, with two (2) access drives into and out of the Property, one from North Point Blvd. and one from Wise Avenue. The Sheetz will connect to public water and sewer as there are no wells or septic systems on the Property. The new building will not exceed 26 ft. in height and therefore will not interfere with light or air as the permitted height is 40 ft. The BR-AS zoning classification is one of the most intense zoning classifications and the AS overlay is specifically for automotive uses. The Sheetz design is an automotive intense use in that it sells fuel and encourages drive-thru food ordering. The use will not be inconsistent with impermeable surface and vegetative retention provisions as a Landscape Plan will be filed, ensuring that all landscaped buffer areas required for fuel service stations will be met and maintained. Lastly, Mr. Rowe confirmed that there are no environmental issues or natural resources on the Property.

In regard to abandoned fuel service stations within the area, based on his personal observations, Mr. Rowe prepared an exhibit showing that there are no abandoned fuel service stations with a ½ mile or a 1 mile radius. (Pet. Ex. 3B). (BCZR, §405.3). Summarily, Mr. Rowe opined that the proposed use of a fuel service station, carry-out restaurant and convenience store meets each of the BCZR, §502.1 Special Exception factors, as well as the requirements of BCZR, §405.2.B.1 and §405.4.E.1. He added that due to the length of time in which it typically takes to obtain permits and approvals, Petitioners are requesting that the Special Exception be valid for five (5) years. BCZR, §502.3.

Mr. Rowe testified that due to the Property's shape and its limited developable area caused by both the Access Easement and Sewer Easement, as well as the setback requirements generated by the adjoining roadways, the Property has unique physical features. Without the Access and/or Sewer Easements, 6 more parking spaces could be provided and no parking Variance would be needed. He emphasized that 37 off-street parking spaces are sufficient for this use as confirmed by Mr. Caloggero's Parking Analysis. Moreover, the addition of the drive-thru lane further reduces the need for 43 parking spaces as it encourages customers to remain in their vehicles. At most, customers accessing the fuel pumps and/or convenience store on average, complete their transactions within 15 minutes.

He opined that these unique physical features of the Property made the placement of the Sheetz building, the drive-thru and order board, fuel pumps, required parking and stacking spaces, as well as the landscape transition areas on the Property, more challenging. Consequently, the proposed 4th enterprise sign on the building in lieu of the permitted 3 signs, with no more than 2 signs on each building façade, is needed to properly identify the convenience store and restaurant (carry-out or dine-in) (Sign Types A, B). The remaining sign Variances being requested are for

the drive-thru lane and order board (Signs 6, 7, 9A, 9B and 10). Because there will be multiple uses operating simultaneously on the Property, visually it is helpful for safety reasons to have larger and taller signs. Specifically, for directional Signs 6, 7, 9A, 9B, the proffered testimony was that height and the area/face of those signs need to be larger to direct traffic safely to the food ordering area. Similarly, the touch-screen order board is not located along the drive-thru lane, and there are no employees taking food orders. Accordingly, those signs need to be 1 ft. taller so customers know where the order board is. (Sign 10). It was further proffered that the requested Variance relief for the signs are directly connected to the unique physical features of the Property. Accordingly, it was alleged that there would be no impact on health, safety or general welfare if parking and sign variances were granted.

Joseph Caloggero, PE of The Traffic Group was accepted as an expert in traffic engineering. (Pet. Ex. 10). In regard to the parking Variance, the total number of spaces required for this use is 43 spaces, calculated as: convenience store/fuel service station (6,139 sf) – 5/1000 sf = 31; outdoor seating area 380 sf – 5/1000 sf = 2 spaces; 1 space per employee on largest shift = 7 spaces; 1 space per ATM = 1 space; and 1 space per air machine = 2 spaces. As per the Amended Petition, Petitioners are providing 37 spaces. There will be 2 handicap parking spaces provided. (BCZR, §409.9). Mr. Caloggero prepared a Parking Analysis dated November 14, 2024 wherein he studied four (4) Sheetz locations in Frederick County using drone footage to determine the number of occupied parking spaces. (Pet. Ex, 11). The results of the Parking Analysis indicated that the required 43 parking spaces equates to 7 spaces per 1,000 sf, and the number of spaces proposed here is 6.02 spaces per 1,000 sf. (Pet. Ex. 10). After analyzing the drone footage of those other Sheetz locations, he confirmed that the highest average 15 min. parking peak rate was 3.76 vehicles/sf and 4.06 vehicles/sf which occurred during the mid-day peak hours. Thus,

The concluded that, because the highest average of 15 minute parkers is 24 and 25 vehicles, the proposed parking spaces of 37 being provided is more than sufficient. Mr. Caloggero added that the Property is not located within a failing traffic shed on the 2024 Basic Services Map. He opined that the proposed Sheetz will not cause congestion in the roads, streets or alley including either North Point Blvd. or Wise Avenue.

SPECIAL EXCEPTION

Under Maryland law, a special exception use enjoys a presumption that it is in the interest of the general welfare, and therefore, valid. *Schultz v. Pritts*, 291 Md. 1 (1981). The *Schultz* standard was revisited in *Attar v. DMS Tollgate*, *LLC*, 451 Md. 272 (2017), where the court of appeals discussed the nature of the evidentiary presumption in special exception cases. The court again emphasized a special exception is properly denied only when there are facts and circumstances showing that the adverse impacts of the use at the particular location in question would be above and beyond those inherently associated with the special exception use.

Based on the uncontroverted evidence in this Case, I find that the Special Exception request to use this Property as a fuel service station in combination with a convenience store and carry-out restaurant with a gross-floor area larger than 6,000 sf, satisfies the requirements of BCZR §502.1 as well as the requirements of BCZR, §405 and §409. Therefore the Special Exception should be granted. Specifically, I find that the proposed use will not have any greater impact at this location than those inherently associated with the Special Exception use elsewhere within the BR-AS zone. I further find that it is reasonable to allow the Special Exception to remain valid for a period of five (5) years as there will be many permits and approvals which will need to be obtained for these multiple uses.

Specifically, as required by BCZR, §405.2.B.1, this fuel service station is located within the Urban-Rural Demarcation Line ("URDL"), in an A.S. District, and no part of the Property is located in a Manufacturing, Restricted (M.R.) Zone. Additionally, Petitioners provided persuasive evidence that there are no abandoned fuel service stations, as defined in BCZR, §405.7, within a one-half-mile radius, or two such stations within a one-mile radius of this Property.

As required in BCZR, §405.4.E.1, a fuel service station in combination with a convenience store and carry-out restaurant, with a gross floor area larger than 6,000 square feet is permitted provided it meets the Special Exception factors in BCZR, §502.1. In regard to those factors, I find that the proposed Sheetz fuel service station in combination with a convenience store and carry out restaurant will not be detrimental to the health, safety or general welfare of the locality. Here, the limited 2.14 acres of net area (which is also the Special Exception area) was drawn by both the Access Easement and Sewer Easement. I find that the proposed use will not tend to create congestion on either Wise Avenue and North Point Blvd., or tend to overcrowd the land, particularly in light of the stacking spaces allotted for the fuel pumps and drive-thru lane, as well as the efficient access and circulation plan. (Pet. Ex. 1). I further find that the proposed use will not create a potential hazard from fire or other danger as all construction will meet all applicable codes and regulations. The proposed use will not interfere with adequate provisions for water, sewerage, or transportation because the Property will connect to public water and sewer. The Property is not located within a deficient area on the 2024 Basic Services Map. Likewise, there is no interference with light or air as the new store, at 22 ft. in height, will be below the permitted height of 40 ft.

The proposed use is certainly within the BR-AS zoning classification which is one of the most intense zones and is therefore consistent with that zone and overlay district. With this BR-AS zone, the County Council contemplated that a fuel service station, convenience store and carryout restaurant were potential uses for this Property. Consequently, there is a presumption of validity for this proposed use, on this Property, which is not adjoining any residential properties.

In regard to impermeable surface and vegetative retention provisions and impacts on environmental features, the evidence is clear that the Property meets the BCZR provisions in this regard. There are no environmental features on the Property. The use will require the approval of a Landscape Plan. Accordingly, the Special Exception relief will be granted.

VARIANCES

Under BCZR, §307, and Maryland common law, in order to be entitled to variance relief the Petitioners must satisfy a two-step legal analysis, summarized as follows:

- (1) It must be shown the property is unique in a manner which makes it unlike surrounding properties, and that uniqueness or peculiarity is what necessitates the requested variance relief; and
- (2) If variance relief is denied, Petitioner will experience a practical difficulty or hardship.

Cromwell v. Ward, 102 Md. App. 691 (1995).

As explained above, the Property is unique due to its irregular shape, and the presence of the Access Easement and Sewer Easement along the rear Property, both of which reduce the developable area. With regard to the requested Parking Variance, the existence of a drive-thru lane in itself effectively reduces the number of parking spaces actually needed for a carryout restaurant. The BCZR parking regulations do not account for the increased use of drive-thrus in recent years which improve efficiency of traffic flow and reduce the number of dine-in customers. I note the use of a touch-screen ordering and apps which allow for preordering of food, add to this efficiency.

Moreover, the Parking Analysis of 4 other Sheetz locations was persuasive in that at best, 26 parking spaces are actually occupied and 37 are proposed here. For this type of use, customers are generally considered to be passerby's, with an average stop of 15 minutes. Thus, I find that Petitioners would suffer a practical difficulty and unreasonable hardship if the parking Variance for 6 spaces were not granted.

Pertaining to the sign Variances, it is also clear that they are needed to direct customers within the Property, particularly given the multiple, simultaneous uses. I find that the Petitioners would suffer a practical difficulty and unreasonable hardship if the proposed sign Variances were not granted because there is an obvious safety issue from these simultaneous uses which can be minimized if customers know where to drive within the site. I also find that all of the requested Variance relief can be granted in strict harmony with the spirit and intent of the BCZR and without injury to the health, safety or general welfare, particularly in light of the lack of opposition.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the Administrative Law Judge for Baltimore County, this <u>21st</u> day of **January**, 2025 that the Petition for Special Exception BCZR, §405.2B.1 and §405.4.E.1, to allow a fuel service station on an individual site in combination with a convenience store and carry-out restaurant with a gross floor area larger than 6,000 sf in the BR-AS zone be, and it is hereby, **GRANTED**; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, pursuant to BCZR, §502.3, the Special Exception is valid for a period of five (5) years from the date of this Order; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Variance relief from the BCZR, §409.6 to allow a total of 37 off-street parking spaces in lieu of the required 43 parking spaces, be, and it is hereby **GRANTED**; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Variance relief from BCZR, §450.4. Table of Sign Regulations 5(a), to allow a total of four wall-mounted enterprise signs for a single tenant building in lieu of the three signs permitted, with no more than two signs on each facade (Sign Types A, B) be, and it is hereby, **GRANTED**; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Variance relief from BCZR, §450.4.Table of Sign Regulations 3(a), to allow freestanding directional signs with a sign height of 13 and 14 ft. in lieu of the permitted 6 ft. (Sign Types 6,7,9A/B) be, and it is hereby, **GRANTED**; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Variance relief from BCZR, § 4504.Table of Sign Regulations 3(a), to allow sign areas/faces of 9, 11 and 17 sf in lieu of the permitted 8 sf (Sign Types 6, 7, 9A/B) be, and it is hereby, **GRANTED**; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Variance relief from BCZR, §450.4.Table of Sign Regulations. 5(f) to allow an order board ancillary to a drive-through lane with a height of 7 ft. in lieu of the permitted 6 ft. (Sign Type 10) be, and it is hereby, **GRANTED**.

The relief granted herein shall be subject to the following:

- 1. Petitioners may apply for necessary permits and/or licenses upon receipt of this Order. However, Petitioners are hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at their own risk until 30 days from the date hereof, during which time an appeal can be filed by any party. If for whatever reason this Order is reversed, Petitioners would be required to return the subject property to its original condition.
- 2. The Site Plan (Pet. Ex. 1) which is attached hereto shall be incorporated herein.
- 3. Prior to issuance of permits, Petitioners must comply with the ZAC comments made by DPR and DEPS which are attached hereto, incorporated herein and made a part hereof.
- 4. There shall not be any inoperable, untagged or unlicensed vehicles parked at the Property.
- 5. Pursuant to BCZR, §405.4.C.3, the Property shall be maintained in a clean and orderly condition. All landscaped areas shall be irrigated as needed and dead plants replaced. The responsibility for compliance with this condition lies with all parties

that individually or collectively have a lease or ownership interest in the fuel service station.

Any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

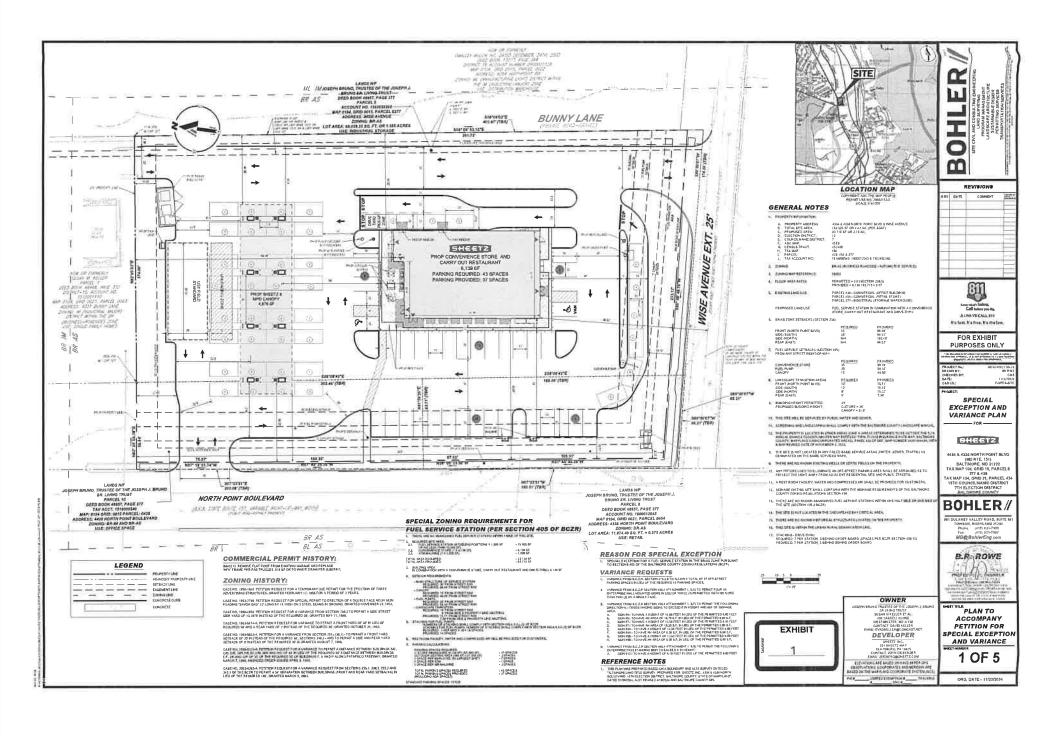

The Bureau of Development Plans Review has reviewed the subject zoning items and we have the following comments.

Variance – Relief from Baltimore County Zoning Regulations:

- 2. Section 450.4 table of sign regulations 5(a) to allow a total of four wall-mounted enterprise signs for a single tenant building in lieu of the three signs permitted, with no more than two signs per façade (Sign Types A, B).

Special Exception – Under section 405.2.B.1 and 405.4.E.1 of the Zoning Regulations of Baltimore County, to determine whether or not the Zoning Commissioner should allow a fuel service station, on an individual site, in combination with a convenience store and carry-out restaurant, with a gross floor area larger than 6,000 square feet in the BR-AS Zone.

The Department of Planning has reviewed the petition for the following:

Variance(s) -

- 1. From Section 409.6 to allow a total of 36 off-street parking spaces in lieu of the required 43 parking spaces.
- 2. From Section 450.4 table of sign regulations 5(a) to allow a total of four wall-mounted enterprise signs for a single tenant building in lieu of the three signs permitted, with no more than two signs per façade (Sign Types A, B).
- 3. From Section 450.4 table of sign regulations 5(a) to allow free standing directional signs with a sign height of 13 and 14 in lieu of the permitted 6 feet (Sign Types 6, 7, 9A/B).
- 4. From Section 450.4, sign regulations 3(a) to allow sign areas/faces of 9, 11 and 17 square feet in lieu of the permitted 8 square feet (Sign Types 6, 7, 9A/B).
- 5. For any further relief that may be deemed necessary by the Administrative Law Judge.

Special Exception – Under section 405.2.B.1 and 405.4.E.1 of the Zoning Regulations of Baltimore County, to determine whether or not the Zoning Commissioner should allow a fuel service station, on an individual site, in combination with a convenience store and carry-out restaurant, with a gross floor area larger than 6,000 square feet in the BR-AS Zone.

The subject site is 4.42-acre parcel at the corner of North Point Boulevard and Wise Avenue in Dundalk. The site is currently improved with an office building, retail building and storage warehouse. The owners are looking to raze the existing buildings and construct a fuel service station with a 6,139 square foot carry-out and convenience store.

The Department of Planning offers the following recommendations regarding the proposed site plan submitted with this request:

1. The dumpster location should be located in an area that minimizes public view. Relocate the currently proposed dumpster from the corner of North Point Boulevard and Wise Avenue to Bunny Lane in the North Eastern corner of the site.

- 2. Provide enhanced landscaping along North Point Boulevard and Wise Avenue.
- 3. The development should comply with CMDP, Division III. Commercial Development within the Urban Rural Demarcation Line, Section B. Freestanding; specifically:
 - b. SITE PLANNING (g) For sites with combined refueling station and convenience store uses, the convenience store should front to the road, with refueling stations either to the side or behind the storefront in order to reduce the vehicular dominance of the use. There should also be a pedestrian pathway that directly connects the convenience store to sidewalks along the major roadway.
 - c. LANDSCAPING (c) Screening/buffering of major roadways; and (f) Adequate landscape screening along the drive-thru lanes that does not block the line of sight.
 - d. CIRCULATION (f) Provide bike racks near the proposed building.

The Department of Planning has no objections to the requested Special Exception and Variance relief pending the site plan issues are addressed to create a better design. The requested land use and proposed signage are similar to that of a fuel service station, convenience store, and carry-out located at the same intersection just opposite of this site. Additionally, the signage appears to be appropriately scaled to the building façade and seems to provide the necessary identification and advertising for the overall site.
