PRE-BID QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

QUESTION 1:

- Can you clarify if the use of steam cure CIPP is allowed on this project? The specification states that steam cure is allowed, but the prebid meeting minutes distributed with addendum 2 mentions that steam cure is not allowed. Please clarify.
- Additionally, the prebid meeting minutes state that the curing process shall be water cure, but the specifications only mention steam cure and UV cure as allowable. Please clarify which curing methods are and are not allowed on this project.

ANSWER 1:

Steam cure and UV cure are allowable methods, per the specifications. Water cure is allowable upon request where the contractor deems it necessary; however, there will be no additional compensation for water cure.
