Pre-Bid Meeting Notes
August 11, 2025

- The Shallow Creek Maintenance Dredging Project includes channels as well as up to 8 spurs. This includes the dredging by mechanical method, transportation, and placement at the Cox Creek DMCF by mechanical or hydraulic means. Baltimore County will pay the associated tipping fee to MPA.
- The Shallow Creek Maintenance Dredging Project is partially funded by DNR Waterway Improvement Grants.
- The Bid Opening is August 26, 2025 at 10:30 am.
- Notice to Proceed should be issued around October 2, 2025 – the selected contractor should plan to begin dredging as soon as the permit windows allow on October 16, 2025.
- This is a 122 calendar day job – Federal and State permits restrict dredging of the Shallow Creek channels and spurs from February 15 to October 15, inclusive of any year. All dredging work must be completed prior to February 14, 2026.
- No additional payment will be made for further mobilization and demobilization necessitated by T.O.Y. closures.
- Construction is permitted 6 days a week (Monday – Saturday). Except for emergencies additional working hours must be requested in writing and approved by the County.
- The Contractor must comply with the prevailing wage rates and instructions for this project.
- The total estimated quantities on the Contract Drawings are only estimates. It is the Contractor's responsibility to verify the depths, character, quality and quantity of the material to be dredged.
- The Low Bid contractor must submit a Placement Operations Plan to Baltimore County and Maryland Port Administration for review and approval prior to placement.
- A pre-con meeting with MPA and MES operations is required prior to commencement.
- The County's representative will stake out the channel. A preconstruction meeting will be conducted to approve the layout. The County's representative will provide the stakes, however, the contractor is responsible for maintaining the stakes until authorized to remove them.

- Side slopes are to be 1 foot vertically to 3 feet horizontally. The channel will be staked out to bottom width.
- A post dredge survey conducted by the County's representative will be used to determine if the work meets the minimum depth and width specified. Additionally, the benchmarks shown on the drawings will be the sole datum used for measuring the work. No other benchmarks will be used.
- The County will not pay for overdredging. The contractor will comply with the maximum depth permitted. The maximum depth is 0.5 feet below the depth specified for each channel segment on the drawings.
- The contractor shall complete daily reports and provide them to the inspector prior to request for payment.
- The contractor shall take all necessary steps to comply with the MPA ROE.
- Spurs will be bid on individually as a lump sum for each one. The County will provide that bid amount to the spur's owner who will at that time determine if they want to proceed with the work.
- The spurs will be staked out by the contractor.
- Each spur will be verified by the County in accordance with the drawings. All changes to the dimensions must be approved by the County.
- The MPA ROE requires a pre and post survey of the unloading area to determine if there has been any spillage or misplaced dredge material. The survey will be conducted by the County representative and paid for by the County.
